ART PARAKHOUSKI • C Sr. • Radford Minsk, Belarus

Parakhouski averaged points, 9.0 rebounds and 3.0 blocks in three games, shot 74.4 percent from the field (29-of-39), 77.8 percent from the charity stripe (21of-27) and posted back-to-back 30-point efforts. He opened the week with 14 points and eight rebounds at Louisville, then poured in 34 points in Radford's 27-point win over George Mason on 11-of-15 shooting from the field and 12-of-15 at the line. Parakhouski added 12 rebounds and five blocked shots against the Patriots, and scored 20 second-half points. He backed the effort with 31 points against UNC Asheville this past Saturday, hitting 12-of-13 from the floor and adding seven rebounds and two blocks. He also scored 16 of Radford's final 26 points in the win over the Bulldogs.

THE CRONS BRAND Freshman of the **W**eek

EVAN GORDON G • Liberty Indianapolis, Ind.

Gordon averaged 16.0 points, 3.3 rebounds, 3.0 assists, shot 50.0 percent from the floor (18-of-36) and 85.7 percent from the line (6-of-7) in three games for the Flames. After collecting seven points, five rebounds and two assists against UCF on Dec. 29, he tallied a team-high 17 points against Buffalo on Dec. 30, going 3-of-6 from beyond the arc and 7-of-12 overall from the field, in addition to two steals. Gordon led Liberty to its victory over VMI this past Saturday with a career-high 24 points on 9-of-13 shooting (=69.2 percent). He also handed out six assists and blocked one shot against the Keydets.

3-0 STARTS

Coastal Carolina and Radford are both 3-0 in Big South games for the first time in several years. The last time the Chanticleers started 3-0 in League play was in 1996-97, and it is their sixth time overall. The Highlanders are 3-0 for the first time since the 2000-01 season and the fifth time in program history. The last time the Big South had two teams open 3-0 in Conference action was in 2006-07 (Winthrop and High Point), and this is the second time that Coastal Carolina and Radford have opened 3-0 in the same year. The first time was in 1990-91 when the Chants started 11-0 in Big South action and the Highlanders opened 6-0.

COASTAL CAROLINA CRACKS MID-MAJOR POLL

Coastal Carolina is ranked No. 21 in this week's Collegeinsider.com Mid-Major Top 25 poll, up four spots from last week's initial appearance at No. 25. Radford was ranked in the Mid-Major Top 25 poll for the first three weeks of the season and has received votes in all but one week. This is the sixth consecutive year that the Big South has had a team ranked in the Mid-Major Top 25, and the second-straight season that more than one team entered the poll. MAKING WAVES

Coastal Carolina is off to its best start in school history at 13-2, bettering the previous best of 10-2 which was accomplished by the 1981-82 Chanticleers. Coastal Carolina, which received a vote in the Dec. 14 ESPN/USA Today Coaches' poll, is the second Big South team in as many years to open the season 13-2, as the VMI Keydets opened the 2008-09 campaign with a 14-2 mark.

SECOND... FOR NOW

Coastal Carolina redshirt-senior JOSEPH HARRIS moved into second-place on the Big South's all-time rebounding list Dec. 29 vs. Georgia Southern, surpassing Campbell's JOE SPINKS' career total of 954. Harris, who opened the season tied for seventh on the League's career rebounding chart, jumped into third-place after just four games and is now second with 968 career rebounds. He needs 46 rebounds to break the Big South career record of 1,013, which was set by High Point's ARIZONA REID just two seasons ago. Harris is on pace to break the record on Jan. 16 at home against High Point and he needs 32 rebounds to become the Big South's second player in history with 1,000 points and 1,000 rebounds.

ELDER STATESMAN

Coastal Carolina head coach CLIFF ELLIS needs one more victory for 650 in his collegiate coaching career, as he owns a lifetime record of 649-386. Ellis has amassed 571 Division I victories, which ranks 11th on the NCAA's active win list. Coastal Carolina's 13 wins this season already exceed last year's total (11) and equals Ellis' win total in his first season as the Chanticleers coach in 2007-08.

BULLETIN BOARD MATERIAL

Radford's ART PARAKHOUSKI became the third player this season and 54th in League history to reach 500 career rebounds when he eclipsed the milestone at Louisville on Dec. 27 -- in just his 43rd career game with the Highlanders. He is officially the Big South's career leader for rebounds per game, as the category is based on a minimum of 500 rebounds. Below is a look at the Big South's active players with 500 rebounds, their rank in League annals, and their current career per game average, through games of Jan. 2:

Based on this season's averages, Harris is on pace to finish with 1,140 career rebounds and Parakhouski is on track to amass 740 in just two seasons. Meanwhile, Daniels needs 36 rebounds to become the 29th player in Big South history with 600 and is on pace for 668 in his career, while Lynch-Flohr is projected to finish with 659 rebounds.

SEEING TRIPLE

The Big South had its second triple-double in a three-week span as Liberty senior **KYLE OHMAN** tallied 16 points, 12 rebounds and 10 assists in the Flames' 110-102 victory at VMI on Jan. 2. It is the sixth triple-double in Big South history, and the third by a Liberty player. On Dec. 12, Flames sophomore guard **JESSE SANDERS** finished with 11 points, 10 rebounds and 10 assists against Kentucky Christian to become the first player in both League annals and Liberty history with two career triple-doubles. He recorded one last season against Presbyterian College on Feb. 9 (10 points, 10 rebounds, 10 assists).

A WORK OF ART

Radford center **ART PARAKHOUSKI** is third in the nation in rebounding at 12.8 per game and is on pace to break his Big South single-season record of 369 rebounds, which he set last season. If he should continue at his current pace of 12.8 rebounds in Radford's next 17 games, Parakhouski would finish with 370 rebounds through the quarterfinals of the Advance Auto Parts Big South Men's Basketball Championship. His per game average is pacing ahead of the League record of 11.4.

Meanwhile, Gardner-Webb senior **GRAYSON FLITTNER** eclipsed 1,000 career points Nov. 21 against Methodist College, and has 1,111 points in his career (492 as a Big South member).

A RARE TRIPLE CROWN AND A POSSIBLE FIRST

Radford senior **ART PARAKHOUSKI** currently leads the Big South in scoring (23.6), rebounding (12.8) and field goal percentage (62.9), and is looking to become just the second player in Big South history to lead the League in all three categories. The first was High Point's **DANNY GATHINGS** in 2002-03 with averages of 18.7 points, 7.6 rebounds and 57.1 percent from the field. Should Parakhouski maintain his averages for the duration of the season, he would become the first player in Big South history to average 20.0 points and 60.0 percent from the field (based on 5.0 field goals per game) in the same season.

CRUZZING ALTITUDE

High Point 6-11 redshirt-senior **CRUZ DANIELS** is second all-time in Big South history with 253 career blocked shots. He has recorded a blocked shot in a career-high 17 consecutive games -- bettering his previous career-long streak of 10 games, and is averaging 2.88 blocks in his current string (49 total). Daniels, who has blocked at least five shots in a game 15 times in his career, is one of just three players in Big South history with 500 career rebounds and 200 career blocked shots, joining Liberty's **PETER ALUMA** (1994-97) and Radford's **TYRONE TRAVIS** (1989-94).

ANOTHER HARRIS MAKING A NAME FOR HIMSELF

High Point senior **EUGENE HARRIS** is the Big South's active three-point field goal leader with a school-record 241 -- good for 11th in Big South history, and just one away from cracking the League's all-time top 10 in the category. He also has 230 career assists, and is on track to become just the fifth player in Big South history with 250 career three-pointers and 250 career assists. The other four are Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** (411 3FG, 353 AST), UNC Greensboro's **SCOTT HARTZELL** (309 3FG, 552 AST), VMI's **CHAVIS HOLMES** (306 3FG, 313 AST) and UNC Asheville's **JOSH KOHN** (296 3FG, 430 AST).

BLOCK STEADY

UNC Asheville redshirt-junior **JOHN WILLIAMS** has blocked a shot in his last 10 games (28 total) and has swatted away 155 shots in his career, tied for 12th in Big South history. He needs eight blocked shots to move into a tie for 10th all-time in League annals. Williams, who blocked a personal-best 76 shots last season, needs 45 rejections to become just the fifth player in Big South history with 200 career blocked shots. Meanwhile, Coastal Carolina's **JOSEPH HARRIS** is tied for 19th in League history with a school-record 122 career blocks.

FLOOR GENERAL

Radford senior **AMIR JOHNSON** needs eight assists to become the 10th player in Big South history with 500 in a career. He is currently 10th all-time on the Big South's career assist list with 492, and is on his way to becoming just the eighth Big South player with 1,000 career points and 500 career assists. In addition, Johnson needs 75 assists to reach the League's all-time record of 567, which is held by Winthrop's **CHRIS GAYNOR** (2004-08). Meanwhile, Johnson leads the Big South with 5.40 assists per game and is looking to become the first player since **Charleston Southern's ED O'NEIL** in 2001-02 and 2002-03 to lead the Big South in assists in back-to-back seasons.

COAST-TO-COAST

Coastal Carolina leads the Big South in field goal percentage (50.1) and field goal defense (37.5) and could become the first team in Big South history to shoot better than 50 percent from the field and hold its opponents below 40 percent in the same season. The last NCAA Division I program to accomplish this feat was 2008 National Champion Kansas (50.8 FG%, 37.9 FG% defense). In addition, Coastal Carolina could become the first Big South team to shoot at least 50.0 percent from the floor since Radford in 1993-94 (50.2 percent).

SCOREBOARD WATCHING

Defending three-time NCAA scoring champion VMI leads the nation in scoring with an average of 94.0 points per game. The Keydets are looking to become the first team in NCAA Division I history to lead the country in scoring four consecutive seasons. VMI, Furman (1952-55) and Loyola Marymount (1987-90) are the only programs to lead the nation three-straight years.

TWO OF CLUBS

Coastal Carolina's **JOSEPH HARRIS**, who became the 94th player in Big South history with 1,000 career points when he surpassed the milestone Nov. 21, is just the second player in Big South history with 1,000 points, 900 rebounds, 150 steals and 100 blocked shots. Harris joins Campbell's **JOE SPINKS** in the exclusive club, as Spinks accumulated 1,711 points, 954 rebounds, 220 steals and 155 blocks for the Camels from 1990-94.

THIS EAGLE IS CLOSE TO LANDING INTO DEFENSIVE CLUB

Winthrop's **MANTORIS ROBINSON** recorded his 100th career steal Dec. 12 in the Eagles' victory over Barton College. He is approaching 500 career rebounds (464) and 100 career blocked shots (75) as well, and should he reach both milestones, he would become just the eighth player in Big South history with 500 rebounds, 100 steals and 100 blocks. Robinson is trying to become the third Winthrop player with 100 steals and 500 rebounds.

HE IS THE ONLY ONE

Radford's **ART PARAKHOUSKI** is the lone Big South men's basketball player to score in double figures in all of his team's games this season, and owns the Big South's longest double-figure scoring streak in the Big South at 14 games, dating back to 2008-09.

38 SPECIAL

Radford's **JOEY LYNCH-FLOHR** became the fourth player this season and 96th overall in Conference history with 1,000 career points in the Big South when he surpassed the milestone Dec. 13 against Roanoke College. In addition, Lynch-Flohr is now the 38th member of the League's 1,000-point/500-rebound club. Teammate **ART PARAKHOUSKI** (816 points, 522 rebounds) is on track to join both clubs before the season is complete.

AUSTIN'S THREE-POINT POWER BARRAGE

Will junior **AUSTIN KENON** became the 24th player in Big South history with 200 career three-point field goals when he reached the milestone Dec. 12 at Seton Hall. Kenon now qualifies for the Big South's career record for three-pointers per game, which is based on 200 career treys. He has made a three-pointer in 56 of his 59 career games and has made 207 total for a 3.51 per game average, which matches the current Big South career record of 3.51, set by Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** from 2004-08. Meanwhile, Kenon's teammate **KEITH GABRIEL** has drained a three-pointer in 38 of his 43 career games and already has 130 in his career, an average of 3.02 per game.

NOT DOGGING IT

Gardner-Webb senior **GRAYSON FLITTNER** needs 41 three-point field goals to become Gardner-Webb's all-time leader, as the current record of 276 was established by **JAMES COLWELL** from 1998-02. This season, 74.4 percent of Flittner's field goals have been from beyond the arc (32 of 43).

The Radford Highlanders extended their Conference road win streak to 11 following their nail-biting victories at Winthrop and Presbyterian College in early December. Radford's Conference road winning streak is the longest in the Big South since Winthrop won 11 consecutive League road contests from Jan. 10, 2005 to Jan. 30, 2006. The Highlanders return to the road this week, beginning Saturday at High Point.

ARTISTIC IMPRESSION

Radford center **ART PARAKHOUSKI** played his seventh opponent from a power Conference when Radford visited Louisville on Dec. 27. He owns a career average of 16.0 points and 11.3 rebounds against these nationally-regarded programs, with five double-doubles. Below is a closer look at his efforts.

FROM THE LAND OF THREE...

Charleston Southern's **JAMARCO WARREN** became the 25th player in Big South history with 200 career three-pointers when he reached the milestone at College of Charleston on Dec. 16. He now has 219 treys in his career. Liberty's **KYLE OHMAN** follows Warren on the League's active three-point list with 188. Warren's consecutive games streak with a three-pointer ended at 40 games when he went 0-of-2 at Virginia Tech on Dec. 19, ending a run in which he was 129-of-326 (=39.6 percent). Warren has started a new streak and is 18-of-38 (=47.4 percent) from beyond the arc in his current three-game string.

TRIFECTA

Radford 6-8 junior forward **LAZAR TRIFUNOVIC**, who missed the first four games of the season due to injury, made his season debut Dec. 3 at Winthrop and showed some early rust in his first three games in the lineup with averages of 10.3 points, 6.3 rebounds and 32.5 percent from the field (13-of-40) in that span. However, in the last five games, Trifunovic is averaging 15.2 points, 11.8 rebounds, 3.2 assists and 54.2 percent shooting (32-of-59) with four double-doubles. For the season (eight games), he is averaging 13.2 points, 9.8 rebounds and 45.5 percent from the field, which would rank 13th, 3rd and 6th, respectively, among the Big South leaders if he met the games played requirement of 75 percent of his team's games. Trifunovic is four games away from qualifying for the leaders (12 of 16 games).

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE ROAD

The road teams have claimed seven of the 14 Big South games played thus far this season, exactly half. The success continues a trend that began last year in which the road teams won 42 of the 90 total Big South games played for a .467 winning percentage away from home.

CLOSE AND NOT SO CLOSE

Seven of the first 14 Big South Conference games have been decided by less than 10 points, with the average margin of victory in those games being 4.6. Of the games decided by more than 10 points, the average margin of victory is 13.0 points. The overall margin of victory in League play stands at 8.8 points. Coastal Carolina has won each of its three Big South games by at least 10 points, the only Big South member to do so, and is enjoying a 13.0 margin of victory thus far in League play.

STEADY EDDIE

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** is second all-time in League history with 107 career regular-season Big South wins, and needs just three League victories to surpass former Radford mentor **RON BRADLEY** as the all-time leader. Bradley had 109 regular-season Big South wins from 1991-02. Meanwhile, with 184 wins at Asheville, Biedenbach is 10 wins shy of tying former Winthrop coach **GREGG MARSHALL** as the Big South's all-time winningest coach. Marshall won 194 games in nine seasons as the Eagles' head coach from 1998-07.

SPEAKING OF WINNING COACHES...

VMI head coach **DUGGAR BAUCOM** won his 100th game as a collegiate head coach when the Keydets defeated Charleston Southern on Dec. 5. It was his 63rd as VMI's head coach, and he is already the fifth-winningest coach in VMI history after just four-plus years at the helm.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern split a pair of games during the holiday break, falling at Auburn and winning in overtime vs. Presbyterian College ... The Bucs led the majority of the first half against the Tigers and were down by three at intermission ... JAMARCO WARREN tied his career-high with 37 points against PC, his second consecutive home game with 37. He hit a three-pointer with 2.2 seconds on the clock that sent the game into OT ... KELVIN MARTIN posted a double-double against the Blue Hose with 17 points and 12 rebounds ... JEREMY SEXTON scored six of his 15 points in the extra session.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina enters the week on a nine-game win streak, its longest since a 12-game streak from Jan. 24-March 2, 2006 ... CCU is 8-0 at home and is looking to go 9-0 at Kimbel Arena for the first time since 1990-91 ... For the first time in school history, the Chants finished the month of December with an unblemished record, going 7-0. The team had a +21.9 scoring margin and shot 55 percent from the field in those seven wins ... DANNY NIEMAN had four steals in the win over Winthrop, including a huge steal and layup to give Coastal a 43-38 lead with 6:29 remaining. He also had 10 points and a game-high six assists.

GARDNER-WEBB

Gardner-Webb has lost nine games in a row, its longest losing streak since the 2002-03 season (11 games) ... **C.J. HAILEY** had a game-high 20 points and made 5-of-5 three point shots at No. 2 Texas ... **GRAYSON FLITTNER** came off the bench for the first time since his freshman season at Texas and finished the game with 12 points on 4-of-8 shooting. He followed with 26 points and six three-pointers this past Saturday at High Point.

HIGH POINT

High Point is 5-0 at home this season ... The Panthers opened up Conference play with two wins in their first three games for the first time since 2006-07, when they went 4-0 en route to an 11-3 Big South record ... After no double-figure scoring efforts in his first nine games, **CRUZ DANIELS** has scored at least 10 points in three-straight games and had HPU's first double-double of the season with 12 points and 13 rebounds against North Carolina Central. He has raised his averages from 3.9 points to 6.3 and 4.6 rebounds to 5.8 in that span.

LIBERTY

KYLE OHMAN's triple-double against the Keydets this past Saturday marked the fourth in school history and the third in the program's Division I era ... Liberty's 110-102 win at VMI marked the first time the Flames reached the century mark in scoring since the 2008 Big South Tournament Quarterfinals (103 points vs. VMI), a span of 50 games.

PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE

CHASE HOLMES netted his third 20-point game of the season with 26 markers at Charleston Southern this past Saturday. He went 9-of-16 from the field. TRAVIS SMITH had a career-high 16 points against the Buccaneers, while JAKE TROYLI added 14. PC went to the charity stripe a season-high 33 times at CSU, hitting 25 attempts for a 75.8 success rate ... The 73 points scored against Charleston Southern was a season-high for PC ... The Blue Hose conclude their seven-game road trip Monday night at League-leading Coastal Carolina.

RADFORD

Radford has won 18 of its last 20 Big South regular-season contests and 21 of its last 23 against League foes (including postseason games) ... The Highlanders shot 70.8 percent (17-of-24) in the second half of their win over UNC Asheville, with **ART PARAKHOUSKI** hitting 8-of-8 ... Radford's frontcourt trio of Parakhouski (23.6 points/12.8 rebounds), **JOEY LYNCH-FLOHR** (13.6 points/6.9 rebounds) and **LAZ TRIFUNOVIC** (13.4 points/9.8 rebounds) account for 69.9 percent of the Highlanders' offense and 69.2 percent of their rebounds per game. Combined, Parakhouski, Lynch-Flohr and Trifunovic are averaging 50.6 points and 29.5 rebounds per game. To go along with their statistical output, the trio has combined for 15 double-doubles this season.

UNC ASHEVILLE

Slow starts hurt the Bulldogs in both losses last week. UNC Asheville fell behind 20-5 at Western Carolina and 24-8 on Saturday at Radford before rallying in both contests ... The Bulldogs have out-rebounded their last two opponents (43-29 at WCU and 37-33 at RU) ... Asheville is in the middle of a five games in 10 days stretch as it will play at High Point on Monday and then host Coastal Carolina (Thursday) and Charleston Southern (Saturday) ... SEAN SMITH is third all-time in school history with 159 three-pointers ... Freshman JARON LANE scored a career-high 12 points at Western Carolina ... The Bulldogs have had five players score in double figures the last two games.

VM

VMI is 3-2 in games when scoring 100 points ... The Keydets fell for the first time after leading at halftime (Liberty), and had been 4-0 when leading at the break ... **KEITH GABRIEL** led VMI with 27 points against the Flames, the sixth time this season he has led the team in scoring ... **AUSTIN KENON** moved past **RAMON WILLIAMS** for second-place in school history with 207 career three-pointers ... The Liberty game marked VMI's second game in a 21-day span and was the squad's first home game since Dec. 5.

WINTHROP

Winthrop enters this week's action on a four-game losing streak ... The Eagles face Charleston Southern Monday, a series dominated by Winthrop. WU has won 17 consecutive match-ups and 26 of the last 28 meetings. The last time Winthrop lost to CSU was in January 2002 ... While Winthrop has allowed a respectable 64 points per game during its current skid, the offense has managed just 51 points per game ... ROBBIE DREHER is the only Eagle to score in double figures in the last two games, including a career-high 14 at North Carolina State.
