JOEY LYNCH-FLOHR • F Sr. • Radford Fairfax, Va.

Lynch-Flohr averaged 22.0 points and 66.7 percent from the field in two games last week. He netted a career-high 26 points at No. 1-ranked Kansas in Radford's firstever meeting with the Javhawks. finishing the game 9-of-14 from the floor (=64.3 percent) and 7-of-9 from the line. Lynch-Flohr scored 13 of Radford's 18 first-half points, including his first career threepointer, while going 3-of-4 from the field and 7-of-9 from the line in the second stanza. On Sunday, he scored 18 points on 7-of-10 from the floor and 4-of-4 from the line in Radford's win over Roanoke College, including his 1,000th career point. For the week, Lynch-Flohr was 16-of-24 from the field (.667), 11-of-13 from the free throw line (.846) and averaged 4.5 rebounds and 1.0 steals.

THE CRONS BRAND FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

ANTWAN BURRUS F • Liberty Winterville, N.C.

Burrus scored a team-high 15 points, grabbed five rebounds, blocked one shot and went 7-of-10 from the field in just 12 minutes of action to lead the Flames past Kentucky Christian. He also added three offensive rebounds and was 1-of-1 at the line during his most extensive action of the season. Burrus was averaging 2.0 points and 0.8 rebounds entering the game against Kentucky Christian.

MAKING WAVES

Coastal Carolina has received a vote in this week's ESPN/USA Today Coaches' poll, and is tied with Northern lowa and Baylor for 49th in the coaches' rankings. The Chanticleers are the second Big South team in as many years to open the season 8-2, as the VMI Keydets opened the 2008-09 campaign with an 8-2 mark before winning another six-straight to go 14-2 after 16 contests. Coastal Carolina is off to its best start since opening the 1981-82 season at 10-2, and has won back-to-back Big South games by 14-or-more points for the first time since 2005-06, when the Chants defeated Winthrop 64-50 on Feb. 4 and High Point 78-60 on Feb. 6.

ARTISTIC IMPRESSION

Radford center **ART PARAKHOUSKI** played his sixth opponent from a power Conference last week when Radford visited No. 1 Kansas. After a slow start, Parakhouski finished with 21 points and 13 rebounds against the Jayhawks, and now owns a career average of 16.3 points and 11.8 rebounds against these nationally-regarded programs, with five double-doubles. Below is a closer look at his efforts.

A WORK OF ART

Radford center **ART PARAKHOUSKI** leads the nation in rebounding with 15.0 per game, and he is on pace to smash his Big South single-season record of 369 rebounds, which he set last season. If he should continue at his current pace, Parakhouski would finish with an astounding 450 rebounds -- just through the quarterfinals of the Advance Auto Parts Big South Men's Basketball Championship. The last NCAA Division I player to average 15.0 rebounds in a season was Alcorn State's **LARRY SMITH** in 1980 with 15.1.

TRIPLE THREAT

Liberty sophomore guard **JESSE SANDERS** recorded the fifth triple-double in Big South history this past Saturday with 11 points, 10 rebounds and 10 assists against Kentucky Christian. Sanders is the first player in both League annals and Liberty history with two career triple-doubles, as he recorded one last season against Presbyterian College on Feb. 9 (10 points, 10 rebounds, 10 assists).

CHIPPING AWAY

With 926 career rebounds, Coastal Carolina redshirt-senior **JOSEPH HARRIS** needs 29 boards to move into second-place on the Big South's all-time list. Harris, who opened the season tied for seventh on the League's career rebounding chart, jumped into third-place after just four games. He stands 88 rebounds shy of breaking the all-time record of 1,013, and if he continues his current pace of 11.0 rebounds a game, he will break the mark on Jan. 9 at Gardner-Webb. Harris needs 74 rebounds to become the Big South's second player in history with 1,000 points and 1,000 rebounds. Below is a look at the Conference's top 3 all-time rebounders.

Radford's **JOEY LYNCH-FLOHR** became the fourth player this season and 96th overall in Conference history with 1,000 career points in the Big South when he surpassed the milestone this past Sunday against Roanoke College. He is the 25th player in Radford history with 1,000 points, and is currently 23rd all-time on the school's list with 1,010. In addition, Lynch-Flohr is now the 38th member of the League's 1,000-point/500-rebound club. Teammate **ART PARAKHOUSKI** (713 points, 489 rebounds) is on track to join both clubs before the season is complete.

BULLETIN BOARD MATERIAL

Radford's **ART PARAKHOUSKI** is 11 rebounds away from becoming the third player this season and 54th in League history with 500 career rebounds, which could very well come Dec. 19 at James Madison in what would be his 42nd game at Radford. Meanwhile, High Point redshirt senior **CRUZ DANIELS** is currently tied for 46th in League history with 533 career rebounds, while Radford's **JOEY LYNCH-FLOHR** is 52nd all-time with 517 caroms.

Meanwhile, Gardner-Webb senior **GRAYSON FLITTNER** eclipsed 1,000 career points Nov. 21 against Methodist College, and has 1,055 points in his career (436 as a Big South member).

CRUZZIN'

High Point redshirt-senior **CRUZ DANIELS** is second all-time in Big South history with 243 career blocked shots. He has recorded a blocked shot in a career-high 13 consecutive games -- bettering his previous career-long streak of 10 games, and is averaging 3.00 blocks in his current string (39 total). Daniels, who has blocked at least five shots in a game 15 times in his career, is one of just three players in Big South history with 500 career rebounds and 200 career blocked shots, joining Liberty's **PETER ALUMA** (1994-97) and Radford's **TYRONE TRAVIS** (1989-94).

AUSTIN'S THREE-POINT POWER BARRAGE

VMI junior **AUSTIN KENON** became the 24th player in Big South history with 200 career three-point field goals when he reached the milestone this past Saturday at Seton Hall. Kenon now qualifies for the Big South's career record for three-pointers per game, which is based on 200 career treys. He has made a three-pointer in 54 of his 57 career games and has made 201 total for a 3.53 per game average, which is pacing ahead of the current Big South career record of 3.51, set by Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** from 2004-08. Meanwhile, Kenon's teammate **KEITH GABRIEL** has drained a three-pointer in 36 of his 41 career games and has 119 already in his career, an average of 2.90 per game.

ANOTHER HARRIS MAKING A NAME FOR HIMSELF

High Point senior **EUGENE HARRIS** is the Big South's active three-point field goal leader with a school-record 232, and he is 10 away from cracking the League's all-time top 10 in the category. He also has 221 career assists, and is on track to become just the fifth player in Big South history with 250 career three-pointers and 250 career assists. The other four are Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** (411 3FG, 353 AST), UNC Greensboro's **SCOTT HARTZELL** (309 3FG, 552 AST), VMI's **CHAVIS HOLMES** (306 3FG, 313 AST) and UNC Asheville's **JOSH KOHN** (296 3FG, 430 AST).

FROM THE LAND OF THREE...

Charleston Southern's **JAMARCO WARREN**'s next three-point field goal will be the 200th of his career, which will make him the 25th player in Big South history with that many. He has made a three-point field goal in 39 consecutive games (127-of-320, .397 percent, 3.26 per game) and in 55 of his last 56 contests. Liberty's **KYLE OHMAN** follows Warren with 181 career threes. Meanwhile, in his last three games, UNC Asheville's **SEAN SMITH** is 15-of-27 from three-point range (=55.6 percent), which includes a 6-of-9 effort at Kentucky. Smith now has 154 career three-pointers, the third-most in UNC Asheville history.

BLOCK STEADY

UNC Asheville redshirt-junior **JOHN WILLIAMS** moved into a tie for 13th place in Big South history with 145 career blocked shots over the weekend. He is the Bulldogs' fifth player on the League's 100-career blocked shots list -- the most for one school in Big South history. Meanwhile, Coastal Carolina's **JOSEPH HARRIS** is 20th in League history with a school-record 118 career blocks.

FLOOR GENERAL

Radford senior **AMIR JOHNSON** moved into 10th place on the Big South's all-time assist list over the weekend with 474, and needs 26 to come the 10th player in Conference annals with 500 in a career. Johnson is 93 assists away from reaching the League's all-time record of 567 assists, which is held by Winthrop's **CHRIS GAYNOR** (2004-08). Johnson is averaging a career-best 6.00 assists per game this season, and is looking to become just the eighth Big South player with 1,000 career points and 500 career assists.

SCOREBOARD WATCHING

Three-time NCAA scoring champion VMI leads the nation in scoring in 2009-10 with an average of 94.0 points per game, ahead of Seton Hall's average of 90.8. The Keydets are looking to become the first team in NCAA Division I history to lead the country in scoring four consecutive seasons. VMI, Furman (1952-55) and Loyola Marymount (1987-90) are the only programs to lead in the nation three-straight

TWO OF CLUBS

Coastal Carolina's JOSEPH HARRIS, who became the 94th player in Big South history with 1,000 career points when he surpassed the milestone Nov. 21, is just the second player in Big South history with 1,000 points, 900 rebounds, 150 steals and 100 blocked shots. Harris joins Campbell's JOE SPINKS in the exclusive club, as Spinks accumulated 1,711 points, 954 rebounds, 220 steals and 155 blocks for the Camels from 1990-94.

SOARING TO NEW HEIGHTS

Winthrop's MANTORIS ROBINSON recorded his 100th career steal this past Saturday in the Eagles' victory over Barton College. He is closing in on 500 career rebounds (439) and 100 career blocked shots (74) as well. Robinson is eighth in the Big South this season with a career-high 6.4 rebounds per game, and has averaged 26.5 blocked shots the past two campaigns.

STEADY EDDIE

UNC Asheville head coach EDDIE BIEDENBACH is second all-time in League history with 107 career regular-season Big South wins, and needs just three League victories to surpass former Radford mentor RON BRADLEY as the all-time leader. Bradley had 109 regular-season Big South wins from 1991-02. Meanwhile, with 183 wins at Asheville, Biedenbach is 11 wins shy of tying former Winthrop coach GREGG MARSHALL as the Big South's all-time winningest coach. Marshall won 194 games in nine seasons as the Eagles' head coach from 1998-07.

SPEAKING OF WINNING COACHES...

VMI head coach DUGGAR BAUCOM won his 100th game as a collegiate head coach when the Keydets defeated Charleston Southern on Dec. 5. It was his 63rd as VMI's head coach, and he is already the fifth-winningest coach in VMI history after just four-plus years at the helm.

AND THEN THERE WAS ONE

Entering last week's action, four players had scored in double figures in every game for their respective teams -- NICK BARBOUR, JAKE TROYLI, ART PARAKHOUSKI and KEITH GABRIEL. Unfortunately, Barbour, Troyli and Gabriel each failed to score 10 points in their games last week, leaving Parakhouski with the longest double-figure scoring streak in the Big South at 10 games.

LOOK WHO IS 2-0

With the first set of Big South games concluding Dec. 5, Coastal Carolina and Radford emerged from the pack with 2-0 League records to tie for first-place in the Conference standings. The Chanticleers are 2-0 in the Big South for the first time since 2006-07, while the Highlanders have won their first two League games for the first time since 2000-01. Conference play will resume Jan. 2, 2010.

TOP DOG IN THE DEAN DOME

Gardner-Webb senior GRAYSON FLITTNER needs 54 three-point field goals to become Gardner-Webb's all-time leader, and 79.2 percent of his field goals this season have been from beyond the arc (19 of 24 overall FG). On Nov. 23, Flittner tied a Dean Smith Center record with nine three-point field goals in the Runnin' Bulldogs' 93-72 loss at No. 11 North Carolina. He equaled the mark set by Georgia Tech's **DENNIS SCOTT** and **DREW BARRY**, and finished the night with 32 points against the Tar Heels.

RADFORD, COASTAL CAROLINA AMONG TOP MID-MAJOR PROGRAMS

Radford was ranked in the Collegeinsider.com Mid-Major Top 25 poll for the first three weeks of the season, marking the sixth consecutive year that the Big South has had a team ranked in the Mid-Major Top 25. CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern did not play last week as part of a 10-day break from competition ... Coming up this week, the Bucs will visit crosstown rival College of Charleston before travelling to Virginia Tech.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina played one game last week due to final exams, defeating Bridgewater College, 91-42 on Saturday. **JOSEPH HARRIS** had a season-high 24 points in the win over the Eagles, going 10-of-12 from the field. Coastal went on a 24-0 run midway through the first half in the win. **CHAD GRAY** had 17 points in the Bridgewater win, and is now averaging 13.3 points and 5.0 rebounds per game ... Coastal Carolina is at Georgia Southern Tuesday night and hosts Savannah State Saturday to begin a five-game homestand.

GARDNER-WEBB

Gardner-Webb has dropped four games in a row for the first time since 2007-08 ... **GRAYSON FLITTNER** was held scoreless at Charlotte this past Saturday (0-of-5 FG), marking the first time in 75 starts that he did not score a point. Flittner has gone 0-of-9 from the floor with 1.0 point per game in two career starts vs. Charlotte ... GWU will play twice on television this week, battling No. 7 Duke on Tuesday (ESPN2) and Penn State on Saturday (ESPNU).

HIGH POINT

High Point's lone game last week was a 76-63 loss at South Carolina State on Wednesday. The teams split their season series after HPU won the Nov. 30 matchup ... **NICK BARBOUR** was held to a season-low eight points at SCSU, his lowest total since he scored eight against Radford in last year's Big South Tournament ... With 17 points at South Carolina State, **EUGENE HARRIS** led the team in scoring for the 13th time in his career ... **CRUZ DANIELS** had season-highs of eight points and eight rebounds at SCSU, and is now averaging 7.7 points and 8.1 rebounds on the season ... HPU plays at Marshall on Sunday in the second meeting between the schools. Marshall won the first meeting, 74-73 on Dec. 21, 2004, on a jumper with five seconds left in the game.

LIBERTY

JESSE SANDERS grabbed the last rebound against Kentucky Christian with just 20 seconds remaining in the contest to secure his triple-double this past Saturday. He scored all 11 of his points in the second half ... Liberty had its best first half three-point shooting performance of the season in the game against Kentucky Christian, hitting 7-of-13 from three-point range (=53.8 percent). JEREMY ANDERSON led the way for the Flames, netting four treys during the opening 20 minutes of action.

PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE

Sophomore **CHASE HOLMES** dropped in a career-high 29 points at No. 10 North Carolina this past Saturday, which is the third-most points scored against the Tar Heels this season. Holmes' 29 points tied **AL'LONZO COLEMAN** for the most scored by a PC student-athlete since moving to Division I ... **JAKE TROYLI**'s streak of consecutive double-figure scoring games came to an end at North Carolina as he managed just four points ... The 103 points allowed to North Carolina was the first time PC gave up 100 points since the NAIA District 6 Playoffs against Newberry (L, 109-98) in the 1988-89 season ... Presbyterian College heads to nationally-ranked Ohio State and Dayton this week before taking a few days off for the holidays.

RADFORD

The Highlanders faced the No. 1-ranked team for the first time in school history last week, and it was the fifth time in the last three seasons that Radford has met a team ranked in the Top 10 ... **LAZ TRIFUNOVIC** had a season-high 22 points against Roanoke College this past Sunday, four points shy of his career-high of 26. The Binghamton transfer has scored in double figures in three of his first four games at Radford.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville won its second game in a row with its 100-49 win over Montreat on Sunday afternoon. The Bulldogs placed five players in double figures, including a game-high 18 points from **SEAN SMITH**. **J.P. PRIMM** added 14 points, eight assists and seven rebounds in the win. Freshman **D.J. CUNNINGHAM** just missed a double-double vs. Montreat with nine points and nine rebounds, in addition to five blocked shots and two assists ... The Bulldogs play twice this week with home games against Catawba and Bluefield.

VMI

The 134 points scored by Seton Hall was the most ever allowed by VMI ... **STEPHEN SARGENT**, VMI's first 7-footer, made his first career start at Seton Hall and scored eight points and had seven rebounds in 18 minutes of action ... **RON BURKS** scored a career-high 19 points at Virginia Tech last week ... **MICHAEL SPARKS** went 8-of-12 (=66.7 percent) from three-point range in two games last week ... VMI will break for exams and will be idle for 10 days. The Keydets resume action at George Mason on Dec. 22, the first meeting between the two teams since the first-ever meeting in 1979-80. The GMU game will be VMI's only contest over a 20-day stretch.

WINTHROP

Winthrop defeated former Division II National Champion Barton College behind MATT MORGAN's 14 points and ANDY BUECHERT's first career double-double (10 points, 18 rebounds). The Eagles have now won 28-straight games against non-Division I opponents ... Winthrop held Barton to 24.6 percent FG shooting (16-of-63) ... The Eagles will play five of their next six games on the road. The one home game is against Charlotte on Dec. 20 and marks the first meeting between these two schools in the Winthrop Coliseum and only the second game ever.
