JOSEPH HARRIS - THE BIG SOUTH'S REBOUNTING KING

Coastal Carolina redshirt-senior **JOSEPH HARRIS** became the Big South's all-time rebounding king on Saturday, Jan. 16 vs. High Point when he corralled his 1,014th career rebound, breaking the Conference record of 1,013 that was set by High Point's **ARIZONA REID** just two seasons ago. Harris reached the 1,000 rebound threshold on Thursday, Jan. 14 vs. Radford, and is just the second player in Big South history with 1,000 points and 1,000 rebounds. Harris opened the 2009-10 campaign tied for seventh on the League's career rebounding chart.

STEADY EDDIE TIES BIG SOUTH WIN RECORD

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** has tied the League record for most regular-season Big South wins with 109, matching the all-time mark established by former Radford coach **RON BRADLEY** from 1991-02. Meanwhile, with 186 wins at Asheville, Biedenbach is eight wins shy of tying former Winthrop coach **GREGG MARSHALL** as the Big South's all-time winningest coach. Marshall won 194 games in nine seasons as the Eagles' head coach from 1998-07.

TV TIME

The "Royal Purple Big South Game of the Week" television package resumes this Saturday when Radford hosts Liberty live on MASN at 6:00pm. **MATT HOGUE** (play-by-play) and **NATE ROSS** (analyst) will call the action. It will be the first of five upcoming telecasts, with the next broadcast set for Jan. 30 (High Point at Gardner-Webb - MASN, 8:00pm).

COASTAL CAROLINA EQUALS BEST 20-GAME START IN BIG SOUTH HISTORY

Already the fastest team in Big South history to win 15 games, which came in their 17th contest of the season, the Coastal Carolina Chanticleers have tied the Big South record for best 20-game start at 17-3, joining the 1991-92 Liberty Flames and the 2008-09 VMI Keydets. The Chanticleers are three victories away from recording 20 regular-season wins for the first time since 1990-91, and are challenging the Big South record for fastest team to win 20 games. That record is 24 games (20-4) and has been accomplished by three teams -- Liberty in 1991-92, Winthrop in 2006-07 and VMI in 2008-09.

TURNAROUND JUMPERS

Coastal Carolina, Charleston Southern and High Point have either matched or exceeded their overall and Big South victory totals from last season. The Chanticleers' exploits have already been detailed, as their 17-3 record and 7-1 Big South start have surpassed last year's 11-20 mark and 5-13 Conference record. Charleston Southern's 10-8 record and 5-3 League mark this season is more than last year's total (9-20 overall and 4-14 Conference). High Point stands at 9-8 overall and 4-3 in Conference to match last year's victory totals in each category (9-21 overall, 4-14 Big South).

BUCKING THE TREND

Charleston Southern's five Big South wins are its most since winning seven in 2005-06 -- **BARCLAY RADEBAUGH**'s first season as head coach. In fact, the Buccaneers' current three-game Big South win streak is their longest since winning four-in-a-row to open League play in 2004-05. CSU's 10-8 mark is its best opening since starting the 2002-03 campaign at 10-7.

ART GALLERY

Radford's **ART PARAKHOUSKI** needs 98 points for 1,000 in his brief time with the Highlanders. He has 902 points in 49 career games at Radford, and is on pace to reach the scoring milestone in his 53rd game (based on his current 23.1 scoring clip), which would make him the sixth-fastest player in Big South history to score 1,000 career points. The record is 48 games, set by Charleston Southern's **BEN HINSON** and **DARNELL SNEED**. ALL ABOUT MARGINS

Coastal Carolina has won 16 of its 17 games this season by 10-or-more points, and owns a +15.7 scoring margin -- pacing ahead of the Big South single-season record of +13.4 set by Winthrop in 2006-07. The Chanticleers have won six of their seven Conference games by double digits, and own a +9.6 scoring margin in Conference games, the highest in the League since Winthrop posted a +9.6 margin against League foes in 2007-08.

BIG SOUTH PRESEASON PLAYER OF THE YEAR

Artsiom Parakhouski, Radford

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE ROAD

The road teams have claimed 16 of the 36 Big South games played thus far this season, a .444 winning percentage. The success marks the third time in the past four seasons that the road teams have won at least 40 percent of the League contests, including last year, when the road squads won 42 of the 90 total Big South games played for a .467 winning percentage away from home.

CLOSE AND NOT SO CLOSE

Of the first 36 Big South Conference games, 18 have been decided by less than 10 points, with the average margin of victory in those games being 4.2 points. Of the 18 games decided by double-digits, the average margin of victory is 15.2 points. The overall margin of victory in League play stands at 9.7 points.

OHMAN, KENON ENTER BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB

Liberty senior and former walk-on **KYLE OHMAN** (97th) and VMI junior **AUSTIN KENON** (98th) each entered the Big South's 1,000-point club last week. Radford's **ART PARAKHOUSKI** (902 points) is the next player on track to join the group. Below is a look at the Big South's active 1,000-point scorers and their respective rank in League history.

Meanwhile, Gardner-Webb senior **GRAYSON FLITTNER** eclipsed 1,000 career points Nov. 21 against Methodist College, and has 1,124 points in his career (505 as a Big South member). Radford's **LAZ TRIFUNOVIC** is 159 points away from 1,000 in his collegiate career, as he scored 686 in two seasons at Binghamton and has 155 after 12 games with the Highlanders.

FLOOR GENERAL

Radford senior **AMIR JOHNSON**, who became the 10th player in Big South history with 500 career assists Jan. 9, is currently ninth all-time on the Big South's career list with 509, and needs one to reach the eighth spot. Now just one of eight players in Conference annals with 1,000 career points and 500 career assists, Johnson is 59 assists away from breaking the Big South career record of 567, which is held by Winthrop's **CHRIS GAYNOR** (2004-08), and is on pace to surpass the mark Feb. 23 at home against Presbyterian College.

ANOTHER HARRIS MAKING A NAME FOR HIMSELF

High Point senior **EUGENE HARRIS** is ninth in Big South history with a school-record 261 career three-point field goals, and needs 14 to move into eighth-place (275 - Coastal Carolina's **KEKE HICKS**, 1992-95). Harris is hitting 46.5 percent from long range in his last five games (20-of-43) and is 39 treys away from becoming the fifth Big South player with 300 career three-pointers. Harris, who is averaging 2.94 3FG a game this season, would need to average 3.00 in High Point's remaining 13 games to reach 300. Meanwhile, Harris also has 240 career assists, and is on track to become just the fifth player in Big South history with 250 career three-pointers and 250 career assists. The other four are Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** (411 3FG, 353 AST), UNC Greensboro's **SCOTT HARTZELL** (309 3FG, 552 AST), VMI's **CHAVIS HOLMES** (306 3FG, 313 AST) and UNC Asheville's **JOSH KOHN** (296 3FG, 430 AST).

A WORK OF ART

Radford center **ART PARAKHOUSKI** was third in the nation in rebounding through games of Jan. 14, and is on pace to break his Big South single-season record of 369 rebounds, which he set last season. If he should continue at his current pace of 12.9 rebounds in Radford's next 14 games, Parakhouski would finish with 387 rebounds through the quarterfinals of the Advance Auto Parts Big South Men's Basketball Championship. His per game average is pacing +1.5 ahead of the League record of 11.4. Through games of Jan. 14, Parakhouski was the only player to rank in the top five nationally in scoring (3rd), rebounding (3rd) and field goal percentage (2nd).

A RARE TRIPLE CROWN AND A POSSIBLE FIRST

Radford senior **ART PARAKHOUSKI** currently leads the Big South in scoring (23.9), rebounding (12.9) and field goal percentage (62.2), and is looking to become just the second player in Big South history to lead the League in all three categories. The first was High Point's **DANNY GATHINGS** in 2002-03 with averages of 18.7 points, 7.6 rebounds and 57.1 percent from the field. Should Parakhouski maintain his averages for the duration of the season, he would become the first player in Big South history to average 20.0 points and 60.0 percent from the field (based on 5.0 field goals per game) in the same season.

Coastal Carolina's **JOSEPH HARRIS** is the first player in Big South history with 1,000 points, 1,000 rebounds, 150 steals and 100 blocked shots.

BULLETIN BOARD MATERIAL

Radford's **ART PARAKHOUSKI** became the third player this season and 54th in League history to reach 500 career rebounds when he eclipsed the milestone at Louisville on Dec. 27 -- in just his 43rd career game with the Highlanders. He is officially the Big South's career leader for rebounds per game, as the category is based on a minimum of 500 rebounds. Winthrop's **MANTORIS ROBINSON** is 15 rebounds away from 500 in his career, while High Point's **CRUZ DANIELS** needs 10 rebounds to become the 29th player in Big South history with 600. COASTAL CAROLINA RANKED IN MID-MAJOR POLL

HE IS THE ONLY ONE

Radford's **ART PARAKHOUSKI** is the lone Big South men's basketball player to score in double figures in all of his team's games this season, and owns the Big South's longest double-figure scoring streak at 18 games, dating back to 2008-09. VMI's **AUSTIN KENON** owns the next-longest streak of double-figure scoring at 14 games.

38 SPECIAL

Radford's **ART PARAKHOUSKI** is on track to become the third player this season and 39th overall in the League's 1,000-point/500-rebound club, as he is 98 points away. Teammate **JOEY LYNCH-FLOHR** entered the club on Dec. 13 when he reached the 1,000-point mark, while Coastal Carolina's **JOSEPH HARRIS** was the first to enter this season when he scored his 1,000th point on Nov. 21. Parakhouski would become the 11th Radford player on the list, the most of any Big South member.

KEYDET KICKS

VMI junior **AUSTIN KENON** has made a three-pointer in 61 of his 64 career games and has made 218 total for a 3.41 per game average, which trails the current Big South career record of 3.51, set by Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** from 2004-08. Meanwhile, Kenon's teammate **KEITH GABRIEL** has drained a three-pointer in 43 of his 48 career games and already has 141 in his career, an average of 2.94 per game.

BLOCK STEADY

UNC Asheville redshirt-junior **JOHN WILLIAMS** has swatted away 166 shots in his career, tied for seventh all-time in Big South history. He needs 17 blocked shots to move into sixth-place in League annals. Williams needs 34 rejections to become just the fifth player in Big South history with 200 career blocked shots, and needs to average 2.62 blocks over the next 13 games to reach the milestone this season. Meanwhile, Coastal Carolina's **JOSEPH HARRIS** is tied for 18th in League history with a school-record 124 career blocks.

ELDER STATESMAN

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** collected his 650th career win on Monday, Jan. 4 when the Chanticleers defeated Presbyterian College. He now owns a lifetime record of 653-387. Ellis has amassed 575 Division I victories, which ranks 11th on the NCAA's active win list. Coastal Carolina's 17 wins this season already exceed last year's total (11) and Ellis' win total in his first season as the Chanticleers coach in 2007-08 (13). Ellis is looking to win 20 games at his fourth Division I school and for the 13th time in his coaching career.

LOCK AND KEY

Winthrop redshirt-senior and reigning Big South Defensive Player of the Year **MANTORIS ROBINSON** is 15 rebounds away from becoming the third Winthrop player with 500 career rebounds and 100 career steals. He limited PC's **CHASE HOLMES** to 10 points this past Saturday, 8.8 points below his season average in Big South games. It was the fourth-straight game and seventh in the last eight that Robinson has held the opponent's leading scorer below his season average. Meanwhile, in his last four games, Robinson is averaging 12.5 points, 5.5 rebounds and 2.3 steals a game, while hitting 15-of-31 from the field (= 48.4), 5-of-11 from beyond the arc (= 45.5) and 15-of-20 from the line (= 75.0).

WELL-ROUNDED INDIVIDUAL

Charleston Southern sophomore forward **KELVIN MARTIN** has been a quiet force for the Buccaneers. He leads the Big South in steals per game with 2.33, is fourth in the League in rebounding at 7.8, and is fourth in field goal percentage (51.6) -- the only Big South player to rank in the top five in the Conference in each category. He also is 11th in the Big South with 14.2 points per game. Martin's 42 steals this season are a career-high, and he is looking to become the first Buccaneer to lead the Big South in steals per game since **ED O'NEIL** in 2003-04.

LONG DISTANCE FRESHMAN

Charleston Southern freshman guard **JEREMY SEXTON** is hitting 58.1 percent from beyond the arc in his last six games (18-of-31), and has shot better than 50.0 percent in each of those contests. He leads the Big South with a 44.2 percent clip from three-point range, which is the second-highest by a freshman in League annals. UNC Greensboro's **SCOTT HARTZELL** made 45.6 percent (73-of-160) of his three-point attempts as a freshman in 1992-93.

CRUZZING ALTITUDE

High Point 6-11 redshirt-senior **CRUZ DANIELS** is second all-time in Big South history with 268 career blocked shots. He has recorded a blocked shot in a career-high 22 consecutive games -- bettering his previous career-long streak of 10 games, and is averaging 2.91 blocks in his current string (64 total). Daniels, who has blocked at least five shots in a game 17 times in his career, is one of just two players in Big South history with 500 career rebounds and 250 career blocked shots, joining Liberty's **PETER ALUMA**, who had 682 rebounds and 366 blocks from 1994-97.

FROM THE LAND OF THREE...

Charleston Southern's **JAMARCO WARREN** became the 25th player in Big South history with 200 career three-pointers when he reached the milestone at College of Charleston on Dec. 16. He now has 227 treys in his career. Liberty's **KYLE OHMAN** is approaching the 200 three-point field goal barrier as he enters this week with 192.

TERRIFIC TRIFUNOVIC

Radford 6-8 junior forward **LAZAR TRIFUNOVIC** has reached the necessary requirements to be ranked among the Big South leaders -- 75 percent of his team's games, as he has played in 12 of Radford's 16 contests this season. He officially ranks 15th in scoring (12.9), third in rebounds (8.6), seventh in field goal percentage (44.0) and third in defensive rebounds (6.17).

BIG MEN ON CAMPUS

Radford's frontcourt trio of **ART PARAKHOUSKI** (23.1 points/12.9 rebounds), **JOEY LYNCH-FLOHR** (13.3 points/6.6 rebounds) and **LAZ TRIFUNOVIC** (12.9 points/8.6 rebounds) account for 64.7 percent of RU's offense and 60.9 percent of the squad's rebounds per game. Combined, Parakhouski, Lynch-Flohr and Trifunovic are averaging 49.3 points and 28.1 rebounds per game. To go along with their statistical output, the trio has combined for 19 double-doubles this season.

COMING SOON - MEN'S BASKETBALL BAREFOOT FOR BARE FEET INITIATIVE

In the coming weeks, Big South men's basketball coaches will participate in the Conference's "Barefoot for Bare Feet" program in support of Samaritan's Feet. The Big South's Student-Athlete Advisory Committee has adopted Samaritan's Feet as its charity for 2009-10 and has pledged to collect 17,000 pairs of shoes this season. Big South coaches will coach in their bare feet at some point during the season. Additional details will be announced soon when finalized.
