CHAD GRAY • F
R-Jr. • Coastal Carolina

Gray averaged 27.5 points and shot a sizzling 84.0 percent from the floor in two Coastal Carolina wins, helping the Chanticleers get to 10-2 on the year. In the Georgia Southern win on Dec. 15, Gray was 10-of-12 from the floor and finished with 24 points. He also had four rebounds and was 3-of-4 from the free throw line in 28 minutes off the bench. In the Savannah State win on Dec. 19, Gray had a career-high 31 points, going 11-of-13 from the field and 9-of-11 from the charity stripe, and corralled nine rebounds in the victory. For the week, Gray was 21-of-25 from the field (.840), 12-of-15 from the line (.800) and averaged 6.5 rebounds.

Sexton averaged 12.3 points, shot 46.4 percent from the floor and 50.0 percent from beyond the arc in three games last week. He posted 13 points at College of Charleston on 5-of-11 shooting, including 3-of-6 from three-point range, and scored eight points late in the game to narrow the margin against the Cougars. Sexton stepped up at Virginia Tech with a team-high 16 points, including four three-pointers in the second half. He added eight points, two assists and four steals in 28 minutes against Southeastern College on Monday. For the week, Sexton was 13-of-28 from the field, 9-of-18 from three-point range and averaged 2.7 rebounds.

MAKING WAVES

Coastal Carolina has tied its best start to a season at 10-2. The 1981-82 Chanticleers also started 10-2 but lost its next game, so this year's squad can set the record for best start in school history with a win over Cornell College of Dec. 27. Coastal Carolina, which received a vote in the Dec. 14 ESPN/USA Today Coaches' poll, is the second Big South team in as many years to open the season 10-2, as the VMI Keydets opened the 2008-09 campaign with an 10-2 mark before winning another four-straight to go 14-2 after 16 contests. In addition, Coastal Carolina is 2-0 in Big South play for the first time since 2006-07, and won back-to-back Big South games by 14-or-more points for the first time since 2005-06, when the Chants defeated Winthrop 64-50 on Feb. 4 and High Point 78-60 on Feb. 6.

A WORK OF ART

Radford center **ART PARAKHOUSKI** entered the week leading the nation in rebounding and is on pace to smash his Big South single-season record of 369 rebounds, which he set last season. If he should continue at his current pace of 14.0 rebounds, Parakhouski would finish with 406 rebounds -- just through the quarterfinals of the Advance Auto Parts Big South Men's Basketball Championship. Parakhouski is looking to become the first NCAA Division I player to average 15.0 rebounds in a season since Alcorn State's **LARRY SMITH** in 1980 (15.1).

CHIPPING AWAY

With 944 career rebounds, Coastal Carolina redshirt-senior **JOSEPH HARRIS** needs 11 boards to move into second-place on the Big South's all-time list. Harris, who opened the season tied for seventh on the League's career rebounding chart, jumped into third-place after just four games. He stands 70 rebounds shy of breaking the all-time record of 1,013, and if he continues his current pace of 10.7 rebounds a game, he will break the mark on Jan. 14 at home vs. Radford. Harris needs 56 rebounds to become the Big South's second player in history with 1,000 points and 1,000 rebounds. Below is a look at the Conference's top 3 all-time rebounders.

TOUCH OF GRAY

In his last five games, Coastal Carolina redshirt-junior **CHAD GRAY** is averaging 20.4 points, 6.2 rebounds and 66.7 percent from the field (42-of-63). He has increased his scoring average from 12.2 points to 15.9 in that span to move into seventh in the League, and is now second in the Big South in field goal percentage at 57.9 percent. Gray has done most of his work off the bench, as he has started just two of his 11 appearances this season.

BULLETIN BOARD MATERIAL

Radford's **ART PARAKHOUSKI** is five rebounds away from becoming the third player this season and 54th in League history with 500 career rebounds. Meanwhile, High Point redshirt senior **CRUZ DANIELS** is currently 44th in League history with 544 career rebounds, while Radford's **JOEY LYNCH-FLOHR** is tied for 49th all-time with 530 caroms.

38 SPECIAL

Radford's **JOEY LYNCH-FLOHR** became the fourth player this season and 96th overall in Conference history with 1,000 career points in the Big South when he surpassed the milestone Dec. 13 against Roanoke College. In addition, Lynch-Flohr is now the 38th member of the League's 1,000-point/500-rebound club. Teammate **ART PARAKHOUSKI** (737 points, 495 rebounds) is on track to join both clubs before the season is complete.

ARTISTIC IMPRESSION

Radford center **ART PARAKHOUSKI** played his sixth opponent from a power Conference when Radford visited No. 1 Kansas on Dec. 9. After a slow start, Parakhouski finished with 21 points and 13 rebounds against the Jayhawks, and now owns a career average of 16.3 points and 11.8 rebounds against these nationally-regarded programs, with five double-doubles. Below is a closer look at his efforts.

ELDER STATESMAN

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** notched his 568th career Division I victory on Dec. 19 vs. Savannah State, moving him into 12th place on the NCAA's active win list. Ellis has now won 646 games in his collegiate coaching career.

Meanwhile, Gardner-Webb senior **GRAYSON FLITTNER** eclipsed 1,000 career points Nov. 21 against Methodist College, and has 1,073 points in his career (454 as a Big South member).

CRUZZIN'

High Point redshirt-senior **CRUZ DANIELS** is second all-time in Big South history with 247 career blocked shots. He has recorded a blocked shot in a career-high 15 consecutive games -- bettering his previous career-long streak of 10 games, and is averaging 2.87 blocks in his current string (43 total). Daniels, who has blocked at least five shots in a game 15 times in his career, is one of just three players in Big South history with 500 career rebounds and 200 career blocked shots, joining Liberty's **PETER ALUMA** (1994-97) and Radford's **TYRONE TRAVIS** (1989-94).

AUSTIN'S THREE-POINT POWER BARRAGE

VMI junior **AUSTIN KENON** became the 24th player in Big South history with 200 career three-point field goals when he reached the milestone Dec. 12 at Seton Hall. Kenon now qualifies for the Big South's career record for three-pointers per game, which is based on 200 career treys. He has made a three-pointer in 55 of his 58 career games and has made 204 total for a 3.52 per game average, which is pacing ahead of the current Big South career record of 3.51, set by Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** from 2004-08. Meanwhile, Kenon's teammate **KEITH GABRIEL** has drained a three-pointer in 37 of his 42 career games and already has 125 in his career, an average of 2.98 per game.

ANOTHER HARRIS MAKING A NAME FOR HIMSELF

High Point senior **EUGENE HARRIS** is the Big South's active three-point field goal leader with a school-record 236 -- good for 11th in Big South history, and he is six away from cracking the League's all-time top 10 in the category. He also has 225 career assists, and is on track to become just the fifth player in Big South history with 250 career three-pointers and 250 career assists. The other four are Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** (411 3FG, 353 AST), UNC Greensboro's **SCOTT HARTZELL** (309 3FG, 552 AST), VMI's **CHAVIS HOLMES** (306 3FG, 313 AST) and UNC Asheville's **JOSH KOHN** (296 3FG, 430 AST).

FROM THE LAND OF THREE...

Charleston Southern's **JAMARCO WARREN** became the 25th player in Big South history with 200 career three-pointers when he reached the milestone at College of Charleston on Dec. 16. He now has 207 treys in his career. Warren's consecutive games streak with a three-pointer ended at 40 games when he went 0-of-2 at Virginia Tech on Dec. 19. In that span, he was 129-of-326 (=39.6 percent). Liberty's **KYLE OHMAN** follows Warren on the League's active three-point list with 182.

BLOCK STEADY

UNC Asheville redshirt-junior **JOHN WILLIAMS** has blocked a shot in his last eight games (26 total) and has swatted away 153 shots in his career, good for 13th in Big South history. He needs 10 blocked shots to move into a tie for 10th all-time in League annals. Williams, who blocked a personal-best 76 shots last season, needs 47 rejections to become just the fifth player in Big South history with 200 career blocked shots. Meanwhile, Coastal Carolina's **JOSEPH HARRIS** is 20th in League history with a school-record 119 career blocks.

HE IS THE ONLY ONE

Radford's **ART PARAKHOUSKI** is the lone Big South men's basketball player to score in double figures in all of his team's games this season, and owns the Big South's longest double-figure scoring streak in the Big South at 11 games, dating back to 2008-09.

LOOK WHO IS 2-0

With the first set of Big South games concluding Dec. 5, Coastal Carolina and Radford emerged from the pack with 2-0 League records to tie for first-place in the Conference standings. The Chanticleers are 2-0 in the Big South for the first time since 2006-07, while the Highlanders have won their first two League games for the first time since 2000-01. Conference play will resume Jan. 2, 2010.

COASTAL CAROLINA, RADFORD AMONG TOP MID-MAJOR PROGRAMS

Radford was ranked in the *CollegeInsider.com* Mid-Major Top 25 poll for the first three weeks of the season, marking the sixth consecutive year that the Big South has had a team ranked in the Mid-Major Top 25. Radford and Coastal Carolina have both received votes the past four weeks. Below is a week-by-week look at this year's rankings among the Conference members:

SCOREBOARD WATCHING

Three-time NCAA scoring champion VMI entered the week leading the nation in scoring with an average of 94.0 points per game. The Keydets are looking to become the first team in NCAA Division I history to lead the country in scoring four consecutive seasons. VMI, Furman (1952-55) and Loyola Marymount (1987-90) are the only programs to lead in the nation three-straight years.

FLOOR GENERAL

Radford senior **AMIR JOHNSON** is 10th all-time on the Big South's career assist list with 477, and needs 23 to come the 10th player in Conference annals with 500 in a career. Johnson is 90 assists away from reaching the League's all-time record of 567 assists, which is held by Winthrop's **CHRIS GAYNOR** (2004-08). Johnson is averaging a career-best 5.57 assists per game this season, and is looking to become just the eighth Big South player with 1,000 career points and 500 career assists.

TWO OF CLUBS

Coastal Carolina's **JOSEPH HARRIS**, who became the 94th player in Big South history with 1,000 career points when he surpassed the milestone Nov. 21, is just the second player in Big South history with 1,000 points, 900 rebounds, 150 steals and 100 blocked shots. Harris joins Campbell's **JOE SPINKS** in the exclusive club, as Spinks accumulated 1,711 points, 954 rebounds, 220 steals and 155 blocks for the Camels from 1990-94.

SOARING TO NEW HEIGHTS

Winthrop's **MANTORIS ROBINSON** recorded his 100th career steal Dec. 12 in the Eagles' victory over Barton College. He is approaching 500 career rebounds (450) and 100 career blocked shots (74) as well, and should he reach both milestones, he would become just the eighth player in Big South history with 500 rebounds, 100 steals and 100 blocks.

STEADY EDDIE

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** is second all-time in League history with 107 career regular-season Big South wins, and needs just three League victories to surpass former Radford mentor **RON BRADLEY** as the all-time leader. Bradley had 109 regular-season Big South wins from 1991-02. Meanwhile, with 184 wins at Asheville, Biedenbach is 10 wins shy of tying former Winthrop coach **GREGG MARSHALL** as the Big South's all-time winningest coach. Marshall won 194 games in nine seasons as the Eagles' head coach from 1998-07.

SPEAKING OF WINNING COACHES...

VMI head coach **DUGGAR BAUCOM** won his 100th game as a collegiate head coach when the Keydets defeated Charleston Southern on Dec. 5. It was his 63rd as VMI's head coach, and he is already the fifth-winningest coach in VMI history after just four-plus years at the helm.

TRIPLE THREAT

Liberty sophomore guard **JESSE SANDERS** recorded the fifth triple-double in Big South history with 11 points, 10 rebounds and 10 assists against Kentucky Christian on Dec. 12. Sanders is the first player in both League annals and Liberty history with two career triple-doubles, as he recorded one last season against Presbyterian College on Feb. 9 (10 points, 10 rebounds, 10 assists).
