JOSEPH HARRIS • F R-Sr. • Coastal Carolina Lejeune, N.C.

Harris had another record-setting week for the Chanticleers as he averaged 18.0 points and 11.0 rebounds in leading Coastal Carolina to two road Conference wins last week. He scored 20 points and had 10 rebounds in the win at VMI. in addition to four blocked shots that gave him the school's all-time blocked shot record. Harris went 10-of-15 from the floor and had two assists as well. At Liberty, he recorded his 37th career double-double with 16 points and 12 rebounds to go along with three assists, one block and one steal. For the week, Harris was 18-of-26 from the floor (=69.2 percent) and averaged 4.0 offensive rebounds, 2.5 assists and 2.5 blocked shots.

THE CRONS BRAND FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

JEREMY SEXTON G • Charleston Southern Chattanooga, Tenn.

Sexton, who had 43 points in his first five games of the season (8.6 per game), reached double figures in all three games last week and averaged 14.7 points in that span. He opened the week with a 12-point, 5-assist performance in CSU's victory over Toccoa Falls, and managed 10 points, two assists and two steals at Liberty. Sexton concluded the week with a careerhigh 22 points at VMI. He came off the bench to shoot 8-of-15 from the floor and 6-of-10 from beyond the arc in 28 minutes to keep the game within reach. Sexton hit all six of his threes in the second half.

LOOK WHO IS 2-0

With the first set of Big South games concluding this past Saturday, Coastal Carolina and Radford emerged from the pack with 2-0 League records to tie for first-place in the Conference standings. The Chanticleers are 2-0 in the Big South for the first time since 2006-07, while the Highlanders have won their first two League games for the first time since 2000-01. Conference play will resume Jan. 2, 2010.

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE ROAD

The road teams claimed six of the nine Big South games played over the weekend, one more than last year's opening weekend win total in the same span. Coastal Carolina and Radford combined for four of the six away wins last week. The success continues a trend that began last year in which the road teams won 42 of the 90 total Big South games played for a .467 winning percentage away from home.

CLOSE AND NOT SO CLOSE

Four of the first nine Big South Conference games went down to the wire, with three being determined on the final shot and one contest needing overtime. Those four games were decided by four points-orless. The remaining five games had an average margin of victory of 14.2 points, with Coastal Carolina winning its two games by an average of 14.5 points.

FIRST TIMERS

New Big South coaches SCOTT CHERRY (High Point) and DALE LAYER (Liberty) each won his Big South debuts this past week. High Point won at Presbyterian College on a last second layup, while Liberty defeated Charleston Southern by 16 points. Cherry and Layer join six of the current men's basketball coaches (BARCLAY RADEBAUGH, CLIFF ELLIS, RICK SCRUGGS, GREGG NIBERT, EDDIE BIEDENBACH and **RANDY PEELE**) that won their Conference game debut in the Big South.

ROADIES

The Radford Highlanders extended their Conference road win streak to 11 following their nail-biting victories at Winthrop and Presbyterian College last week. Radford's Conference road winning streak is the longest in the Big South since Winthrop won 11 consecutive League road contests from Jan. 10, 2005 to Jan. 30, 2006.

HARRIS CONTINUES ASCENSION

Coastal Carolina redshirt-senior JOSEPH HARRIS, who opened the season tied for seventh on the Big South's all-time rebounding chart, jumped into third-place after just four games. He now is the third player in League history with 900 career rebounds (919) and needs 38 boards to move into a tie for second. Harris stands 95 shy of breaking the all-time record of 1,013, and if he continues his current pace of 11.4 rebounds a game, he will break the mark on Jan. 7 at UNC Asheville. Harris needs 81 rebounds to become the Big South's second player in history with 1,000 points and 1,000 rebounds. Below is a look at the Conference's top 3 all-time rebounders.

TWO OF CLUBS

Coastal Carolina's JOSEPH HARRIS, who became the 94th player in Big South history with 1,000 career points when he surpassed the milestone Nov. 21, is just the second player in Big South history with 1,000 points, 900 rebounds, 150 steals and 100 blocked shots. Harris joins Campbell's **JOE SPINKS** in the exclusive club, as Spinks accumulated 1,711 points, 954 rebounds, 220 steals and 155 blocks for the Camels from 1990-94.

THE BIG MAN AGAINST THE BIG BOYS

Radford center ART PARAKHOUSKI, who became the first player in Radford history with 20 points and 20 rebounds in a game Nov. 29 at Duquesne, will play his sixth opponent from a power Conference this week when Radford visits No. 1 Kansas on Wednesday. Parakhouski, who is currently 13th in the nation in scoring and first in rebounding, owns a career average of 15.4 points and 11.6 rebounds against these nationally-regarded programs, with four double-doubles. SHOOTING FOR 1,000

Radford's **JOEY LYNCH-FLOHR** is 34 points away from becoming the fourth player this season and 96th overall in Conference history with 1,000 career points in the Big South. Lynch-Flohr will become the 38th member of the League's 1,000-point/500-rebound club when he reaches the scoring milestone. Below is a look at the Big South's active 1,000-point scorers and their respective rank in League history, as well as additional players closing in on the milestone.

Meanwhile, Gardner-Webb senior **GRAYSON FLITTNER** eclipsed 1,000 career points Nov. 21 against Methodist College, and has 1,055 points in his career (436 as a Big South member).

BULLETIN BOARD

Radford's **JOEY LYNCH-FLOHR** became the 53rd player in Big South history with 500 career rebounds when he eclipsed the mark in the Conference opener at Winthrop. He enters this week with 508. High Point redshirt senior **CRUZ DANIELS** is currently tied for 49th in League history with 525 career rebounds. Radford's **ARTSIOM PARAKHOUSKI** is 42 away from the milestone, and is on pace to reach the mark Dec. 19 at James Madison in what would be his 42nd game at Radford.

BABY LET'S CRUZ

High Point redshirt-senior **CRUZ DANIELS** is second all-time in Big South history with 241 career blocked shots. He has recorded a blocked shot in a career-high 12 consecutive games -- bettering his previous career-long streak of 10 games, and is averaging 3.08 blocks in his current string (37 total). Daniels, who has blocked at least five shots in a game 15 times in his career, is one of just three players in Big South history with 500 career rebounds and 200 career blocked shots, joining Liberty's **PETER ALUMA** (1994-97) and Radford's **TYRONE TRAVIS** (1989-94).

AUSTIN'S THREE-POINT POWER BARRAGE

VMI junior **AUSTIN KENON** has made a three-pointer in 52 of his 55 career games, including a streak of 41-straight to open his collegiate career. He has 192 career treys for a 3.49 per game average. The Big South career record for three-pointers per game -- based on 200 career treys -- is 3.51, set by Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** from 2004-08.

ANOTHER HARRIS MAKING A NAME FOR HIMSELF

High Point senior **EUGENE HARRIS** is the Big South's active three-point field goal leader with a school-record 228, and he is 14 away from cracking the League's all-time top 10 in the category. He also has 219 career assists, and is on track to become just the fifth player in Big South history with 250 career three-pointers and 250 career assists. The other four are Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** (411 3FG, 353 AST), UNC Greensboro's **SCOTT HARTZELL** (309 3FG, 552 AST), VMI's **CHAVIS HOLMES** (306 3FG, 313 AST) and UNC Asheville's **JOSH KOHN** (296 3FG, 430 AST).

FROM THE LAND OF THREE...

Charleston Southern's **JAMARCO WARREN**'s next three-point field goal will be the 200th of his career, which will make him the 24th player in Big South history with that many. He has made a three-point field goal in 39 consecutive games (127-of-320, .397 percent, 3.26 per game) and in 55 of his last 56 contests. VMI's **AUSTIN KENON** is next at 192 and Liberty's **KYLE OHMAN** has 180. Meanwhile, VMI sophomore **KEITH GABRIEL** has drained a three-pointer in 35 of his 39 career games and has 117 already in his career, an average of 3.00 per game.

BLOCK STEADY

UNC Asheville redshirt-junior **JOHN WILLIAMS** moved into 14th place in Big South history with 142 career blocked shots last week, and needs four to move into 13th. He is the Bulldogs' fifth player on the League's 100-career blocked shots list — the most for one school in Big South history. Meanwhile, Coastal Carolina's **JOSEPH HARRIS** is now 20th in League history with a school-record 117 career blocks.

FLOOR GENERAL

Radford senior **AMIR JOHNSON** is currently 12th in Big South history with 461 career assists. He needs nine to move into a tie for 10th, and 39 helpers to become the 10th player in Conference annals with 500 in a career. Johnson is 106 assists away from reaching the League's all-time record of 567 assists, which is held by Winthrop's **CHRIS GAYNOR** (2004-08). Johnson is averaging a career-best 5.75 assists per game this season.

TOP DOG IN THE DEAN DOME

Gardner-Webb senior **GRAYSON FLITTNER** needs 54 three-point field goals to become Gardner-Webb's all-time leader, and 79.2 percent of his field goals this season have been from beyond the arc (19 of 24 overall FG). On Nov. 23, Flittner tied a Dean Smith Center record with nine three-point field goals in the Runnin' Bulldogs' 93-72 loss at No. 11 North Carolina. He equaled the mark set by Georgia Tech's **DENNIS SCOTT** and **DREW BARRY**, and finished the night with 32 points against the Tar Heels.

STEADY EDDIE

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** is second all-time in League history with 107 career regular-season Big South wins, and needs just three League victories to surpass former Radford mentor **RON BRADLEY** as the all-time leader. Bradley had 109 regular-season Big South wins from 1991-02. Meanwhile, with 182 wins at Asheville, Biedenbach is 12 wins shy of tying former Winthrop coach **GREGG MARSHALL** as the Big South's all-time winningest coach. Marshall won 194 games in nine seasons as the Eagles' head coach from 1998-07.

SPEAKING OF WINNING COACHES...

VMI head coach **DUGGAR BAUCOM** won his 100th game as a collegiate head coach when the Keydets defeated Charleston Southern this past Saturday. It was his 63rd as VMI's head coach, and he is already the fifth-winningest coach in VMI history after just four-plus years at the helm.

SCOREBOARD WATCHING

Three-time NCAA scoring champion VMI leads the nation in scoring in 2009-10 with an average of 95.1 points per game, ahead of Syracuse's average of 90.9. The Keydets are looking to become the first team in NCAA Division I history to lead the country in scoring four consecutive seasons. VMI, Furman (1952-55) and Loyola Marymount (1987-90) are the only programs to lead in the nation three-straight years.

MAKING WAVES

Coastal Carolina is off to its best start since 1981-82, and the Chanticleers are four wins shy of matching their win total from all of last season. Coastal made a Conference-game record 49 field goals in its 14-point win at VMI last Thursday, and followed that performance with a 15-point victory Saturday at Liberty. The last time the Chanticleers won back-to-back Big South games by 14-or-more points was in 2005-06, when Coastal Carolina defeated Winthrop 64-50 on Feb. 4 and High Point 78-60 on Feb. 6.

BLUE MAN GROUP

Presbyterian College lost its two Big South games over the weekend by a combined six points. The Blue Hose held a 10-point lead against High Point before falling to the Panthers by two. PC led defending Big South champion Radford at the break, but lost the lead and the game to the Highlanders by four points. Dating back to last season, PC's last five Big South losses have been by a combined 20 points (4.0 average), with the largest defeat in that span being six points (Gardner-Webb).

MIDDLE GROUND

Winthrop's **REGGIE MIDDLETON** scored a career-high 25 points in leading the Eagles to an 82-68 victory over High Point this past Saturday. It was the most points scored by a Winthrop player since **MICHAEL JENKINS** scored 33 points in the Big South Championship game against UNC Asheville on March 8, 2008, and the most scored in a regular-season Conference game since Jenkins had 28 against Radford on Feb. 16, 2008.

RADFORD, COASTAL CAROLINA AMONG TOP MID-MAJOR PROGRAMS

Radford was ranked in the *Collegeinsider.com* Mid-Major Top 25 poll for the first three weeks of the season, marking the sixth consecutive year that the Big South has had a team ranked in the Mid-Major Top 25. Below is a week-by-week look at this year's rankings among the Conference members:

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern set a school and Big South single-game record with 70 rebounds in last week's win over Toccoa Falls. The Bucs outrebounded the Eagles, 70-20 in the 50-point win ... In their Big South opener at Liberty, the Buccaneers struggled as they hit 26.6 percent from the field and 23.1 percent from beyond the arc ... At VMI, Charleston Southern shot 50.7 percent against the Keydets, including 50.0 percent from three-point range. **JER-EMY SEXTON** and **KENNY MITCHELL** had career highs with 22 and 16 points, respectively.

COASTAL CAROLINA

The last time Coastal Carolina won at both VMI and Liberty in the same season was in 2006-07 ... The freshmen trio of **KIERRE GREENWOOD**, **DANNY NIEMAN** and **CHRIS EVANS** combined for 52 points in the Chants' 111-97 win at VMI. Nieman scored 22 points on 8-of-11 shooting, while Greenwood and Evans added 20 and 10, respectively ... **JOSEPH HARRIS** had 16 points and 12 rebounds at VMI, while **MARIO EDWARDS** had 16 points and a career-high 10 boards. It was the third-straight game that two Chanticleers had double-doubles in a game.

GARDNER-WEBB

Senior guard **ANTON SILVER** scored a season-high and team-high 14 points -- all in the second half -- of Friday's 58-56 loss to UNC Asheville ... After entering last season with a 25-7 series edge over Asheville, Gardner-Webb has dropped three-straight in the series ... GWU is 0-1 in League play for the fifth time in eight seasons, but for just the first time since joining the Big South Conference.

HIGH POINT

Sophomore **NICK BARBOUR** has led High Point in scoring in all seven games this season, and in 17 of HPU's last 20 contests, dating back to last season. He has been High Point's leading scorer 21 times in his career and is averaging 22.2 points when doing so ... High Point defeated Presbyterian College, 63-61, on a buzzer-beating layup by **TEHRAN COX**, his only two points of the game. It was HPU's first win over PC since March 6, 1996 ... The Panthers finished the PC game 11-of-21 from beyond the arc, tied for the third-most made in a game and percentage (52.4) in HPU's Division I era.

LIBERTY

Freshman **EVAN GORDON** had career-highs of 21 points and eight rebounds in the win over Charleston Southern. He was 6-of-10 from the field, including four three-pointers in the first half. Freshman **DAVID MINAYA** also had a personal-best with 14 points against the Bucs ... **KYLE OHMAN** now ranks 22nd in school history with 896 career points. He is just 59 points away from the 21st position, which is held by **ALEX McLEAN** (954) ... Liberty posted its best first-half three-point shooting percentage of the season in its Big South opener against Charleston Southern, hitting 5-of-11 from behind the arc (45.5 percent).

PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE

Redshirt-freshman **JAKE TROYLI** has scored in double figures in nine consecutive games to open his career, a PC record during the school's move to Division I. Troyli is one of four players in the Big South to score in double figures in all of his team's games this season ... The Blue Hose picked up a win over Montreat in their home opener, with Troyli scoring a career-high 22 points in the victory. **WALT ALLEN** tallied a career-high seven rebounds and two blocks in the game ... PC will play five road non-Conference games before returning to Big South action, beginning with Saturday's match-up at No. 10 North Carolina.

RADFORD

ART PARAKHOUSKI continues to lead the nation in rebounding (14.8), while ranking 13th in scoring at 22.3 points per outing. Parakhouski has recorded eight-straight double-doubles dating back to last season and has 23 for his career in 39 games ... **LAZ TRIFUNOVIC** made his anticipated Highlander debut last Thursday at Winthrop with 11 points and eight rebounds in 41 minutes ... Radford will conclude its longest road trip of the season (five games) when it travels to No. 1 Kansas on Wednesday. This will be the Highlanders' second top 10 opponent of 2009-10.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville ended a six-game losing streak to open the season with a 58-56 victory at Gardner-Webb Friday night. The Bulldogs got the winning basket from **CHRIS STEPHENSON** with 1.6 seconds left. Asheville is now 13-1 in Big South openers under head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** ... **SEAN SMITH** now has 149 career three-pointers and is in third-place on Asheville's all-time career list in that category.

VMI

VMI's 108-93 win over Lynchburg College last week marked the fourth consecutive season that the Keydets have opened 3-0 at home ... VMI went 47-of-108 from beyond the arc in its three games last week for a 43.5 percentage. **KEITH GABRIEL** was 14-of-33 for a 42.4 clip, and made six threes against both LC and Charleston Southern. **MICHAEL SPARKS** was 16-of-24 from three-point range last week (=66.7 percent), and made 7-of-10 against Lynchburg ... VMI stands just three wins away from its 200th win at Cameron Hall. VMI is currently 197-168 on its home floor ... The Jan. 16 game time with Gardner-Webb has been moved to 7:00pm from 1:00pm.

WINTHROP

Winthrop led Radford 46-40, but went five minutes without a field goal that allowed the Highlanders to reclaim the lead. **GIDEON GAMBLE** sent the game into overtime with a 28-footer at the end of regulation ... Winthrop defeated High Point for the 23rd time in 27 meetings behind **REGGIE MIDDLETON**'s career-high 25 points, including 19 in a row during the final seven minutes of the game ... The Eagles had their highest point production of the season with 82 points against the Panthers, and shot better than 50 percent from the floor for the first time this season. WU, which entered the game with just 15 threes, was 9-of-14 from three-point range ... The 82 points were the third-most by Winthrop over the past two years.
