COASTAL CAROLINA TIES RECORD FOR FASTEST TEAM TO 20 WINS

Coastal Carolina tied the Big South record for fastest team to 20 wins, as the Chanticleers collected their 20th victory of the season in their 24th game of the year. The Chants join the 1991-92 Liberty Flames, the 2006-07 Winthrop Eagles and the 2008-09 VMI Keydets as the only teams to start 20-4. Earlier this season, Coastal Carolina was the fastest team in Big South history to win 15 games, which came in their 17th contest, and matched the Big South record for best 20-game start at 17-3.

20/20 VISION

Coastal Carolina has won 20 regular-season games for the first time since 1990-91, when the Chanticleers won 20 games before the Conference Tournament en route to a school-record 24 wins that year.

HISTORY REPEATING ITSELF??

Last season, Radford established the Big South's best "worst-to-first" in League history, as the Highlanders improved from seventh-place in 2007-08 to League champion in 2008-09. Radford's historical turnaround could be short-lived, as Coastal Carolina sits in first-place this season after finishing eighth in the standings a year ago. The Chanticleers hold a two-game lead atop the standings with five Conference games remaining.

SCREAMING EAGLES

Winthrop has won five-straight games to move into a tie for second-place in the Big South standings. During the current run, the Eagles have held every opponent below 40 percent from the field (34.6 percent total), while out-rebounding the competition by +8.0 (44.8 to 36.8). Winthrop is averaging 68.2 points and 42.9 percent from field in its win streak, while holding opponents to 57.6 points. Winners of eight of their last nine, Winthrop has held three foes below 50 points in that span.

TURN BABY TURN

Coastal Carolina is enjoying a turnaround from last season's 11-20 overall mark and 5-13 Big South record. The Chants are +10 in the overall win column from a year ago and +6 on the Conference win side -- tied for the best year-to-year improvement in Conference play based on the same number of League games the previous season. Liberty posted a 6-win improvement during a 12-game Conference schedule in 2002-03. That year, the Flames went 8-6 in the League after going 2-12 in 2001-02. The Big South's best ever year-to-year improvement in overall wins is +15 by Radford in 1990-91, as the Highlanders finished 22-7 that season after posting a 7-22 mark in 1989-90. In Big South games, the League's top overall year-to-year win improvement is +10, which was accomplished by Radford in 2008-09. Last season, the Highlanders went 15-3 after going 5-9 in 2007-08.

ANOTHER FIRST FOR COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina is the first team in Big South history to win back-to-back Conference games by at least 30 points. The Chanticleers defeated Gardner-Webb by 36 points on Feb. 4 (96-60), then equaled the margin of victory against UNC Asheville on Feb. 6 (98-62). The Chanticleers have won nine of their 11 Big South games by 10-or-more points and their average margin of victory in their 11 Conference wins is 20.6 points. Coastal Carolina owns an overall scoring margin of +16.4, which is pacing ahead of the Big South single-season record of +13.4 set by Winthrop in 2006-07. The Chanticleers have a +13.2 scoring margin in Conference games, the highest in the League since Winthrop posted a +15.2 margin against League foes in 2006-07.

GOING FOR 10

Winthrop is one Big South win away from winning 10 League games for the 10th time, which would extend its Big South record. Radford also is one victory shy of 10 Big South wins this season, which would mark the eighth time overall that the Highlanders have recorded double-digit Conference wins as well as their first back-to-back seasons with 10 Big South victories since 1999-00 and 2000-01.

MILESTONE WATCH #1 - EUGENE HARRIS CLOSING IN TWO 250 CLUBS

High Point senior **EUGENE HARRIS** needs one assist to become just the fifth player in Big South history with 250 career three-pointers and 250 career assists. He ranks ninth in Big South history with a school-record 272 career three-point field goals, and would join Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** (411 3FG, 353 AST), UNC Greensboro's **SCOTT HARTZELL** (309 3FG, 552 AST), VMI's **CHAVIS HOLMES** (306 3FG, 313 AST) and UNC Asheville's **JOSH KOHN** (296 3FG, 430 AST) on the League's 250 3FG, 250 AST list. Meanwhile, Harris needs three treys to move into eighth-place in League annals (275 - Coastal Carolina's **KEKE HICKS**, 1992-95).

MILESTONE WATCH #2 - 700 REBOUND MEMBERSHIP

Radford's **ART PARAKHOUSKI** is 24 rebounds away from becoming the 20th player in Big South history with 700 career rebounds. He would also become the 19th player with 1,000 points and 700 boards. Meanwhile, Parakhouski tied his career-high with six blocked shots, including the 100th of his career, Sunday vs. High Point and is now just one of eight players in Big South history with 1,000 points, 600 rebounds and 100 blocked shots.

TV TIME

The Big South Conference Royal Purple "Game of the Week" television package continues this Saturday with two broadcasts. SportSouth will air Presbyterian College at Winthrop beginning at 3:30pm, while MASN will televise the Charleston Southern at High Point game at 6:00pm. CSU-HPU will also be simulcast on WMMP-TV 36 in Charleston, S.C., and WMBF News XTRA in Myrtle Beach, S.C. **MATT HOGUE** (play-by-play) and **RALPH PATTERSON** (analyst) will call the SportSouth broadcast, while **MARK BRYANT** (play-by-play) and **NATE ROSS** (analyst) will handle the MASN telecast. The final Royal Purple TV "Game of the Week" will be the Feb. 27 regular-season finale between Winthrop and Radford on MASN at 4:00pm.

ELDER STATESMAN

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** has now directed four Division I programs to 20 win seasons, and has reached 20 victories for the 13th time in his coaching career. He collected his 650th career win on Monday, Jan. 4 when the Chanticleers defeated Presbyterian College, and owns a lifetime record of 657-388. Ellis has amassed 579 Division I victories, which ranks 11th on the NCAA's active win list. Coastal Carolina's 21 wins nearly equal his combined total from his first two years leading the Chanticleers (24).

HOME AWAY FROM HOME?

The road teams have won 27 of the first 64 Big South games played -- a .422 winning percentage, and marks the third time in the last four seasons that road teams have won at least 40 percent of Conference games. Here is a look at each team's home and road record in Big South games this season, in current standings order:

CLOSE AND NOT SO CLOSE

Of the first 64 Big South Conference games, 32 have been decided by less than 10 points (50.0 percent), with the average margin of victory in those games being 4.72 points. Of the 32 games decided by double-digits, the average margin of victory is 17.78 points. The overall margin of victory in League play stands at 11.25 points.

MILESTONE WATCH #3 - JOHNSON ON CUSP OF ASSIST RECORD

Radford senior **AMIR JOHNSON** is 12 assists away from breaking the Big South career record of 567, which was set by Winthrop's **CHRIS GAYNOR** from 2004-08. Johnson is averaging 6.71 helpers in his last seven games and is currently fifth in League history with 556. Just one of eight players in Conference annals with 1,000 career points and 500 career assists, Johnson's 454 career rebounds are the most of the 1,000-point/500-assist club members.

A WORK OF ART

Radford center **ART PARAKHOUSKI** is just the second player in Big South history with 300 rebounds in back-to-back seasons, as he leads the Conference with 307 overall and 13.3 per game. He is on pace to pull down 400 boards through the quarterfinals of the Advance Auto Parts Big South Men's Basketball Championship, which would break his Big South single-season record of 369 rebounds, which he set last season. His per game average is pacing +1.9 ahead of the League record of 11.4. Meanwhile, Parakhouski enters this week ranked in the top 10 nationally in scoring (9th - 22.0), rebounding (2nd - 13.3) and field goal percentage (4th - 59.7).

MILESTONE WATCH #4 - JOHN WILLIAMS' BUILDING BLOCKS

UNC Asheville redshirt-junior **JOHN WILLIAMS** became UNC Asheville's all-time leading shot blocker this past Saturday at Coastal Carolina with his 191st career rejection, breaking the previous mark of 190 that was set by **C.J. WALKER** from 2003-07. Williams needs nine blocked shots to become the fifth player in League annals with 200 career blocks. He also is 10 rebounds shy of 500 in his career, which would make him just the fourth Big South player with 500 rebounds and 200 rejections when he reaches both milestones.

KEYDET KICKS

VMI junior **AUSTIN KENON** has made a three-pointer in 67 of his 71 career games and has made 234 total for a 3.30 per game average, which is currently the fourth-highest per game clip in League history. The Big South career record is 3.51, set by Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** from 2004-08. Meanwhile, Kenon's teammate **KEITH GABRIEL** has drained a three-pointer in 49 of his 54 career games and already has 157 in his career, an average of 2.91 per game.

FROM THE LAND OF THREE...

Charleston Southern junior **JAMARCO WARREN** became the Buccaneers' all-time three-point field goal leader last week as he surpassed the mark of 234 established by **BRETT LARRICK** from 1993-97. Warren now has 241 in his career and is 12th on the Big South's all-time list. He needs 13 treys to crack the League's top 10. Liberty's **KYLE OHMAN**, currently sidelined 2-6 weeks with an injury, has 192. UNC Asheville's **SEAN SMITH** has 183 treys in his career, second-most in school history.

I WANNA BLOCK

UNC Asheville leads the Big South with 136 blocked shots and 5.67 per game, and is on pace for 170 blocks this season -- which would be the second-most in a single-season in Big South history. The Bulldogs already own the top two marks -- 196 in 2007-08 and 165 in 1997-98. **JOHN WILLIAMS** leads the Conference with 2.78 blocks a game, and is looking to become the ninth Bulldog player to lead the Big South in blocked shots, the last being **KENNY GEORGE** in 2007-08 (3.3).

A RARE TRIPLE CROWN AND A POSSIBLE FIRST

Radford senior **ART PARAKHOUSKI** currently leads the Big South in scoring (22.0), rebounding (13.3) and field goal percentage (59.7), and is looking to become just the second player in Big South history to lead the League in all three categories. The first was High Point's **DANNY GATHINGS** in 2002-03 with averages of 18.7 points, 7.6 rebounds and 57.1 percent from the field. Parakhouski is attempting to become the first player in Big South history to average 20.0 points and 60.0 percent from the field (based on 5.0 field goals per game) in the same season.

PARAKHOUSKI ENTERS BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB

Radford's **ART PARAKHOUSKI** became the 99th player in Big South history with 1,000 points when he eclipsed the milestone Feb. 2 at VMI -- and tied for the sixth-fastest player in League annals to score 1,000 career points (55 games). Below is a look at the Big South's active 1,000-point scorers and their respective rank in League history.

He also has 542 career rebounds (164 at Radford). Gardner-Webb senior **GRAYSON FLITTNER** eclipsed 1,000 career points Nov. 21 against Methodist College and has 1,156 points in his career (537 as a Big South member).

HE IS THE ONLY ONE

Radford's **ART PARAKHOUSKI** is the lone Big South men's basketball player to score in double figures in all of his team's games this season, and owns the Big South's longest double-figure scoring streak at 25 games, dating back to 2008-09.

BIG SOUTH COACHES TO GO BAREFOOT FOR BARE FEET

The Big South men's basketball coaches are participating in the Conference's "Barefoot for Bare Feet" initiative in support of Samaritan's Feet. Charleston Southern's **BARCLAY RADEBAUGH**, Gardner-Webb's **RICK SCRUGGS** and Coastal Carolina's **CLIFF ELLIS** have recently coached barefoot, and this week, UNC Asheville's **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** (Feb. 11), Winthrop's **RANDY PEELE** (Feb. 13) and High Point's **SCOTT CHERRY** (Feb. 13) will all coach barefoot. The Big South's Student-Athlete Advisory Committee has adopted Samaritan's Feet as its charity for 2009-10 and has pledged to collect the equivalent of 17,000 pairs of shoes the entire 2009-10 athletic season.

MILESTONE WATCH #5 - GARDNER-WEBB'S JOSHUA TREE

Gardner-Webb sophomore forward **JOSH HENLEY** needs just 25 rebounds for 500 in his young career, and would become the second player in Big South history to amass 500 career rebounds as a sophomore. Campbell's **JOE SPINKS** was the first Big South sophomore to reach 500 rebounds, as he totaled 523 in his first two seasons with the Camels en route to becoming the Big South's all-time leading rebounder from 1994-2008. Henley needs to average 4.17 rebounds in Gardner-Webb's six remaining regular-season games to reach the milestone prior to the Big South Tournament.

MILESTONE WATCH #6 - STEADY EDDIE LOOKING TO SCORE SECOND WIN RECORD

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** is three wins shy of tying former Winthrop coach **GREGG MARSHALL** as the Big South's all-time winningest coach. Biedenbach is 191-216 at Asheville, and is approaching Marshall's 194 wins as the Eagles' head coach from 1998-07. Biedenbach became the Big South's all-time leader for most regular-season Conference wins on Thursday, Jan. 21 with the Bulldogs' 66-53 triumph over Winthrop, as he collected his 110th Big South victory that night, breaking the record of 109 that was established by former Radford coach **RON BRADLEY** from 1991-02. Biedenbach now has 113 regular-season Big South victories.

BIG SOUTH'S BRACKETBUSTERS OPPONENTS REVEALED

The official 2010 BracketBusters match-ups were unveiled on Monday, Feb. 1, and the Big South will play two members from the OVC and one each from the SoCon and CAA. A League-high four members will represent the Big South in 2010 -- Gardner-Webb, Presbyterian College, Radford and Winthrop. Winthrop, which will make its fifth-straight appearance in the series, will play at Eastern Kentucky, while Presbyterian College will make its BracketBusters debut at Jacksonville State. Gardner-Webb will make its second appearance and will host Elon, while first-time participant Radford will host UNC Wilmington. The four games are scheduled for Saturday, Feb. 20.

WELL-ROUNDED INDIVIDUAL

Charleston Southern sophomore forward **KELVIN MARTIN** has been a quiet force for the Buccaneers. He leads the Big South in steals per game with 2.35, is fourth in the League in rebounding at 8.3, and is fourth in field goal percentage (50.0) -- the only Big South player to rank in the top five in the Conference in each category. He also is 12th in the Big South with 13.5 points per game. Martin's 54 steals this season are a career-high, and he is looking to become the first Buccaneer to lead the Big South in steals per game since **ED O'NEIL** in 2003-04.

ART CLASS

Radford's **ART PARAKHOUSKI** has recorded 14 games this season with 20 points and 10 rebounds, with seven coming against Big South members. In those seven games, he is averaging 26.0 points and 14.4 rebounds. Parakhouski has yet to post a 20-10 game against Charleston Southern and Presbyterian College, but will get a chance this Thursday vs. Charleston Southern and Feb. 25 vs. PC. Parakhouski did not reach the 20-point/10-rebound threshold in two games this season against UNC Asheville.

CRUZZING ALTITUDE

High Point 6-11 redshirt-senior **CRUZ DANIELS** is second all-time in Big South history with 285 career blocked shots. He has recorded a blocked shot in a career-high 28 consecutive games and is averaging 2.89 blocks in that span (81 total). Daniels, who has blocked at least five shots in a game 17 times in his career, is one of just two players in Big South history with 600 career rebounds and 250 career blocked shots, joining Liberty's **PETER ALUMA**, who had 682 rebounds and 366 blocks from 1994-97.

BIG MEN ON CAMPUS

Radford's frontcourt trio of **ART PARAKHOUSKI** (22.0 points/13.3 rebounds), **LAZ TRIFUNOVIC** (14.4 points/8.6 rebounds) and **JOEY LYNCH-FLOHR** (12.2 points/7.0 rebounds) account for 61.8 percent of RU's offense and 62.8 percent of the squad's rebounds per game. Combined, Parakhouski, Lynch-Flohr and Trifunovic are averaging 48.6 points and 28.9 rebounds per game. To go along with their statistical output, the trio has combined for 32 double-doubles this season.

SCOREBOARD WATCHING

Defending three-time NCAA scoring champion VMI continues to lead the nation in scoring with an average of 89.6 points per game. The Keydets are looking to become the first team in NCAA Division I history to lead the country in scoring four consecutive seasons. VMI, Furman (1952-55) and Loyola Marymount (1987-90) are the only programs to lead the nation three-straight years.

PLANNING AHEAD

Presbyterian College is in the second-to-last year of its transition to Division I and will become full-fledged members of the NCAA's top division in 2011-12. PC will be eligible for the Big South's postseason tournament and automatic bid that same year. Therefore, head coach **GREGG NIBERT** is redshirting three of his top players this season -- **AL'LOUNZO COLEMAN**, **JOSH JOHNSON** and **PIERRE MILLER**, so all three will be fifth-year seniors in 2011-12. The trio combined for 946 points last season -- 54.7 percent of the Blue Hose's season total, and Coleman earned Second-Team All-Conference honors after averaging 15.0 points and 8.4 rebounds.

CHARTER MEMBER

Coastal Carolina's **JOSEPH HARRIS** is the first player in Big South history with 1,000 points, 1,000 rebounds, 150 steals and 100 blocked shots. He became the Big South's all-time rebounding king on Saturday, Jan. 16 vs. High Point when he corralled his 1,014th career rebound, breaking the Conference record of 1,013 that was set by High Point's **ARIZONA REID** just two seasons ago.

COASTAL CAROLINA REMAINS IN TOP 20 OF MID-MAJOR POLL

Coastal Carolina is ranked No. 15 in this week's *Collegeinsider.com* Mid-Major Top 25 poll, up two spots from last week's ranking and within one slot of its season-high ranking of No. 14 the week of Jan. 25. This is the sixth consecutive year that the Big South has had a team ranked in the Mid-Major Top 25, and the second-straight season that more than one team entered the poll, as Radford was ranked the first three weeks of the season. CSU lost at home for just the second time, falling to Gardner-Webb this past Saturday. **JEREMY SEXTON** had a career-high 23 points in the losing effort, including 15 in the second stanza.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina has won 20 games in a season for the ninth time in school history, the first since the 2005-06 campaign ... Coastal shot 57.6 percent from the field in its two wins last week and went 46.4 percent from beyond the arc. The Chants also had a 16.5 rebounding advantage over its opponents ... **JOSEPH HARRIS** is now eighth on Coastal Carolina's career scoring chart with 1,334 points ... The **MARIO EDWARDS**-to-**CHRIS EVANS** alley-oop dunk against Gardner-Webb last Thursday was #7 on ESPN's SportCenter's "Top 10 Plays" of the night ... Evans averaged 11.0 points and 71.4 percent from the field last week.

GARDNER-WEBB

Gardner-Webb shot a season-best 65.0 percent from the field in Saturday's win at Charleston Southern. The effort gave GWU a 5-game win streak over the Buccaneers ... 6-11 senior **MATT MADEN** made his first career start against the Bucs and finished with a career-high six points on 3-of-4 shooting ... **BRANDON JACKSON** scored a career-high eight points at CSU, one of three players to reach career highs in scoring in the game ... **C.J. HAILEY** has scored 47 points in his last three halves. He had 17 second-half points at Coastal Carolina and a career-high 30 for the game at Charleston Southern.

HIGH POINT

High Point is four Conference wins ahead of last season, as the Panthers were 2-10 after 12 Big South games in 2008-09 ... LIBERTY

Sophomore **JESSE SANDERS** surpassed the 250 career assist mark this past Saturday vs. Presbyterian College. PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE
