COASTAL CAROLINA COULD STILL TIE RECORD FOR FASTEST TEAM TO 20 WINS

Already the fastest team in Big South history to win 15 games, which came in their 17th contest of the season, as well as matching the Big South record for best 20-game start at 17-3, the Coastal Carolina Chanticleers could still tie the Conference record for fastest team to win 20 games. The Chants would need to win their next contest (Feb. 4 vs. Gardner-Webb) to equal the mark of 24 games (20-4), which has been accomplished by three teams -- Liberty in 1991-92, Winthrop in 2006-07 and VMI in 2008-09. Coastal Carolina is one win shy of recording 20 regular-season wins for the first time since 1990-91.

MILESTONE WATCH #1 - PARAKHOUSKI SET TO ENTER BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB

Radford's **ART PARAKHOUSKI** needs three points to become the 99th player in Big South history with 1,000 points. Below is a look at the Big South's active 1,000-point scorers and their respective rank in League history.

Meanwhile, Radford's **LAZ TRIFUNOVIC** is 79 points away from 1,000 in his collegiate career, as he scored 686 in two seasons at Binghamton and has 235 after 17 games with the Highlanders. He also has 527 career rebounds (149 at Radford). Gardner-Webb senior **GRAYSON FLITTNER** eclipsed 1,000 career points Nov. 21 against Methodist College, and has 1,153 points in his career (534 as a Big South member).

MILESTONE WATCH #2 - EUGENE HARRIS CLOSING IN TWO 250 CLUBS

High Point senior **EUGENE HARRIS** needs three assists to become just the fifth player in Big South history with 250 career three-pointers and 250 career assists. He ranks ninth in Big South history with a school-record 267 career three-point field goals, and would join Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** (411 3FG, 353 AST), UNC Greensboro's **SCOTT HARTZELL** (309 3FG, 552 AST), VMI's **CHAVIS HOLMES** (306 3FG, 313 AST) and UNC Asheville's **JOSH KOHN** (296 3FG, 430 AST) on the League's 250 3FG, 250 AST list. Meanwhile, Harris needs eight treys to move into eighth-place (275 - Coastal Carolina's **KEKE HICKS**, 1992-95), and is 33 away from becoming the fifth Big South player with 300 career three-pointers. He would need to average 3.67 in High Point's remaining nine games scheduled to reach 300.

MILESTONE WATCH #3 - JOHN WILLIAMS' BUILDING BLOCKS

UNC Asheville redshirt-junior **JOHN WILLIAMS** is averaging 4.83 blocked shots in his last six games (29 total) to increase his career total to 190 -- tying UNC Asheville's all-time record set by **C.J. WALKER** from 2003-07 and tied for fifth in Big South history. Williams needs 10 blocked shots to become the fifth player in League annals with 200 career blocks. He also is 26 rebounds shy of 500 in his career, which would make him just the fourth Big South player with 500 rebounds and 200 rejections when he reaches both milestones.

MILESTONE WATCH #4 - 1,000 POINT, 600 REBOUND MEMBERSHIP

Radford's **ART PARAKHOUSKI** is on track to become the third player this season and 25th overall in the League's 1,000-point/600-rebound club, as he is three points away. Teammate **JOEY LYNCH-FLOHR** entered the club this past Saturday when he reached the 600-rebound mark, while Coastal Carolina's **JOSEPH HARRIS** was the first to enter this season when he scored his 1,000th point on Nov. 21.

MILESTONE WATCH #5 - GARDNER-WEBB'S JOSHUA TREE

Gardner-Webb sophomore forward **JOSH HENLEY** needs just 28 rebounds for 500 in his young career, and would become the second player in Big South history to amass 500 career rebounds as a sophomore. Campbell's **JOE SPINKS** was the first Big South sophomore to reach 500 rebounds, as he totaled 523 in his first two seasons with the Camels en route to becoming the Big South's all-time leading rebounder from 1994-2008.

MILESTONE WATCH #6 - STEADY EDDIE LOOKING TO SCORE SECOND WIN RECORD

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** is three wins shy of tying former Winthrop coach **GREGG MARSHALL** as the Big South's all-time winningest coach. Biedenbach is 191-214 at Asheville, and is approaching Marshall's 194 wins as the Eagles' head coach from 1998-07. Biedenbach became the Big South's all-time leader for most regular-season Conference wins on Thursday, Jan. 21 with the Bulldogs' 66-53 triumph over Winthrop, as he collected his 110th Big South victory that night, breaking the record of 109 that was established by former Radford coach **RON BRADLEY** from 1991-02. Biedenbach has now won 113 regular-season Big South games.

HISTORY REPEATING ITSELF??

Last season, Radford established the Big South's best "worst-to-first" in League history, as the Highlanders improved from seventh-place in 2007-08 to League champion in 2008-09. Radford's historical turnaround could be short-lived, as Coastal Carolina sits in first-place this season after finishing eighth in the standings a year ago. The Chanticleers hold a two-game lead atop the standings with seven Conference games remaining.

FLOOR GENERAL

Radford senior **AMIR JOHNSON**, who became the 10th player in Big South history with 500 career assists Jan. 9, is currently seventh all-time on the Big South's career list with 541, and needs two to reach the sixth spot. Johnson is 27 assists away from breaking the Big South career record of 567, which is held by Winthrop's **CHRIS GAYNOR** (2004-08), and is on pace to surpass the mark Feb. 16 at home against Liberty. Just one of eight players in Conference annals with 1,000 career points and 500 career assists, Johnson's 446 career rebounds are the most of the 1,000-point/500-assist club members.

HOME AWAY FROM HOME?

The road teams have won 23 of the first 54 Big South games played -- a .426 winning percentage, and marks the third time in the last four seasons that road teams won at least 40 percent of Conference games. Here is a look at each team's home and road record in Big South games this season, in current standings order:

A WORK OF ART

Radford center **ART PARAKHOUSKI** enters this week ranked in the top 10 nationally in scoring (10th - 22.1), rebounding (2nd - 12.8) and field goal percentage (5th - 59.2). He is on pace to pull down 383 rebounds through the quarterfinals of the Advance Auto Parts Big South Men's Basketball Championship, which would break his Big South single-season record of 369 rebounds, which he set last season. His per game average is pacing +1.4 ahead of the League record of 11.4, and he is 32 caroms away from becoming the second player in Big South history with back-to-back seasons with 300 rebounds.

BOARD REPORT

Within an eight-day span, three Big South players eclipsed 600 career rebounds. Radford's **ART PARAKHOUSKI** was the first (Jan. 23), followed by High Point's **CRUZ DANIELS** (Jan. 28) and Highlanders' forward **JOEY LYNCH-FLOHR** (Jan. 31). Parakhouski is tied for 25th in Big South history with 637, Daniels is tied for 29th at 614, while Lynch-Flohr is 31st with 603. Winthrop's **MANTORIS ROBINSON** became the 55th player on the Big South's 500-rebound chart on Jan. 23. KEYDET KICKS

VMI junior **AUSTIN KENON** has made a three-pointer in 64 of his 68 career games and has made 225 total for a 3.31 per game average, which is currently the fourth-highest per game clip in League history. The Big South career record is 3.51, set by Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** from 2004-08. Meanwhile, Kenon's teammate **KEITH GABRIEL** has drained a three-pointer in 47 of his 52 career games and already has 152 in his career, an average of 2.92 per game.

FROM THE LAND OF THREE...

Charleston Southern junior **JAMARCO WARREN** has 234 career three-pointers, tying the school record established by **BRETT LARRICK** from 1993-97 and tied for 12th on the Big South's all-time list. Liberty's **KYLE OHMAN**, currently sidelined 2-6 weeks with an injury, has 192. UNC Asheville's **SEAN SMITH** has 181 treys in his career, second-most in school history.

I WANNA BLOCK

UNC Asheville leads the Big South with 133 blocked shots and 6.05 per game, and is on pace for 181 blocks this season -- which would be the second-most in a single-season in Big South history. The Bulldogs already own the top two marks -- 196 in 2007-08 and 165 in 1997-98. **JOHN WILLIAMS** leads the Conference with 3.00 blocks a game, and is looking to become the fourth player in League history to average 3.0 blocks per game in one season, joining Liberty's **PETER ALUMA** (three times), UMBC's **PASCAL FLUERY** (twice) and former teammate **KENNY GEORGE** (once). At 6-4, Williams would be the shortest player in Big South history to average 3.0 blocks.

A RARE TRIPLE CROWN AND A POSSIBLE FIRST

Radford senior **ART PARAKHOUSKI** currently leads the Big South in scoring (22.1), rebounding (12.8) and field goal percentage (59.2), and is looking to become just the second player in Big South history to lead the League in all three categories. The first was High Point's **DANNY GATHINGS** in 2002-03 with averages of 18.7 points, 7.6 rebounds and 57.1 percent from the field. Parakhouski is looking to become the first player in Big South history to average 20.0 points and 60.0 percent from the field (based on 5.0 field goals per game) in the same season.

ART GALLERY

Radford's **ART PARAKHOUSKI** needs three points for 1,000 in his brief time with the Highlanders. He has 997 points in 54 career games at Radford, and is on track to match the sixth-fastest player in Big South history to score 1,000 career points (55 games). The record is 48 games, set by Charleston Southern's **BEN HINSON** and **DARNELL SNEED**. Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** collected his 650th career win on Monday, Jan. 4 when the Chanticleers defeated Presbyterian College. He now owns a lifetime record of 655-388. Ellis has amassed 577 Division I victories, which ranks 11th on the NCAA's active win list. Coastal Carolina's 19 wins this season already exceed last year's total (11) and Ellis' win total in his first season as the Chanticleers coach in 2007-08 (13). Ellis is looking to win 20 games at his fourth Division I school and for the 13th time in his coaching career.

CLOSE AND NOT SO CLOSE

Of the first 54 Big South Conference games, 28 have been decided by less than 10 points (51.9 percent), with the average margin of victory in those games being 4.54 points. Of the 26 games decided by double-digits, the average margin of victory is 15.88 points. The overall margin of victory in League play stands exactly at 10.0 points.

TURNAROUND JUMPERS

Coastal Carolina, Charleston Southern and High Point have exceeded their overall and Big South victory totals from last season, and Winthrop is poised to be the next squad to join the trio. The Eagles have matched last year's win total of 11 and need two League wins to equal the nine they won in 2008-09. The Chanticleers' exploits have already been detailed, as their 19-4 record and 9-2 Big South start have surpassed last year's 11-20 mark and 5-13 Conference record. Charleston Southern's 10 wins and five Big South victories are more than last year's total (9-20 overall and 4-14 Conference). High Point stands at 11-10 overall and 6-5 in Conference to exceed last year's victory totals in each category (9-21 overall, 4-14 Big South).

BIG SOUTH'S BRACKETBUSTERS OPPONENTS REVEALED

The official 2010 BracketBusters match-ups were unveiled on Monday, Feb. 1, and the Big South will play two members from the OVC and one each from the SoCon and CAA. A League-high four members will represent the Big South in 2010 -- Gardner-Webb, Presbyterian College, Radford and Winthrop. Winthrop, which will make its fifth-straight appearance in the series, will play at Eastern Kentucky, while Presbyterian College will make its BracketBusters debut at Jacksonville State. Gardner-Webb will make its second appearance and will host Elon, while first-time participant Radford will host UNC Wilmington. The four games are scheduled for Saturday, Feb. 20.

BIG SOUTH COACHES TO GO BAREFOOT FOR BARE FEET

The Big South men's basketball coaches are participating in the Conference's "Barefoot for Bare Feet" initiative in support of Samaritan's Feet. Charleston Southern's **BARCLAY RADEBAUGH** and Gardner-Webb's **RICK SCRUGGS** have recently coached barefoot, and this week Coastal Carolina's **CLIFF ELIS** will coach shoeless on Feb. 6. The Big South's Student-Athlete Advisory Committee has adopted Samaritan's Feet as its charity for 2009-10 and has pledged to collect 17,000 pairs of shoes the entire 2009-10 athletic season.

WELL-ROUNDED INDIVIDUAL

Charleston Southern sophomore forward **KELVIN MARTIN** has been a quiet force for the Buccaneers. He leads the Big South in steals per game with 2.19, is fourth in the League in rebounding at 8.4, and is fourth in field goal percentage (49.8) -- the only Big South player to rank in the top five in the Conference in each category. He also is 10th in the Big South with 14.0 points per game. Martin's 46 steals this season are a career-high, and he is looking to become the first Buccaneer to lead the Big South in steals per game since **ED O'NEIL** in 2003-04.

ART CLASS

Radford's **ART PARAKHOUSKI** has recorded 13 games this season with 20 points and 10 rebounds, with six coming against Big South members. In those six games, he is averaging 25.3 points and 13.2 rebounds. Parakhouski has yet to post a 20-10 game against Charleston Southern and Presbyterian College, but will get a chance on Feb. 11 vs. Charleston Southern and Feb. 25 vs. PC. Parakhouski did not reach the 20-point/10-rebound threshold in two games this season against UNC Asheville.

CRUZZING ALTITUDE

High Point 6-11 redshirt-senior **CRUZ DANIELS** is second all-time in Big South history with 280 career blocked shots. He has recorded a blocked shot in a career-high 26 consecutive games and is averaging 2.92 blocks in that span (76 total). Daniels, who has blocked at least five shots in a game 17 times in his career, is one of just two players in Big South history with 600 career rebounds and 250 career blocked shots, joining Liberty's **PETER ALUMA**, who had 682 rebounds and 366 blocks from 1994-97.

SPEAKING OF BLOCKS

Radford's **ART PARAKHOUSKI** needs four blocked shots for 100 in his career, and will become the eighth player in Big South history with 1,000 points, 600 rebounds and 100 blocks once he reaches the scoring and blocks milestones. He also will be the third Radford player on the list (most of any Big South school), joining **TYRONE TRAVIS** and **CHRIS OLIVER**.

STAN THE MAN

In a five-game stretch coming off the bench from Jan. 14-26, VMI 6-5 freshman forward **STAN OKOYE** went for 20 points and 10 rebounds in each game, averaging 22.4 points and 11.6 rebounds in that stretch. He scored a career-high 24 points twice (High Point, Southern Virginia) and set a personal-best with 14 rebounds against HPU. In addition, Okoye shot 61.1 percent from the floor (44-of-72), including 5-of-9 from three-point range, as well as blocking 3.0 shots and contributing 1.7 steals.

BIG MEN ON CAMPUS

Radford's frontcourt trio of **ART PARAKHOUSKI** (22.1 points/12.8 rebounds), **LAZ TRIFUNOVIC** (13.8 points/8.8 rebounds) and **JOEY LYNCH-FLOHR** (12.3 points/6.9 rebounds) account for 62.6 percent of RU's offense and 62.3 percent of the squad's rebounds per game. Combined, Parakhouski, Lynch-Flohr and Trifunovic are averaging 48.2 points and 28.5 rebounds per game. To go along with their statistical output, the trio has combined for 28 double-doubles this season.

COMING FULL CIRCLE

Former Big South charter member Campbell University is rejoining the Big South in 2011-12, increasing the League's membership to 11. Campbell enjoyed a successful stint in the Conference, winning the 1992 Big South championship and becoming the League's first automatic bid recipient that year. The Camels appeared in a total of four Conference championship games before departing for the Trans America Athletic Conference (TAAC) following the 1993-94 season.

HE IS THE ONLY ONE

Radford's **ART PARAKHOUSKI** is the lone Big South men's basketball player to score in double figures in all of his team's games this season, and owns the Big South's longest double-figure scoring streak at 23 games, dating back to 2008-09.

CHARTER MEMBER

Coastal Carolina's **JOSEPH HARRIS** is the first player in Big South history with 1,000 points, 1,000 rebounds, 150 steals and 100 blocked shots. He became the Big South's all-time rebounding king on Saturday, Jan. 16 vs. High Point when he corralled his 1,014th career rebound, breaking the Conference record of 1,013 that was set by High Point's **ARIZONA REID** just two seasons ago.

ALL ABOUT MARGINS

Coastal Carolina has won 17 of its 19 games this season by 10-or-more points, and owns a +14.7 scoring margin -- pacing ahead of the Big South single-season record of +13.4 set by Winthrop in 2006-07. The Chanticleers have won eight of their nine Conference games by double digits, and own a +9.1 scoring margin in Conference games, the highest in the League since Winthrop posted a +9.6 margin against League foes in 2007-08.

COASTAL CAROLINA RANKED IN MID-MAJOR POLL

Coastal Carolina is ranked No. 17 in this week's *Collegeinsider.com* Mid-Major Top 25 poll, down three spots from its season-high ranking of No. 14 last week. This is the sixth consecutive year that the Big South has had a team ranked in the Mid-Major Top 25, and the second-straight season that more than one team entered the poll, as Radford was ranked the first three weeks of the season. Presbyterian College is in the second-to-last year of its transition to Division I and will become full-fledged members of the NCAA's top division in 2011-12. PC will be eligible for the Big South's postseason tournament and automatic bid that same year. Therefore, head coach **GREGG NIBERT** is redshirting three of his top players this season -- **AL'LONZO COLEMAN**, **JOSH JOHNSON** and **PIERRE MILLER**, so all three will be fifth-year seniors in 2011-12. The trio combined for 946 points last season -- 54.7 percent of the Blue Hose's season total, and Coleman earned Second-Team All-Conference honors after averaging 15.0 points and 8.4 rebounds.
