STEADY EDDIE GETS BIG SOUTH WIN RECORD

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** became the Big South's all-time leader for most regular-season Conference wins on Thursday, Jan. 21 with the Bulldogs' 66-53 triumph over Winthrop. Biedenbach collected his 110th Big South victory that night, breaking the record of 109 that was established by former Radford coach **RON BRADLEY** from 1991-02. Biedenbach notched win No. 111 this past Saturday against Presbyterian College. Meanwhile, with 189 wins at Asheville, Biedenbach is five wins shy of tying former Winthrop coach **GREGG MARSHALL** as the Big South's all-time winningest coach. Marshall won 194 games in nine seasons as the Eagles' head coach from 1998-07.

COASTAL CAROLINA RECEIVES VOTE IN AP TOP 25 POLL

League-leading Coastal Carolina received a vote in this week's *Associated Press* Top 25 poll. This is the first time this season that the Chanticleers have received a vote in the AP poll, and they are tied with Harvard for 46th place with the one vote. Coastal Carolina received a vote in the *ESPN/USA Today* Coaches' poll the week of Dec. 14.

HALFWAY HOME

The Conference season is at the exact midway point, and the road teams have won 20 of the first 45 Big South games played -- a .444 winning percentage. Last season, the road team was victorious in 22 of the first 45 contests. In addition, five teams stand at 5-4 in Conference play -- the League had four teams deadlocked with 5-4 Conference records last season. BIG SOUTH'S 500-, 600-REBOUNDING CLUBS ADD NEW MEMBERS

Winthrop's **MANTORIS ROBINSON** grabbed his 500th career rebound this past Saturday at Gardner-Webb, becoming the 55th player on the Big South's 500-rebound chart. Meanwhile, Radford's **ART PARAKHOUSKI** became the 29th player in League history to reach 600 career rebounds when he eclipsed the milestone this past Saturday against Liberty. He surpassed 500 caroms on Dec. 27 at Louisville, and is the Big South's career leader for rebounds per game. High Point's **CRUZ DANIELS** is two rebounds shy of 600, while Radford's **JOEY LYNCH-FLOHR** is 18 away from the 600-rebound mark. JUMPIN' JOSH

Gardner-Webb sophomore forward **JOSH HENLEY** needs just 47 rebounds for 500 in his young career. Should he reach the milestone this season, he would become the second player in Big South history to amass 500 rebounds as a sophomore. Campbell's **JOE SPINKS** was the first Big South sophomore to reach 500 rebounds, as he totaled 523 in his first two seasons with the Camels en route to becoming the Big South's all-time leading rebounder from 1994-2008.

CLOSE AND NOT SO CLOSE

Of the first 45 Big South Conference games, 22 have been decided by less than 10 points, with the average margin of victory in those games being 4.5 points. Of the 23 games decided by double-digits, the average margin of victory is 15.8 points. The overall margin of victory in League play stands at 10.2 points.

COASTAL CAROLINA CHALLENGING RECORD FOR FASTEST TEAM TO 20 WINS

Already the fastest team in Big South history to win 15 games, which came in their 17th contest of the season, as well as matching the Big South record for best 20-game start at 17-3, the Coastal Carolina Chanticleers are challenging the League mark for fastest team to win 20 games. That record is 24 games (20-4) and has been accomplished by three teams -- Liberty in 1991-92, Winthrop in 2006-07 and VMI in 2008-09. The Chanticleers are two victories away from recording 20 regular-season wins for the first time since 1990-91.

PARAKHOUSKI SET TO ENTER BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB

Radford's **ART PARAKHOUSKI** needs 42 points to become the 99th player in Big South history with 1,000 points. Below is a look at the Big South's active 1,000-point scorers and their respective rank in League history.

Meanwhile, Gardner-Webb senior **GRAYSON FLITTNER** eclipsed 1,000 career points Nov. 21 against Methodist College, and has 1,137 points in his career (518 as a Big South member). Radford's **LAZ TRIFUNOVIC** is 124 points away from 1,000 in his collegiate career, as he scored 686 in two seasons at Binghamton and has 190 after 14 games with the Highlanders.

JOSEPH HARRIS - THE BIG SOUTH'S REBOUNING KING

Coastal Carolina redshirt-senior **JOSEPH HARRIS** became the Big South's all-time rebounding king on Saturday, Jan. 16 vs. High Point when he corralled his 1,014th career rebound, breaking the Conference record of 1,013 that was set by High Point's **ARIZONA REID** just two seasons ago. Harris reached the 1,000 rebound threshold on Thursday, Jan. 14 vs. Radford, and is just the second player in Big South history with 1,000 points and 1,000 rebounds. Harris opened the 2009-10 campaign tied for seventh on the League's career rebounding chart.

ANOTHER HARRIS MAKING A NAME FOR HIMSELF

High Point senior **EUGENE HARRIS** is ninth in Big South history with a school-record 263 career three-point field goals, and needs 12 to move into eighth-place (275 - Coastal Carolina's **KEKE HICKS**, 1992-95). Harris is 37 treys away from becoming the fifth Big South player with 300 career three-pointers, and would need to average 3.36 in High Point's remaining 11 games scheduled to reach 300. Meanwhile, Harris also has 244 career assists, and is on track to become just the fifth player in Big South history with 250 career three-pointers and 250 career assists. The other four are Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** (411 3FG, 353 AST), UNC Greensboro's **SCOTT HARTZELL** (309 3FG, 552 AST), VMI's **CHAVIS HOLMES** (306 3FG, 313 AST) and UNC Asheville's **JOSH KOHN** (296 3FG, 430 AST).

FLOOR GENERAL

Radford senior **AMIR JOHNSON**, who became the 10th player in Big South history with 500 career assists Jan. 9, is currently eighth all-time on the Big South's career list with 519, and needs one to reach the seventh spot. Now just one of eight players in Conference annals with 1,000 career points and 500 career assists, Johnson is 49 assists away from breaking the Big South career record of 567, which is held by Winthrop's **CHRIS GAYNOR** (2004-08), and is on pace to surpass the mark Feb. 25 at home against Presbyterian College.

A WORK OF ART

Radford center **ART PARAKHOUSKI** is second in the nation in rebounding, and is on pace to break his Big South single-season record of 369 rebounds, which he set last season. If he should continue at his current pace of 12.9 rebounds in Radford's next 12 games, Parakhouski would finish with 387 rebounds through the quarterfinals of the Advance Auto Parts Big South Men's Basketball Championship. His per game average is piling +1.5 ahead of the League record of 11.4. Parakhouski enters this week as the only NCAA Division I player to rank in the top five nationally in scoring (4th), rebounding (2nd) and field goal percentage (1st).

A RARE TRIPLE CROWN AND A POSSIBLE FIRST

Radford senior **ART PARAKHOUSKI** currently leads the Big South in scoring (23.6), rebounding (12.9) and field goal percentage (62.2), and is looking to become just the second player in Big South history to lead the League in all three categories. The first was High Point's **DANNY GATHINGS** in 2002-03 with averages of 18.7 points, 7.6 rebounds and 57.1 percent from the field. Should Parakhouski maintain his averages for the duration of the season, he would become the first player in Big South history to average 20.0 points and 60.0 percent from the field (based on 5.0 field goals per game) in the same season.

TURNAROUND JUMPERS

Coastal Carolina, Charleston Southern and High Point have exceeded their overall and Big South victory totals from last season. The Chanticleers' exploits have already been detailed, as their 18-3 record and 8-1 Big South start have surpassed last year's 11-20 mark and 5-13 Conference record. Charleston Southern's 10-9 record and 5-4 League mark this season is more than last year's total (9-20 overall and 4-14 Conference). High Point stands at 10-9 overall and 5-4 in Conference to exceed last year's victory totals in each category (9-21 overall, 4-14 Big South).

ART GALLERY

Radford's **ART PARAKHOUSKI** needs 42 points for 1,000 in his brief time with the Highlanders. He has 958 points in 51 career games at Radford, and is on pace to reach the scoring milestone in his 53rd game (based on his current 23.6 scoring clip), which would make him the sixth-fastest player in Big South history to score 1,000 career points. The record is 48 games, set by Charleston Southern's **BEN HINSON** and **DARNELL SNEED**. Below is a look at the five fastest players to score 1,000 career points in Big South history and the season it was accomplished:

Radford's **ART PARAKHOUSKI** is on track to become the third player this season and 39th overall in the League's 1,000-point/500-rebound club, as he is 42 points away. Teammate **JOEY LYNCH-FLOHR** entered the club on Dec. 13 when he reached the 1,000-point mark, while Coastal Carolina's **JOSEPH HARRIS** was the first to enter this season when he scored his 1,000th point on Nov. 21. Parakhouski would become the 11th Radford player on the list, the most of any Big South member.

BLOCK STEADY

UNC Asheville redshirt-junior **JOHN WILLIAMS** is averaging 3.43 blocked shots in his last seven games, including 4.33 in three games last week, to increase his career total to 179 -- good for seventh all-time in Big South history. He needs four blocks to move into sixth-place in League annals, 12 to break UNC Asheville's all-time record of 190 (set by **C.J. WALKER** from 2003-07) and 21 to become just the fifth player in Big South history with 200 career blocked shots.

KEYDET KICKS

VMI junior **AUSTIN KENON** has made a three-pointer in 63 of his 66 career games and has made 221 total for a 3.35 per game average, which trails the current Big South career record of 3.51, set by Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** from 2004-08. Meanwhile, Kenon's teammate **KEITH GABRIEL** has drained a three-pointer in 45 of his 50 career games and already has 147 in his career, an average of 2.94 per game.

ELDER STATESMAN

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** collected his 650th career win on Monday, Jan. 4 when the Chanticleers defeated Presbyterian College. He now owns a lifetime record of 654-387. Ellis has amassed 576 Division I victories, which ranks 11th on the NCAA's active win list. Coastal Carolina's 18 wins this season already exceed last year's total (11) and Ellis' win total in his first season as the Chanticleers coach in 2007-08 (13). Ellis is looking to win 20 games at his fourth Division I school and for the 13th time in his coaching career.

COMING FULL CIRCLE

Former Big South charter member Campbell University is rejoining the Big South in 2011-12, increasing the League's membership to 11. Campbell enjoyed a successful stint in the Conference, winning the 1992 Big South championship and becoming the League's first automatic bid recipient that year. The Camels appeared in a total of four Conference championship games before departing for the Trans America Athletic Conference (TAAC) following the 1993-94 season.

BIG SOUTH COACHES TO GO BAREFOOT FOR BARE FEET

The Big South men's basketball coaches are participating in the Conference's "Barefoot for Bare Feet" initiative in support of Samaritan's Feet. Charleston Southern head coach **BARCLAY RADEBAUGH** kicked off the involvement this past weekend against Coastal Carolina. This week, Gardner-Webb head coach **RICK SCRUGGS** will coach barefoot on Saturday, Jan. 30 vs. High Point. The Big South's Student-Athlete Advisory Committee has adopted Samaritan's Feet as its charity for 2009-10 and has pledged to collect 17,000 pairs of shoes the entire 2009-10 athletic season.

LONG DISTANCE FRESHMAN

Charleston Southern freshman guard **JEREMY SEXTON** is hitting 55.2 percent from beyond the arc in his last seven games (21-of-38), and has shot better than 50.0 percent in six of those contests. He leads the Big South with a 44.1 percent clip from three-point range, which is the second-highest by a freshman in League annals. UNC Greensboro's **SCOTT HARTZELL** made 45.6 percent (73-of-160) of his three-point attempts as a freshman in 1992-93.

WELL-ROUNDED INDIVIDUAL

Charleston Southern sophomore forward **KELVIN MARTIN** has been a quiet force for the Buccaneers. He leads the Big South in steals per game with 2.26, is fourth in the League in rebounding at 8.2, and is third in field goal percentage (51.5) -- the only Big South player to rank in the top five in the Conference in each category. He also is 10th in the Big South with 14.3 points per game. Martin's 43 steals this season are a career-high, and he is looking to become the first Buccaneer to lead the Big South in steals per game since **ED O'NEIL** in 2003-04.

ART CLASS

Radford's **ART PARAKHOUSKI** has recorded 13 games this season with 20 points and 10 rebounds, with six coming against Big South members. In those six games, he is averaging 25.3 points and 13.2 rebounds. Parakhouski has yet to post a 20-10 game against Charleston Southern, Presbyterian College and UNC Asheville this season, but will get a chance with the second half of the Conference season set to begin. His first opportunity will be Jan. 30 at UNC Asheville, followed by Feb. 11 vs. Charleston Southern and Feb. 25 vs. PC.

CRUZZING ALTITUDE

High Point 6-11 redshirt-senior **CRUZ DANIELS** is second all-time in Big South history with 272 career blocked shots. He has recorded a blocked shot in a career-high 24 consecutive games -- bettering his previous career-long streak of 10 games, and is averaging 2.83 blocks in his current string (68 total). Daniels, who has blocked at least five shots in a game 17 times in his career, is one of just two players in Big South history with 500 career rebounds and 250 career blocked shots, joining Liberty's **PETER ALUMA**, who had 682 rebounds and 366 blocks from 1994-97.

FROM THE LAND OF THREE...

Charleston Southern's **JAMARCO WARREN** became the 25th player in Big South history with 200 career three-pointers when he reached the milestone at College of Charleston on Dec. 16. He now has 230 treys in his career. Liberty's **KYLE OHMAN** is approaching the 200 three-point field goal barrier as he has 192, but he is sidelined with an injury for approximately 2-6 weeks. UNC Asheville's **SEAN SMITH** has 177 treys in his career, second-most in school history.

BIG MEN ON CAMPUS

Radford's frontcourt trio of **ART PARAKHOUSKI** (23.6 points/12.9 rebounds), **JOEY LYNCH-FLOHR** (13.0 points/6.8 rebounds) and **LAZ TRIFUNOVIC** (13.6 points/8.7 rebounds) account for 65.3 percent of RU's offense and 61.6 percent of the squad's rebounds per game. Combined, Parakhouski, Lynch-Flohr and Trifunovic are averaging 50.2 points and 28.4 rebounds per game. To go along with their statistical output, the trio has combined for 23 double-doubles this season.

BIG SOUTH TO MAKE FIFTH APPEARANCE IN BRACKETBUSTERS EVENT

The Big South will again participate in the BracketBusters event this season during the weekend of February 19-20. A League-high four members will represent the Big South in 2010 -- Gardner-Webb, Presbyterian College, Radford and Winthrop. Winthrop, which will make its fifth-straight appearance in the series, and PC will play road contests, while Gardner-Webb and Radford will host games. The Big South is 5-6 all-time in the BracketBusters, including two wins in 2006 and 2007. The Conference also has been selected for national television appearances in each of the past three years: 2007 (ESPN2), 2008 (ESPN2) and 2009 (ESPN2).

The top eight of the nine postseason eligible teams will earn a berth in this year's Championship, with the No. 1 seed having a chance to host throughout the tournament.

For the fifth consecutive season, the Semifinals will be contested at the site of the No. 1 seed and will be broadcast live on ESPN2 on Thursday, March 4. The highest remaining seed will host the Championship game on its home floor Saturday, March 6 live on ESPN2.



HE IS THE ONLY ONE

Radford's **ART PARAKHOUSKI** is the lone Big South men's basketball player to score in double figures in all of his team's games this season, and owns the Big South's longest double-figure scoring streak at 20 games, dating back to 2008-09.

CHARTER MEMBER

Coastal Carolina's **JOSEPH HARRIS** is the first player in Big South history with 1,000 points, 1,000 rebounds, 150 steals and 100 blocked shots.

BUCKING THE TREND

Charleston Southern's five Big South wins are its most since winning seven in 2005-06 -- **BARCLAY RADEBAUGH's** first season as head coach. In fact, the Buccaneers' three-game Big South win streak from Jan. 9-16 was their longest since winning four-in-a-row to open League play in 2004-05.

ALL ABOUT MARGINS

Coastal Carolina has won 16 of its 18 games this season by 10-or-more points, and owns a +15.3 scoring margin -- pacing ahead of the Big South single-season record of +13.4 set by Winthrop in 2006-07. The Chanticleers have won six of their eight Conference games by double digits, and own a +9.4 scoring margin in Conference games, the highest in the League since Winthrop posted a +9.6 margin against League foes in 2007-08.

COASTAL CAROLINA RANKED IN MID-MAJOR POLL

Coastal Carolina is ranked No. 14 in this week's *Collegeinsider.com* Mid-Major Top 25 poll, up five spots from last week's ranking of No. 19 and its highest placing this season. This is the sixth consecutive year that the Big South has had a team ranked in the Mid-Major Top 25, and the second-straight season that more than one team entered the poll, as Radford was ranked the first three weeks of the season. PC will be eligible for the Big South's postseason tournament and automatic bid that same year. Therefore, head coach **GREGG NIBERT** is redshirting three of his top players this season -- **AL'LONZO COLEMAN**, **JOSH JOHNSON** and **PIERRE MILLER**, so all three will be fifth-year seniors in 2011-12. The trio combined for 946 points last season -- 54.7 percent of the Blue Hose's season total, and Coleman earned Second-Team All-Conference honors after averaging 15.0 points and 8.4 rebounds.
