Williams averaged 20.5 points, 9.0 rebounds and 3.0 blocked shots in two key wins for the Bulldogs. He posted a double-double with 10 points and 10 rebounds in a 75-72 victory over Liberty on Feb. 11, in addition to three blocks. Williams then exploded for a season-high 31 points vs. VMI on Feb. 13, and had eight rebounds and three rejections. He was 12-of-15 from the floor and 7-of-11 from the free throw line against the Keydets. He finished the week 16-of-24 from the field (=66.7 percent).

Okoye averaged 21.5 points, 8.0 rebounds and 2.0 blocked shots in two games for VMI. He opened the week with 26 points and 11 rebounds in the Keydets' victory at Gardner-Webb. He was 10-of-15 from the field and blocked four shots while recording his sixth 20-point, 10-rebound game of the season. Okoye then scored 17 points, went 7-of-9 from the floor and grabbed five rebounds at UNC Asheville, despite playing just 11 minutes against the Bulldogs due to foul trouble. In his two games, Okoye posted a 70.8 field goal percentage (17-of-24) and was 7-of-11 from the charity stripe.

**CHANTICLEERS ON VERGE OF CLINCHING HOME SEED, REGULAR-SEASON TITLE**

League-leading Coastal Carolina is one Big South victory away from clinching a home seed in the 2010 Advance Auto Parts Big South Men's Basketball Championship, and can clinch sooner if UNC Asheville, Liberty and High Point suffer defeats this week. The last time the Chanticleers were a home seed was in 2007 as the No. 4 seed. Coastal Carolina needs two more Big South wins to clinch at least a share of the regular-season championship.

**ONE RECORD DOWN, ANOTHER ONE WITHIN REACH**

Radford senior **AMIR JOHNSON** is the Big South's new all-time assist leader, as he broke the record of 567 career assists in the Highlanders' loss to Coastal Carolina this past Saturday. He now has 569 helpers in his collegiate career, two more than **CHRIS GAYNOR**'s previous Big South record set in 2008. Johnson, who is averaging 6.67 assists in his last nine games, is just one of eight players in Conference annals with 1,000 career points and 500 career assists, and his 457 career rebounds are the most of the 1,000-point/500-assist club members. Meanwhile, Johnson is 22 rebounds away from becoming the first player in League history with four consecutive seasons with 100 assists and 100 rebounds.

**HISTORY REPEATING ITSELF??**

Last season, Radford established the Big South's best "worst-to-first" in League history, as the Highlanders improved from seventh-place in 2007-08 to League champion in 2008-09. Radford's historical turnaround could be short-lived, as Coastal Carolina sits in first-place this season after finishing eighth in the standings a year ago. The Chanticleers hold a 1.5 game lead atop the standings with three Conference games remaining.

**THE NUMBER 10**

Winthrop has won 10 Big South games for the 10th time, extending its Conference record. Radford also has 10 League victories this season, marking its eighth time overall and the first time since 1999-00 and 2000-01 that the Highlanders have recorded back-to-back 10-win Big South campaigns. Meanwhile, UNC Asheville is one Conference victory away from recording three consecutive 10-win Big South seasons for the first time in school history.

**SCREAMING EAGLES**

Winthrop has won six-straight games to move into second-place in the Big South standings at 10-4. During the current run, the Eagles have held five opponents below 40 percent from the field (35.4 percent overall), while out-rebounding the competition by +8.0 (43.5 to 35.5). Winthrop is averaging 67.8 points and 42.2 percent from the field in its win streak, while holding opponents to 56.8 points. Winners of nine of their last 10, the Eagles have held three foes below 50 points in that span.

**MILESTONE WATCH #1 - STEADY EDDIE LOOKING TO SCORE SECOND WIN RECORD**

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** is one win shy of tying former Winthrop coach **GREGG MARSHALL** as the Big South's all-time winningest coach. Biedenbach is 193-216 at Asheville, and is approaching Marshall's record 194 wins as the Eagles' head coach from 1998-07. Biedenbach became the Big South's all-time leader for most regular-season Conference wins on Thursday, Jan. 21 with the Bulldogs' 66-53 triumph over Winthrop, as he collected his 110th Big South victory that night, breaking the record of 109 that was established by former Radford coach **RON BRADLEY** from 1991-02. Biedenbach now has 115 regular-season Big South victories.

**TURN BABY TURN**

Coastal Carolina is enjoying a turnaround from last season's 11-20 overall mark and 5-13 Big South record. The Chants are +11 in the overall win column from a year ago and +7 on the Conference win side -- the best year-to-year improvement in Conference play based on the same number of League games the previous season. Liberty first set that record with a 6-win improvement during a 12-game Conference schedule in 2002-03. That year, the Flames went 8-6 in the League after going 2-12 in 2001-02. The Big South's best ever year-to-year improvement in overall wins is +15 by Radford in 1990-91, as the Highlanders finished 22-7 that season after posting a 7-22 mark in 1989-90. In Big South games, the League's top overall year-to-year win improvement is +10, which was accomplished by Radford in 2008-09. Last season, the Highlanders went 15-3 after going 5-9 in 2007-08.

**EUGENE HARRIS ENTERS 250/250 CLUB**

High Point senior **EUGENE HARRIS** became the fifth player in Big South history with 250 career three-pointers and 250 career assists on Feb. 11 when he reached the assist milestone. He is tied for eighth in Big South history with a school-record 275 career three-point field goals, and joins Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** (411 3FG, 353 AST), UNC Greensboro's **SCOTT HARTZELL** (309 3FG, 552 AST), VMI's **CHAVIS HOLMES** (306 3FG, 313 AST) and UNC Asheville's **JOSH KOHN** (296 3FG, 430 AST) on the League's 250 three-pointer, 250 assist list.

**HOME AWAY FROM HOME?**

The road teams have won 30 of the 73 Big South games played thus far -- a .411 winning percentage, marking the third time in the last four seasons that road teams have won at least 40 percent of Conference games. **CLOSE AND NOT SO CLOSE**

Of the 73 Big South Conference games played in 2009-10, 39 have been decided by less than 10 points (53.4 percent), with the average margin of victory in those games being 4.67 points. Of the 34 games decided by double-digits, the average margin of victory is 17.62 points. The overall margin of victory in League play stands at 10.70 points.

**MILESTONE WATCH #2 - 700 REBOUND MEMBERSHIP**

Radford's **ART PARAKHOUSKI** is one rebound away from becoming the 20th player in Big South history with 700 career rebounds. He would also become the 19th player with 1,000 points and 700 boards, as well as the seventh player in Big South history with 1,000 points, 700 rebounds and 100 blocked shots.

**MILESTONE WATCH #3 - JOHN WILLIAMS' BUILDING BLOCKS**

UNC Asheville redshirt-junior **JOHN WILLIAMS** became the 56th player in Big South history with 500 career rebounds when he reached the milestone Feb. 11 vs. Liberty. The Bulldogs' all-time leading shot blocker, Williams is three blocked shots away from becoming the fifth player in League annals with 200 career rejections. He is on the cusp of becoming just the fourth Big South player with 500 rebounds and 200 blocked shots.

**MILESTONE WATCH #4 - GARDNER-WEBB'S JOSHUA TREE**

Gardner-Webb sophomore forward **JOSH HENLEY** needs just 12 rebounds for 500 in his young career, and would become the second player in Big South history to amass 500 career rebounds as a sophomore. Campbell's **JOE SPINKS** was the first Big South sophomore to reach 500 rebounds, as he totaled 523 in his first two seasons with the Camels en route to becoming the Big South's all-time leading rebounder from 1994-2008.

**ELDER STATESMAN**

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** has now directed four Division I programs to 20 win seasons, and has reached 20 victories for the 13th time in his coaching career. He collected his 650th career win on Monday, Jan. 4 when the Chanticleers defeated Presbyterian College, and owns a lifetime record of 658-389. Ellis has amassed 580 Division I victories, which ranks 11th on the NCAA's active win list. Coastal Carolina's 22 wins this season nearly equal his combined total from his first two years leading the Chanticleers (24).

**A WORK OF ART**

Radford center **ART PARAKHOUSKI** is just the second player in Big South history with 300 rebounds in back-to-back seasons, as he leads the Conference with 330 overall and 13.2 per game. He is on pace to pull down 396 boards through the quarterfinals of the Advance Auto Parts Big South Men's Basketball Championship, which would surpass his Big South single-season record of 369 rebounds, which he set last season. His per game average is pacing +1.8 ahead of the League record of 11.4. Meanwhile, Parakhouski enters this week ranked in the top 10 nationally in rebounding (2nd - 13.2) and field goal percentage (6th - 58.7), and is 15th in scoring (21.5).

**CHARTER MEMBER**

Coastal Carolina's **JOSEPH HARRIS** is the first player in Big South history with 1,000 points, 1,000 rebounds, 150 steals and 100 blocked shots. He became the Big South's all-time rebounding king on Saturday, Jan. 16 vs. High Point when he corralled his 1,014th career rebound, breaking the Conference record of 1,013 that was set by High Point's **ARIZONA REID** just two seasons ago.

## KEYDET KICKS

VMI junior **AUSTIN KENON** has made a three-pointer in 69 of his 73 career games and has made 241 total for a 3.30 per game average, which is currently the fourth-highest per game clip in League history. The Big South career record is 3.51, set by Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** from 2004-08. Meanwhile, Kenon's teammate **KEITH GABRIEL** has drained a three-pointer in 51 of his 56 career games and already has 165 in his career, an average of 2.95 per game.

## FROM THE LAND OF THREE...

Charleston Southern junior **JAMARCO WARREN** became the Buccaneers' all-time three-point field goal leader Feb. 4 when he surpassed the mark of 234 established by **BRETT LARRICK** from 1993-97. Warren now has 246 in his career and is 12th on the Big South's all-time list. He needs eight treys to crack the League's top 10. Liberty's **KYLE OHMAN** has 192 career threes, while UNC Asheville's **SEAN SMITH** has 185 treys in his career, second-most in school history.

## I WANNA BLOCK

UNC Asheville leads the Big South with 150 blocked shots and 5.77 per game, and is on pace for 173 blocks this season -- which would be the second-most in a single-season in Big South history. The Bulldogs already own the top two marks -- 196 in 2007-08 and 165 in 1997-98. **JOHN WILLIAMS** leads the Conference with 2.80 blocks a game, and is looking to become the ninth Bulldog player to lead the Big South in blocked shots, the last being **KENNY GEORGE** in 2007-08 (3.3).

## A RARE TRIPLE CROWN AND A POSSIBLE FIRST

Radford senior **ART PARAKHOUSKI** currently leads the Big South in scoring (21.5), rebounding (13.2) and field goal percentage (58.7), and is looking to become just the second player in Big South history to lead the League in all three categories. The first was High Point's **DANNY GATHINGS** in 2002-03 with averages of 18.7 points, 7.6 rebounds and 57.1 percent from the field. Parakhouski is attempting to become the first player in Big South history to average 20.0 points and 60.0 percent from the field (based on 5.0 field goals per game) in the same season.

## PARAKHOUSKI ENTERS BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB

Radford's **ART PARAKHOUSKI** became the 99th player in Big South history with 1,000 points when he eclipsed the milestone Feb. 2 at VMI -- and tied for the sixth-fastest player in League annals to score 1,000 career points (55 games). He also has 556 career rebounds (178 at Radford). Gardner-Webb senior **GRAYSON FLITTNER** eclipsed 1,000 career points Nov. 21 against Methodist College and has 1,173 points in his career (554 as a Big South member).

## HE IS THE ONLY ONE

Radford's **ART PARAKHOUSKI** is the lone Big South men's basketball player to score in double figures in all of his team's games this season, and owns the Big South's longest double-figure scoring streak at 27 games, dating back to 2008-09.

**BIG SOUTH COACHES GOING BAREFOOT FOR BARE FEET**

The Big South men's basketball coaches are participating in the Conference's "Barefoot for Bare Feet" initiative in support of Samaritan's Feet. Charleston Southern's **BARCLAY RADEBAUGH**, Gardner-Webb's **RICK SCRUGGS**, Coastal Carolina's **CLIFF ELLIS**, UNC Asheville's **EDDIE BIEDENBACH**, Winthrop's **RANDY PEELE** and High Point's **SCOTT CHERRY** have all coached barefoot at least once for the cause. This week, Presbyterian College's **GREGG NIBERT**, Liberty's **DALE LAYER** and VMI's **DUGGAR BAUCOM** will all coach barefoot on Tuesday, Feb. 16. The Big South's Student-Athlete Advisory Committee has adopted Samaritan's Feet as its charity for 2009-10 and has pledged to collect the equivalent of 17,000 pairs of shoes the entire 2009-10 athletic season.

**BRACKETBUSTERS WEEKEND UPON US**

The Big South's fifth consecutive appearance in the BracketBusters commences this Saturday, Feb. 20, with a League-record four members participating in the event -- Gardner-Webb, Presbyterian College, Radford and Winthrop. The Big South will play two members from the OVC and one each from the SoCon and CAA. Winthrop, which will make its fifth-straight appearance in the series, will play at Eastern Kentucky, while Presbyterian College will make its BracketBusters debut at Jacksonville State. Gardner-Webb will make its second appearance and will host Elon, while first-time participant Radford will host UNC Wilmington.

**WELL-ROUNDED INDIVIDUAL**

Charleston Southern sophomore forward **KELVIN MARTIN** has been a quiet force for the Buccaneers. He leads the Big South in steals per game with 2.32, is third in the League in rebounding at 8.5, and is fifth in field goal percentage (49.2) -- the only Big South player to rank in the top five in the Conference in each category. He also is 13th in the Big South with 13.4 points per game. Martin's 58 steals this season are a career-high, and he is looking to become the first Buccaneer to lead the Big South in steals per game since **ED O'NEIL** in 2003-04. Meanwhile, Martin could become the third player in Big South history to lead the Conference in steals per game while averaging 8.0 rebounds a contest.

**ANOTHER FIRST FOR COASTAL CAROLINA**

The Chanticleers have won nine of their 12 Big South games by 10-or-more points and their average margin of victory in their 12 Conference wins is 15.5 points. Coastal Carolina owns an overall scoring margin of +15.0, which is pacing ahead of the Big South single-season record of +13.4 set by Winthrop in 2006-07. The Chanticleers have a +11.3 scoring margin in Conference games, the highest in the League since Winthrop posted a +15.2 margin against League foes in 2006-07.

**20/20 VISION**

Coastal Carolina has won 20 regular-season games for the first time since 1990-91, when the Chanticleers won 20 games before the Conference Tournament en route to a school-record 24 victories that year. The most regular-season wins by a Big South member prior to the League Tournament is 25 by Winthrop in 2006-07.

**CRUZZING ALTITUDE**

High Point 6-11 redshirt-senior **CRUZ DANIELS** is second all-time in Big South history with 288 career blocked shots. He has recorded a blocked shot in a career-high 30 consecutive games and is averaging 2.80 blocks in that span (84 total). He also is looking to become the first player since at least before the 2004-05 campaign to record a blocked shot in every game during the season. Daniels, who has blocked at least five shots in a game 17 times in his career, is one of just two players in Big South history with 600 career rebounds and 250 career blocked shots, joining Liberty's **PETER ALUMA**, who had 682 rebounds and 366 blocks from 1994-97.

**BIG MEN ON CAMPUS**

Radford's frontcourt trio of **ART PARAKHOUSKI** (21.5 points/13.3 rebounds), **LAZ TRIFUNOVIC** (13.9 points/8.5 rebounds) and **JOEY LYNCH-FLOHR** (12.5 points/6.8 rebounds) account for 62.4 percent of RU's offense and 62.4 percent of the squad's rebounds per game. Combined, Parakhouski, Lynch-Flohr and Trifunovic are averaging 47.9 points and 28.5 rebounds per game. To go along with their statistical output, the trio has combined for 33 double-doubles this season.

**SCOREBOARD WATCHING**

Defending three-time NCAA scoring champion VMI continues to lead the nation in scoring with an average of 90.0 points per game. The Keydets are looking to become the first team in NCAA Division I history to lead the country in scoring four consecutive seasons. VMI, Furman (1952-55) and Loyola Marymount (1987-90) are the only programs to lead the nation three-straight years.

Presbyterian College is in the second-to-last year of its transition to Division I and will become full-fledged members of the NCAA's top division in 2011-12. PC will be eligible for the Big South's postseason tournament and automatic bid that same year. Therefore, head coach **GREGG NIBERT** is redshirting three of his top players this season -- **AL'LONZO COLEMAN**, **JOSH JOHNSON** and **PIERRE MILLER**, so all three will be fifth-year seniors in 2011-12. The trio combined for 946 points last season -- 54.7 percent of the Blue Hose's season total, and Coleman earned Second-Team All-Conference honors after averaging 15.0 points and 8.4 rebounds.

### COASTAL CAROLINA REMAINS IN TOP 20 OF MID-MAJOR POLL
