CHANTICLEERS, EAGLES CLINCH HOME SEED; CCU CLOSING IN ON REGULAR-SEASON TITLE

League-leading Coastal Carolina and current second-place Winthrop have clinched home seeds in the 2010 Advance Auto Parts Men's Basketball Championship. The Chanticleers will host a Tournament game for the first time since 2007 when they were a No. 4 seed, while the Eagles return to the hosting side after a one-year hiatus. Coastal Carolina needs one more Big South win to clinch at least a share of the regular-season championship, but Winthrop and Radford enter the week still in contention for the regular-season title.

FOUR TEAMS VYING FOR THE FINAL TWO HOME SEEDS

Radford, UNC Asheville, Liberty and High Point are all battling for the final two home seeds in the 2010 Advance Auto Parts Men's Basketball Championship. Both Radford and UNC Asheville need one victory each to clinch a top four seed. Liberty and High Point are still mathematically alive for a home seed, but will need help in the form of losses and/or tiebreakers to qualify.

WINTHROP-RADFORD MATCH-UP IS THE FINAL ROYAL PURPLE TV "GAME OF THE WEEK"

This Saturday's Big South Conference Royal Purple "Game of the Week" features Radford against Winthrop from the Dedmon Center live at 4:00pm on MASN and WMBF News XTRA in Myrtle Beach, S.C. **MATT HOGUE** (play-by-play) and **RALPH PATTERSON** (analyst) will call the action in the game that could determine the final top four seedings.

CONFERENCE SEASON HEATS UP IN FEBRUARY

The last 15 Big South Conference games played this month have been decided by an average margin of 6.67 points, with 12 of the contests decided under 10 points. In addition, the home team is 10-5 in that span. Of the 79 Big South Conference games played in 2009-10, 44 have been decided by less than 10 points (55.7 percent) -- including 27 by five points-or-less. The average margin of victory in games decided by less than 10 points is 4.80 points. Of the 35 games decided by double-digits, the average margin of victory is 17.40 points. The overall margin of victory in League play stands at 10.38 points. Last season at this time, the average margin of victory in the Conference was 9.38.

HISTORY REPEATING ITSELF??

Last season, Radford established the Big South's best "worst-to-first" in League history, as the Highlanders improved from seventh-place in 2007-08 to League champion in 2008-09. Radford's historical turnaround could be short-lived, as Coastal Carolina sits in first-place this season after finishing eighth in the standings a year ago. The Chanticleers hold a 1.5 game lead atop the standings with two Conference games remaining.

ALL ABOUT THE NUMBER 10

UNC Asheville has won 10 Big South games for the third consecutive season -- the first time in school history and just the third Big South program to accomplish the trifecta. The Bulldogs join UNC Greensboro (three times from 1993-96) and Winthrop (nine times from 1999-08) as the only schools with three-straight 10-win Conference seasons. Liberty is one League win shy of giving the Big South five teams with 10 Conference wins for the first time since 1993-94.

STEADY EDDIE TIES OVERALL WIN RECORD

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** has equaled former Winthrop coach **GREGG MARSHALL** (1998-07) as the Big South's all-time winningest coach with 194 overall wins. Biedenbach tied the mark with the Bulldogs' 69-66 overtime win at Presbyterian College on Tuesday, Feb. 16. Now 194-216 at Asheville, Biedenbach became the Big South's all-time leader for most regular-season Conference wins on Thursday, Jan. 21 with the Bulldogs' 66-53 triumph over Winthrop, which was his 110th Big South victory, breaking the record of 109 that was established by former Radford coach **RON BRADLEY** from 1991-02. Biedenbach now has 116 regular-season Big South victories.

GARDNER-WEBB'S JOSHUA TREE

Gardner-Webb sophomore forward **JOSH HENLEY** surpassed 500 career rebounds this past Saturday against Elon, becoming the 57th Big South player to reach the milestone and just the second to do it in his sophomore season. Henley joins Campbell's **JOE SPINKS** as the only sophomores to reach 500 career rebounds. Spinks totaled 523 in his first two seasons with the Camels en route to becoming the Big South's all-time leading rebounder from 1994-2008.

MEMBERS ONLY

Radford's **ART PARAKHOUSKI** became the 20th player in Big South history to grab 700 career rebounds when he eclipsed the mark on Feb. 16 at Liberty. Parakhouski is now 12th all-time in League annals with 726, and needs 29 to move into the top 10. He also is the seventh player in Big South history with 1,000 points, 700 rebounds and 100 blocked shots.

BIG SOUTH'S BRACKET BUSTING

The Big South made its fifth consecutive appearance in the BracketBusters this past weekend, and for the third time, the League won two of its match-ups -- both coming from its first-timers. Radford defeated UNC Wilmington at home, while Presbyterian College won at Jacksonville State to snap a 27-game overall road losing streak and 13-game non-Conference road skid. Winthrop, which made its fifth-straight appearance in the series, lost at Eastern Kentucky, while Gardner-Webb fell at home to Elon.

BACK TO THE FUTURE

Coastal Carolina has tied two school records -- most wins in a season with 24 and the most Conference victories with 13. Both marks were set by the 1990-91 squad (24-8, 13-1 Big South). With two regular-season games remaining, the Chanticleers could break the League record for most regular-season wins. That record is 25, which was set by Winthrop prior to the Big South Tournament in 2006-07.

PUNCHING THE TIME CLOCK

Presbyterian College has played four overtime Big South games this season, the most in the Conference since UNC Asheville played four extra session League contests in 2008-09. It is nothing new for the Blue Hose, as PC took three Big South foes to overtime last season.

HOME AWAY FROM HOME?

The road teams have won 32 of the 79 Big South games played thus far -- a .405 winning percentage, marking the third time in the last four seasons that road teams have won at least 40 percent of Conference games. Here is a look at each team's home and road record in Big South games this season, in current standings order:

MILESTONE WATCH #1 - JOHN WILLIAMS' BUILDING BLOCKS

UNC Asheville redshirt-junior **JOHN WILLIAMS**, the school's all-time leading shot blocker, is three blocked shots away from becoming the fifth player in League annals with 200 career rejections. He became the 56th player in Big South history with 500 career rebounds when he reached the milestone Feb. 11 vs. Liberty, and is on the cusp of becoming just the fourth Big South player with 500 rebounds and 200 blocked shots.

ELDER STATESMAN

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** has now directed four Division I programs to 20 win seasons, and has reached 20 victories for the 13th time in his coaching career. He collected his 650th career win on Monday, Jan. 4 when the Chanticleers defeated Presbyterian College, and owns a lifetime record of 660-389. Ellis has amassed 582 Division I victories, which ranks 11th on the NCAA's active win list. Coastal Carolina's 24 wins this season equal his combined total from his first two years leading the Chanticleers.

A WORK OF ART

Radford center **ART PARAKHOUSKI** is 13 rebounds away from breaking his Big South single-season record of 369, which he set last season. The first player in Big South history with 350 rebounds in back-to-back seasons, Parakhouski is on pace to pull down 397 boards through the quarterfinals of the Advance Auto Parts Big South Men's Basketball Championship. His per game average is pacing +1.8 ahead of the League record of 11.4. Meanwhile, Parakhouski enters this week ranked in the top 10 nationally in rebounding (2nd - 13.2) and field goal percentage (7th - 58.9), and is 14th in scoring (21.4).

CHARTER MEMBER

Coastal Carolina's **JOSEPH HARRIS** is one rebound shy of 1,100 and is nine steals away from becoming the 12th player in League history with 200. He is the first player in Big South history with 1,000 points, 1,000 rebounds, 150 steals and 100 blocked shots. Harris became the Big South's all-time rebounding king on Saturday, Jan. 16 vs. High Point when he corralled his 1,014th career rebound, breaking the Conference record of 1,013 that was set by High Point's **ARIZONA REID** just two seasons ago.

FEBRUARYS IN ROCK HILL

Since the 2004-05 season, Winthrop is 37-10 (=78.7 winning percentage) in the month of February, including a 32-8 mark in League games (=80.0 percent). The Eagles are 4-1 thus far in February 2010, and are looking to win at least five games in the final full month of the season for the sixth consecutive season.

FEBRUARY'S BEST

VMI's **AUSTIN KENON** is the Big South's leading scorer in the month of February this season, as he is averaging 22.3 points in six games this month. Teammate **KEITH GABRIEL** is third at 19.0, while fellow Keydet **STAN OKOYE** is fifth at 17.7 points. Radford's **ART PARAKHOUSKI** is averaging a League-high 14.8 rebounds this month, followed by Coastal Carolina's **JOSEPH HARRIS** (10.0) and UNC Asheville's **D.J. CUNNINGHAM** (9.8). Radford's **AMIR JOHNSON** is averaging 7.00 assists in February, while Gardner-Webb's **C.J. HAILEY** is making 90.5 percent of his free throws this month. Asheville's **J.P. PRIMM** is tops in steals with 2.80 a game, and Coastal Carolina's **MARIO EDWARDS** is tops in three-point shooting this month at 50.0 percent (18-of-36).

On the team side, Coastal Carolina is allowing just 56.0 points a game this month, as well as a League-low 23.2 percent from beyond the arc. Radford is making a Conference-best 50.8 percent from the field this February, in addition to a League-leading 42.6 percent from three-point range. The Highlanders are also tops in field goal defense this month at 36.0 percent.

I WANNA BLOCK

UNC Asheville leads the Big South with 156 blocked shots and 5.78 per game, and is on pace for 173 blocks this season -- which would be the second-most in a single-season in Big South history. The Bulldogs already own the top two marks -- 196 in 2007-08 and 165 in 1997-98. **JOHN WILLIAMS** leads the Conference with 2.69 blocks a game, and is looking to become the ninth Bulldog player to lead the Big South in blocked shots, the last being **KENNY GEORGE** in 2007-08 (3.3).

BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB

High Point sophomore **NICK BARBOUR** is 88 points away from 1,000 in his career, as he has 912 points in 56 career games played. Radford's **ART PARAKHOUSKI** became the 99th player in Big South history with 1,000 points when he eclipsed the milestone Feb. 2 at VMI -- and tied for the sixth-fastest player in League annals to score 1,000 career points (55 games). SWEEPS SEASON

With 33 Conference series in the books already, 20 have resulted in season sweeps (60.6 percent). Coastal Carolina and Winthrop have each swept four opponents this year, followed by Liberty and UNC Asheville with three.

A RARE TRIPLE CROWN AND A POSSIBLE FIRST

Radford senior **ART PARAKHOUSKI** currently leads the Big South in scoring (21.4), rebounding (13.2) and field goal percentage (58.9), and is looking to become just the second player in Big South history to lead the League in all three categories. The first was High Point's **DANNY GATHINGS** in 2002-03 with averages of 18.7 points, 7.6 rebounds and 57.1 percent from the field. Parakhouski is trying to become the first player in Big South history to average 20.0 points and 60.0 percent from the field (based on 5.0 field goals per game) in the same season.

EUGENE HARRIS ENTERS 250/250 CLUB

High Point senior **EUGENE HARRIS** is the fifth player in Big South history with 250 career three-pointers and 250 career assists. He is eighth in Big South history with a school-record 280 career three-point field goals, and joins Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** (411 3FG, 353 AST), UNC Greensboro's **SCOTT HARTZELL** (309 3FG, 552 AST), VMI's **CHAVIS HOLMES** (306 3FG, 313 AST) and UNC Asheville's **JOSH KOHN** (296 3FG, 430 AST) on the League's 250 three-pointer, 250 assist list.

WELL-ROUNDED INDIVIDUAL

Charleston Southern sophomore forward **KELVIN MARTIN** continues to lead the Big South in steals per game with 2.26, and is third in the League in rebounding at 8.4 as well as fifth in field goal percentage (50.0) -- the only Big South player to rank in the top five in the Conference in each category. He also is 13th in the Big South with 13.5 points per game. Martin's 61 steals this season are a career-high, and he is five away from 100 in his young career. He is looking to become the first Buccaneer to lead the Big South in steals per game since **ED O'NEIL** in 2003-04, and could become the third player in Big South history to lead the Conference in steals per game while averaging 8.0 rebounds a contest.

DOUBLE DIGIT WINS BY DOUBLE DIGITS

The Chanticleers have won 10 of their 13 Big South games by 10-or-more points, the most such wins in the Conference since Winthrop had 11 in 2005-06. Coastal Carolina's average margin of victory in their 13 Conference wins is 15.1 points, and the team owns an overall scoring margin of +14.7, which is pacing ahead of the Big South single-season record of +13.4 set by Winthrop in 2006-07. The Chanticleers have a +11.2 scoring margin in Conference games, the highest in the League since Winthrop posted a +15.2 margin against League foes in 2006-07.

ONE RECORD DOWN, ANOTHER ONE WITHIN REACH

Radford senior **AMIR JOHNSON** became the Big South's all-time assist leader on Feb. 13 against Coastal Carolina, as he broke the record of 567 career assists in the game. He now has 583 helpers in his collegiate career and is just one of eight players in Conference annals with 1,000 career points and 500 career assists. His 461 career rebounds are the most of the 1,000-point/500-assist club members, and he is 18 rebounds away from becoming the first player in League history with four consecutive seasons with 100 assists and 100 rebounds.

HE IS THE ONLY ONE

Radford's **ART PARAKHOUSKI** is the lone Big South men's basketball player to score in double figures in all of his team's games this season, and owns the Big South's longest double-figure scoring streak at 29 games, dating back to 2008-09. In addition, Parakhouski leads the nation with 22 double-doubles -- including 14 in 16 Big South contests.

CRUZZING TO NEW HEIGHTS

High Point 6-11 redshirt-senior **CRUZ DANIELS** is the first player in Big South history to block at least 65 shots in four consecutive seasons, and could also become the first player since at least before the 2004-05 campaign to record a blocked shot in every game during the season. Daniels enters the final week of the regular-season second all-time in League annals with 291 career blocked shots, and he has recorded a blocked shot in a career-high 32 consecutive games, averaging 2.72 blocks in that span (87 total). Daniels, who has blocked at least five shots in a game 17 times in his career, is one of just two players in Big South history with 650 career rebounds and 250 career blocked shots, joining Liberty's **PETER ALUMA**, who had 682 rebounds and 366 blocks from 1994-97.

IT'S ACADEMIC

Coastal Carolina redshirt-senior **LOGAN JOHNSON** was named to the 2010 *ESPN The Magazine/CoSIDA* Academic All-District III First-Team on Feb. 4, and is now a candidate for the Academic All-America. Johnson's selection marks the fifth consecutive year that the Big South has had an Academic All-District honoree.

OH-MAN, OH-MY

Liberty senior **KYLE OHMAN** scored a career-high 39 points this past Saturday against High Point, including 18-of-25 from the free throw line. Ohman's effort was the fourth-most free throws made in a Big South single-game, while his attempts were the second-most in a League contest. The single-game records for free throws made and attempted are held by the same two individuals. Both Towson State's **DEVIN BOYD** (Feb. 27, 1993 vs. UMBC) and UNC Asheville's **ANDRE SMITH** (Feb. 1, 2003 vs. Elon) went 22-of-26 from the charity stripe. The other player to make more free throws in a game than Ohman was former Liberty Flame **MATT HILDEBRAND**, who made 19 vs. Charleston Southern on Feb. 19, 1994.

KEYDET KICKS

VMI junior **AUSTIN KENON** has made a three-pointer in 70 of his 74 career games and has made 247 total for a 3.34 per game average, which is currently the fourth-highest per game clip in League history. The Big South career record is 3.51, set by Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** from 2004-08. Meanwhile, Kenon's teammate **KEITH GABRIEL** has drained a three-pointer in 52 of his 57 career games and already has 168 in his career, an average of 2.95 per game.

FROM THE LAND OF THREE...

Charleston Southern junior **JAMARCO WARREN** has made a school-record 253 three-point field goals in his career, good for 11th on the Big South's all-time list and just one away from cracking the League's top 10. Warren broke the CSU mark of 234 (**BRETT LARRICK**, 1993-97) on Feb. 4. Meanwhile, Liberty's **KYLE OHMAN** has 196 career threes, while UNC Asheville's **SEAN SMITH** has 187 treys in his career, second-most in school history.

TURN BABY TURN

Coastal Carolina is enjoying a turnaround from last season's 11-20 overall mark and 5-13 Big South record. The Chants are +13 in the overall win column from a year ago and +8 on the Conference win side -- the best year-to-year improvement in Conference play based on the same number of League games the previous season. Liberty first set that record with a 6-win improvement during a 12-game Conference schedule in 2002-03. That year, the Flames went 8-6 in the League after going 2-12 in 2001-02. The Big South's best ever year-to-year improvement in overall wins is +15 by Radford in 1990-91, as the Highlanders finished 22-7 that season after posting a 7-22 mark in 1989-90. In Big South games, the League's top overall year-to-year win improvement is +10, which was accomplished by Radford in 2008-09. Last season, the Highlanders went 15-3 after going 5-9 in 2007-08.

MILESTONE WATCH #2 - SCRUGGS NEARING 200 WINS AT GARDNER-WEBB

Gardner-Webb head coach **RICK SCRUGGS** needs two more wins for 200 as the leader of the Runnin' Bulldogs. In addition, Presbyterian College's **GREGG NIBERT** is one win shy of 350 in his coaching career. PC will be eligible for the Big South's postseason tournament and automatic bid that same year. Therefore, head coach **GREGG NIBERT** is redshirting three of his top players this season -- **AL'LONZO COLEMAN**, **JOSH JOHNSON** and **PIERRE MILLER**, so all three will be fifth-year seniors in 2011-12. The trio combined for 946 points last season -- 54.7 percent of the Blue Hose's season total, and Coleman earned Second-Team All-Conference honors after averaging 15.0 points and 8.4 rebounds.

It is the most home wins for Coastal Carolina since winning 12 in 2006-07, for Radford since winning 12 last season, for Winthrop since winning 12 in 2007-08, for High Point since winning 13 in 2007-08 and for Charleston Southern since winning 11 in 1987-88 as Baptist College. Meanwhile, UNC Asheville needs one more home victory to join the fivesome.

COASTAL CAROLINA RECEIVES HIGHEST RANKING IN MID-MAJOR POLL

Coastal Carolina is ranked No. 11 in this week's *Collegeinsider.com* Mid-Major Top 25 poll, the team's highest position in the poll this season. The Chants' previous best ranking was No. 14 the week of Jan. 25. KEEP AN EYE ON...

UNC Asheville sophomore guard **J.P. PRIMM** and Liberty sophomore point guard **JESSE SANDERS**. Primm enters the final week of the regular-season needing 14 assists for 300 in his young career. He also has 105 steals in less than two seasons. Sanders has been the Flames' top rebounder in 13 of 28 games this season, and already has 355 boards in his career. He also is 23 assists shy of 300.

BIG MEN ON CAMPUS

Radford's frontcourt trio of **ART PARAKHOUSKI** (21.4 points/13.2 rebounds), **LAZ TRIFUNOVIC** (14.0 points/8.4 rebounds) and **JOEY LYNCH-FLOHR** (12.1 points/6.6 rebounds) account for 62.1 percent of RU's offense and 62.5 percent of the squad's rebounds per game. Combined, Parakhouski, Lynch-Flohr and Trifunovic are averaging 47.5 points and 28.2 rebounds per game. To go along with their statistical output, the trio has combined for 35 double-doubles this season.

SCOREBOARD WATCHING

Defending three-time NCAA scoring champion VMI continues to lead the nation in scoring with an average of 90.0 points per game. The Keydets are looking to become the first team in NCAA Division I history to lead the country in scoring four consecutive seasons. VMI, Furman (1952-55) and Loyola Marymount (1987-90) are the only programs to lead the nation three-straight years.

COMING FULL CIRCLE

Former Big South charter member Campbell University is rejoining the Big South in 2011-12, increasing the League's membership to 11. Campbell enjoyed a successful stint in the Conference, winning the 1992 Big South championship and becoming the League's first automatic bid recipient that year. The Camels appeared in a total of four Conference championship games before departing for the Trans America Athletic Conference (TAAC) following the 1993-94 season.

BIG SOUTH TOURNAMENT TIDBITS

Since the Big South adopted its current home site Conference Tournament format in 2003, the home seeds are a combined 31-12 (=.721) in 43 possible home games. This total does not include games that were played on a neutral floor in 2003 (semifinals and finals) and 2006, 2007, 2008 and 2009 (semifinals).

In the quarterfinals, the home seeds are 19-9 (=.679 percent) on their home courts after last year's top four seeds were all victorious in the same season for the second consecutive year.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern shot lights out from the floor in its win over North Greenville last week, hitting 53.0 percent (35-of-66) from the field and 40.7 percent (11-of-27) from long distance. **JAMARCO WARREN** had a game-high 28 points against the Crusaders, including five threes ... At Coastal Carolina, CSU managed just 26.3 percent from the floor (15-of-57) and a 15.7 clip (3-of-19) from behind the arc. The lone bright spot for CSU was **KELVIN MARTIN**, who posted a double-double with a game-high 14 points and 10 rebounds off the bench.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina held Charleston Southern to just 26.3 percent shooting from the field in its 47-37 win over the Bucs. That is the sixth time this season that the Chants have held an opponent to under 30 percent shooting ... **JOSEPH HARRIS'** 19 rebounds in the CSU win is a high for a Chanticleer this season. He had 17 rebounds in the season opener against the College of Charleston ... **SAM McLAURIN** had six blocks in two games last week and now has 50 on the season. He sits 10th all-time in Coastal Carolina history in blocked shots.

GARDNER-WEBB

Gardner-Webb has two players currently averaging more than 10.0 points for the first time since early January in **C.J. HAILEY** (12.6 ppg) and **ANTON SILVER** (10.1 ppg) ... Gardner-Webb has dropped four games in a row and eight of its last nine games overall ... The Runnin' Bulldogs have lost six home games in a row, the team's longest home drought since moving to NCAA Division I in 2000-01.

HIGH POINT

Sophomore **NICK BARBOUR** has HPU's top five scoring performances this season, beginning with a 38-point night on Nov. 14 against UNC Pembroke and most recently a 28-point performance in HPU's win over Charleston Southern on Feb. 13 ... Freshman **JAIROS SIMMS** went 3-for-4 on three-pointers against VMI last week and is shooting 50 percent (21-for-42) from beyond the arc this season ... The Panthers had two double-doubles in the same game for the first time this season against VMI as **CRUZ DANIELS** had 18 points and 12 rebounds, and **COREY LAW** had 13 points and 13 rebounds ... High Point is 12-4 when leading at halftime this season, but just 2-3 in the last five games when leading at the half. HPU has won just one game when trailing at halftime, a 63-61 win over Presbyterian on Dec. 3 ... HPU allowed its first two 30-plus point scorers last week -- VMI's **AUSTIN KENON** (38) and Liberty's **KYLE OHMAN** (39).

LIBERTY

Playing his final regular season contest inside the Vines Center this past Saturday, **KYLE OHMAN** scored a career-high 39 points in addition to 10 rebounds. Ohman's point total surpasses his previous career of 38, which he achieved at Gardner-Webb last season. Ohman's 39 points were the sixth-highest single-game point total in school history, falling just shy of **MATT HILDEBRAND**'s Vines Center record of 41, which was set on Feb. 19, 1994 against Charleston Southern ... Ohman's 25 free throw attempts against High Point set a school record, surpassing the old mark of 20 held by Hildebrand and **PETER ALUMA**. His 18 makes from the charity stripe was just one shy of matching Hildebrand's mark of 19.

PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE

The Blue Hose snapped a 27-game road losing skid dating back to Dec. 6, 2008 with the win at Jacksonville State in the BracketBusters. The victory was PC's second non-Conference win on the road since moving to NCAA Division I (Dec. 1, 2008 at Army) ... **WALT ALLEN** and **JAKE TROYLI** each accounted for a team-high 14 points at JSU. Allen also led the squad with six rebounds and a career-high four assists ... The Blue Hose had their hottest half of the season at Jacksonville State, canning 14-of-21 shots from the floor in the first 20 minutes ... **KHALID MUTAK-ABBIR** has played every minute of the last three games, including last Tuesday's overtime loss to UNC Asheville.

RADFORD

Radford has won 15 of its last 18 Big South road contests ... In Radford's BracketBusters win over UNC Wilmington, **LAZ TRIFUNOVIC** became the third Highlander this season and fourth on the current roster to hit the 1,000-point plateau ... Radford has won at least 15 games for the 17th time since the 1986-87 season, the most of any Big South member. This is also the first time the Highlanders have recorded back-to-back 15-win seasons since recording six-straight 15-win seasons from 1996-97 to 2001-02.

UNC ASHEVILLE

The Bulldogs played just once last week but picked up an important 69-66 overtime road victory at Presbyterian College. Asheville won despite committing 24 turnovers. **J.P. PRIMM** led the Bulldogs with 20 points, including 10 in overtime, while freshman center **D.J. CUNNINGHAM** tied a career high with 15 rebounds. He also scored a bucket late in regulation to send the game into overtime.

VMI

VMI won its first ever Senior Night since **DUGGAR BAUCOM** became head coach in 2006 when the Keydets defeated High Point, 91-84, last Tuesday night. The win also guaranteed VMI a winning home record for the fourth straight year as the Keydets finished 8-6 at Cameron Hall ... **STAN OKOYE**'s eight double-doubles are the most since **REGGIE WILLIAMS** ... **AUSTIN KENON**'s 38 points against High Point were a career-high. He made six straight free throws in the last :41 seconds to seal the win.

WINTHROP

MATT MORGAN set career highs for points for the third time in his last five games. He tied the mark of 17 against Gardner-Webb and then broke it with 18 at Eastern Kentucky. The game was Morgan's first in the state of Kentucky since he played high school ball at Millersburg Military Institute ... In the past 12 games, Winthrop has been outrebounded just twice, and both times it was by two rebounds (Charleston Southern and Eastern Kentucky).
