
KRISTEN SHIFFLETT • Jr. SS • Radford Charlottesville, Va.

Shifflett batted .600 (6-10) with seven runs scored, five runs batted in, three doubles and two home runs to lead the Highlanders to a 3-1 record this past week, including a series sweep over Charleston Southern last weekend. She also slugged 1.500, with five of her six hits going for extra bases and recorded a .692 on-base percentage. In the three game series against CSU, she hit .750 (6-8) with seven runs, three doubles, two home runs and five RBIs. In the 7-1 game one win against the Bucs, she was 3for-3 with two doubles, a home run, three runs and three RBI. She also tallied two hits, three runs and two RBI in the series finale on Sunday. For the week, Shifflett was also stellar with the glove with no errors in 11 attempts at shortstop.

Smith was 2-0 with a 0.82 ERA last week with wins over preseason favorite Radford and ACC foe Virginia. The righty recorded 12 strikeouts in 11 innings of work, allowing one earned run and two walks. Against Radford on March 23, Smith gave up three hits in five innings, while allowing one earned run and striking out six to pick up Liberty's first Conference victory of the season. The next day against the UVA, she threw six innings with no earned runs, while giving up four hits and fanning six batters in the 6-4 victory.
