CHOICE HOTELS OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

ZACH MacDOWALL • QB • R-Senior
Coastal Carolina • Acworth, Ga.

MacDowall was 25-of-37 passing for 382 yards and three touchdowns into addition to a rushing score in leading Coastal Carolina to a 45-31 victory over No. 11 Liberty. He tied his own school record for passing yards, did not throw an interception and scored a rushing touchdown for the fifth-straight game. MacDowall led Coastal to points on each of its six possessions of the first half and helped the Chanticleers convert 7-of-8 third downs in the opening 30 minutes. Of Coastal's 11 third downs converted against the Flames, MacDowall threw completions eight times -- including three touchdowns, and rushed for one for a total of nine 3rd down conversions.

DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

DAVONTE ANDERSON • CB • Freshman
Stony Brook • Corona, Calif.

Anderson set a Big South single-game record with four interceptions in Stony Brook's victory over Gardner-Webb, three of which led to 13 points. He also had a pass break-up and accounted for four of the Seawolves' seven takeaways. Anderson's first interception was on a deep pass in Stony Brook territory, with the Seawolves scoring on the very next play. He returned his second interception 34 yards to the Gardner-Webb 16-yard line that resulted in a field goal. His third pick was a 21-yard return to the GWU 21-yard line that eventually netted three points. Anderson's record-breaking interception came on the Runnin' Bulldogs first play of the fourth quarter.

SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

BROCK JACKOLSKI • KR • Junior
Stony Brook • Shirley, N.Y.

Jackolski returned the opening kickoff of the second half 94 yards for a touchdown against Gardner-Webb that increased Stony Brook's lead to 27-3, marking Stony Brook's first kickoff return for a score since 2007. Jackolski also had a 23-yard return earlier in the game and finished the afternoon with 256 all-purpose yards. Jackolski scored three times in the third quarter and became the first player in Big South history to score a kickoff return touchdown, a rushing touchdown and receiving touchdown in the same game.

THE CRONS BRAND FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

Coastal Carolina • North Augusta, S.C.

Hazel, who entered the game against Liberty with nine catches and one touchdown, responded with four receptions for 41 yards and three touchdowns against the Flames, tying the school record for touchdown catches in a game. All three touchdown grabs came on third down and his other reception was an 11-yarder that resulted in a first down. Hazel is just the second freshman in Big South history to catch three touchdown passes in a game.

BIG SOUTH CHAMPIONSHIP SATURDAY TO DETERMINE LEAGUE'S FIRST AUTO BID RECIPIENT

The Big South Conference's first-ever automatic bid to the FCS Playoffs will be determined this Saturday, Nov. 20, and **Stony Brook** (5-0), **Coastal Carolina** (4-1) and **Liberty** (4-1) are still in contention. Below is a breakdown for each team, as well as the scenarios in breaking a potential three-way tie for first-place at 5-1. The Conference's first three tiebreakers would not be enough to break the three-way tie, therefore, the fourth step -- **Points allowed in Conference games** -- would be the next procedure needed to break the three-way tie. Should this step fail to break the tie, the next step of Sagarin ratings following the week of Nov. 13 games will be used. If multiple ties are reduced to a tie between two teams, the Conference's two-way tiebreaker formula shall be utilized. Coastal Carolina hosts Charleston Southern at 1:00pm, while Stony Brook meets Liberty Saturday at 3:30pm live on MASN.

STONY BROOK (5-0, 68 points allowed in Conference games) has clinched at least a share of the Big South football championship and can clinch the League's automatic bid with:

- A victory at Liberty to finish as outright Big South champions at 6-0; or
- A loss at Liberty coupled with a Coastal Carolina victory over Charleston Southern to tie as co-champions at 5-1, plus finishing with fewer points allowed in Conference games than Coastal Carolina and Liberty.

COASTAL CAROLINA (4-1, 106 points allowed in Conference games) can clinch the League's automatic bid with:

- A victory over Charleston Southern AND a Stony Brook loss at Liberty to tie as co-champions with Stony Brook and Liberty at 5-1, plus finishing with fewer points allowed in Conference games than Stony Brook and Liberty.

LIBERTY (4-1, 110 points allowed in Conference games) can clinch the League's automatic bid with:

- A victory over Stony Brook AND a Coastal Carolina loss to Charleston Southern to tie as co-champions with Stony Brook at 5-1, and winning the two-way tiebreaker of head-to-head; or
- A victory over Stony Brook and a Coastal Carolina victory over Charleston Southern to tie as co-champions at 5-1, and finishing with fewer points allowed in Conference games than Stony Brook and Coastal Carolina.

DID YOU KNOW...

...That prior to this past Saturday the winner of the previous six Coastal Carolina-Liberty match-ups has won or shared the Big South football Championship? The Chanticleers won three-straight over Liberty from 2004-06 en route to three consecutive titles (two outright, one shared). The Flames were victorious from 2007-09 while winning three-straight Big South crowns (two outright, one shared). Coastal Carolina won the 2010 meeting this past Saturday and is still alive for the Conference championship. Stay tuned.

TWO OF A KIND

Stony Brook running backs **MIGUEL MAYSONET** (1,095) and **BROCK JACKOLSKI** (1,003) are the second pair of teammates in Big South history to rush for 1,000 yards in the same season. The duo is the first tandem to surpass the threshold this season at the FCS and FBS level. The two rank 1-2 in the Big South in rushing yards, and are looking to become the first pair of teammates to finish first and second in the category in League history. In addition, they each have scored 12 touchdowns this season and are looking to become the fourth duo with 10 rushing touchdowns each, as Maysonet has 10 and Jackolski has nine.

STILL BURNING

Liberty extended its Big South-record Conference home winning streak to 11 games in Week 10 with its 40-14 victory over Gardner-Webb. During this stretch, the Flames have scored 500 points (45.5 points per game), while holding its League brethren to 168 points (15.3 average). In Week 6, Charleston Southern was the first Big South team to score 20 points against Liberty in Williams Stadium since 2007.

JACK-OF-ALL-TRADES

Stony Brook's **BROCK JACKOLSKI** is the first player in Big South history to score a rushing touchdown, receiving touchdown and a kickoff return touchdown in the same game. He accomplished the feat this past Saturday against Gardner-Webb -- all in succession and all in the third quarter. Jackolski returned the opening kickoff of the second half 94 yards for a score, and followed with a 6-yard TD catch and a 19-yard scoring run.

UP IN SMOKE

Coastal Carolina's 45 points against Liberty this past weekend were the most allowed by the Flames in a Big South game since giving up 56 to Elon in 2002. The Chanticleers' 541 yards of offense was the most ever by a Big South opponent against Liberty.

BIG WEEKEND FOR FRESHMEN

Four freshman football players turned in some memorable performances this past weekend. Stony Brook freshman DB **DAVONTE ANDERSON** set a Big South single-game record with four interceptions against Gardner-Webb this past Saturday. The previous single-game mark was three picks, which was done five previous times, including twice this season. Against Liberty, Coastal Carolina's **MATT HAZEL** became the second freshman in Big South history to catch three touchdown passes in a game, while Charleston Southern's **MALCOM DIXON** is the first freshman since **COLLIN DRAFTS** in 2003 and second in League history to throw four touchdown passes in a game. Meanwhile, Presbyterian College freshman QB **RYAN SINGER** is the first player to throw two 50-yard touchdown passes in the same game since Charleston Southern's **SIDNEY BRYANT** in 2007, and is the first freshman to accomplish this feat. At Charleston Southern this past Saturday, Singer first connected on a 53-yard scoring play with **JEREMY COLE**, and later teamed with **MICHAEL RUFF** for a 54-yard touchdown pass.

SEAWOLVES LAND RECORD FOR LARGEST CONFERENCE WIN

Stony Brook defeated Gardner-Webb this weekend, 55-3, and the 52-point margin of victory is the largest winning margin in a Big South game. The previous high was a 46-point victory established in 2003 when the Runnin' Bulldogs blanked Charleston Southern 46-0 on Nov. 8 of that year. Stony Brook has won all five of its Big South games this season by double figures and its average margin of victory in League games is 26.0 points.

CHAMPIONSHIPS ARE WON IN NOVEMBER

Charleston Southern is 14-4 (=77.8 percent) in the month of November since 2005. Coastal Carolina is 18-6 (=75.0) in its history during the final month of the season, while Liberty is 19-8 (=70.4) since 2002. Stony Brook is 5-2 in November since joining the Big South in 2008. With its victory at VMI in Week 10, Coastal Carolina is the only Big South member to win a game in November every season since 2003.

IT'S GOOD TO TURN 50

Gardner-Webb WR **JAMES PERRY III** is the second player in Big South history with three 50-reception seasons, joining former Runnin' Bulldog wideout **DUVAUGHN FLAGLER**, who accomplished the feat from 2005-07. Perry has 57 catches this season, which is four away from matching his career-high of 61 last season. He caught 55 balls during his first collegiate season in 2008. Perry needs three receptions to become the second player in League annals with two 60-reception seasons.

TEN HUT

Liberty QB **MIKE BROWN** is the first quarterback in Big South football history to pass for 200 yards in 10 consecutive games -- all since the beginning of the season. Brown's 10 games with at least 200 yards passing is tied for the most in a single-season in Conference annals. Coastal Carolina's **TYLER THIGPEN** had 10 games with at least 200 passing yards in 2006.

BIG MAC ATTACK

Coastal Carolina QB **ZACH MacDOWALL** continues to move up the Conference's career charts in several categories. He became the fifth player in Big South history with 40 career scoring strikes when he reached the milestone against Liberty this past weekend. MacDowall also is 180 passing yards away from becoming the fifth quarterback with 6,000 career passing yards. He ranks fifth in League annals with 6,487 career total offensive yards, while his 1,008 career offensive plays are fifth-most in the Conference record books. Meanwhile, MacDowall has scored a rushing touchdown in five-straight games, the longest streak by a Big South QB since Charleston Southern's **COLLIN DRAFTS** scored a rushing TD in a Big South-record six consecutive games in 2005.

2,000-RECEIVING YARD ODYSSEY

Gardner-Webb's **JAMES PERRY III** became the fifth player in Big South history and second this season with 2,000 career receiving yards when he surpassed the milestone this past weekend at Stony Brook. Perry, who ranks third all-time with 173 career receptions, is fifth in League annals with 2,005 yards. Charleston Southern's **GERALD STEVENSON** first eclipsed 2,000 career receiving yards in Week 9 (also against the Seawolves), and is currently fourth all-time with 2,096. Stevenson is fourth in career receptions with 163 and eighth with 15 career touchdown receptions.

POINT OF ORDER

Liberty owns the Conference's active scoring streak at 62 games, which is the second-longest in League history. Meanwhile, Presbyterian College has not been shutout in its last 51 games (33 as official Big South members), followed by Gardner-Webb (32), Stony Brook (26) and Charleston Southern (18).

SUMMERS TIME

Liberty's **CHRIS SUMMERS** has broken the Big South single-season records for receiving yards and has tied the League mark for most 100-yard receiving games. He is also on track to shatter the record for receiving yards per game. Summers' 1,081 receiving yards this season surpasses the old mark of 1,077 that was set by Coastal Carolina's **JEROME SIMPSON** in 2006. Summers' six 100-yard receiving games equals **MAURICE PRICE**'s record with Charleston Southern in 2005, and his 108.1 yards per game average is way ahead of Simpson's 89.8 clip from 2006. Summers also leads the Big South with 76 receptions and 15 touchdowns (second-most in a season), but he is likely out for the season-finale against Stony Brook due to an injury suffered this past Saturday at Coastal Carolina.

A LOT TO A LITTLE

Of the 18 Big South Conference games played this season, 15 have been decided by at least 10 points -- a League record for most Big South games decided by double figures in a season. The previous record was 10, which was established in 2009 during a 21-game League slate. Eight of this year's Conference games have been decided by at least 20 points. The average winning margin for the Big South season currently sits at 18.9 points -- the highest since 2007.

DOUBLE DOWN

Stony Brook is the Big South's active leader for most consecutive games scoring in double figures at 26, the fourth-longest streak in Big South history. The Seawolves took over the top spot after Liberty's Big South-record of 45 consecutive games scoring double figures was snapped in Week 4 at James Madison, as the Flames managed just a field goal against the Dukes.

DOUBLED UP

Liberty has set the Conference record for most consecutive League games scoring in double figures at 27. The Flames broke the record of 26 games that was established by VMI from Oct. 4, 2003 - Oct. 10, 2009. Meanwhile, Liberty and VMI have not been shutout in Big South play. The Flames have scored in all 39 of their Big South games since 2002, while the Keydets have tallied points in all 36 of their Big South contests since joining in 2003.

GROUND GAINER

Liberty QB **MIKE BROWN** has rushed for 694 yards this season, the second-highest single-season rushing total for a quarterback in League history. The Big South single-season record for most rushing yards by a quarterback is 1,266 by VMI's **TIM MAYPRAY** in 2008.

HIGH RATE OF RETURN

Charleston Southern's **GERALD STEVENSON** is the Big South's all-time leader for combined kick return yardage at 2,579 (2,379 kickoffs, 200 punts), as well as the all-time leader in kickoff return yards and tied as the career leader with 98 kickoff returns. Stevenson is second in Conference history with 5,561 career all-purpose yards.

SUPER SIZED COMBO

Stony Brook running back duo **BROCK JACKOLSKI** and **MIGUEL MAYSONET** have rushed for 100 yards in the same game three times this season and have 10 100-yard rushing games between them. The pair combined for 341 rushing yards in Week 9 against Charleston Southern, the seventh-highest rushing total by two teammates in a single-game in League history, and combined for 231 in Week 10 at Presbyterian College. Jackolski has six 100-yard rushing games and averages 136.8 yards when he surpasses the century mark. Maysonet has averaged 159.8 yards when he eclipses the 100-yard barrier in a game.

RUSHING UPDATE

Below is a look at the Big South Conference's active career 1,000-yard rushers and where they rank in League history. Stony Brook's **EDWIN GOWINS**, the Big South's active leading career rusher with 2,355 yards, is out for the remainder of the season with an injury.

HE'S COULT-IVATING

In his last six games, Stony Brook QB **MICHAEL COULTER** is 78-of-120 passing (=65.0) for 1,042 yards and 11 touchdowns for a 168.19 passing efficiency rating. More important is that he has not thrown an interception in that span. Coulter threw four touchdown passes in Week 10 at Presbyterian College and is tied for second in the Big South with 15 TD throws. Meanwhile, Coulter has quietly entered the Conference's all-time top 10 for passing yards, touchdown passes and completions, as he ranks 10th with 3,656 career passing yards, is seventh with 30 career TDs and 10th with 274 career completions.

TOTAL RECALL

Liberty QB **MIKE BROWN** ranks second in the nation in total offense at 331.6, which is currently pacing ahead of the Big South single-season record of 329.3, which was set by Coastal Carolina's **TYLER THIGPEN** in 2006. Brown's 3,316 total offensive yards this season as well as his six 300-yard total offense games are second-most in a campaign in League history. Thigpen holds both records with 3,952 yards of total offense and nine 300-yard total offense games during Coastal's 2006 playoff season.

CATCHING UP

Liberty redshirt-junior **CHRIS SUMMERS** has 124 career receptions for 1,698 yards and 19 touchdowns in his career, and is one TD grab away from becoming the fourth Big South player with 20 career touchdown catches. Summers also is three catches away from cracking the League's top 10. Summers has caught a touchdown pass in eight of 10 games this year, including five multi-TD receiving games -- matching the Big South single-season record that was first set by Coastal Carolina's **JEROME SIMPSON** in 2006.

BIG BROWN

In just 11 career starts at quarterback, Liberty QB **MIKE BROWN** is 232-of-356 passing (=65.2 percent) for 2,864 yards and 22 touchdowns, in addition to being 8-3. He also has rushed 150 times for 782 yards (5.2 average) and eight scores starting under center. Brown's 149 rushing yards at Presbyterian College in Week 9 was the third-highest single-game total by a quarterback in Big South history. He also was the third Big South player to pass for 250 yards and rush for 100 yards in the same game at PC.

FAVORITE TOPPINGS

Liberty leads the Big South in both scoring offense (34.7) and scoring defense (19.4), a feat they accomplished in 2007 and 2009. The Flames are looking to become the first team in Big South history to lead in scoring offense in consecutive seasons, while their defensive prowess has them on track to have the Conference's top scoring defense for an unprecedented fifth-straight year.

50-50 RAFFLE

Liberty junior **MATT BEVINS** is the first player in Big South history to make 50 career field goals, as well as the third kicker in Conference annals with two career field goals from 50 yards-or-longer. He booted a career-long 52-yarder at Coastal Carolina this past Saturday. Bevins is 50-of-65 in career field goals at Liberty (=76.9), and ranks second in Big South history with 250 career points kicking as well as fifth in overall scoring. He is 47 points away from tying the Big South career record for kick scoring, which is 297 points by Coastal Carolina's **JOSH HOKE** (2003-06). Bevins and Hoke are tied for the most 10-point kicking games in League history with 10 each.

BULL DURHAM

Coastal Carolina kicker **JUSTIN DURHAM** became Coastal Carolina's all-time leader in career field goals when he made a career-long 46-yarder this past Saturday against Liberty. It was his 41st career field goal, breaking **JOSH HOKE**'s school-record of 40. Of Durham's 41 career field goals, 10 have been 40 yards-or-longer. Coupled with 103 point-after kicks, Durham has 226 career points.

SOMETHING SPECIAL

Coastal Carolina holds the Big South's longest streak of not allowing a punt return touchdown in a Conference game at 36 games. The last time the Chanticleers allowed a punt return touchdown in a League game was in their first-ever Big South contest, Oct. 4, 2003 against Gardner-Webb.

TACKLE BOX

Gardner-Webb linebacker **JEFFERY WILLIAMS**, who became the eighth player in Big South history with 300 career tackles when he surpassed the milestone with 18 tackles in GWU's season-opening win over Brevard, is fourth all-time in Big South history with 334 career stops. He needs 14 to move into a tie for third-place, which is currently held by former Liberty LB **MANNY ROJAS** (2003-06) with 348.

A BIG PUP

Gardner-Webb true freshman DE **PRESTON PEMASA** continues to lead the Big South with 5.5 quarterback sacks, and is looking to become the first frosh in League history to lead the Conference in sacks. Pemasa is challenging the freshman sack record of 6.5, which was set by Coastal Carolina's **ADRAIN GRADY** in 2003.

The NCAA does not list reclassifying teams in its overall statistics listings, therefore, Presbyterian College will not be ranked in the NCAA statistics again this season.

ROAD WORK

The road teams have won 10 of the 18 Conference games played this season (=55.6 percent), breaking the League record for the most times the road squads have won during a Conference season (nine in 2009, which featured 21 League contests for the first time).

CUNNINGHAM HARDWARE

Coastal Carolina's **KEON CUNNINGHAM** is the Big South's all-time leader in career interception return yardage with 225. He has intercepted eight passes in his career and has returned two of them for touchdowns -- tied for the most INT return touchdowns in Big South history.

SIR CHARLES

Charleston Southern DB **CHARLES JAMES** leads the Big South with six interceptions and 17 passes defended. His six picks ties the school record that was set by **PHILIP ASHLEY** in 2008. James' 17 passes defended are third-most in a season in Big South history.

THREE-PEAT

Liberty QB **MIKE BROWN** has thrown at least three TD passes in a game four times this season, just two away from the Big South single-season record of six, which was set by Coastal Carolina's **TYLER THIGPEN** in 2006. In addition, Brown's 21 touchdown passes this year are tied for third-most in a season in League history. He was the first player in Big South history to throw three touchdown passes in three consecutive games earlier this season during Weeks 5-7.

STONEWALLED

Stony Brook is looking to become the first Big South team since Coastal Carolina in 2005 to lead the Conference in both rushing offense and rushing defense. The Seawolves are averaging 234.9 rushing yards a game while holding their opponents to 117.1 rushing yards per game. SBU would become the fourth team in League history to lead in both rushing offense and rushing defense in the same season if it can maintain its current pace.

THE IGNITOR

Liberty QB **MIKE BROWN** is the first player in Big South history with 1,000 career rushing, passing and receiving yards. Brown surpassed the rushing milestone in Week 9 at Presbyterian College, and now has 1,278 career rushing yards, 3,074 career passing yards and 1,047 career receiving yards.

GOOD WORK YOUNG MAN

Charleston Southern OL **JORDAN LANCASTER** was one of 22 players from all classifications to be named to the Allstate AFCA Good Works Team -- college football's preeminent community service award. Lancaster is the first Big South Conference student-athlete to be recognized with this achievement.

IT'S ACADEMIC

Presbyterian College OL **JARED TAVERNIER** and Charleston Southern LB **BRAD SWEATT** were named to the 2010 *ESPN The Magazine*/CoSIDA Academic All-District III team and are now eligible for Academic All-America honors. The All-District team is comprised of Division I student-athletes in both FBS and FCS, and the Big South has had multiple All-District honorees every year since starting football in 2002.

TWO FOR THE PRICE OF ONE -- BIG SOUTH SCORES FIRST-EVER FBS WINS

Gardner-Webb and Liberty made Big South Conference history in Week 2 as both schools defeated FBS opponents -- the League's first-ever wins against FBS programs. Gardner-Webb was the first to claim victory with its 38-37 overtime triumph at Akron at 3:15pm. Less than seven hours later, Liberty emerged with a 27-23 win at Ball State at 9:55pm. The Big South is playing a League-record 10 games against FBS opponents in 2010. The previous high was eight, just last year. Charleston Southern, Presbyterian College and VMI each will play two FBS foes this season.

BROWN ADDED TO PAYTON AWARD WATCH LIST

On Monday, Oct. 4, Liberty QB **MIKE BROWN** was one of four players added to the Walter Payton Award Watch List, which is presented by *The Sports Network* and sponsored by Fathead.com. Brown is the first Big South player on the Watch List since former Flames RB **RASHAD JENNINGS** in 2008, and is the fourth overall to be among the top candidates for the top individual honor in FCS. The final official ballot will be sent out to voters on Nov. 22.

NORTHERN EXPOSURE
