2 IN THE POSTSEASON

The Big South Conference has two teams in the Postseason ... Gardner-Webb will represent the Big South Conference in the NCAA Tournament as Liberty plays in the WNIT.

WINNING THE REBOUNDING WAR (LEY)

Liberty's **AVERY WARLEY** took over the Big South single-season rebounding record as she has ripped down 363 boards this season ... She also set the Big South Tournament rebound record as she pulled down 48 in her three tournament contests.

THIRD TIME IS A CHARM

The third time was the time for Gardner-Webb in the Big South Championship finals. After advancing to the finals for two-straight years, the Runnin' Bulldogs knocked off Liberty to win the school's first-ever Big South Women's Basketball Championship ... The win marked the first time in League history that a team downed the Lady Flames in the Championship finals.

7-UP

High Point's **CHEYENNE PARKER** set a milestone on March 8 as she became the first player in Big South Conference history to earn 7 Big South Freshman of the Week honors in a single season.

NO. 25 ON THE ROSTER NO. 1 IN THE NATION

Charleston Southern's **KATIE TULL** currently ranks No. 1 in the country with 3.5 triples per game.

RIDE'N 30

Radford's **DA'NARIA ERWIN SPENCER**'s 30 points on Feb. 28 vs. Presbyterian College is the highest single-game effort on the season as she is the only player in the League this year with a game of 30 or more points. She also became the first Highlander since the 2007-08 season to post 30-or-more points in a game.

SIX-TACULAR

DEQUESHA MCCIANAHAN earned Big South Freshman of the Week honors six times this season. She joins four players in the Big South to earn six plaudits, including current High Point Panther **SHAMIA BROWN** who picked up her six nods in 2008-09.

STYLE'N & PROFILE'N

Charleston Southern and Liberty set single-game records over the past couple of weeks. Liberty pulled down 65 rebounds in a win over Gardner-Webb on Feb. 12 to best the old standard of 63 held by Charleston Southern since 1992 ... Charleston Southern reset its single-game three point field goal mark as it canned 18 in the win over UNC Asheville on Feb. 19. The Bucs old standard of 17 was set against High Point on Feb. 2, 2009.

DOUBLE-TROUBLE

UNC Asheville's **KELLI RILES** and **AVERY WARLEY** of Liberty are the only two players in the League averaging a double-double. Riles is currently averaging 11.1 points and 10.3 rebounds per game, while Warley is posting 12.0 points and 11.2 boards per game. Warley also tops the Big South with 16 double-doubles on the season, while Riles is close behind her with 11.

MAKE'N THE GRADE

Coastal Carolina's **KATIE WHITE** and **MACKENZIE MAIER** from High Point each earned bids to the CoSIDA Academic All-District III teams. White was named to the first time while Maier was tabbed a second team selection. The honors also mark the seventh-straight year that the League has boasted at least one All-District honoree.

2 AIN'T ENOUGH JACK, YOU BETTER MAKE IT 3

Charleston Southern's **KATIE TULL** took over the No. 1 spot all-time in career three-pointers on Jan. 24. She reset her single-season record with 105 three-pointers this season, including nine treys against Voorhees on Nov. 16. The nine triples set the CSU single game mark and was one off the Big South single game standard ... There are currently three other players in the Big South making their way up in the career three-pointers list. Here is a look at how they stack up:

COUNTER BLOCKWISE

MACKENZIE MAIER took over the No. 1 spot all-time in the Big South record book with 306 career rejections. The senior has finished ranked in the Top-10 in the Big South single-season blocks list in each of the past two seasons and holds the No. 2 position with 91 blocks during the 2009-10 campaign. Her 10 blocks vs. Campbell on Dec. 2 tied the Big South single-game record ... Also making her way up the list is **KATIE WHITE** from Coastal Carolina. She currently has 204 blocked shots in her career and is ranked No. 6 all-time... White has also become Coastal Carolina's career blocked shots leader.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Charleston Southern Buccaneers lost in the Advanced Auto Parts Big South Championship Quarterfinals at the hands of tournament host High Point at a score of 77-49. The loss ends their season with an overall record of 14-16 (8-8, Big South Regular Season). The loss effectively ends the careers of four Buccaneers barring another invitation to a postseason tournament. **KATIE TULL**, **KELSEY WASMER**, **LYDIA JOHNSON**, and **ABBY POOLE** all played in their final games for Charleston Southern University. Two of those seniors Wasmer and Tull were in double-figure scoring. Wasmer had 15 points in the loss while Tull had 12. Johnson led the Buccaneers with seven rebounds. Tull ends her career at CSU at third on the all-time scoring list while Wasmer finishes at ninth.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina ended the season with a loss to Liberty, 51-44, in the Big South Tournament Quarterfinals... Coastal ends the season with 10-19 (4-12 Big South) record... **SYDNEI MOSS** scored 25 points in the loss to finish her career with 1329 points... She is now the eighth leading scorer in Coastal Carolina history... Moss also ends her career ranked seventh in the Chanticleer record books with 685 rebounds... **KATIE WHITE** broke the Chants single season shot blocks record with 67 rejections this season... White now holds every blocked shots record at Coastal Carolina.

GARDNER-WEBB

The Gardner-Webb women's basketball team wrapped up its 2010-11 season in a place where the Runnin' Bulldogs program had never been before, the NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Championship, as the Runnin' Bulldogs season came to an end in an 80-62 first round loss to the No. 3 seeded Miami Hurricanes. Gardner-Webb ended the season at 23-11, posting back-to-back 20 win seasons for the first time in the program's 36-year history. GWU not only made it to their first ever NCAA Championships Tournament, but also won the 2011 Big South Championships, defeating No. 1 Liberty 67-66. In the Runnin' Bulldogs' first ever NCAA Championship Tournament game, **DOMINIQUE HUDSON** had 18 points and five assists, while **MONIQUE HUDSON** added 17 points and seven rebounds in the loss to No. 11 nationally ranked Miami. The Runnin' Bulldogs' seniors of Dominique Hudson, Monique Hudson, **LATROYA POPE** and **SANDRA VAITKUTE** all finished their careers at GWU in the NCAA Tournament, taking the program to new heights each and every season that they wore the Runnin' Bulldog uniforms. First-Team All-Conference selection and Big South Tournament MVP Dominique Hudson finishes her career ranked first on Gardner Webb's Division I all-time list in points (1407), assists (579), games played (129), minutes (3545), steals (244), and free throws made (419). Second-Team All-Conference selection and Big South All-Tournament honoree Monique Hudson finishes her career ranked fifth on Gardner Webb's Division I all-time scoring list (1147), third in 3 point field goals made (115), third in steals (211), fourth in assists (265), fourth in made free throws (240). Senior LaTroya Pope finishes her career second in GWU's Division I history in blocks (125), tied for third in games played (126), fourth in minutes played (3075), fourth in rebounds (656), and tied for fifth in games started (84). All-Tournament selection Sandra Vaitkute, who played her last two years at Gardner-Webb after transferring from the University of Maine, finished her career third in GWU's Division I record book in blocks (103) and second in career field goal percentage (.486).

HIGH POINT

Women's basketball picked up a 77-49 win over Charleston Southern before ending its season one day later with a 76-55 loss to Liberty in the Big South semifinals. Junior **SHAMIA BROWN** averaged 16 points per game in the two contests while **MACKENZIE MAIER** averaged 15 points per game in her final Big South Tournament. HPU jumped out to a 17-3 lead over the Lady Buccaneers and never looked back. The Panthers shot 55.8 percent from the field for the game and 68.8 percent from behind the arc, connecting on 11 three pointers. Against Liberty, HPU trailed by just one at 25-24 late in the first half before the Flames closed the half on an 11-2 run to take a 10-point lead into the break. The Panthers could not pull closer than eight points in the second period losing to Liberty in the semifinals for the second-straight season. Maier finished her career with a Big South record 306 blocks while senior **JURICA HARGRAVES** broke the HPU DI career scoring record in her final game, finishing her career with 1,330 career points.

LIBERTY

Liberty finished the 2010-11 season with a 22-11 record, winning at least 20 games for the 13th time in the last 15 seasons ... The Lady Flames captured their 12th Big South regular-season title, after going 14-2 in conference play ... Liberty made its first-ever appearance in the Postseason WNIT, dropping a first-round contest at Charlotte by a 62-56 score on March 16 ... **KITTERY MAINE**, **RACHEL MCLEOD** and **DIAMOND MORGAN** graduated as the winningest senior class in program history ... Liberty went 101-30 over the past four seasons ... Redshirt junior center **AVERY WARLEY** had a stellar season, becoming the first Lady Flame since **KATIE FEENSTRA** in 2004-05 to average a double-double ... The Big South Defensive Player of the Year broke the Liberty and Big South Conference single-season rebounding records with 363 boards ... 48 of Warley's rebounds came at the Big South Championship, setting a new tournament record.

PRESBYTERIAN

Senior **AMANDA MILLS** moved into sole possession of third place all time in the program's career record books with 153 three-pointers (in only three seasons). PC ended its season with a 49-40 loss at Liberty, marking the third straight time against the Flames that PC was held to 40 points exactly. The 9 wins for PC this season marked a new Division I high, and the 4 road wins were more than the team saw over the last four seasons combined. PC also swept UNC Asheville (No. 6 seed) this season, showing an improvement since being picked last in the preseason poll.

RADFORD

Radford women's basketball enjoyed a successful conference season finishing tied for second and earning the second seed for the upcoming tournament. Head coach **TAJAMA ABRAHAM NGONGBA** was rewarded for her team's success, being named Big South Coach of the Year. She is the fourth Highlander to earn this award and the first since 2001-02 when interim coach **KRISTEN HOLT** garnered the honor ... The Highlanders finished 11-5 and recorded the most league wins since the 1993-94 season and earned the second seed for the third time in five seasons. The league marked was helped by a 7-1 start, their best since 1997-98. Along the way, Radford picked up some big wins (three in overtime), but none bigger than its 61-52 triumph at Liberty on Jan. 17. The victory was their first at the Vines Center since 1996 ending a 16-game losing streak in Lynchburg and putting the only blemish on Liberty's home schedule in 11 contests. Radford also posted its 600th win on Jan. 22 at home against Presbyterian.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville was eliminated from the 2011 Advanced Auto Parts Big South Conference Championship by eventual tournament winner Gardner-Webb, 69-58, on March 11. With the loss the Bulldogs season came to an end, finishing the year with an overall record of 12-18. They also finished the year 5-11 in conference play, 5-10 at home and 7-7 on the road. Senior guard **KENDALL SHEPARD** was named to the All-Big South Conference Second Team for her efforts on the year. Shepard averaged 15.2 points per game to lead all players, while also leading the team in assists with 105 and free throws with 120. For the season four players averaged 10 or more points per game. Sophomore guard **KELLI RILES** averaged a double-double on the season, posting 11.1 points and 10.3 rebounds per contest. Shepard and fellow upperclassman **LINDSEY MONTGOMERY** each joined Asheville's 1,000 point club on the year.

WINTHROP

LACEY LYONS finished her career on Saturday in the semifinals loss to eventual conference champion Gardner-Webb and will go down in Big South history as one of the top three-point scoring threats. Lyons finished with 194 in her career between Winthrop and Coastal Carolina, which ranks 8th on the all-time list in the Big South. She finished her career with 946 points ... **TAQUOIA HAMMICK** finished the season on a strong note having recorded double-doubles in five of the last eight games, including back-to-back in the conference tournament. She had 13 points and 10 rebounds against Radford and had the same numbers the next day against Gardner-Webb. Hammick finished the season with 28 blocks and now has 60 in her career, which ranks 6th all-time in Winthrop history. She trails fifth place by 14 and is 22 back of fourth ... Freshman **DEQUESHA MCCLANAHAN** had an impressive first season with the Lady Eagles and was rewarded by being named the Big South Conference Freshman of the Year. Her numbers rank among the best for a freshman in Winthrop history. She scored 386 points, which ranks third, had 64 steals (4th), 110 assists (2nd), 32 three-pointers made (6th), and set new freshman records in minutes played (1,038), games started with 30 and free throws made with 103. She is the only freshman in school history to play 1,000 minutes ... Winthrop's appearance in the semifinals of the Big South Tourney this past weekend was the fifth time there in the last six seasons.

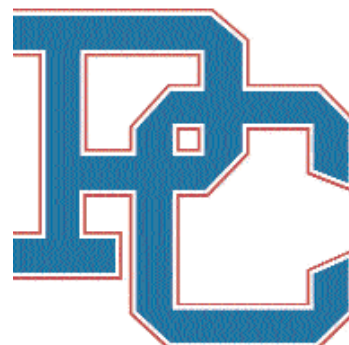
