Coastal Carolina's **SYDNEI MOSS** and **MACKENZIE MAIER** are the only active players in the Big South more than 1,000 points and 500 boards ... The milestone mark the first time since the 2008-09 season that the League has had two active players with 1,000 points and 500 boards.

PRIMETIME PLAYERS

The Big South has featured some really big games from players across the League. **LINDSEY THOMPSON** of UNC Asheville put in a Big South season-high 29 points vs. Appalachian State on Dec. 2. **KATIE TULL** of Charleston Southern matched that effort as she recorded 29 points against Pfeiffer on Dec. 11 ... Both Thompson and Tull have went for 20-or-more points four times ... **LINDSEY MONTGOMERY** and **KELLI RILES** of UNC Asheville had big games against Furman on Dec. 11. Montgomery finished the contest with 25 points and 10 rebounds, while Riles notched 21 points and 15 boards ... **MACKENZIE MAIER** posted an unconventional double-double as she put in 22 points and posted 10 rejections against Campbell on Dec. 1 ... Winthrop's **DEQUESHA McCLANAHAN** recorded the top freshman scoring performance as she piled up 26 points against VCU on Nov. 17.

WHERE THE LEATHER MEETS THE HARDWOOD

The Big South Conference women's basketball teams will begin their push to the NCAA Championship on Monday, Jan. 3 ... Monday marks the first day of Conference games as each team looks to position themselves for a run at the Big South Title and automatic bid to the NCAA Championship.

BENJAMIN

Gardner-Webb Head Coach **RICK REEVES** passed a milestone on Dec. 5 and 7th as his Runnin' Bulldogs went 2-0. The two wins gave Reeves his 100th win at Gardner-Webb.

MAKE'N IT RAIN

Charleston Southern's **KATIE TULL** has been locked in from downtown throughout her career in the Big South Conference. She currently ranks No. 2 all-time in the Big South with 252 career three-pointers. She needs only 12 more treys to take over the No. 1 spot in the Conference as former Winthrop guard **TIFFANY RODD** is ranked No. 1 with 263. She set the single season record with 100 three-pointers last season and this season she poured in nine treys against Voorhees on Nov. 16. The nine triples set the CSU single game mark and was one off the Big South single game standard ... She currently has 45 on the season.

COUNTER BLOCKWISE

MACKENZIE MAIER is currently ranked No. 2 all-time in the Big South record book with 259 career rejections. She needs 35 blocks to take hold of the No. 1 position held by former Radford center **KELLI DARDEN**. The senior has finished ranked in the Top-10 in the Big South single-season blocks list in each of the past two seasons and holds the No. 2 position with 91 blocks during the 2009-10 campaign. Her 10 blocks vs. Campbell on Dec. 2 tied the Big South single-game record ... Also making her way up the list is **KATIE WHITE** from Coastal Carolina. She currently has 168 blocked shots in her career and is ranked No. 8 all-time.

GIVE & TAKE

Winthrop's **DEQUESHA McCLANAHAN** set this season's standard in assists as she dished out nine helpers against North Carolina A&T on Nov. 14. In her next game against Virginia Commonwealth on Nov. 17, she set the season's standard in steals as she posted eight take-aways against the Rams.

RILED UP

UNC Asheville's **KELLI RILES** has established herself as the League's top rebounder this season. She is ranked No. 1 in the League with 12.0 boards per contest and has went for double-digits in seven of her nine games this season. She has posted a Big South season-high 16 rebounds on Dec. 15 and posted three-straight games with at least 10 boards twice this season. She is the only player in the Big South averaging a double-double as she averages 12.0 points per contest.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Buccaneer senior guard **KATIE TULL** hit a three to give the Bucs the lead with 11 seconds remaining to win the game over Mercer. That victory over Mercer ties up the all-time series between the two schools at five wins apiece.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina went 0-2 on the week with a 79-45 defeat at home to UNC Wilmington, its first home loss of the season, and a 71-63 loss to Butler in the Crescent Bank Carolinas Challenge held at the Myrtle Beach Convention Center... **OLIVIA IRICK** established a new single game points mark as she scored 18 against UNC Wilmington. Irick made seven baskets including three treys in her 33 minutes on the court... **SYDNEI MOSS** reestablished this season's single game points total in her 20 point performance against Butler. Moss connected on eight shots, also a Chanticleer season-high, and went 4-of-6 from the line.... In the Butler defeat, the Chants forced 25 Butler miscues and responded with a season-high 34 points off the turnovers... Coastal will take the next 10 days off for the Christmas holiday before closing out the calendar year on the road at USC Upstate on Dec. 30.

GARDNER-WEBB

The Gardner-Webb Runnin' Bulldogs extended its winning streak to five games in dominating fashion with an 81-47 home win over the Converse College Valkyries last week. In the win, the Runnin' Bulldogs were led by **DOMINIQUE HUDSON**, who had a game-high 20 points, and fellow senior **LATROYA POPE** who posted here third double-double of the season with 15 points and 11 rebounds. **MONIQUE HUDSON** added 13 points, while freshman **CATRINA GREEN** was the fourth GWU player in double figures with a career-high 10 points in 16 minutes of action. The Runnin' Bulldogs as a team dished out a season-high 23 assists in the win, the fourth highest in its 10-year GWU Division I history. Gardner-Webb also held the Valkyries to only six made field goals in the final 20 minutes of play, marking the fourth-time this season that GWU has held a team to only six field goals in a half. The Runnin' Bulldogs will have a challenging few weeks to wrap up the month of December, as Gardner-Webb will host two BCS schools before the new year. The Runnin' Bulldogs will host Purdue on December 22nd at 7 p.m., before taking on the Tennessee Temple Crusaders on December 29th at 7 p.m. Then the Runnin' Bulldogs will host the No. 10 North Carolina Lady Tar Heels at 3 p.m. on December 31st at Paul Porter Arena in Boiling Springs, N.C.

HIGH POINT

High Point traveled to Athens, Ga., to take on Georgia. The Panthers opened the game shooting 5-5 from the field and 4-4 from behind the arc and led for most of the first half. HPU never trailed by more than seven in the second half and had a chance to tie the game while down three with 13 seconds left. A three by senior **JURICA HARGRAVES** put up a shot from the corner but it hit the back rim and Georgia held on for the five-point win. Seniors Hargraves and **MACKENZIE MAIER** and junior **SHAMIA BROWN** all had 13 points to lead High Point. Maier moved past 1,000 points for her career in the game and is the second HPU player in the team's Division I era to reach 1,000 points and 500 rebounds.

LIBERTY

Liberty is 3-0 at the Vines Center this season, but 0-6 in games played away from Lynchburg ... the Lady Flames' next seven games are all road or neutral contests ... **AVERY WARLEY** became the eighth Lady Flame ever to grab 600 career rebounds, during Saturday's game at North Carolina Central ... The redshirt junior now ranks No. 7 in program history with 606 career boards ... Liberty had won 29 straight games against MEAC opponents, before Saturday's loss at North Carolina Central ... The Lady Flames play at VCU Tuesday at 7 p.m. and need a win to avoid their first three-game losing streak since Liberty dropped five games in a row between Nov. 22 and Dec. 7, 2008.

PRESBYTERIAN

Presbyterian College reaches the Christmas break mired in a five-game losing streak with a pair of defeats last week against NC State and Ohio. **MARIAH PIETROWSKI** leads PC in scoring with 11.4 points per game with 6.2 rebounds per game. She leads the Big South in shooting and ranks among the top-50 in the nation with a .576 field goal percentage. **SHONDA BURNSIDE** has 9.0 points per game. Against Ohio, **AMANDA MILLS** became the leading scorer in the Division I era with a 12-point performance to push her over the 600 career points plateau.

RADFORD

Radford will conclude the road portion of its non-conference schedule when it faces off against local foe Virginia Tech on Dec. 21. The Highlanders have played eight of their first 11 games away from the Dedmon Center. **BROOKE MCELROY** has pulled down 15 and 14 boards in her last two contests. Her 15 rebounds at UNCG was the best single-game rebounding performance since Kelli Darden pulled down the same amount on Jan. 26, 2008 against High Point in the Dedmon Center. Her 18 points was her single-best game in a Highlander uniform. The Highlanders recorded season highs in points (81), field goals (27), three-point field goals (7), field goal (71) and three-point (22) attempts at USC Upstate. It marked the first 80-point performance in regulation since Jan. 5, 2009 vs. Gardner-Webb in Peters Hall (W, 82-74). After 16 steals at USC Upstate, Radford ranks 25th in the NCAA at 12.4 thefts per contest. The Highlanders recorded a season-high 25 versus Southern Virginia on Dec. 9.

UNC ASHEVILLE

The Bulldogs went 1-1 on the week with an 84-69 victory over South Carolina State on Wednesday evening at home in the Justice Center before falling on the road to Big East foe Marquette 75-46 on Saturday. The trip to Marquette was the first time UNC Asheville had ever played a contest in the state of Wisconsin and was a homecoming for senior guard **DANA WAGNER**, who is a native of Sun Prairie, Wis. Asheville is now 5-4 on the season with a 4-2 mark at home and a 1-2 record on the road. Asheville currently leads the Big South in scoring offense and field goal percentage. The Bulldogs are averaging 73.1 points per game and are shooting .417 from the floor. **KENDALL SHEPARD** and **LINDSEY THOMPSON** lead the Big South in scoring as Shepard averages 17.4 points per game and Thompson averages 16.9. **KELLI RILES** is ninth in the Big South in scoring with a 12.0 ppg average giving the Bulldogs three players in the top-10 in scoring in the league. Riles also leads the league in rebounds (12.0 rpg) and field goal percentage (.583). Shepard currently leads the league in minutes played averaging 36.7 per contest and is second in assists with 4.8 apg. Thompson currently ranks first in free throw percentage with a mark of .914. The Bulldogs will play at Mercer on Wednesday in their only game this week. The Bulldogs received three votes in the Collegiate Insider Mid-Major Poll this week. It's the first time Asheville has ever picked any votes in the poll.

WINTHROP

Freshman **DEQUESHA MCCLANAHAN** continued her good play away from the Winthrop Coliseum as she scored 17 points in a victory over Maine. The young guard is averaging 18.8 points, 4.5 rebounds, 3.0 assists, and 4.5 steals in four games away from home. She is also shooting 43 percent from the floor and 47 percent from three. The Lady Eagles made their third trip ever to the Edmunds Center on the campus of Stetson University and picked up their first ever win there against Maine. Winthrop is now 3-8 all-time in the state in the Florida since moving to the NCAA Division I level.

BIG SOUTH MISCELLANEOUS STATISTICS
