Riles shot 72 percent from the floor and posted two 20-point outings to lead Asheville to a 2-1 record over the holiday break. She got things going with 22 points on 11-of-13 from the floor and chipped in nine boards and a steal as the Bulldogs downed Mercer on Dec. 22. On Dec. 29, Riles scored 12 points on 44 percent from the field as Asheville dropped North Carolina Central, 67-56. She also ripped down nine rebounds and dished out two helpers in the contest. Five days later in Asheville's Conference opener against Radford, Riles poured in 20 points on 80 percent shooting and 4-of-4 from the line to go along with 11

THE CRONS BRAND FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

Emily Frazier G • Liberty Magnolia, Texas

Frazier averaged 10 points on 52 percent from the floor to help the Lady Flames to a 3-1 record over the holiday season, including a win over Big South foe High Point. She notched a career-high 12 points on 50 percent from the floor in a Dec. 21 win over Virginia Commonwealth Frazier then put in seven points against No. 18 St. John's on Dec. 28. The next day against La Salle, she reset her career-best as she finished with 14 on 4-of-6 from the floor, 2of-2 from long range and 4-of-6 from the line as Liberty downed the Explorers, 73-53. She closed the four-game span out with seven points and eight assists as Liberty picked up its first Big South win of the 2010-11 campaign. She finished the holiday break with 10 rebounds, 15 assists and an 86 percent clip from the line.

HERE WE GO!!!

The Big South Conference women's basketball opened up Conference play over the weekend. Liberty, Gardner-Webb, Radford and Presbyterian College each opened the season with a win.

WE'RE THE ONLY ONES!!!

Coastal Carolina's SYDNEI MOSS and MACKENZIE MAIER are the only active players in the Big South more than 1,000 points and 500 boards \dots The milestone marks the first time since the 2008-09 season that the League has had two active players with 1,000 points and 500 boards.

PRIMETIME PLAYERS

The Big South has featured some really big games from players across the League. LINDSEY THOMP-SON of UNC Asheville put in a Big South season-high 29 points vs. Appalachian State on Dec. 2. KATIE TULL of Charleston Southern matched that effort as she recorded 29 points against Pfeiffer on Dec. 11... Both Thompson and Tull have went for 20-or-more points four times ... LINDSEY MONTGOMERY and KELLI RILES of UNC Asheville had big games against Furman on Dec. 11. Montgomery finished the contest with 25 points and 10 rebounds, while Riles notched 21 points and 15 boards ... MACKEN-ZIE MAIER posted an unconventional double-double as she put in 22 points and posted 10 rejections against Campbell on Dec. 1 ... Winthrop's DEQUESHA McCLANAHAN recorded the top freshman scoring performance as she piled up 26 points against VCU on Nov. 17.

BENJAMIN

Gardner-Webb Head Coach RICK REEVES passed a milestone on Dec. 5 and 7th as his Runnin' Bulldogs went 2-0. The two wins gave Reeves his 100th win at Gardner-Webb.

MAKE'N IT RAIN

Charleston Southern's KATIE TULL has been locked in from downtown throughout her career in the Big South Conference. She currently ranks No. 2 all-time in the Big South with 260 career three-pointers. She needs only 3 more treys to take over the No. 1 spot in the Conference as former Winthrop guard TIFFANY RODD is ranked No. 1 with 263. She set the single season record with 100 three-pointers last season and this season she poured in nine treys against Voorhees on Nov. 16. The nine triples set the CSU single game mark and was one off the Big South single game standard ... She currently has 53 on the season.

COUNTER BLOCKWISE

MACKENZIE MAIER is currently ranked No. 2 all-time in the Big South record book with 262 career rejections. She needs 32 blocks to take hold of the No. 1 position held by former Radford center KELLI DARDEN. The senior has finished ranked in the Top-10 in the Big South single-season blocks list in each of the past two seasons and holds the No. 2 position with 91 blocks during the 2009-10 campaign. Her 10 blocks vs. Campbell on Dec. 2 tied the Big South single-game record ... Also making her way up the list is KATIE WHITE from Coastal Carolina. She currently has 168 blocked shots in her career and is ranked No. 8 all-time.

GIVE & TAKE

Winthrop's DEQUESHA McCLANAHAN set this season's standard in assists as she dished out nine helpers against North Carolina A&T on Nov. 14. In her next game against Virginia Commonwealth on Nov. 17, she set the season's standard in steals as she posted eight take-aways against the Rams.

RII FD LIF

UNC Asheville's **KELLI RILES** has established herself as the League's top rebounder this season. She is ranked No. 1 in the League with 11.4 boards per contest and has went for double-digits in eight of her 12 games this season. She has posted a Big South season-high 16 rebounds on Dec. 15 and posted three-straight games with at least 10 boards twice this season. She is the only player in the Big South averaging a double-double as she averages 13.5 points per contest.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

This past week the Bucs of Charleston Southern defeated their crosstown rival College of Charleston. Three of Charleston Southern's nine victories over the Cougars have come during Head Coach JULIE GOODENOUGH'S tenure at CSU, the most recent being a victory coming in the 2007-08 season. The Bucs dropped their first Big South Conference game on the road on Monday, losing to last year's regular season Champion; Gardner-Webb, 67-51. The Bucs continue their conference road swing with games against Winthrop and Coastal Carolina next week.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina finished the week 1-1 with a 70-62 victory at USC Upstate and a 52-36 defeat to Presbyterian...In Coastal's win at Upstate the Chants were led by KIRA CARTER's career-high 21 points and Katie White's career-tying 17 points.... In the win, Coastal's starting five scored 49 points as they shot 59.4 percent from the field... The Upstate game also featured the Chanticleers best shooting performance of the season as the team combined to shoot 54.0 percent from the floor... The Chanticleers dropped its Big South Conference opener for the second consecutive year...In the loss to PC, Coastal shot a season-low 27.8 percent and had a scoring drought that lasted for the first 9:43 of the second half... The Chants will return to the court on Monday, Jan. 10 to host Charleston Southern at Kimbel Arena. The game, which is the first of three in a row at home, is set to tip at 7 p.m.

GARDNER-WEBB

The Runnin' Bulldogs had four tough home games over the last two weeks, hosting Purdue, Tennessee Temple, #10 North Carolina and Charleston Southern. The Runnin' Bulldogs went 2-2 over the four home games, dropping games to Purdue of the Big Ten and No. 10 North Carolina of the ACC. Gardner-Webb battled the Purdue Boilermakers for the full 40 minutes of play, as the Runnin' Bulldogs had a 58-56 lead with 34 seconds to go in the contest. However, Purdue hit a well-contested threepointer with 16.1 seconds to play to escape with the 59-58 win over GWU. Gardner-Webb bounced back with a record setting 88-40 win over Tennessee Temple in which GWU shot over 57 percent and dished out 23 assists as a team in the win. The Runnin Bulldogs battled No. 10 North Carolina in front of 2750 fans in Paul Porter Arena on New Year's Eve, yet without Vaitkute, GWU struggled with the size and athleticism of the Lady Tar Heels in the 83-62 loss. Gardner-Webb's Big South Regular season Title defense began on January 3, as the Runnin' Bulldogs had four different players score in double figures to defeat the Charleston Southern Buccaneers 67-51 to start the conference season off at 1-0. The Runnin' Bulldogs will now hit the road for its next four games, all of which are conference contests. GWU will take on Radford, who handed GWU its only conference loss last season, on Saturday, January 8th at 3 p.m. in Radford, Va. Then the Runnin' Bulldogs will take on the Lady Eagles of Winthrop on Monday night, January 10th, at 7 p.m. in Rock Hill, S.C.

HIGH POINT

High Point opened the Big South season with a 68-60 loss to defending conference champion Liberty at home on Monday. Senior JURICA HARGRAVES led the team with 13 points on the night. The Panthers fell behind early in the contest but managed to pull to within five at the half, scoring the final four points of the period on two free throws by senior AMY DODD and a jumper by senior MACKENZIE MAIER. HPU was unable to pull any closer in the second half, ultimatly losing by a score of 68-60. The Panthers struggled from behind the arc, connecting on just 6-of-28 three pointers. Dodd and junior SHAMIA BROWN joined Hargraves in double figures with 11 and 10 respectivly.

After losing its first six games away from the Vines Center this season, the Lady Flames have won three of their last four road/neutral tilts ... Liberty is 3-3 on its current nine-game road swing ... The Lady Flames are 1-0 to start Big South play for the 10th time in the last 11 seasons ... With his next victory, head coach CAREAN will have accounted for exactly half of Liberty's all-time victories. He has 270 of the Lady Flames' 541 wins currently ... Redshirt junior AVERY WARLEY, who has 30 rebounds in her last two games, already ranks No. 6 in program history with 648 career boards.

Presbyterian College opened conference play with a 52-36 rout of Coastal Carolina to improve the Blue Hose winning streak to two games after PC downed Campbell in the final game of 2010. During the last week, PC also fell against South Carolina in Columbia, 68-40. In the Big South opener, KRISTEN STEVENS splashed in four three-pointers as PC went on a 15-1 run through the middle portions of the second half.

RADFORD

Radford began the New Year winning its Big South opener at UNC Asheville. The Highlanders snapped a five-game slide an improved to 19-6 in league openers (6-1 on the road) with the victory. Under head coach TAJAMA ABRAHAM NGONGBA, RU has won all three conference openers. In the win over the Bulldogs, senior KAYLYN CROSIER dropped in a career-high 20 points. As a team, the Highlanders recorded season-highs in shooting percentage (53 percent), assists (21) and field goals (34) and a season-low in turnovers (12). With the season-low in turnovers, Radford snapped an eight game streak with 20-plus miscues and posted its first positive assist/turnover ratio (21/12) this season.

UNC ASHEVILLE

The game with the Highlanders was the first league game of the season for both teams, with RU improving to 4-10 overall with a 1-0 mark in the Big South. Asheville is now 7-5 on the season overall, 0-1 in conference, 4-3 at home and 3-2 on the road. The Bulldogs will host two more conference games this week in the Justice Center as they welcome High Point on Saturday in a contest scheduled for 2 p.m. followed by Liberty on Monday in a game set to start at 7 p.m. Currently Asheville leads the Big South in scoring offense (72.5 ppg), free throw percentage (.725) and field goal (.421) percentage. Three Bulldogs are currently in the top five in scoring in the Big South with KENDALL SHEPARD (15.7 ppg) and LINDSEY THOMPSON (14.8 ppg) sitting in first and second place, respectively, and KELLI RILES (13.5 ppg) in fifth. Currently Riles is ranked fifth nationally and leads the league in field goal percentage with a mark of .625.Riles also leads the Big South and is ninth in the nation in rebounding averaging 11.4 per contest. Thompson currently leads the league and is 11th in the nation in free throw percentage with mark of .919.

The Lady Eagles are riding a four-game win streak and after a 2-6 start have evened their record at 6-6 before starting the Big South Conference slate next weekend. Winthrop started the streak in Florida as it won two games to for a Co-Championship of the Hatter Classic and came home to capture the next two games. Winthrop had struggled at home all season at 1-4, but captured wins over Southern Wesleyan and Colorado State this past week to start to erase the memories of the slow start. During the win streak, Winthrop is outscoring its opponents 63.8-49.8 and shooting 42 percent from the floor. Senior LACEY LYONS reached the 800 career point mark over the break as she scored 24 points in the win over Southern Wesleyan.
