MAKE'N IT RAIN

Charleston Southern's KATIE TULL has been locked in from downtown throughout her career in the Big South Conference. She currently ranks No. 3 all-time in the Big South with 233 career three-pointers. She needs only 31 more treys to take over the No. 1 spot in the Conference as former Winthrop guard TIFFANY RODD is ranked No. 1 with 263. She set the single season record with 100 three-pointers last season and this season she poured in nine three against Voorhees on Nov. 16. The nine triples set the CSU single game mark and was one off the Big South single game standard.

COUNTER BLOCKWISE

MACKENZIE MAIER is currently ranked No. 3 all-time in the Big South record book with 234 career rejections. She needs 60 blocks to take hold of the No. 1 position held by former Radford center KELLI DARDEN. The senior has finished ranked in the Top-10 in the Big South single-season blocks list in each of the past two seasons and holds the No. 2 position with 91 blocks during the 2009-10 campaign. Also making her way up the list is KATIE WHITE from Coastal Carolina. She currently has 157 blocked shots in her career and is ranked No. 8 all-time.

GIVE & TAKE

Winthrop's DEQUESHA McCLANAHAN set this season's standard in assists as she dished out nine helpers against North Carolina A&T on Nov. 14. In her next game against Virginia Commonwealth on Nov. 17, she set the season's standard in steals as she posted eight take-aways against the Rams.

RILED UP

UNC Asheville's **KELLI RILES** has established herself as the League's top rebounder this season. She is ranked No. 1 in the League with 11.6 boards per contest and has went for double-digits in four of her five games this season. She has posted a Big South season-high 14 rebounds twice this season and posted three-straight games with at least 10 boards during the span of Nov. 12-20. She is also averaging a double-double with an average of 11.0 points per game this season.

LINDSEY THOMPSON of UNC Asheville has been the points pacesetter five weeks into the season. In the five games she has played in, she has went for more than 20 points three times and as been in double-digits in scoring in all of her games. She currently tops the Big South with 19.4 points per contest.

Charleston Southern competed in the World Vision Classic this past week in Lubbock, Texas hosted by Texas Tech University. The Bucs returned to Charleston without a win after those three contests. However, there were several bright spots for the Buccaneers. CSU had three players log double-doubles in a single game in a loss to Sam Houston State; LYDIA JOHNSON and LAKEITHA ALSTON both had double-doubles, as well as guard HELEN TERRY who brought down a career high 10 rebounds. Buccaneer senior guard KELSEY WASMER was named to the World Vision Classic All-Tournament team for her consistent performance this weekend.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina won both games this week at home with a come from behind victory against Campbell (58-52) and a domi-Coastal Carolina won both games this week at home with a come from behind victory against Campbell (88-52) and a dominating performance over Coker (78-25)... The Chants set a season-high field goal percentage shooting 47.6 percent from the floor against Coker as Coastal set a new season-high in points with 78... Senior center KATIE WHITE established a new career high with eight blocks against Campbell... For the first time this season, three Chants scored in double figures in the win over Campbell as SYDNEI MOSS (17), OLIVIA IRICK (12), and KATIE WHITE (10) accounted for 39 of Coastal's 58 points in the game...Thirteen players contributed points in the victory over Coker as Olivia Irick led all scorers with 11 points in the game...The Chanticleers will travel to Evansville, Ind. to take part in the Heritage Federal Credit Union Aces Classic presented by Dunn Hospitality hosted by the University of Evansville. Coastal will play Mid-American Conference member Central Michigan on Friday, Dec. 3 to open the Classic.

GARDNER-WEBB

GARDNER-WEBB

The Runnin' Bulldogs had a week for of highs and lows, as Gardner-Webb went 1-3 overall, with all four games coming on the road. After starting the season off 2-0 with two decisive victories, the Runnin' Bulldogs hit a road block, dropping three straight games. The three-game losing streak was the first three-game losing streak for GWU since 2007-08. Gardner-Webb's lows started last Monday night, as the Runnin' Bulldogs suffered its first loss of the year, a 30 point defeat to the Appalachian State Mountaineers in Boone, N.C. The Runnin' Bulldogs then looked to put the bad loss behind them with its three games at the Basketball Travelers Invitational Tournament hosted by the University of Oklahoma in Norman, Okla. GWU looked to have gotten back on the right track in the first game on Friday night, rolling out to a 32-16 halftime lead over Prairie View in the first game of the BTI Classic. However, GWU allowed 49 points in the second half to the Lady Panthers and suffered a 58-65 win to drop its second consecutive game. However, things looked up for Gardner-Webb on Saturday, as the Runnin' Bulldogs put together a solid team effort to push the No. 10 nationally ranked Oklahoma Sooners to the end before falling 75-84. The strong performance against the Sooners appeared to have turned a light bulb on for the Runnin' Bulldogs who wrapped up the BTI Classic with an 82-54 route of Texas-Pan American on Sunday afternoon, in which GWU led by 20 points or more for over 20 minutes in the contest. Senior guard DOMINIOUE HUDSON was named to the BTI All-Tournament Team, as her week was highlighted by a 25 point performance versus No. 10 Oklahoma. Four other Runnin' Bulldogs posted career-high scoring contests for the week, as well, as GWU will look to carrie over the momentum from Sunday's win to this week. Gardner-Webb remains on the road for its next two bouts, taking on Kennesaw State in Kennesaw, Ga. on Thursday night at 7 p.m. and then wrapping up its six-game road trip at Longwood on Sunday afternoon at 2

HIGH POINT
High Point struggled at the University of Texas-El Paso Thanksgiving Classic, dropping games to both Arkansas and Idaho State.
The Panthers led the Razorbacks for much of the first half but a 24-6 run by Arkansas to start the second half made the score 64-40 with 11 minutes to play. Senior JURICA HARGRAVES and sophomore ERIN REYNOLDS each had 13 points to lead High Point. The following day, the Panthers faced off with Idaho State, losing 63-55. The game was back and forth with nine ties and 14 lead changes. senior MACKENZIE MAIER had 11 points and 10 rebounds for her second double-double of the season.

Liberty's 81-42 loss at No. 2/3 Baylor on Nov. 26 wrapped up the first back-to-back matchups against Top 10 teams in program history, as well as the Lady Flames' first two games ever played in Texas... The Lady Flames will return home to play Glenville State on Tuesday ... Both of Liberty's wins this year have come at the Vines Center, and the team is still in search of its first victory away from Lynchburg in 2010-11 ... After Tuesday's contest, the Lady Flames will play their next nine games on the road ... It will be Liberty's longest road trip since a 10-game road swing in 1991-92 ... With 579 career rebounds, AVERY WARLEY ranks No. 11 in program history ... She needs only four more boards to join Liberty's career top 10 list, even though she is only six games into her junior season ... Liberty remains ranked No. 21 in the CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25 for the second straight week straight week.

PRESBYTERIAN

Presbyterian College snapped the nation's longest road losing streak last week with a 51-38 win over South Carolina State in Orangeburg. The landmark victory was the first road victory for third-year head coach RONNY FISHER. It was the first time PC held an opponent in the 30-39 point range since 1995 and moved the Blue Hose to 2-2 on the year. A post-Thanksgiving loss to Furman soured a chance for PC to win consecutive road games for the first time in the D-I era. This week, PC hosts USC Upstate before facing ACC rival Clemson on Sunday afternoon.

RADFORD

With their win at George Mason, the Highlanders earned their first non-conference road win in 20 tries since defeating Presbyterian, 67-54 on Dec. 8, 2008, snapping a 19-game losing streak in the process. It also ended a 24-game regular season skid against Division I non-conference opponents which also dated back to the Presbyterian victory. BROOKE MCELROY recorded her collegiate double-double with 12 points and 10 rebounds at George Mason on Nov. 26. Radford won its 200th game against a state of Virginia school when it defeated George Mason, 63-56, on Nov. 26. It was the 12th win over the Patriots which is the third highest win total against Commonwealth schools. The Highlanders have defeated Liberty 23 times for the top spot in this category and VCU on 16 occasions, while earning 11 triumphs over Bridgewater and Emory and Henry. The Highlanders first ever victory over a Virginia school was in their very first collegiate basketball game, a 58-26 victory over Stratford. Radford has picked up right where it left off last season on the defensive side of the ball. Its swarming defense has forced 20-plus turnovers and won the turnover battle in its four of its first five games of the season. Ferrum coughed it up 25 times, Hampton 22, while Howard and Pittsburgh recorded 20 apiece. Last season, Radford forced 20-plus miscues 16 times and on 15 different occasions in 2008-09. Radford was successful in its first season opener at home since 1999-00 and just the 11th in 40 seasons with a 55-38 victory over Ferrum on Nov. 15. Prior to Monday, the Highlanders lost to Mount St. Marys, 83-67 in their last season opener at home on Nov. 20, 1999. With the victory, the Highlanders won their 30th home opener in 40 seasons. They are now 30-10 overall and 2-1 under third-year head coach TAJAMA NGONGBA. With their win at George Mason, the Highlanders earned their first non-conference road win in 20 tries since defeating

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville went 1-1 on the week with a 95-76 victory over USC Upstate last Tuesday before dropping a 71-61 decision to Brevard College on Monday evening. The Bulldogs are now 3-2 on the season overall with a 2-2 mark at home and a 1-0 record on the road. Before last night, Asheville had won its last two contests. The Bulldogs were looking to go 4-1 for the first time on the road. Before last night, Asheville had won its last two contests. The Bulldogs were looking to go 4-1 for the first time since the 2003-04 season before last night's setback. Asheville still leads the Big South Conference in scoring offense, averaging 74.2 points per contest. The Bulldogs also lead the league in field goal percentage with a mark of .420 while also leading the league in assists per contest averaging 15.2 per game. Asheville currently have the second best record in the conference at 3-2. Junior guard LINDSEY THOMPSON and senior guard KENDALL SHEPARD are currently first and second, respectively, in the Big South in scoring with Thompson averaging 19.4 points per contest and Shepard averaging 18.8. Asheville's KELLI RILES leads the league in rebounding averaging 11.6 per contest. Shepard also leads the league in minutes played with a 36.8 minute per game average.
