PRIMETIME PLAYERS

The Big South has featured some really big games from players across the League. **LINDSEY THOMPSON** of UNC Asheville put in a Big South season-high 29 points vs. Appalachian State on Dec. 2. **KATIE TULL** of Charleston Southern matched that effort as she recorded 29 points against Pfeiffer on Dec. 11 ... Both Thompson and Tull have went for 20-or-more points four times ... **LINDSEY MONTGOMERY** and **KELLI RILES** of UNC Asheville had big games against Furman on Dec. 11. Montgomery finished the contest with 25 points and 10 rebounds, while Riles notched 21 points and 15 boards ... **MACKENZIE MAIER** posted an unconventional double-double as she put in 22 points and posted 10 rejections against Campbell on Dec. 1 ... Winthrop's **DEQUESHA McCLANAHAN** recorded the top freshman scoring performance as she piled up 26 points against VCU on Nov. 17.

CRANK'N BACK UP

After a relatively quiet week in the Big South, the member institutions are finishing up fall finals are getting back to the hardwood.

BENJAMIN

Gardner-Webb Head Coach **RICK REEVES** passed a milestone over the weekend as his Runnin' Bulldogs went 2-0. The two wins gave Reeves his 100th win at Gardner-Webb.

MAKE'N IT RAIN

Charleston Southern's **KATIE TULL** has been locked in from downtown throughout her career in the Big South Conference. She currently ranks No. 2 all-time in the Big South with 242 career three-pointers. She needs only 22 more treys to take over the No. 1 spot in the Conference as former Winthrop guard **TIFFANY RODD** is ranked No. 1 with 263. She set the single season record with 100 three-pointers last season and this season she poured in nine treys against Voorhees on Nov. 16. The nine triples set the CSU single game mark and was one off the Big South single game standard.

COUNTER BLOCKWISE

MACKENZIE MAIER is currently ranked tied for No. 2 all-time in the Big South record book with 257 career rejections. She needs 37 blocks to take hold of the No. 1 position held by former Radford center **KELLI DARDEN**. The senior has finished ranked in the Top-10 in the Big South single-season blocks list in each of the past two seasons and holds the No. 2 position with 91 blocks during the 2009-10 campaign. Her 10 blocks vs. Campbell on Dec. 2 tied the Big South single-game record ... Also making her way up the list is **KATIE WHITE** from Coastal Carolina. She currently has 166 blocked shots in her career and is ranked No. 8 all-time.

GIVE & TAKE

Winthrop's **DEQUESHA McCLANAHAN** set this season's standard in assists as she dished out nine helpers against North Carolina A&T on Nov. 14. In her next game against Virginia Commonwealth on Nov. 17, she set the season's standard in steals as she posted eight take-aways against the Rams.

RILED UP

UNC Asheville's **KELLI RILES** has established herself as the League's top rebounder this season. She is ranked No. 1 in the League with 11.3 boards per contest and has went for double-digits in five of her seven games this season. She has posted a Big South season-high 14 rebounds twice this season and posted three-straight games with at least 10 boards during the span of Nov. 12-20. She is the only player in the Big South averaging a double-double as she averages 11.7 points per contest.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern remains undefeated at home with a 74-59 win over scrappy NCAA D-II Conference Carolina member Pfeiffer. Leading the Buccaneers in the win were seniors **KATIE TULL** and **KELSEY WASMER**. Tull continues her hot shooting inside the friendly confines of Buccaneer field house, shooting over 56% in the Bucs' first four games at home from deep. She led all scorers with a career high 29 points. Wasmer contributed her third double double of the season by tying a career high in rebounds with 12 and scoring 18 points for Charleston Southern.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina easily dispatched Converse 86-33 in its only contest of the week... The Chants were led by **OLIVIA IRICK**'s and **LAUREN GROCHOWSKI**'s 12 points each in the non-conference match up... Junior college transfer **KIRA CARTER** scored in double digits for the second time in a Coastal uniform as she matched her previous season best of 11 in the game... This week the Chants face two tough mid-major opponents in UNC Wilmington (5-2) and Butler (5-4)... Coastal will host UNCW on Wednesday and face Butler on Sunday as part of the Carolinas Challenge at the Myrtle Beach Convention Center.

GARDNER-WEBB

The Runnin' Bulldogs are riding a current four-game winning streak, its longest of the season, and are coming off a 62-54 home win over N.C. Central on December 7th. In the win, GWU held N.C. Central to only 16 points on 8-of-22 shooting, 36.4 percent, in the first half, and forced the Lady Eagles into 31 turnovers for the game. GWU's **MONIQUE HUDSON** led the way with 14 points and five steals, while senior center **SANDRA VAITKUTE** had 13 points and five rebounds in the win. Another career mark was surpassed in the win, as senior forward **LATROYA POPE** grabbed her 500th career rebound in the early minutes of the contest to become only the fifth-player in GWU women's basketball Division I history to reach 500 career rebounds. Gardner-Webb, who is 2-0 at home this season, will remain at home for its next four contests. GWU will finish up its exams this week before taking on Converse College at 7 p.m. on December 16th. Then the Runnin' Bulldogs will host Purdue on December 22nd at 7 p.m., before taking some time off for the Christmas holiday.

HIGH POINT

High Point finished its seven-game road trip with a 79-60 win over UNC Greensboro and then returned home to the Millis Center and defeated Bluefield College by a score of 102-45 to finish 2-0 on the week. All five starters scored in double figures for HPU in the win over the Spartans, led by senior **MACKENZIE MAIER**'s 19 points. Senior **FRANCES FIELDS** had a career-high 18, senior **JURICA HARGRAVES** and junior **SHAMIA BROWN** each had 12 and senior **AMY DODD** finished with 11. Sophomore **ERIN REYNOLDS** came off the bench to dish out a career-high six assists. The Panthers continued their strong offensive showing against Bluefield College later in the week, setting a team Division I single-game record by shooting 58.2 percent from the field. Brown led the team with 21 points and Maier turned in a great overall performance with 19 points, seven rebounds, six assists and four blocks. The 102 points was the second-highest single game total in DI for HPU and the team tied its own Division I record with 27 assists.

LIBERTY

Liberty's game at North Carolina Central on Dec. 18 will be its first contest in 13 days ... The Lady Flames also had a 13-day gap between games last December, from the 15th to the 28th ... Liberty is looking for its first win away from the Vines Center this season ... The team is 3-0 at home but 0-5 in road/neutral contests ... Liberty has won 28 consecutive games against the teams currently comprising the MEAC, but this will be the Lady Flames' first contest against North Carolina Central as a MEAC member ... Liberty is in the midst of a string of nine straight games away from home, and the Lady Flames' next home game is not until Jan. 17, versus Radford.

PRESBYTERIAN

Presbyterian College reaches the fall exam period at 2-5 dropping a pair of games last week by narrow margins. PC lost to I-26 rival USC Upstate on Thursday night at the Templeton Center in Clinton 78-73 in OT. PC led for large stretches of the game but fell short in the end. Against Clemson, PC hung with an ACC opponent for the second consecutive game trailing by just two at the break. A 23-3 run for the Tigers to start the second half put the Blue Hose down, but the visitors were not out. A late rally cut the Tiger lead to just 12 points at the final horn. This week, PC breaks for exams before playing two road games just prior to Christmas. The Blue Hose visit NC State on 12/16 and head to Ohio University on 12/19.

RADFORD

Radford posted several team and individual marks against Southern Virginia on Thursday. The Highlanders recorded season highs in points (71), field goals (27), shooting percentage (.519), assists (18), forced turnovers (35) and steals (25). The 25 steals recorded against Southern Virginia was the highest mark under third-year head coach **TAJAMA NGONGBA**. **CIARA HAYES**, **KAYLYN CROSIER** and **DANARIA ERWIN SPENCER** posted career highs against Southern Virginia. Hayes posted career marks in points (12), field goals (6) and rebounds (8). Crosier (5) and Erwin Spencer (7) racked up career marks in steals on a night when Radford registered 25 thefts. Hayes was a perfect 6-for-6 from the field against Southern Virginia on Dec. 9. It was one shy of the school mark. It also was the first game of perfection with five-plus field goals since Jan. 22, 2005 when Alisha Jones went 5-for-5 against Birmingham-Southern. Against UNC Greensboro, **BROOKE MCELROY** recorded a game-high 15 rebounds. It was the most boards by a Highlanders since Kelli Darden pulled down 15 vs. High Point on 1/26/08.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville went 1-0 on the week with a victory over Southern Conference foe Furman on Saturday afternoon. The Bulldogs had four players score in double-digits with Lindsey Montgomery scoring 25 in her first game back from suspension. Montgomery and **KELLI RILES** each recorded double-doubles in the contest. Asheville is now 4-3 overall, 3-2 at home and 1-1 on the road. The Bulldogs will host South Carolina State on Wednesday evening at the Justice Center before travelling to Marquette on Saturday to take on the Golden Eagles. The Blue & White currently lead the Big South Conference in scoring offense, averaging 75.4 points per contest. The Bulldogs also lead in field goal percentage (.422) and are second in defensive rebounds (27.6 rpg) and 3-point field goals made (6.4 per game). Junior guard **LINDSEY THOMPSON** leads the league in scoring, averaging 19.0 points per game with teammate **KENDALL SHEPARD** a close second averaging 17.6 points per contest. Thompson also leads the league in free throw percentage (.935). Riles leads the league in rebounding with an 11.3 rebound per game average while Shepard is first in assist/turnover ration (1.6). Shepard also leads the conference in minutes played (37.0 mpg).

WINTHROP

Winthrop suffered one of its biggest defeats in school history with a 53-15 loss to Southern Poly State on Sunday. Winthrop scored the fewest points in a single game by and Winthrop team and the six points in the second half is also a school record low. Winthrop's previous record was set Feb. 15, 2010 when it posted 18 points in a home loss to Liberty. Freshman **DEQUESHA MCCLANAHAN** did pick up four steals in the loss to Southern Poly State and now has 25 on the year for an average of 3.1 per game.
