Avery Warley • R-Jr. C • Liberty Washington, D.C.

Warley averaged 15.5 points and shot 65 percent from the field to lead her squad to a 1-1 record last week. The center got her week started with 17 points on 75 percent from the floor and added 10 boards, two blocks, two steals and an assist to lead the Ladv Flames to a win over Glenville State on Nov. 30. Five days later at James Madison, she put in 14 points as she connected on 56 percent from the floor. She was a perfect 4-of-4 from the line in a Liberty 9-0 run to cut the Dukes' lead to just two within the final four minutes in a narrow loss. She pulled down seven boards against JMU and recorded one steal. She led her squad in scoring in both contests as her double-double against Glenville State marked her second of the year.

THE CRONS BRAND FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

Dequesha McClanahan G • Winthrop Oak Ridge, Tenn.

McClanahan averaged 16 points and posted a 41 percent clip from the floor to help the Lady Eagles to a 1-1 record last week. Against N.C. Central on Dec. 2, she connected on a jumper that knotted the score at 57 with 1:23 left in the contest. With four seconds left, McClanahan tallied the game-winner to give Winthrop the 62-60 win. She finished the contest with 14 points, five boards, six steals and two assists. She followed that effort with 18 points on 50 percent from the floor, two from downtown and 4-of-5 from the line against the Virginia Tech on Dec. 5. She also chipped in three rebounds and two steals against the

Gardner-Webb Head Coach Rick Reeves passed a milestone over the weekend as his Runnin' Bulldogs went 2-0. The two wins gave Reeves his 100th win at Gardner-Webb.

MAKE'N IT RAIN

Charleston Southern's KATIE TULL has been locked in from downtown throughout her career in the Big South Conference. She currently ranks No. 3 all-time in the Big South with 235 career three-pointers. She needs only 29 more treys to take over the No. 1 spot in the Conference as former Winthrop guard TIFFANY RODD is ranked No. 1 with 263. She set the single season record with 100 three-pointers last season and this season she poured in nine treys against Voorhees on Nov. 16. The nine triples set the CSU single game mark and was one off the Big South single game standard.

COUNTER BLOCKWISE

MACKENZIE MAIER is currently ranked No. 3 all-time in the Big South record book with 249 career rejections. She needs 45 blocks to take hold of the No. 1 position held by former Radford center KELLI DARDEN. The senior has finished ranked in the Top-10 in the Big South single-season blocks list in each of the past two seasons and holds the No. 2 position with 91 blocks during the 2009-10 campaign. Her 10 blocks vs. Campbell on Dec. 2 tied the Big South single-game record ... Also making her way up the list is KATIE WHITE from Coastal Carolina. She currently has 165 blocked shots in her career and is ranked No. 8 all-time.

GIVE & TAKE

Winthrop's **DEQUESHA McCLANAHAN** set this season's standard in assists as she dished out nine helpers against North Carolina A&T on Nov. 14. In her next game against Virginia Commonwealth on Nov. 17, she set the season's standard in steals as she posted eight take-aways against the Rams.

RILED UP

UNC Asheville's **KELLI RILES** has established herself as the League's top rebounder this season. She is ranked No. 1 in the League with 10.7 boards per contest and has went for double-digits in four of her six games this season. She has posted a Big South season-high 14 rebounds twice this season and posted three-straight games with at least 10 boards during the span of Nov. 12-20. She is also averaging a double-double with an average of 10.2 points per game this season.

20's & 10's

LINDSEY THOMPSON of UNC Asheville has been the points pacesetter five weeks into the season. In the six games she has played in, she has went for more than 20 points four times and as been in double-digits in scoring in all of her games. She set the 2010-11 standard with 29 points vs. Appalachian State on Dec. 2. She currently tops the Big South with 21.0 points per contest.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern's come back against Furman fell just short after being down by thirteen points earlier in the contest. The Bucs also had a nice showing against SEC opponent South Carolina, in which they cut the Gamecocks lead to as low as seven points in the second half. Leading the Bucs in scoring over that span was sophomore forward LAKEITHA ALSTON who averaged 15 points a game for those two contests. Senior guard KATIE TULL continues to climb the CSU all-time scoring list, and her 24 points against Furman cracked the top-ten with 1,091 career points. CSU continues their non-conference slate against Conference Carolinas opponent Pfeiffer on Saturday.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina was defeated in both games this week at the Aces Winter Classic hosted by the University of Evansville... Central Michigan shot 50 percent from the field as the Mid-American Conference school defeated the Chants by a 96-42 final on Dec. 4... Coastal rallied to tie Valparaiso in a back in forth battle before ultimately losing in 59-52 in overtime... During the contest against Valpo, Coastal held the Crusaders score less during the first 9:53 of the second half which was a season-high... Freshman KAYLA COOK had the best performances of her career on her way to being named to the Aces Winter Classic All-Tournament team. Cook scored 21 points on the weekend including a new career-high of 11 against Central Michigan... KATIE WHITE's eight block on the weekend moves her season total to 23 which ranks 12th nationally at 2.9 per game... Nationally, the Chants rank 39th in field-goal defense allowing opponents to only connect on 34.7 percent of their shots... Coastal will take the week off for finals and return the hardwood on Dec. 12 to take on Converse at Kimbel Arena.

GARDNER-WEBB

The Gardner-Webb Runnin' Bulldogs ended its six-game road trip with three straight wins and moved to 5-3 on the season. Last week, GWU went 2-0 picking up two non-conference road wins and giving head coach RICK REEVES his 100th career win at GWU in the process. Gardner-Webb used its team defense in its 59-48 win at Kennesaw State on December 2nd, as the Runnin' Bulldogs held the Lady Owls to only six made field goals in the entire second half of play in the win. Gardner-Webb then wrapped up its six-game road trip with a 68-58 win at Longwood, in which MONIQUE HUDSON had 19 points, while three other Runnin' Bulldogs had 12 points apiece. Senior forward LATROYA POPE has been a beast on the boards in pursuit of career rebound 500, as she posted a double-double of 15 points and 11 rebounds in the win at KSU and hauled in 11 rebounds once more in the win at Longwood. Pope is only one rebound shy of number 500 and is set to accomplish that feat come Tuesday night when the Runnin' Bulldogs open up a six-game home stand against the Lady Eagles of North Carolina Central at 6 p.m.

HIGH POINT

High Point went 1-1 on the week, beating Campbell by a score of 74-51 before falling at No. 10 West Virginia by a score of 89-57. MACKENZIE MAIER led the Panthers in their win over Campbell with 22 points, 10 blocks and nine rebounds. The 10 blocks for Maier is a new HPU Division i single-game record, breaking the previous mark of seven which Maier had also held. The double-double of points and blocks was a first for HPU. Against WVU, sophomore ERIN REYNOLDS came off the bench to score a career-high 20 points. Reynolds shot 8-12 from the field and 2-2 from behind the arc, finishing as the only HPU player in double figures against the No. 10 team in the country.

LIBERTY

Liberty's 93-75 home win over Glenville State on Nov. 30 marked the 12th time in Carey Green's 12 seasons as head coach that the Lady Flames have scored 90 or more points ... Sunday's game at James Madison started a string of nine straight road/neutral contests for the Lady Flames ... That's Liberty's longest stretch of games away from home since a 10-game road trip in 1991-92 ... Big South Preseason Player of the Year DEVON BROWN returned from injury to score 14 points in 17 minutes at James Madison on Sunday, after missing the season's first seven games ... Redshirt junior AVERY WARLEY has moved up to No. 8 on Liberty's career rebounding list with 596 boards ... Liberty will not play again until Nov. 18, when the Lady Flames travel to North Carolina Central for the first time in program history.

PRESBYTERIAN

Presbyterian College reaches the fall exam period at 2-5 dropping a pair of games last week by narrow margins. PC lost to I-26 rival USC Upstate on Thursday night at the Templeton Center in Clinton 78-73 in OT. PC led for large stretches of the game but fell short in the end. Against Clemson, PC hung with an ACC opponent for the second consecutive game trailing by just two at the break. A 23-3 run for the Tigers to start the second half put the Blue Hose down, but the visitors were not out. A late rally cut the Tiger lead to just 12 points at the final horn. This week, PC breaks for exams before playing two road games just prior to Christmas. The Blue Hose visit NC State on 12/16 and head to Ohio University on 12/19.

RADFORD

Radford returns to the Dedmon Center for a rare non-conference home game when it hosts Southern Virginia on Thursday. The Highlanders open the season with eight of their first 11 games on the road before closing out December and the non-conference schedule with a pair of home contests. **DA'NARIA ERWIN SPENCER** is averaging 17 points over the last four games which included a season-high 21-point performance at Davidson on Dec. 4. She has led Radford in scoring four times and has posted double figures in five of six games. Erwin Spencer hit a career-high eight field goals and three three pointers at Davidson.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville went 0-1 on the week, falling to Southern Conference foe Appalachian State last Thursday evening, 99-71. Junior guard LINDSEY THOMPSON scored a career-high 29 points against the Mountaineers as she continues to lead the Big South Conference in scoring with a 21.0 points per game average. Fellow guard KENDALL SHEPARD is second in the conference in scoring, averaging 18.3 points per contest. With the loss the Bulldogs now sit a .500 for the season with an overall mark of 3-3. Asheville is now also 2-2 at home and 1-1 on the road. The Bulldogs currently lead the league in scoring offense posting 73.7 points per contest, and field goal percentage with a mark of .418. Asheville also averages 14.3 assists per contest which leads the Big South. Forward KELLI RILES leads the league in rebounding averaging 10.7 per game. Riles is also third in the conference in field goal percentage with a mark of .529. The Bulldogs only have one contest this week. Asheville will host SoCon opponent Furman on Saturday as part of a doubleheader with the Bulldogs men's basketball team.

WINTHROP

Freshman TIFFANY CHARLES continues to be a lift off the bench for the Lady Eagles as she came in against Virginia Tech to score 10 points and pull down six rebounds. So far this season she's averaging 6.7 points, 4.3 rebounds and 2.3 steals coming off the bench in all seven games in an average of 20.9 minutes.
