Tull averaged 20.5 points per game and shot 46 percent from the floor to lead her squad to a 2-0 record last week. The guard got her week started with 14 points and four steals to go along with two boards and two assists as the Bucs downed Presbyterian College on Jan. 15. Two days later against UNC Asheville, Tull finished just two points shy of her career-high as she poured in 27 points against the Bulldogs. She was 60 percent from the floor and canned five treys to tie for the No. 1 spot all-time in the Big South with 263 career treys. She also dished out five helpers and was 4-of-5 from the line in the victory.

BIG SOUTH TV NETWORK SCHEDULE

BENJAMIN

Gardner-Webb Head Coach **RICK REEVES** passed a milestone on Dec. 5 and 7th as his Runnin' Bulldogs went 2-0. The two wins gave Reeves his 100th win at Gardner-Webb.

MAKE'N IT RAIN

Charleston Southern's **KATIE TULL** has been locked in from downtown throughout her career in the Big South Conference. She is currently tied for No. 1 all-time in the Big South with 263 career three-pointers with former Winthrop guard **TIFFANY RODD**. She set the single-season record with 100 three-pointers last season and this season she poured in nine treys against Voorhees on Nov. 16. The nine triples set the CSU single game mark and was one off the Big South single game standard ... She currently has 56 on the season ... Winthrop's **LACEY LYONS** has found her way into the League's career top 10 as well. She has 176 treys in her career to rank No. 7 on the all-time list.

COUNTER BLOCKWISE

MACKENZIE MAIER is currently ranked No. 2 all-time in the Big South record book with 262 career rejections. She needs 32 blocks to take hold of the No. 1 position held by former Radford center **KELLI DARDEN**. The senior has finished ranked in the Top-10 in the Big South single-season blocks list in each of the past two seasons and holds the No. 2 position with 91 blocks during the 2009-10 campaign. Her 10 blocks vs. Campbell on Dec. 2 tied the Big South single-game record ... Also making her way up the list is **KATIE WHITE** from Coastal Carolina. She currently has 177 blocked shots in her career and is ranked No. 8 all-time.

RILED UP

UNC Asheville's **KELLI RILES** has established herself as the League's top rebounder this season. She is ranked No. 1 in the League and No. 5 on the Big South single-season list with 11.1 boards per contest and has went for double-digits in 10 games this season. She has posted a Big South season-high 16 rebounds on Dec. 15 and posted three-straight games with at least 10 boards twice this season. She is the only player in the Big South averaging a double-double as she averages 12.8 points per contest.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern logged their third Big South victory in a row this season Monday with a win in Buccaneer Field House over the UNC Asheville Bulldogs. The Bucs have won five out of their last seven games. With five three-pointers against UNC Asheville The Buccaneers return to action this weekend with a road trip to Virginia to square off against a pair of conference foes. The trip opens with a matchup at Liberty on Saturday, Jan. 22 and concludes at Radford on Monday, Jan. 24.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina fell in both games this week losing 65-53 to UNC Asheville and 45-34 to Gardner-Webb... **SYDNEI MOSS** made her return to the Chanticleer lineup after sitting out the first two conference games with an injury... Moss recorded 10 points in each game as she led Coastal in scoring on the week... Defensively, Coastal held both UNC Asheville and Gardner-Webb below their season shooting average holding the opponents to 37.9 and 35.4 percent respectively... The Chanticleers will start a four game road trip this week playing at High Point on Sunday, Jan. 22 and at Liberty on Monday, Jan. 24.

GARDNER-WEBB

The Runnin' Bulldogs used its tough defense to go 2-0 on the week and improve to 4-1 in conference play and to 12-6 overall on the year. Gardner-Webb wrapped up a huge four-game conference road trip with back-to-back wins at High Point and Coastal Carolina. In the win over High Point on Saturday afternoon, GWU held High Point scoreless for over three minutes and outscored the Panthers 10-2 over the final 4:50 of the game to come away with the 62-54 road win. Gardner-Webb had nine players score in the win, highlighted by **DOMINIQUE HUDSON** who just missed a triple-double with 11 points, 9 rebounds and 8 assists. GWU held the Panthers to 33.3 percent shooting, including forcing High Point to go 4-of-16 from behind the three-point line on their home floor. Gardner-Webb again used a total team effort in a 45-34 win at Coastal Carolina on Monday night, as not only did nine Runnin' Bulldogs scored, but GWU held Coastal Carolina to only 19.3 percent shooting for the game. Gardner-Webb held Coastal Carolina to only 11 made field goals out of 57 attempts and outrebounded the Chanticleers 46-31 for the game. The Runnin' Bulldogs have won three-straight and improve to 4-1 in conference play for the second straight season. GWU returns home for its next three contests, as Coach Reeves' squad will host Presbyterian College on Monday night, January 24th, at 7 p.m. and UNC Asheville the following Saturday, January 29th, at 3 p.m. Gardner-Webb's three-game home stand will wrap up on Monday night, January 31st, at 7 p.m. versus Liberty. The Runnin' Bulldogs are 5-2 at home this season with the losses coming to Purdue of the Big Ten and to then No.10 North Carolina of the ACC.

HIGH POINT

Freshman **CHEENNE PARKER** had a career game against Gardner-Webb, leading High Point with career-highs in points, rebounds, steals and minutes played. In her second start of the season, Parker tied HPU's second-highest single-game total for rebounds in the DI era with 16 while also setting career highs in points (19), steals (5), and minutes played (37). Parker shot 6-15 from the floor and 7-11 from the free throw line. She also blocked two shots.

LIBERTY

Liberty's 62-53 home loss to Radford on Monday came in its first home game since Nov. 30 ... the Lady Flames had won 16 straight home games against the Highlanders, since Radford's win at the Vines Center on Feb. 3, 1996 ... the setback also snapped Liberty's overall win streak (5 games), home win streak (7 games), win streak against Radford (8 games) and January home win streak (42 games) ... Liberty had not dropped a home game during January since a 77-72 loss to Elon on Jan. 13, 2000 ... **DEVON BROWN** scored 21 of her 27 points during the second half at Longwood on Friday ... it was the most points in a single half by a Lady Flame since **MEGAN FRAZEE**'s 21-point second half at Xavier on Nov. 25, 2007 ... Brown also tallied six rebounds and five assists versus the Lancers, making her the first Liberty player since **ELENA KISSELEVA** on Feb. 20, 1997 to post at least 25 points, 5 rebounds and 5 assists in the same contest ... Kisseleva had 27 points, 17 rebounds and 7 assists against UNC Greensboro ... Liberty will now host Charleston Southern on Saturday and Coastal Carolina on Monday ... the Lady Flames have defeated CSU 27 straight times and the Chanticleers on 33 straight occasions.

PRESBYTERIAN

PC has won the last two over Winthrop, snapped a three game losing streak on Monday, and will look to gain its first win over Radford (0-6 all time). PC lost both games to GWU last season, the final being an away loss in OT (53-50). Kristen Stevens ranks third in the Big South for 3 pt fg pct. (.395). Karlee Taylor went 8-11 (fg) and 6-7 (3 pt fg) during the last two conference games.

RADFORD

Radford improved to 4-1 in league play for the second consecutive season after upending Liberty on Monday night in Lynchburg. The Highlanders victory at the Vines Center snapped a 16-game losing streak in the that building and an eight-game slide against the Lady Flames. The last time Radford won in Lynchburg was on Feb. 3, 1996 and the last victory over Liberty was on March 9, 2007 in the Big South semifinals. **DA'NARIA ERWIN SPENCER** has been the Radford's and the game's leading scorer in the last four contests. She has averaged 20 points and defensively has added 3.5 steals per contest.

UNC ASHEVILLE

The Bulldogs went 1-1 this week defeating Big South Conference foe Coastal Carolina 65-53 on Saturday before falling to Charleston Southern on Monday evening 85-74 on Monday evening. The Bulldogs had been winless in the Big South prior to their victory over the Chanticleers. The win for the Bulldogs snapped a three-game losing streak and was the first conference win of the season. It was also the first victory for the Bulldogs against the Chanticleers in Conway, S.C., since the 2006-07 season. The Bulldogs defeated Coastal 76-46 on Feb. 10, with **BRITTANY HENDLEY** scoring a game-high 20 points for the Blue & White. The win against Coastal Carolina was the eighth win of the season for UNC Asheville, matching the wins total from the 2009-10 season when the Bulldogs went 8-22 on the year. Last season the Bulldogs did not pick up their eighth victory until March 1. UNC Asheville's **KELLI RILES** has established herself as the Big South's top rebounder this season. The Bulldogs are now 8-8 overall, 1-4 in the Big South, 4-5 at home and 4-3 on the road. Asheville currently leads the Big South in scoring offense averaging 70.3 points per game and field goal percentage with a mark of .406. **KENDALL SHEPARD** (14.3 ppg) ranks third, **LINDSEY THOMPSON** (13.3 ppg) ranks sixth and Kelli Riles (12.4 ppg) ranks eighth in scoring in the Big South Conference, giving the Bulldogs three players in the top 10 in scoring.

WINTHROP

Lacey Lyons is trying to become a 1,000 point scorer in her career as she currently has 845 points with at least 14 games remaining. Over the those 14 games she will have to average 11.1 points per game to reach 1,000 points on the dot. Lyons is also trying to become just the 6th or 7th different player in conference history to reach the 200 mark for three-point field goals made in a career. She currently has 177. It's likely Jurica Hargraves of High Point will be the 6th as she has 199 in her career. Freshman Tiffany Charles continues to be a key asset to the Lady Eagles and the best player off the bench. In the win over Radford, she came off the bench to record two points, a rebound, two assists and three steals in 15 minutes. Against the Blue Hose she came off the bench to score 11 points, grab five rebounds, dish out two assists and pick up a steal. 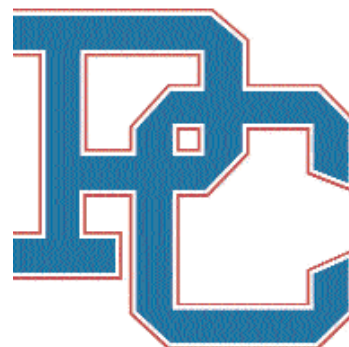
