CINCO DE FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK-O

Winthrop's **DEQUESHA MCCLANAHAN** became just the sixth player in the Big South Conference to earn at least five Big South Freshman of the Week accolades... High Point's **CHEYENNE PARKER** joined McClanahan on the list becoming the seventh player in the League's history to earn five plaudits... There are only two players in the League with six Freshman of Week plaudits, including **SHAMIA BROWN** of High Point who picked up her six nods in 2008-09.

MAKE'N THE GRADE

Coastal Carolina's **KATIE WHITE** and **MACKENZIE MAIER** from High Point each earned bids to the CoSIDA Academic All-District III teams. White was named to the first time while Maier was tabbed a second team selection. The honors also mark the seventh-straight year that the League has boasted at least one All-District honoree.

Coastal Carolina's **SYDNEI MOSS** and **MACKENZIE MAIER** are the only active players in the Big South with more than 1,000 points and 500 boards... The milestone marks the first time since the 2008-09 season that the League has had two active players with 1,000 points and 500 boards.

BIG SOUTH TV NETWORK SCHEDULE

Five regular-season Big South games as well as the Semifinals and Finals of the Advance Auto Parts Women's Basketball Championship will be broadcast via the Big South Television Network (BSTN). The BSTN will utilize eight local, regional and national affiliates to carry some or all of the games this season, including seven nationally on Fox College Sports (FCS). Gardner-Webb Head Coach **RICK REEVES** passed a milestone on Dec. 5 and 7th as his Runnin' Bulldogs went 2-0. The two wins gave Reeves his 100th win at Gardner-Webb.

2 AIN'T ENOUGH JACK, YOU BETTER MAKE IT 3

Charleston Southern's **KATIE TULL** took over the No. 1 spot all-time in career three-pointers on Jan. 24. She set the single-season record with 100 three-pointers last season and this season she poured in nine treys against Voorhees on Nov. 16. The nine triples set the CSU single game mark and was one off the Big South single game standard... She currently has 72 on the season... There are currently three other players in the Big South making their way up in the career three-pointers list. Here is a look at how they stack up:

COUNTER BLOCKWISE

MACKENZIE MAIER is currently ranked No. 2 all-time in the Big South record book with 266 career rejections. She needs 27 blocks to take hold of the No. 1 position held by former Radford center **KELLI DARDEN**. The senior has finished ranked in the Top-10 in the Big South single-season blocks list in each of the past two seasons and holds the No. 2 position with 91 blocks during the 2009-10 campaign. Her 10 blocks vs. Campbell on Dec. 2 tied the Big South single-game record... Also making her way up the list is **KATIE WHITE** from Coastal Carolina. She currently has 194 blocked shots in her career and is ranked No. 6 all-time... White has also become Coastal Carolina's career blocked shots leader.

RILED UP

UNC Asheville's **KELLI RILES** has established herself as the League's top rebounder this season. She is ranked No. 1 in the League and No. 9 on the Big South single-season list with 10.9 boards per contest and has went for double-digits in 11 games this season. The forward was rebound off the Big South single game record as she pulled down 22 rebounds in the Bulldogs' road win against Radford on Feb. 5. The 22 caroms set the UNC Asheville single-game standard. She is the only player in the Big South averaging a double-double as she averages 14.7 points per contest.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern lost their first game at home to Gardner-Webb this past Saturday at a score of 71-64. This breaks an eight game winning streak at home for the Buccaneers. Senior guards **KATIE TULL** and **KELSEY WASMER** continue to lead the way for Charleston Southern in scoring. Tull continues to lead the Big South Conference in scoring averaging 15.5 ppg and Wasmer is not far behind her with a 14.5 ppg average that ranks her third in the conference. The Bucs' next contest is against Big South foe High Point this Saturday in High Point, N.C. The Buccaneers defeated the Panthers earlier this season at home at a score of 80-72 on Jan. 31.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina defeated Presbyterian College 47-34 in its only game of the week... Coastal Carolina has now won back-to-back games by double-digits for the first time this season while holding both opponents under 35 points... **OLIVIA IRICK** paced all scorers in the game with 12 points... It was Irick's 13th double-digit scoring effort of the season, a Coastal Carolina team-high... **JESSICA NOLL** was Coastal's top rebounder for the first time this season as she matched her season-high with seven boards... The Chants have two home contests this week as Winthrop comes to Conway on Saturday and Radford on Monday.

GARDNER-WEBB

The Runnin' Bulldogs bounced back from back-to-back home conference losses in a big way, as GWU handed the Charleston Southern Buccaneers its first home loss of the season, a 71-64, road conference win last Saturday afternoon. GWU erased a four point halftime deficit and a 10 point second half deficit to outscore the Buccaneers 46-35 in the final 20 minutes of play to come away with its fourth straight road conference victory. In the win, the Hudson sisters combined for 44 points on 14-of-27 shooting, as Monique matched her career-high with 25 points, while Dominique had 19 points. **DOMINIQUE HUDSON** also dished out six assists to increase her career assists total to 496 and put her only four away from 500. **MONIQUE HUDSON**'s 25 points pushed her career points total to 975, placing her only 25 points shy of reaching 1,000 in her career at GWU. As a team, GWU had 10 steals in the game and six blocks and outscored CSU 26-18 in points in the paint. Gardner-Webb will have a very tough challenge ahead of them this week, as the Runnin' Bulldogs will take on both Liberty and UNC Asheville on the road. Both teams defeated GWU at home only two weeks ago. However, Gardner-Webb has won four straight road conference games and will look to carry over the momentum from last Saturday's win into play this week.

HIGH POINT

High Point battled Liberty down to the wire before ultimately falling in a nail biter to the Flames by a score of 58-57. HPU had a chance to win the game in the final seconds but a layup attempt by sophomore Erin Reynolds was blocked away. Freshman **CHEYENNE PARKER** tied her career high with 19 points in the game. The Panthers trailed by seven at the half and by as much as 12 in the second half before a late run 14-4 run tied the game at 47. The Panthers took their first lead of the game with 5:00 minutes left in the contest when senior **AMY DODD** hit both ends of a one and one to put HPU up, 49-48. The lead would swing back and forth between the two squads until back-to-back baskets by **AVERY WARLEY** put the Flames up three, 58-55, with 1:12 left in the contest. Down three the Panthers again went to Parker who managed to get free in the lane off a pick and roll and laid the ball in to bring HPU to within one, 58-57, with 44 seconds remaining. The High Point defense settled in needing a stop to have a chance to win and stymied the LU offense, forcing a shot clock violation and getting the ball back with 12 seconds remaining.

LIBERTY

After a 4-7 start to the season, Liberty is 10-1 in its last 11 games, including its current five-game winning streak ... The Lady Flames have shot 50 percent or higher from the field in each of the last three games, winning all three contests ... Liberty is now 77-1 under head coach **CAREY GREEN** when making 50 percent of its field goals ... The Lady Flames are also 98-6 in their last 104 February games ... **AVERY WARLEY** notched her 12th double-double of the season and the 25th of her career versus High Point on Saturday ... She is now tied with **ELENA KISSELEVA** for third place on Liberty's career double-doubles list ... Interestingly, Liberty's scoring margin in Big South road games is +17.0, while it is just +3.3 at home.

PRESBYTERIAN

PC has won three road games this season (3-11) after only winning three total over the last four seasons (3-61) combined. **KARLEE TAYLOR** had a career high 15 points in the road victory over Savannah State. PC shot .500 (20-40) in the road victory over Savannah State, marking the first time PC has shot 50 percent or better from the field this season.

RADFORD

Radford had its four-game winning streak snapped on Saturday against UNC Asheville, the longest since the 2007-08 season. Despite the defeat, the Highlanders committed a season-low five turnovers while dishing out 19 assists on 24 field goals, which led to a 3.8 turnover/assist ratio. It set a new school mark for fewest turnovers in a game (dating back to 1985-86). The previous record of six was set back on Nov. 27, 1994 against Morehead State. It also set a new Dedmon Center record, breaking the mark of seven that was recorded twice. With those five, Radford has committed just 14 turnovers in their last two contests, a tad under what they are averaging (14.4) during conference play. **ASHLEY BUCKHANNON** has been turning into Radford's sixth man as of late. She has come off the bench to score in double figures the last three games, including team-high against Coastal and Asheville. She's averaged 13.7 points in the last three contests and 8.3 ppg over the last eight games she has played in. In those eight contests, she has dropped in seven points or more seven times.

UNC ASHEVILLE

The Bulldogs went 1-0 on the week with a 70-60 victory over Big South Conference foe Radford this past Saturday afternoon. The Bulldogs were led on offense by senior forward **LINDSEY MONTGOMERY** who scored 22 points en route to her sixth double-double of the season (10 rebounds). Not be outdone by an upperclassman, sophomore forward **KELLI RILES** scored 18 points and pulled down a career-high and UNC Asheville NCAA Division I school record 22 rebounds (18 defensive). Asheville is now 10-11 overall with a 3-6 mark in the Big South. The Bulldogs are also 4-7 at home and 6-4 on the road overall while in conference play they are 0-4 at home and 3-2 on the road. Asheville's six road wins is the most by a Bulldog team since the 2006-07 team won seven games. Kelli Riles is 15th nationally in rebounding this week with a 10.9 average. The Bulldogs have won (10) two more games than it did all of last season. Asheville leads the Big South in scoring (68.5) and free throw percentage (71.1%). 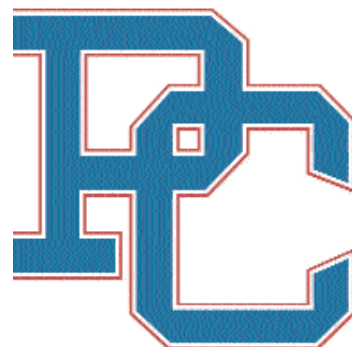
