Erwin Spencer keyed Radford to a pair of League victories over Gardner-Webb and High Point last week. The guard, averaged 20.5 points, six rebounds and three steals per contest, while shooting 48.6 percent from the field. Against the Bulldogs on Jan. 8, she tallied a game-high 17 points with seven rebounds and three steals. She hit a crucial jumper with 31 seconds left to quiet a Bulldog comeback attempt. Two days later, she matched a career-high with 24 points in a thrilling overtime victory over High Point. Erwin Spencer's last field goal was the game-winner with 36 second left in the extra period. She also added six rebounds and three steals against the Panthers.

Coastal Carolina's **SYDNEI MOSS** and **MACKENZIE MAIER** are the only active players in the Big South with more than 1,000 points and 500 boards ... The milestone marks the first time since the 2008-09 season that the League has had two active players with 1,000 points and 500 boards.

PRIMETIME PLAYERS

The Big South has featured some really big games from players across the League. **LINDSEY THOMPSON** of UNC Asheville put in a Big South season-high 29 points vs. Appalachian State on Dec. 2. **KATIE TULL** of Charleston Southern matched that effort as she recorded 29 points against Pfeiffer on Dec. 11 ... **LINDSEY MONTGOMERY** and **KELLI RILES** of UNC Asheville had big games against Furman on Dec. 11. Montgomery finished the contest with 25 points and 10 rebounds, while Riles notched 21 points and 15 boards ... **MACKENZIE MAIER** posted an unconventional double-double as she put in 22 points and posted 10 rejections against Campbell on Dec. 1 ... Winthrop's **DEQUESA McCLANAHAN** recorded the top freshman scoring performance as she piled up 26 points against VCU on Nov. 17.

BENJAMIN

Gardner-Webb Head Coach **RICK REEVES** passed a milestone on Dec. 5 and 7th as his Runnin' Bulldogs went 2-0. The two wins gave Reeves his 100th win at Gardner-Webb.

MAKE'N IT RAIN

Charleston Southern's **KATIE TULL** has been locked in from downtown throughout her career in the Big South Conference. She currently ranks No. 2 all-time in the Big South with 261 career three-pointers. She needs only 2 more treys to take over the No. 1 spot in the Conference as former Winthrop guard **TIFFANY RODD** is ranked No. 1 with 263. She set the single-season record with 100 three-pointers last season and this season she poured in nine treys against Voorhees on Nov. 16. The nine triples set the CSU single game mark and was one off the Big South single game standard ... She currently has 54 on the season ... Winthrop's **LACEY LYONS** has found her way into the League's career top 10 as well. She has 174 treys in her career to rank No. 7 on the all-time list.

COUNTER BLOCKWISE

MACKENZIE MAIER is currently ranked No. 2 all-time in the Big South record book with 262 career rejections. She needs 32 blocks to take hold of the No. 1 position held by former Radford center **KELLI DARDEN**. The senior has finished ranked in the Top-10 in the Big South single-season blocks list in each of the past two seasons and holds the No. 2 position with 91 blocks during the 2009-10 campaign. Her 10 blocks vs. Campbell on Dec. 2 tied the Big South single-game record ... Also making her way up the list is **KATIE WHITE** from Coastal Carolina. She currently has 173 blocked shots in her career and is ranked No. 8 all-time.

RILED UP

UNC Asheville's **KELLI RILES** has established herself as the League's top rebounder this season. She is ranked No. 1 in the League and No. 5 on the Big South single-season list with 10.9 boards per contest and has went for double-digits in eight games this season. She has posted a Big South season-high 16 rebounds on Dec. 15 and posted three-straight games with at least 10 boards twice this season. She is the only player in the Big South averaging a double-double as she averages 12.4 points per contest.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern got their first win in Big South Conference play this week at Coastal Carolina. The win is only the second win on the road for the Buccaneers on the road this season. LAKEITHA ALSTON and KELSEY WASMER both logged double-doubles with 15 points and 13 rebounds. Senior guard KATIE TULL sits two behind the Big South All-time mark for three pointers made in a career. The Buccaneers look to get their first Big South victory at home against the Presbyterian Blue Hose this Saturday in Buccaneer Field House.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina fell in overtime 60-53 to Charleston Southern in its only game of the week... The game, which was originally scheduled for Monday, had to be postponed to Tuesday due to the inclement weather in South Carolina... OLIVIA IRICK turned in a career day points wise as she led all scorers with 19... Irick drained three treys in the contest including one in overtime to give Coastal its final lead in the game... The Chanticleer's three point defense shined as the home squad held Charleston Southern to only two three pointers, well below their NCAA sixth ranked average of 8.5 per game.... Coastal also held the Big South's leading scorer and three point shooter, Katie Tull, 0-of-7 from long range.... Coastal Carolina will continue its home stand as hosts to UNC Asheville on Saturday, Jan. 15 and Gardner-Webb on Monday, Jan. 17.

GARDNER-WEBB

For the second straight year, the Runnin' Bulldogs started the Big South Conference slate off at 1-0 only to fall to the Highlanders of Radford in its second conference game to fall to 1-1 to start the conference season. GWU, which was missing SANDRA VAITKUTE due to injury and three other players due to a one-game suspension, struggled to protect the ball and score against Radford, falling to the Highlanders 57-50 in Radford, Va. GWU bounced back from the loss with a 45-42 win over Winthrop on Tuesday afternoon in Rock Hill, S.C., overcoming 25 percent shooting to hold the Lady Eagles to only 12 points in the final half of play to secure the come from behind win. GWU was down 30-20 to the Lady Eagles at the halftime break, yet held Winthrop to only five made baskets on 15.9 percent shooting in the second half to come away with the 45-42 road conference win. The Hudson sisters combined for 25 of GWU's 45 points, while Vaitkute and SIERRA LITTLE scored 16 points off the bench for Coach Reeves' squad. The Runnin' Bulldogs will remain on the road for its next two games, taking on High Point on Saturday afternoon at 4 p.m. and then heading south to do battle with Coastal Carolina at 7 p.m. on Monday night.

HIGH POINT

High Point split its conference road trip this week, winning at UNC Asheville before falling in overtime at Radford. Against the Bulldogs, HPU set a new team record for Points in a Big South Conference game with 94, surpassing the previous record of 90 set against Coastal Carolina in 2003. Four different players scored in double digits for High Point, led by senior AMY DODD and junior SHAMIA BROWN who each had 18. Senior JURICA HARGRAVES had 17 and senior LATEISHA DEAN had 16. Freshman CHEYENEE PARKER stepped up with 10 rebounds and tied her career high with six blocks. The Panthers then headed to Radford where they forced overtime with a late comeback and game-tying buzzer beater before falling by a score of 68-63 in the extra period. HPU had the ball on the sideline with 0.6 second left and senior FRANCES FIELDS sent a high inbounds pass to the post where Parker rose up to tap the ball in at the buzzer. The score capped a 16-5 run by the Panthers over the final five minutes of the game.

LIBERTY

After starting the season 3-6, Liberty has now won five of its last six contests, including a season-high four in a row ... At 8-7, Liberty is above the .500 mark for the first time this season ... The Lady Flames are 5-3 on their nine-game road swing, with a non-conference contest at Longwood Friday remaining to be played ... Liberty will finally return home Monday, welcoming Radford to the Vines Center in the Lady Flames' first home game since Nov. 30 ... Liberty posted road wins over Presbyterian College and UNC Asheville in consecutive days over the weekend, marking the first time the Lady Flames have played Big South games on back-to-back days since Feb. 5-6, 1995 (UMBC and Towson) ... Head coach CAREY GREEN has now been at the helm for more than half (272) of Liberty's 543 wins in program history ... No Lady Flame has scored 20 points in a game this season ... DEVON BROWN has come the closest, netting 19 points against La Salle on Dec. 29.

PRESBYTERIAN

PC is trying to tie its record for most wins since moving to Division I (5) while giving COACH FISHER his 14th career win as a head coach. AMANDA MILLS moved into a tie for fourth on the career 3-point FGs list (130) during the last game against Liberty.

RADFORD

DANARIA ERWIN SPENCER keyed Radford to a pair of league victories over Gardner-Webb and High Point last week. The sophomore guard, averaged 20.5 points, six rebounds and three steals per contest, while shooting 48.6 percent from the field. Two days later, she matched a career-high with 24 points in a thrilling overtime victory over High Point. Erwin Spencer's last field goal was the game-winner with 36 second left in the extra period. She also added six rebounds and three steals.

UNC ASHEVILLE

The Bulldogs went 0-2 on the week, falling to Big South Conference foes High Point on Saturday, 94-75, and then Liberty on Sunday, 61-44. The game with Liberty was moved up from Monday evening to Sunday afternoon due to inclement weather expected in the Asheville area. The Blue & White is now 7-7 on the season overall, 4-5 at home, 3-2 on the road and 0-3 in conference play. The three losses in a row is the longest losing skid of the season for the Bulldogs. Asheville currently leads the Big South in scoring offense averaging 70.6 points per game and field goal percentage with a mark of .408. Senior guard KENDALL SHEPARD is currently tied for the league-lead in scoring averaging 14.4 ppg. LINDSEY THOMPSON (6th) and KELLI RILES (8th) are also in the top 10 in the league in scoring, giving Asheville three players in the top 10 in scoring. Riles also leads the league in rebounding (10.9 rpg) and field goal percentage (.603).

WINTHROP

DEQUESHA MCCLANAHAN recorded 19 points in the win over Charleston Southern, which was her fifth straight game with 17 or more points. She currently leads the Lady Eagles with 12.5 points per game. She has scored double-figures in eight of the teams 14 games. Senior LACEY LYONS hit three treys in the loss to Gardner-Webb and now has 174 for her career, which is ranked 8th on the Big South's All-Time List. She made 30 total in 2009-10, but already has 29 on the year. Before the loss to Gardner-Webb on Tuesday, Winthrop had won five straight. The last time Winthrop won five games in a row was the 2008-09 season. Winthrop is in the middle of a stretch in which it plays six straight games at home and nine of 11. MARY ROLAND GRIFFIN passed away on Monday, Jan. 3 at the age of 81. Griffin was instrumental to the start of the women's basketball program at Winthrop as she became the school's first athletic director in 1970. Griffin coached the Lady Eagles for three seasons (71-72, 72-73, and 73-74) as she won 50 games in that time frame. In memory of Griffin, the Lady Eagles are getting the letters MRG placed on their jerseys. The emblem will remain on the jersey for the remainder of the year. In addition to her contributions to athletics, Griffin served as a professor for many years in the physical education department before she retired in 1994. She was honored twice by the National Association for Girls and Women in Sports as a pioneer and for extraordinary service, and received a Woman of Achievement Award from the Governor of South Carolina for her pioneer work in sports for girls and women.


