Warley averaged 14.5 points and 14.5 rebounds per game to lead her squad to a 2-0 record in Big South play last week. The center got her week started with 15 points on 67 percent from the floor and 3-of-3 from the line to go along with 16 rebounds, two steals and an assist as Liberty downed Charleston Southern on Jan. 22. She followed that performance with 14 points and 13 boards as the Lady Flames downed Coastal Carolina on Jan. 24. In the final 85 seconds of the contest against the Chanticleers, Warley blocked a shot, ripped down two boards and was a perfect 4-of-4 from the line to seal the four point win. Her two double-doubles marked her fourth and fifth straight contests with a double-double.

McClanahan averaged 22 points on 52 percent shooting to fuel the Lady Eagles to a 1-1 record last week. In the win over UNC Asheville on Jan. 22, McClanahan scored 15 points in the second half to rally Winthrop from a 15-point halftime deficit. She finished the contest with 26 points on 60 percent from the floor, one from downtown and seven from the line. She also chipped in eight helpers and came away with three steals in the win. Two days later against High Point, she connected on 44 percent from the field and two long-range to finish with 18 points as well as six boards, two assists and three steals.

FRESH PRINCESS OF ROCK HILL

Winthrop's **DEQUESA MCCLANAHAN** became just the sixth player in the Big South Conference to earn at least five Big South Freshman of the Week accolades. There are only two players in the League with six Freshman of Week plaudits, including **SHAMIA BROWN** of High Point who picked up her six nods in 2008-09.

WE'RE THE ONLY ONES!!!

Coastal Carolina's **SYDNEI MOSS** and **MACKENZIE MAIER** are the only active players in the Big South with more than 1,000 points and 500 boards ... The milestone marks the first time since the 2008-09 season that the League has had two active players with 1,000 points and 500 boards.

BIG SOUTH TV NETWORK SCHEDULE

Gardner-Webb Head Coach **RICK REEVES** passed a milestone on Dec. 5 and 7th as his Runnin' Bulldogs went 2-0. The two wins gave Reeves his 100th win at Gardner-Webb.

QUEENS OF 3-ON

Charleston Southern's **KATIE TULL** took over the No. 1 spot all-time in career three-pointers with 267 on Jan. 24. She set the single-season record with 100 three-pointers last season and this season she poured in nine treys against Voorhees on Nov. 16. The nine triples set the CSU single game mark and was one off the Big South single game standard ... She currently has 60 on the season ... There are currently three other players in the Big South making their way up in the career three-pointers list. Here is a look at how they stack up.

COUNTER BLOCKWISE

MACKENZIE MAIER is currently ranked No. 2 all-time in the Big South record book with 263 career rejections. She needs 31 blocks to take hold of the No. 1 position held by former Radford center **KELLI DARDEN**. The senior has finished ranked in the Top-10 in the Big South single-season blocks list in each of the past two seasons and holds the No. 2 position with 91 blocks during the 2009-10 campaign. Her 10 blocks vs. Campbell on Dec. 2 tied the Big South single-game record ... Also making her way up the list is **KATIE WHITE** from Coastal Carolina. She currently has 181 blocked shots in her career and is ranked No. 8 all-time.

RILED UP

UNC Asheville's **KELLI RILES** has established herself as the League's top rebounder this season. She is ranked No. 1 in the League and No. 5 on the Big South single-season list with 10.9 boards per contest and has went for double-digits in 11 games this season. She is the only player in the Big South averaging a double-double as she averages 12.0 points per contest.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Charleston Southern Buccaneers lost two Big South Contests on the road this weekend to Liberty and then Radford. The loss to Liberty snapped a three game Big South Conference winning streak. Senior guard **KATIE TULL** broke the all time Big South mark for three pointers in the first half against Liberty. She sits alone atop the record books with 267 career threes. With ten points against Radford, Charleston Southern senior guard **KELSEY WASMER** eclipsed the millennium mark for her career. She also added eight boards. She presently sits in 14th place on CSU's all-time scoring list with 1,002 points. Charleston Southern is one of only two teams to have two active players with over 1,000 points, the other team being their upcoming opponent High Point.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina fell in both games on the week dropping a 80-66 decision at High Point and falling short in a second half comeback bid at Liberty 58-54... Coastal improved its shooting percentage against High Point connecting on 47.4 percent of its shots from the floor in the defeat... The performance was the best the Chants has shot in the Big South this season... Coastal's bench poured in 41 points against High Point, its highest output this season... The Chanticleers made a season-high eight three pointers against Liberty including three in the final 3:02 of play... **SYDNEI MOSS**, still limited by her injury, contributed a team-high 22 points on the week... Senior sharpshooter **JESSICA NOLL** contributed heavily as she knocked down four three pointers, three of which came in the first half against Liberty to keep the Chants in the game... Senior center **KATIE WHITE** moved into eighth place on the Big South career blocks list with four on the week upping her career total to 184... The Chanticleers will be on the road again in the coming week playing at Radford on Jan. 29 and at Winthrop on Jan. 31.

GARDNER-WEBB

The Runnin' Bulldogs forced the Blue Hose of Presbyterian College into 35 turnovers, while holding them to only 33 points in GWU's 52-33 home conference win on Monday night. In GWU's lone game of the week, the Runnin' Bulldogs held PC to 33 points, the lowest point total allowed by GWU this season and the second lowest total in its Division I history. Gardner-Webb dished out 16 assists, picked up 14 steals and swatted away eight shots in the game, holding PC to 11-of-41 shooting, 26.8 percent, including only four made field goals in the first half. In the win, **MONIQUE HUDSON** had 16 points, eight assists, five rebounds and three steals, while **SIERRA LITTLE** had 12 points, five rebounds and a career-high five blocks in the win. GWU, who is 6-2 at home this season and 31-6 over the last two plus seasons at home in Paul Porter Arena, will return to action next week to host UNCA on Saturday, January 29th, at 3 p.m. and the Liberty Lady Flames on Monday night, January 31st, at 7 p.m.

HIGH POINT

High Point went 2-0 on the week with home wins over Coastal Carolina and Winthrop to improve to .500 in the Big South with a 3-3 conference mark. Junior **SHAMIA BROWN** led the team on the weekend, averaging 17 points per game in the two wins. Against Coastal Carolina, High Point used strong post play from Brown and Freshman **CHEYENNE PARKER** to set the pace early, opening up the HPU guards later in the contest and allowing them to hit a season-high 10 three pointers. Brown finished with 18 points while Parker notched her second-straight double-double with 13 points and 13 rebounds. The Panthers used stifling defense to limit Winthrop to 49 points in its 15-point win, forcing 18 turnovers on the night. The Eagles' point total was the lowest of the season for any of HPU's DI opponents. Sophomore **ERIN REYNOLDS** scored a game-high 18 points and dished out four assists in her first start of the season while Brown finished with 16 points with 12 coming in the second half.

LIBERTY

Liberty extended two of the nation's longest active winning streaks against a single opponent, winning its 28th straight game versus Charleston Southern and its 34th straight game against Coastal Carolina ... **AVERY WARLEY** posted double-doubles in both games, giving her five consecutive double-doubles ... Warley also went over the 800-point and 700-rebound plateaus over the weekend, becoming only the fifth player in program history to reach both milestones ... After a 4-7 start to the season, Liberty has won seven of its last eight games ... **JELENA ANTIC** scored in double figures against both Charleston Southern and Coastal Carolina, extending her run of successful play at the Vines Center ... She has scored in double digits in eight straight home games and is averaging four more points per game at home than on the road during her career.

PRESBYTERIAN

PC is 3-3 at home, with two overtime losses this season. PC is shooting .402 FG%, scoring an average of 56.3 ppg, and holding opponents to 51.7 ppg when playing at home. PC is holding League opponents to 46.7 ppg through 6 conference games.

RADFORD

Radford picked up a pair of four-point home victories over Presbyterian and Charleston Southern to improved to 6-1 in the league, its best start since the 1997-98 team began 10-1 and finished 10-2 overall. The Highlanders 49-45 win over the Blue Hose was a monumental and rare one. On the monumental side, it was the 600th in program history. The Highlanders are now 601-457 (.569) after this weekend. It was also marked first victory when scoring less than 50 points since a 47-42 win at UMBC on Dec. 7, 2004 and the first ever time in the Dedmon Center. The Highlanders have won a total of 15 times when not reaching 50 points, but 13 of those came between the 1971-72 and 1979-80 seasons. **KAHEALANI VICK** has recorded 13 steals (4.3) over the last three games and 17 (3.4) over the last five.

UNC ASHEVILLE

The Bulldogs went 0-2 on the week with a loss to Big South Conference foe Winthrop on Saturday and a loss to non-conference opponent Longwood on Monday evening. In both contests Asheville held the lead in the second half before eventually losing each. The loss to Winthrop dropped the Bulldogs to under .500 for the first time this season as they also fall to 1-5 in the Big South. Asheville has now lost six out of their last seven contests with their lone victory coming against Coastal Carolina. The win against Coastal Carolina was the eighth win of the season for UNC Asheville, matching the wins total from the 2009-10 season when the Bulldogs went 8-22 on the year. Last season the Bulldogs did not pick up their eighth victory until March 1. 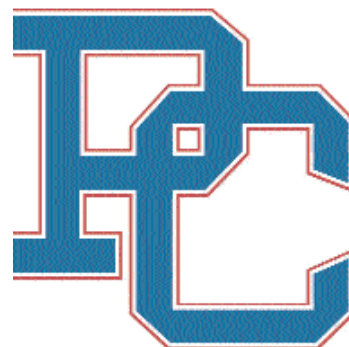
