HALF WAY THERE

With eight games under their belts, the Big South Women's Basketball Conference Schedule is halfway through. The squads will begin their second run through the League schools beginning on Saturday, Feb. 5.

QUEENS OF THEIR CASTLE

The Charleston Southern women's basketball squad is a perfect 8-0 at the CSU Fieldhouse this season ... Coupled with the Charleston Southern men's undefeated streak at home, Charleston Southern is one of just five of the 333 NCAA Division I schools who can boast that both its men's and women's teams are unscathed at home this season. The Bucs find themselves in the company of schools such as Arizona (PAC-10), Duke (ACC), McNeese State (Southland), and Princeton (Ivy League).

FRESH PRINCESS OF ROCK HILL

Winthrop's DEQUESHA MCCLANAHAN became just the sixth player in the Big South Conference to earn at least five Big South Freshman of the Week accolades. There are only two players in the League with six Freshman of Week plaudits, including SHAMIA BROWN of High Point who picked up her six nods in 2008-09.

WE'RE THE ONLY ONES!!!

Coastal Carolina's SYDNEI MOSS and MACKENZIE MAIER are the only active players in the Big South with more than 1,000 points and 500 boards ... The milestone marks the first time since the 2008-09 season that the League has had two active players with 1,000 points and 500 boards.

BIG SOUTH TV NETWORK SCHEDULE

Five regular-season Big South games as well as the Semifinals and Finals of the Advance Auto Parts Women's Basketball Championship will be broadcast via the Big South Television Network (BSTN). The BSTN will utilize eight local, regional and national affiliates to carry some or all of the games this season, including seven nationally on Fox College Sports (FCS). Gardner-Webb Head Coach RICK REEVES passed a milestone on Dec. 5 and 7th as his Runnin' Bulldogs went 2-0. The two wins gave Reeves his 100th win at Gardner-Webb.

2 AIN'T ENOUGH JACK, YOU BETTER MAKE IT 3

Charleston Southern's KATIE TULL took over the No. 1 spot all-time in career three-pointers on Jan. 24. She set the single-season record with 100 three-pointers last season and this season she poured in nine treys against Voorhees on Nov. 16. The nine triples set the CSU single game mark and was one off the Big South single game standard ... She currently has 66 on the season ... There are currently three other players in the Big South making their way up in the career three-pointers list. Here is a look at how they stack up.

COUNTER BLOCKWISE

MACKENZIE MAIER is currently ranked No. 2 all-time in the Big South record book with 265 career rejections. She needs 28 blocks to take hold of the No. 1 position held by former Radford center KELLI DARDEN. The senior has finished ranked in the Top-10 in the Big South single-season blocks list in each of the past two seasons and holds the No. 2 position with 91 blocks during the 2009-10 campaign. Her 10 blocks vs. Campbell on Dec. 2 tied the Big South single-game record ... Also making her way up the list is KATIE WHITE from Coastal Carolina. She currently has 192 blocked shots in her career and is ranked No. 6 all-time... White has also become Coastal Carolina's career blocked shots leader.

RILED UP

UNC Asheville's KELLI RILES has established herself as the League's top rebounder this season. She is ranked No. 1 in the League and No. 9 on the Big South single-season list with 10.3 boards per contest and has went for double-digits in 11 games this season. She is the only player in the Big South averaging a double-double as she averages 11.4 points per contest.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern defeated the High Point Panthers to remain undefeated at home this season. Charleston Southern's pair of senior guards **KELSEY WASMER** and **KATIE TULL** each scored 26 points in the win ... Charleston Southern will return to action this Saturday when they take the floor against Gardner-Webb who is presently in third place in the conference standings

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina split its games this week with a loss at Radford and a win at Winthrop... Coastal's 48-29 victory at Winthrop was its first Big South victory this season and snapped a seven game losing skid... Winthrop's 29 points was the fewest the Chanticleers have ever allowed in a Big South Conference game... **SYDNEI MOSS** recorded her best back-to-back performances of the season as she picked up double-doubles in each contest. Moss had 18 points and 12 rebounds against Radford and 18 points and 15 rebounds against Winthrop... Moss' 36 points on the week also moved her into sole possession of ninth place on the Chants career scoring list with 1197 points... **KATIE WHITE** set Coastal Carolina's all-time blocks record against Radford as she finished with seven blocks to move her career total to 191... Coastal returns home to Kimbel Arena on Feb. 5 to start the second half of conference play against Presbyterian.

GARDNER-WEBB

The Gardner-Webb Runnin' Bulldogs suffered back-to-back home conference losses last week, the first-time GWU has lost back-to-back home games since 2007-08 and the first time GWU has lost more than two home games in the entire season since 2007-08. Gardner-Webb struggled offensively and at the free throw line last Saturday afternoon, as the Runnin' Bulldogs squandered away a 13 point first half lead and a six point halftime lead to fall to Asheville 60-59 in Paul Porter Arena. In the loss to Liberty on Monday night, Gardner-Webb couldn't overcome foul trouble to three of its starters and a cold shooting night, as Liberty shot 52.3 percent compared to the Runnin' Bulldogs 28.6 percent to come away with the 68-56 road win. Gardner-Webb's leading duo of **DOMINIQUE** and **MONIQUE HUDSON** has had a terrible time on the offensive end over the last few games, as in last week's two losses, the two combined to average only 15 points, 8.5 assists, 2.5 steals and 10.5 assists per game, while shooting only 17 percent from the floor overall. With the reinjury to **SANDRA VAIKUTE**'s ankle in the second half of the UNCA game, the Runnin' Bulldogs top three players had a very tough week on the court for Coach Reeves' squad. However, freshmen **JASMINE DALE** and **CATRINA GREEN** both stepped up, as the duo each posted career-high nights of 15 points in the loss to Liberty and both hauled in six rebounds in the game. The Runnin' Bulldogs will try to avoid its second three-game losing streak of the season, as this Saturday afternoon, February 5th, GWU will take on Charleston Southern at 2 p.m. in Charleston, S.C.

HIGH POINT

High Point finished the first swing through conference play with a 4-4 record after going 1-1 in road games at Presbyterian College and Charleston Southern. The Panthers held PC to just 41 points in a 56-41 win in Clinton, S.C., on Saturday before falling at Charleston Southern by a score of 80-72. HPU held PC to just 33.3 percent shooting from the floor and forced 19 turnovers in the win over the Blue Hose. The 41 points allowed by High Point was the lowest scored by any of the Panthers' Division I opponents this season. Junior **SHAMIA BROWN** led a balanced High Point attack with 11 points. Against the Buccaneers, High Point had a late comeback from a 12-point deficit fall just short as the Panthers lost for the second-straight season in the Buccaneer Fieldhouse. Freshman **CHEYENNE PARKER** recorded her third double-double of Big South play with 15 points and 14 rebounds while Brown tied Parker with 15 points to lead HPU. The Panthers kick-off the second half of their conference slate with a game at Liberty Saturday.

LIBERTY

Liberty's wins at Winthrop and Gardner-Webb extended the Lady Flames' road winning streak to seven games ... The Lady Flames have also won four straight games overall and nine of their last 10 contests ... Liberty finished the month of January 8-1 for the second straight year, and the Lady Flames are 87-10 in January under head coach **CAREY GREEN** ... Redshirt junior **EVERY WARLEY** continues to climb Liberty's all-time record lists ... She now ranks fourth in program history with 24 double-doubles, 11 of which have come this season, and is tied for fifth in Liberty history with 92 career blocked shots ... Liberty has only played six of its first 21 games at home, but five of its eight remaining contests will be played inside the Vines Center ... At least three Lady Flames have scored in double figures in each of the last 12 games, helping Liberty go 10-2 during that time ... for the season, **DEVON BROWN** (13.3 ppg), **JELÉNA ANTIC** (10.8 ppg) and **Warley** (10.2 ppg) are all averaging double figures in the scoring column ... Liberty has not had three players average double digits for an entire season since 1999-2000, Green's first year at the helm of the Lady Flames.

PRESBYTERIAN

PC set a new Division I record for wins (6) and tied last year's record of 3 conference wins. PC is 4-4 at home with two overtime losses. PC is 3-1 on Mondays.

RADFORD

Radford ended the first half of the season with a 66-55 win over Coastal Carolina to extend its winning streak to four games and remain in a tie for first place with Liberty. It continues the best start in 13 seasons and is the longest winning streak since the 2007-08 season. During the winning streak, Radford has allowed 52 points, forced 25 turnovers and recorded 15.5 steals per game. They have scored 23 points per contest off those miscues and have been holding onto the ball as well. The Highlanders, who committed a season-low nine miscues against the Chanticleers, have turned it over just 13.8 times during the streak and have a plus 11.5 turnover ratio. **KAHEALANI VICK** recorded a career-high six blocks against Coastal Carolina, while **DENAY WOOD** registered a career-best five steals. In two of its last three games (PC and Coastal), Radford has taken advantage of a significant free throw differential in the second half. The Highlanders attempted an average of 26 (25/27) second half freebies, 22 more (+23/+21) than their opponents. In both instances, it was the difference in the outcome as RU scored over half their points from the charity stripe and out scored its opponents by a total of 31 points (+12/+19) with the final margin being 15 points (+4/+11)

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville went 1-1 on the week defeating Big South Conference foe Gardner-Webb 60-59 on Saturday afternoon and then losing to Presbyterian College 53-51 on Monday evening. The Bulldogs are now 9-11 overall with a 2-6 mark in conference play. They are also 4-7 at home and 5-4 on the road. Since entering league play with an overall record of 7-4, the Bulldogs have gone 2-7 overall with two 3-game losing streaks in that span. Sophomore forward **KELLI RILES** continues to have a fantastic season for the Bulldogs. She has posted nine double-doubles on the year and leads the Big South Conference in rebounding (10.4) and is third in field goal percentage (55.5%). Not to be outdone by an underclassman, senior forward **LINSEY MONTGOMERY** is averaging 13.2 ppg along with 8.2 rpg. She has recorded five double-doubles on the season as well. The win against Coastal Carolina was the eighth win of the season for UNC Asheville, matching the wins total from the 2009-10 season when the Bulldogs went 8-22 on the year. Last season the Bulldogs did not pick up their eighth victory until March 1. Asheville only has one game this week, a road matchup with Big South opponent Radford on Saturday afternoon.

WINTHROP

Things took a hard turn south for the Lady Eagles over the weekend as they managed to score a total of just 62 points in two games and were a combined 26-for-111 from the field (23 percent), 2-for-24 from three (8 percent) and 8-for-16 from the foul line (50 percent). Winthrop out shot opponents 111-93 and had equal amount of turnovers (34), but struggled from the field. The 33 points against Liberty on Saturday and 27 points against Coastal Carolina on Monday rank among the all-time low in total points in school history. **DEQUESA MCCLANAHAN** had her worst weekend as a Lady Eagle as she battled the flu in both games and was a combined 3-for-23 from the field and averaged 4.5 points and 2.0 assists. McClanahan still leads the team in scoring at 12.8 per game, which ranks fifth in the Big South. **TAQUOIA HAMMICK** had a decent weekend as she led the team in scoring with 9.0 points per game and also averaged 6.0 rebounds. She had three blocks in the two games and now has 49 in her career, which moves her into the top 10 all-time at Winthrop. She is now eighth. Two more blocks will move her into seventh place. Winthrop's all-time shot block leader in **TAMMY JONES** with 170 (1.5 per game).

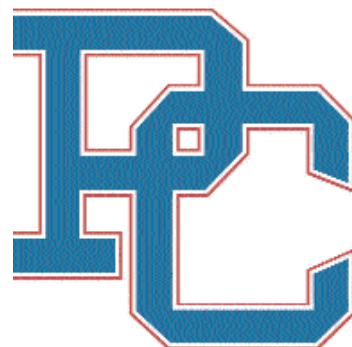
