Warley averaged 17 points and 9.5 rebounds per game to lead the Lady Flames to a 2-0 record in Big South play last week. She got her week started with 24 points on 83 percent from the floor to go along with 11 rebounds in Liberty's win over UNC Asheville on March 4. Three days later against Presbyterian College, the center put in 10 points and posted eight boards, two blocks, two steals and one helper as the Lady Flames downed the Blue Hose, 49-40. Warley finished the week with a 78 percent clip from the field.

Parker posted 15.0 points per game and ripped down 10.0 rebounds to help the Panthers finish the week with a 1-1 mark. She highlighted her week with 21 points and 16 rebounds in High Point's 106-58 win over UNC Asheville on March 6. She connected on 78 percent from the floor against the Bulldogs and nailed 7-of-10 from the line to go along with three blocks, a steal and an assist in the win. Against Radford on March 4, Parker posted nine points, six blocks and four rebounds in the three-point overtime loss to the Highlanders. The honor marks Parker's seventh Big South Freshman of the Week honor this season as she becomes the first player in Big South history to earn the award seven times in a season.

SEEDS ARE SET

Liberty won its 12th Big South women's basketball regular-season championship with its 14-2 League record, and has earned the No. 1 seed in this week's Advance Auto Parts Big South Women's Basketball Championship. Radford and Gardner-Webb each posted identical 11-5 records in League action. The Highlanders picked up a win over Liberty during the regular-season to break the tie and earn the No. 2 seed. High Point posted a Conference record of 9-7 to pick up the No. 4 seed, while Charleston Southern's 8-8 record was good for the No. 5 position. UNC Asheville and Winthrop each went 5-11 during the Big South regular-season. Asheville's win over Gardner-Webb broke the tie to grab the No. 6 slot, leaving Winthrop with the No. 7 seed. Coastal Carolina rounds out the seeding at No. 8 with its 4-12 record in Conference play.

7-UP

High Point's **CHEYENNE PARKER** set a milestone on March 8 as she became the first player in Big South Conference history to earn 7 Big South Freshman of the Week honors in a single season.

NO. 25 ON THE ROSTER NO. 1 IN THE NATION

Charleston Southern's **KATIE TULL** currently ranks No. 1 in the country with 3.5 triples per game.

RIDE'N 30

Radford's **DA'NARIA ERWIN SPENCER**'s 30 points on Feb. 28 vs. Presbyterian College is the highest single-game effort on the season as she is the only player in the League this year with a game of 30 or more points. She also became the first Highlander since the 2007-08 season to post 30-or-more points in a game.

SIX-TACULAR

DEQUESHA MCCIANAHAN earned Big South Freshman of the Week honors six times this season. She joins four players in the Big South to earn six plaudits, including current High Point Panther **SHAMIA BROWN** who picked up her six nods in 2008-09.

STYLE'N & PROFILE'N

Charleston Southern and Liberty set single-game records over the past couple of weeks. Liberty pulled down 65 rebounds in a win over Gardner-Webb on Feb. 12 to best the old standard of 63 held by Charleston Southern since 1992 ... Charleston Southern reset its single-game three point field goal mark as it canned 18 in the win over UNC Asheville on Feb. 19. The Bucs old standard of 17 was set against High Point on Feb. 2, 2009.

DOUBLE-TROUBLE

UNC Asheville's **KELLI RILES** and **AVERY WARLEY** of Liberty are the only two players in the League averaging a double-double. Riles is currently averaging 10.2 points and 10.7 rebounds per game, while Warley is posting 11.0 points and 10.7 boards per game. Warley also tops the Big South with 16 double-doubles on the season, while Riles is close behind her with 11.

MAKE'N THE GRADE

Coastal Carolina's **KATIE WHITE** and **MACKENZIE MAIER** from High Point each earned bids to the CoSIDA Academic All-District III teams. White was named to the first time while Maier was tabbed a second team selection. The honors also mark the seventh-straight year that the League has boasted at least one All-District honoree.

Coastal Carolina's **SYDNEI MOSS** and **MACKENZIE MAIER** are the only active players in the Big South with more than 1,000 points and 500 boards ... The milestone marks the first time since the 2008-09 season that the League has had two active players with 1,000 points and 500 boards.

Charleston Southern's **KATIE TULL** took over the No. 1 spot all-time in career three-pointers on Jan. 24. She reset her single-season record with 105 three-pointers this season, including nine treys against Voorhees on Nov. 16. The nine triples set the CSU single game mark and was one off the Big South single game standard ... There are currently three other players in the Big South making their way up in the career three-pointers list. Here is a look at how they stack up:

COUNTER BLOCKWISE

MACKENZIE MAIER took over the No. 1 spot all-time in the Big South record book with 302 career rejections. The senior has finished ranked in the Top-10 in the Big South single-season blocks list in each of the past two seasons and holds the No. 2 position with 91 blocks during the 2009-10 campaign. Her 10 blocks vs. Campbell on Dec. 2 tied the Big South single-game record ... Also making her way up the list is **KATIE WHITE** from Coastal Carolina. She currently has 203 blocked shots in her career and is ranked No. 6 all-time... White has also become Coastal Carolina's career blocked shots leader.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern won their last regular season game against the Eagles of Winthrop University. Buccaneer senior **KATIE TULL** broke her own single season record for three pointers in a single season. Last year in her junior campaign she hit 100 three pointers. After tonight's contest she has 105 for this season with at least one game to play. Tull also holds the all-time Big South record for three pointers made in a career with a total of 321. The Buccaneers win at home that puts them at 10-2 on the season.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina wrapped up its regular season with a 61-58 win at Charleston Southern on Friday... The win improves the Chants to 4-12 in conference play... **SYDNEI MOSS** scored a season-high 23 points and pulled down a season-high tying 13 boards... Moss was 6-of-7 from the field in the first half, including her first six straight... **OLIVIA IRICK** also scored in double-figures for the 16th time this season as she poured in 14... The Chants bench outscored Charleston Southern 10-0 in the contest as only four Buccaneers contributed points... Moss has now scored 1,304 points in her career which ranks eighth on the Chanticleers all-time list and 25th in the Big South record book... Coastal is the No. 8 seed in the Big South Tournament and will play top seeded Liberty on Friday, March 11 at Noon.

GARDNER-WEBB

The Gardner-Webb wrapped up its 2010-11 regular season with back-to-back home conference wins that placed them in a tie with Radford for second-place overall in the final regular season Big South standings. The Runnin' Bulldogs scored first one minute into the game and never looked back, pushing its lead to as much as 23 in the second half in the 62-46 win over Winthrop on Friday night. Gardner-Webb scored 14 points off of Winthrop's six first half turnovers to take a double-digit lead midway through the opening half. For the game, GWU outscored Winthrop 28-10 points in the paint, 23-16 in points off turnovers, 16-4 in second chance points, 10-2 in fast break points and 21-14 in bench points. On Sunday, which served as Senior Day for GWU, the Runnin' Bulldogs ran out to a 29-19 halftime lead over Radford, only to have the Highlanders roar back to tie the game on a last second shot attempt to force the game into overtime. In the overtime period, GWU outscored Radford 20-8 in the extra five minutes to secure a 79-67 home win. The win gave GWU its second straight 20 win season, after having won no more than 17 games in a single season since moving to NCAA Division I in 2000-01. The Runnin' Bulldogs will enter the 2011 Advance Auto Parts Big South Women's Basketball Championships as the No. 3 seed and will look to advance to the championship game for the third straight year.

HIGH POINT

High Point closed out the 2010-11 regular season by splitting a pair of games at home, falling in overtime to Radford before coming back to beat UNC Asheville in the season finale. The Panthers battled back from eight down in the final two minutes to force overtime against the Highlanders. HPU led by three with 1:39 remaining in the extra period but RU scored the next five points to take the lead. Senior **AMY DODD** Led High Point with 15 points while senior **MACKENZIE MAIER** had 11 points, eight rebounds, five assists and four blocks. With her four blocks, Maier became the Big South career blocks leader with 293 career rejections. HPU bounced back on Sunday with a 106-58 win over UNC Asheville. The 106 points are a season high and the highest total against a DI opponent in HPU history. Freshman **CHEYENNE PARKER** recorded her fourth double-double of the season with a career high 21 points and 16 rebounds. Dodd finished with 20 points, seven rebounds and six assists and Maier finished with 15 points, nine blocks and eight rebounds. The Panthers hit an HPU record 18 three-pointers in the game with five each coming from Dodd and Maier. HPU also dished out 30 assists to set a new single-game record.

LIBERTY

Liberty closed the regular season with a 20-9 record, notching its 12th 20-win season in the last 14 years and its fourth in a row ... The Lady Flames will enter the Big South Women's Basketball Championship as the No. 1 seed for the 12th time ... Liberty has won the title each of the previous 11 times it has been the top seed ... The Lady Flames have held 12 straight opponents to 58 points or fewer ... **AVERY WARLEY** now ranks 10th in Big South Conference history with 847 career rebounds ... She is also nearing the 1,000-point mark, as she will enter the tournament with 960 career tallies ... **DEVON BROWN** made five three-pointers during Friday's win over UNC Asheville, making her the first Lady Flame since **RACHEL HAMMOND** on Jan. 31, 2009 to hit five triples in a single contest ... Brown (27 points) and Warley (24 points) both eclipsed the 20-point mark versus UNC Asheville on Friday, marking the third time in their career that both players have notched 20 points in the same contest.

PRESBYTERIAN

Senior **AMANDA MILLS** moved into sole possession of third place all time in the program's career record books with 153 three-pointers (in only three seasons). PC ended its season with a 49-40 loss at Liberty, marking the third straight time against the Flames that PC was held to 40 points exactly. The 9 wins for PC this season marked a new Division I high, and the 4 road wins were more than the team saw over the last four seasons combined. PC also swept UNC Asheville (No. 6 seed) this season, showing an improvement since being picked last in the preseason poll.

RADFORD

Radford will face Winthrop in the first round of the Advance Auto Parts Big South Championships. Radford and Winthrop split during the regular season winning on their respective home courts. The Highlanders finished 11-5 in the league, posting the most regular season wins since 1993-94 when they went 12-4. Radford played a pair of overtime games last weekend, making that four during league play. The Highlanders and Panthers went to an extra five minutes for the second time this season. At Gardner-Webb **VICTORIA HAMILTON** beat the buzzer to send the contest into overtime. It was the third time a shot at the buzzer sent RU and its opponent to OT. In all four games, the team that tied the game ended up on the short end. This will be the ninth all-time meeting, the most against any opponent, in the tournament. The Highlanders hold a 6-2 advantage after edging the Lady Eagles, 50-44, in the 2008 semifinals. It will be the third time in five seasons Radford enters the tournament in the two spot. In both 2007 and 2008, the Highlanders reached the championship game as the two seed, finishing as the runner-up to host UNC Asheville and Liberty, respectively.

UNC ASHEVILLE

The Bulldogs went 0-2 on the week with losses to Big South Conference foes Liberty and High Point. Asheville fell to the Lady Flames 72-58 with senior guard **KENDALL SHEPARD** scoring 21 points for the Blue & White in defeat. Fellow senior **LINDSEY MONTGOMERY** reached 1,000 points for her career in that contest, scoring 10 points off the bench. The Bulldogs ran into a buzz saw at High Point on Sunday afternoon, as the Panthers handed Asheville its worst loss of the season, a 106-58 victory for the home team. Five players scored in double figures for HPU ... Both the Lady Flames and the Panthers earned season sweeps over the Bulldogs with their wins. The UNC Asheville women's basketball team will be seeded sixth for the 2011 Advance Auto Parts Big South Conference Women's Basketball Tournament and will take on third-seeded Gardner-Webb Friday night in the quarterfinals at High Point starting at 7:30 p.m. The Bulldogs finished in a tie with Winthrop for the sixth seed but Asheville earned it with a 60-59 victory over Gardner-Webb this year, while the Lady Eagles lost both games to the Runnin' Bulldogs. This will be the second straight year the Bulldogs have faced Gardner-Webb in the quarterfinals. Last year, Asheville was the eighth-seed and led for most of the game against the top-seeded Runnin' Bulldogs before Gardner-Webb rallied to win, 77-65. The teams split road victories during the year. Asheville held off Gardner-Webb on Jan. 29 in Boiling Springs, 60-59. The Runnin' Bulldogs rallied past the Bulldogs at Justice Center on Feb. 14, 68-65.

WINTHROP

After holding opponents to less than 60 points in 16 of 24 games, Winthrop has allowed 60 or more points in four of the last five games. In the last five games, Winthrop is allowing 64.8 points per game while averaging 50.8. Senior **LACEY LYONS** had four three-pointers in the loss at Charleston Southern and has opened the possibility of reaching 200 made for her career as she now has 193. She was 4-for-6 against the Bucs. She now has 943 career points. Freshman **DEQUESHA MCCLANAHAN** started her 28th game of the season on Monday, which ties a Winthrop freshman record for starts in a single season. Lisa Koop had 28 in 2005-06. With a start on Friday against Radford, McClanahan will set a new record of 29. Her 357 points ranks fifth all-time, but fourth place is reachable (Ashley Fann, 362). Her 61 steals is the fifth most in a single season and second most by a Winthrop player at the Division I level. Monday night McClanahan also moved into second on the freshman single season record list of assists with 104.

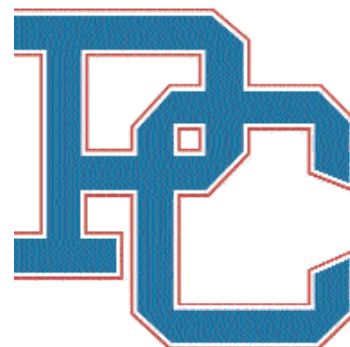
