Erwin Spencer averaged 25 points per game and shot 59 percent from the floor to lead the Highlanders to a 2-0 record in League play last week. She put in a career-high 30 points on 63 percent from the field and 9-of-11 from the stripe as Radford downed Presbyterian College on Feb. 28. She also chipped in seven boards, a pair of assists and two steals. Her 30-point performance notched the first time a Radford player has went for 30 or more points since the 2007-08 season. The guard began her week with 20 points as she connected on 7-of-13 from the floor, 83 percent from the line and one from downtown in Radford's overtime win over Charleston Southern on Feb. 26. She also finished with four rebounds, dished out two helpers and came away with one steal in the victory over the Bucs.

BIG WEEK AHEAD

In the last week of the Big South Women's Basketball Regular Season the seedings heading into the tournament are still up for grabs. A Liberty win will clinch the No. 1 seed for the tournament ... A big game to watch for is second-place Radford taking on third-place Gardner-Webb ... High Point also has a date with the second-place Highlanders ... The race for the seeds is still too close to call as a lot will be determined this week.

RIDE'N 30

Radford's **DA'NARIA ERWIN SPENCER** had a huge week for the Highlanders, helping them pick up two crucial wins. Against Presbyterian College on Feb. 28, the guard put in 30 points in the Radford effort, becoming the first Highlander to earn six plaquds, including current High Point Panther **SHAMIA BROWN** who picked up her six nods in 2008-09.

SIX-TACULAR

High Point's **CHEYENNE PARKER** and **DEQUESA McCANAHAN** have each earned Big South Freshman of the Week honors six times this season. The pair step into some elite company as there have only been four players in the Big South to earn six plaquds, including current High Point Panther **SHAMIA BROWN** who picked up her six nods in 2008-09.

STYLE'N & PROFILE'N

Charleston Southern and Liberty set single-game records over the past couple of weeks. Liberty pulled down 65 rebounds in a win over Gardner-Webb on Feb. 12 to best the old standard of 63 held by Charleston Southern since 1992 ... Charleston Southern reset its single-game three point field goal mark as it canned 18 in the win over UNC Asheville on Feb. 19. The Bucs old standard of 17 was set against High Point on Feb. 2, 2009.

DOUBLE-TROUBLE

UNC Asheville's **KELLI RILES** and **EVERY WARLEY** of Liberty are the only two players in the League averaging a double-double. Riles is currently averaging 11.0 points and 10.2 rebounds per game, while Warley is posting 11.0 points and 10.7 boards per game. Warley also tops the Big South with 15 double-doubles on the season, while Riles is close behind her with 11.

MAKE'N THE GRADE

Coastal Carolina's **KATIE WHITE** and **MACKENZIE MAIER** from High Point each earned bids to the CoSIDA Academic All-District III teams. White was named to the first time while Maier was tabbed a second team selection. The honors also mark the seventh-straight year that the League has boasted at least one All-District honoree.

WE'RE THE ONLY ONES!!!

Coastal Carolina's **SYDNEI MOSS** and **MACKENZIE MAIER** are the only active players in the Big South with more than 1,000 points and 500 boards ... The milestone marks the first time since the 2008-09 season that the League has had two active players with 1,000 points and 500 boards.

BIG SOUTH TV NETWORK SCHEDULE

Five regular-season Big South games as well as the Semifinals and Finals of the Advance Auto Parts Women's Basketball Championship will be broadcast via the Big South Television Network (BSTN). The BSTN will utilize eight local, regional and national affiliates to carry some or all of the games this season, including seven nationally on Fox College Sports (FCS). WSET/RTV Channel 13.2 in Lynchburg/Roanoke will carry four games this season, with Liberty University's Flames Sports Network and WCWG-TV 20 in Greensboro/High Point/Winston-Salem both picking up two broadcasts. Charleston Southern's **KATIE TULL** took over the No. 1 spot all-time in career three-pointers on Jan. 24. She set the single-season record with 100 three-pointers last season and this season she poured in nine treys against Voorhees on Nov. 16. The nine triples set the CSU single game mark and was one off the Big South single game standard ... She currently has 72 on the season ... There are currently three other players in the Big South making their way up in the career three-pointers list. Here is a look at how they stack up:

The senior has finished ranked in the Top-10 in the Big South single-season blocks list in each of the past two seasons and holds the No. 2 position with 91 blocks during the 2009-10 campaign. She currently has 201 blocked shots in her career and is ranked No. 6 all-time... White has also become Coastal Carolina's career blocked shots leader.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern went 1-1 in their last two games inside Buccaneer Field House, moving them to 9-2 at home. The Bucs lost a close contest to Radford in OT, after **KELSEY WASMER** hit a three in the dying moments of regulation to send it to OT. CSU would rebound with a 54-51 win over Liberty at home. It was Charleston Southern's first victory over Liberty since a 66-60 win Jan. 18, 1999 at Buccaneer Field House. In that game, CSU overcame a 14-point first-half deficit to beat Liberty. Prior to tonight's win, Charleston Southern had lost 11 straight games to Liberty inside the friendly confines of the Buc Dome. Charleston Southern will play the third leg of their final home stand on Friday, Mar. 4 against Coastal Carolina. Tip-off for that game is scheduled for 7 p.m. They will then face Winthrop at home on Mar. 7 to close out Big South regular season play.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina went 0-2 on the week with losses at home to Liberty (64-44) and High Point (62-48)... The two games marked not only the final games at home in Kimbel Arena for the Chanticleers this season, but in program history as the Chants will move into the new Convocation Center next fall... Against Liberty **JESSICA NOLL** recorded a personal season-high with 15 point and four triples.... Her four made threes also tied Coastal season-high as she equaled **OLIVIA IRICK**'s output from deep at Radford on Jan. 29.... **SYDNEI MOSS** scored 15 points against High point marking the 14th time in 25 games that Moss has scored at least 10 points... With one regular season game and a minimum of one Big South tournament game remaining, **KATIE WHITE** sits four blocked shots away from breaking Coastal Carolina's single season blocks record of 66 that has stood since the 1980-81 season... The Chanticleers will wrap up its regular season with a trip to Charleston Southern on Friday, March 4.

GARDNER-WEBB

Gardner-Webb went 1-1 last week, picking up a 68-50 non-conference win over Longwood at home on Wednesday night, yet suffered a 73-65 loss to Presbyterian College in Clinton, S.C. on Saturday afternoon. GWU dominated the paint in the win over Longwood, outscoring the Lancers 38-20 in points in the paint and 19-8 in second chance points. GWU also outscored Longwood 31-9 in points off turnovers and 20-4 in fast break points. However, the Runnin' Bulldogs took a step back on Saturday afternoon, suffering a 73-65 loss at PC, snapping GWU's winning streak at four games. Presbyterian College shot 45.8 percent from the floor and was 25-of-33 from the free throw line, outscoring GWU by 13 points at the charity stripe. The Runnin' Bulldogs will look to wrap up its 2010-11 regular season slate this weekend, as GWU will host Winthrop on Friday night at 7 p.m. and Radford on Sunday afternoon at 3 p.m.

HIGH POINT

High Point won both its road games on the weekend with wins at Winthrop and Coastal Carolina to push its overall record back over .500 for the first time since early December. The Panthers used a stifling defense to hold both opponents to less than 50 points as the Eagles scored just 45 and Coastal Carolina notched just 48. Against Winthrop, High Point used a 13-0 run to take control of the contest late in the first half before ultimately winning, 57-45. Junior **SHAMIA BROWN** led HPU with 18 points in the win. HPU held Winthrop to just 29.5 percent shooting in the game. The Panthers then travelled to Coastal Carolina, picking up a 62-48 win over the Chanticleers. The two teams were tied at 12-12 midway through the first half when High Point went on an 18-0 run to take control. Brown and sophomore **ERIN REYNOLDS** each scored 14 points to lead HPU. High Point held CCU to just 29.7 percent shooting and blocked 13 shots. Senior **MACKENZIE MAIER** blocked six shots, giving her 14 on the weekend and 289 for her career. She is just three blocks shy of the Big South record for career blocks which is held by Radford's Kelli Darden.

LIBERTY

Liberty extended the seventh-longest active winning streak versus a single opponent in NCAA Division I women's basketball on Saturday, claiming its 35th straight win over Coastal Carolina ... However, the Lady Flames' 54-51 loss at Charleston Southern on Monday snapped a number of streaks ... Liberty had won nine straight games overall, nine straight road games, 15 straight road games against Big South opponents and 28 straight contests versus CSU, prior to Monday ... **AVERY WARLEY** pulled down a career-high 21 rebounds in the Charleston Southern game, which is the most by a Lady Flame since Dec. 4, 1992 and her second 20-rebound game this season ... During the weekend, Warley became the fourth Lady Flame ever to record 100 career blocked shots and the sixth Liberty player to reach 800 career rebounds ... **EMILY FRAZIER**'s career-high six steals at Coastal Carolina marked the first six- steal game by a Liberty freshman since Michelle Parker notched a half-dozen steals at American on Jan. 6, 2004.

PRESBYTERIAN

PC averaged 72 points per game at home last week while giving up 71.5 ... Freshman **KARLEE TAYLOR** scored 15 points in each of the last two games and went 14-14 from the FT line ... **SHONDA BURNSIDE** started both games, averaging 14 points and five rebounds ... **KRISTEN STEVENS** needs one 3pt FG to move into second place in PC's record books for made 3pt FG in a season (49) ... **AMANDA MILLS** needs one more 3pt FG to move into sole possession of third place in PC's record books for made 3pt FG in a career (151) ... The win over GWU marked **RONNY FISHER**'s 18th career win as a head coach.

RADFORD

Radford picked up a pair of crucial road wins at Charleston Southern and Presbyterian last week. The Highlanders shot 52 percent in both games, their third 50-plus percent shooting contest during conference play. In the PC game, **DA'NARIA ERWIN SPENCER** netted a career-high 30 points, becoming the first 30-point scorer for Radford since Feb. 10, 2007 when **KELLI DARDEN** dropped in 31 at Winthrop. The Highlanders also had four player score in double figures at PC for the first time this season. The 10 conference wins are the most since the 2007-08 season.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville only had one game this week, defeating Winthrop University 66-61 on Monday evening at Winthrop Coliseum in Big South Conference play. The win avenges a loss to the Lady Eagles on Jan. 22 with Winthrop earning a 71-64 decision at the Justice Center. The win was the second one in a row for the Bulldogs, who prior to that streak had lost four straight. Asheville is now 12-15 overall, 5-9 in the Big South, 5-10 at home and 7-5 on the road. The Bulldogs are also 1-7 in home conference games and 4-2 in Big South games on the road. Last Monday evening senior guard **KENDALL SHEPARD** reached 1,000 point for her career with the Bulldogs, the 13th player in Asheville history to do so. Last night fellow senior **LINDSEY MONTGOMERY** scored 15 points against the Lady Eagles, leaving her just nine points shy of 1,000 for her career. If Montgomery is able to score nine more points she will become the fifth Bulldog this season to do so. On the men's side John Williams, Matt Dickey and J.P. Primm all reached the 1,000-point plateau followed by Shepard last Monday. The Bulldogs will be on the road the rest of the season, playing at Liberty on Friday evening before closing out the regular season on Sunday at High Point. The Bulldogs currently lead the Big South in scoring offense with 68.8 points per game and free throw percentage with a mark of 70.2 percent.

WINTHROP

TAQUOIA HAMMICK recorded her second double-double of the season on Monday and the fourth double-figure rebounding game in the last five. She now has 381 career boards and at her current average should pass the 400 rebound mark. So far this season she's averaging 8.6 rebounds and has averaged 9.2 since missing a game with a knee injury. Winthrop lost its 10th home game on Monday, the most since the 2006-07 season, when the line-up was all freshmen and sophomores. It's not the school record as that was set in 1989-90, 1990-91, and 1992-93 under head coach Germaine McAuley. Winthrop is 4-5 on the road. **DEQUESA MCCLANAHAN** scored her third 20-point game of the season against Asheville on Monday. She now has 332 points on the season and is 30 points shy of Ashley Fann's freshman total of 362. She will be the first freshman to lead the team in scoring since Fann did in 2005-06.

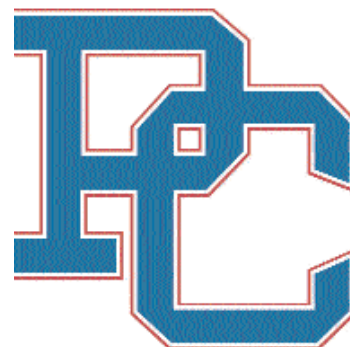
