Wasmer averaged 18.0 points and 7.5 rebounds per game to fuel her Bucs to a 2-0 record in League play last week. She got her week started with 23 points on 8-of-13 from the floor and 7-of-10 from downtown as Charleston Southern downed UNC Asheville on Feb. 19. She also chipped in six helpers, five rebounds, two blocks and a steal in the victory. Two days later at Presbyterian College, the guard posted a 13 point, 10 rebound double-double in addition to one steal and an assist. She finished the two-game span with a 57 percent stroke from the floor and a 62 percent clip from downtown. The honor marks her first Big South Player of the Week nod this season.

McClanahan shot 50 percent from the floor and averaged 13.0 points per game as Winthrop finished with a 1-1 record in League play last week. In the win over Presbyterian College on Feb. 19, McClanahan poured in 14 points on 56 percent from the field, two from long range and two from the line as well as three boards and three assists. At Radford on Feb. 21, she finished with 12 points, a 45 percent clip from the floor, four assists, two caroms and two steals. The honor marks her sixth Big South Freshman of the Week as she becomes just the fourth player in League history to earn the honor six times in a season.

SIX-TACULAR

High Point's **CHEYENNE PARKER** and **DEQUESHA McCANAHAN** have each earned Big South Freshman of the Week honors six times this season. The pair step into some elite company as there have only been four players in the Big South to earn six plaquidts, including current High Point Panther **SHAMIA BROWN** who picked up her six nods in 2008-09.

STYLE'N & PROFILE'N

Charleston Southern and Liberty set single-game records over the past couple of weeks. Liberty pulled down 65 rebounds in a win over Gardner-Webb on Feb. 12 to best the old standard of 63 held by Charleston Southern since 1992 ... Charleston Southern reset its single-game three point field goal mark as it canned 18 in the win over UNC Asheville on Feb. 19. The Bucs old standard of 17 was set against High Point on Feb. 2, 2009.

RACE TO THE TOP

Liberty, Gardner-Webb and Radford are each battling it out for the top spot heading into the upcoming Advance Auto Parts Big South Championship. A win by Liberty on Saturday would seal the deal for the No. 1 seed in the race with the Runnin' Bulldogs even if Gardner-Webb wins out, as Liberty owns the regular-season tiebreaker ... If the Highlanders win both games and Liberty picks up two wins this week, Liberty would clinch the No. 1 seed ... Note: If two teams are tied for the top spot, the League will declare Co-Regular-Season Champions.

DOUBLE-TROUBLE

UNC Asheville's **KELLI RILES** and **AVERY WARLEY** of Liberty are the only two players in the League averaging a double-double. Riles is currently averaging 11.3 points and 10.4 rebounds per game, while Warley is posting 11.1 points and 10.4 boards per game. Each player has posted one game this season with at least 20 rebounds, with Riles holding the season standard at 22. Warley also tops the Big South with 15 double-doubles on the season, while Riles is close behind her with 11.

MAKE'N THE GRADE

Coastal Carolina's **KATIE WHITE** and **MACKENZIE MAIER** from High Point each earned bids to the CoSIDA Academic All-District III teams. White was named to the first time while Maier was tabbed a second team selection. The honors also mark the seventh-straight year that the League has boasted at least one All-District honoree.

WE'RE THE ONLY ONES!!!

Coastal Carolina's **SYDNEI MOSS** and **MACKENZIE MAIER** are the only active players in the Big South with more than 1,000 points and 500 boards ... The milestone marks the first time since the 2008-09 season that the League has had two active players with 1,000 points and 500 boards.

BIG SOUTH TV NETWORK SCHEDULE

Five regular-season Big South games as well as the Semifinals and Finals of the Advance Auto Parts Women's Basketball Championship will be broadcast via the Big South Television Network (BSTN). The BSTN will utilize eight local, regional and national affiliates to carry some or all of the games this season, including seven nationally on Fox College Sports (FCS). WSET/RTV Channel 13.2 in Lynchburg/Roanoke will carry four games this season, with Liberty University's Flames Sports Network and WCWG-TV 20 in Greensboro/High Point/Winston-Salem both picking up two broadcasts. Other affiliates airing Big South women's basketball are WMBF News XTRA in Conway/Myrtle Beach, WMMP MyTV in Charleston, S.C., WMYA My 40 in Greenville/Asheville/Spartanburg and WTAT-Fox 24 in Charleston, S.C. Charleston Southern's **KATIE TULL** took over the No. 1 spot all-time in career three-pointers on Jan. 24. She set the single-season record with 100 three-pointers last season and this season she poured in nine treys against Voorhees on Nov. 16. The nine triples set the CSU single game mark and was one off the Big South single game standard ... She currently has 72 on the season ... There are currently three other players in the Big South making their way up in the career three-pointers list. Here is a look at how they stack up:

MACKENZIE MAIER is currently ranked No. 2 all-time in the Big South record book with 275 career rejections. She needs 18 blocks to take hold of the No. 1 position held by former Radford center **KELLI DARDEN**. The senior has finished ranked in the Top-10 in the Big South single-season blocks list in each of the past two seasons and holds the No. 2 position with 91 blocks during the 2009-10 campaign. Her 10 blocks vs. Campbell on Dec. 2 tied the Big South single-game record ... Also making her way up the list is **KATIE WHITE** from Coastal Carolina. She currently has 198 blocked shots in her career and is ranked No. 6 all-time... White has also become Coastal Carolina's career blocked shots leader.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern gets two Big South wins on the road over Asheville and Presbyterian. Against Asheville, the Bucs broke the Big South record for three point field goals made in a game with 18, a record they previously owned themselves. CSU set that record set last season at High Point, on Feb. 9, 2010, when they made 17 from beyond the arc. The Bucs were unconscious from three point land in the first half. Eleven of their 18 three point makes came in the opening frame. After a disappointing outing against High Point in which she was held scoreless for the first time in her CSU career, senior guard **KELSEY WASMER** responded and led the Buccaneers with 23 points on the night. She shot an astounding 7-of-10 from beyond the arc. Charleston Southern's point total of 98 was the third highest scoring output in CSU women's basketball history, and the program record for the most points ever scored in a Big South Conference game.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina fell in both games on the week losing 58-36 to Gardner-Webb and 64-67 to UNC Asheville... The Chanticleers struggled from the field against Gardner-Webb, but improved drastically against Asheville to shoot 50 percent for the game, its highest shooting percentage of the Big South season... **SYDNEI MOSS** and **ANGELICA HENRY** led the Chants in points in the games as each dropped 17.... **JESSICA NOLL** continued to be Coastal's sharpshooter from the perimeter as she went 4-of-7 from three point land... Against Asheville, Coastal's bench produced a season-high 41 points as **NOLL** and **TAYLOR EPLY** led the way with 11 and 10 point respectively... The Chanticleers, who will move into the new Convocation Center next season, return home to Kimbel Arena for the final time in program history to host Liberty on Saturday, Feb. 26 and High Point on Monday, Feb. 28.

GARDNER-WEBB

The Runnin' Bulldogs had two very strong performances last week, as GWU held its opponents to an average of 48 points per game, while scoring on average 63 points and shooting a stellar clip of 44.8 percent en route to a 2-0 week. Gardner-Webb used a total team effort on both ends of the floor in Saturday's 58-36 win over Coastal Carolina, as GWU had nine different players score in the contest and held the Chanticleers to only 19 percent shooting in the second half of play. Gardner-Webb shot over 50 percent for the game, while holding the Chanticleers offense to only 13 made field goals for the entire 40 minutes of play. In GWU's home win over High Point on Monday night, the Runnin' Bulldogs overcame the Panther's nine three-pointers by way of the paint and dribble drive to come away with the 68-60 win. Gardner-Webb shot over 40 percent for the game and outscored High Point 44-22 in points in the paint. GWU also out-rebounded High Point 54-35 for the contest and tallied 13 team assists in the win. **MONIQUE HUDSON** posted a career-high 26 points to lead GWU, while **SANDRA VAITKUTE** and **DOMINIQUE HUDSON** had 18 and 13 points apiece, respectively. GWU has won three in a row and will step out of conference play for its next tilt, a 7 p.m. contest with Longwood on Wednesday night in Paul Porter Arena. Then GWU will play its final road game of the regular season on Saturday, as the Runnin' Bulldogs will take on PC in Clinton, S.C. at 5 p.m.

HIGH POINT

High Point played Gardner-Webb close in the team's only game of the week but could not take the lead in the second half. The Panthers managed to tie the game six times in the second half but could never move ahead. Junior **SHAMIA BROWN** had 14 points and six rebounds in the game for HPU while senior **LATEISHA DEAN** finished with 13 and senior **JURICA HARGRAVES** had 11. Senior **MACKENZIE MAIER** led High Point with seven rebounds and five assists.

LIBERTY

Liberty posted a 66-50 victory at Radford on Saturday, meaning the Lady Flames will carry several winning streaks into their final road trip of the regular season ... Liberty has won eight straight games overall, eight straight road games, 14 straight road games against Big South opponents, 28 straight matchups against Charleston Southern and 34 straight contests versus Coastal Carolina ... **EVERY WARLEY** and **DEVON BROWN** both achieved career milestones during the Lady Flames' triumph at Radford ... Warley became the 14th Lady Flame ever to score 900 career points ... She needs only two more rebounds to become the sixth Lady Flame to join the 800-career rebound club ... Meanwhile, Brown is the fourth sophomore in program history to reach the 800-career point plateau ... Liberty is 4-0 in February, improving to 101-6 in its last 107 February contests.

PRESBYTERIAN

PC is currently on a three-game losing streak and two games into a four-game home stand ... **AMANDA MILLS** averaged 11 points per game last week ... **MARIAH PIETROWSKI** went 10-14 from the charity stripe last week but only two of 14 from the field ... Mills scored her 700th career point for PC last game (ranks first in the DI era) ... Mills is one three-pointer away from tying for third all-time on the PC's career list (150 total) ... **KRISTEN STEVENS** is two three-pointers away from tying for second on PC's single season list (48 total).

RADFORD

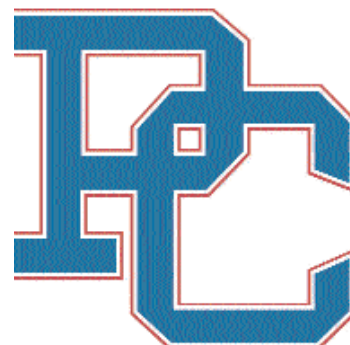
