Warley averaged 13.0 points and 16.0 rebounds to lead Liberty to a 2-0 record in Big South play last week. The center got her week started with 10 points and 20 rebounds as the Lady Flames downed Gardner-Webb on Feb. 12. Two days later against Winthrop, she poured in 16 points on 60 percent from the field and 4-of-5 from the line. Warley also ripped down 12 rebounds and posted two blocks and one assist in the win. The two double-doubles ran her season mark to 14 double-doubles on the year.

Parker averaged 9.5 points per game and shot 47 percent from the field to help the Panthers pick up two Big South wins last week. Against Charleston Southern on Feb. 12, Parker notched 10 points to go along with six rebounds, one block and one helper. She followed that effort with nine points and 17 rebounds as well as five blocks, 3 assists and two steals in the win over Presbyterian College on Feb. 14. The honor marks her sixth Freshman of the Week selection as she becomes just the third player in League history to earn the plaudit six times in a season.

HEADLINE'N

High Point's **CHEYENNE PARKER** earned her sixth Big South Freshman of the Week honor of Feb. 14. Her sixth nod makes her just the third player in League history to earn six plaquidts, including teammate **SHAMIA BROWN** who picked up her six nods in 2008-09.

DOUBLE-TROUBLE

UNC Asheville's **KELLI RILES** and **AVERY WARLEY** of Liberty are the only two players in the League averaging a double-double. Riles is currently averaging 11.4 points and 10.3 rebounds per game, while Warley is posting 10.8 points and 10.2 boards per game. Each player has posted one game this season with at least 20 rebounds, with Riles holding the season standard at 22. Warley also tops the Big South with 14 double-doubles on the season, while Riles is close behind her with 13.

CINCO DE FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK-O

Winthrop's **DEQUESHA MCCLANAHAN** is just one of seven players in Big South Conference history to earn at least five Big South Freshman of the Week accolades.

MAKE'N THE GRADE

Coastal Carolina's **KATIE WHITE** and **MACKENZIE MAIER** from High Point each earned bids to the CoSIDA Academic All-District III teams. White was named to the first time while Maier was tabbed a second team selection. The honors also mark the seventh-straight year that the League has boasted at least one All-District honoree.

Coastal Carolina's **SYDNEI MOSS** and **MACKENZIE MAIER** are the only active players in the Big South with more than 1,000 points and 500 boards ... The milestone marks the first time since the 2008-09 season that the League has had two active players with 1,000 points and 500 boards.

BIG SOUTH TV NETWORK SCHEDULE

Gardner-Webb Head Coach **RICK REEVES** passed a milestone on Dec. 5 and 7th as his Runnin' Bulldogs went 2-0. The two wins gave Reeves his 100th win at Gardner-Webb.

2 AIN'T ENOUGH JACK, YOU BETTER MAKE IT 3

Charleston Southern's **KATIE TULL** took over the No. 1 spot all-time in career three-pointers on Jan. 24. She set the single-season record with 100 three-pointers last season and this season she poured in nine treys against Voorhees on Nov. 16. The nine triples set the CSU single game mark and was one off the Big South single game standard ... She currently has 72 on the season ... There are currently three other players in the Big South making their way up in the career three-pointers list. Here is a look at how they stack up:

MACKENZIE MAIER is currently ranked No. 2 all-time in the Big South record book with 272 career rejections. She needs 21 blocks to take hold of the No. 1 position held by former Radford center **KELLI DARDEN**. The senior has finished ranked in the Top-10 in the Big South single-season blocks list in each of the past two seasons and holds the No. 2 position with 91 blocks during the 2009-10 campaign. Her 10 blocks vs. Campbell on Dec. 2 tied the Big South single-game record ... Also making her way up the list is **KATIE WHITE** from Coastal Carolina. She currently has 198 blocked shots in her career and is ranked No. 6 all-time ... White has also become Coastal Carolina's career blocked shots leader.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Charleston Southern Buccaneers fell to the High Point Panthers at a score of 68-54. The loss drops CSU to an overall record of 10-13 (4-6, BSC). Leading the Bucs was senior guard **KATIE TULL** who had 19 points on the night. The loss takes the Buccaneers out of a tie with High Point for fourth in the Big South conference standings, and moves them into fifth place alone. The Buccaneers will play the second leg of their three game road swing next Saturday when they will travel to Asheville, N.C. to take on the Bulldogs of UNC Asheville who the Bucs defeated earlier this season at Buccaneer Field House at a score of 85-74.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina split its two games on the week losing to Winthrop 64-48 and defeating Radford 55-54... The Chanticleers have now won three of its last four games, all of which have been against conference opponents... On the week **SYDNEI MOSS** averaged a double-double with 18 points and 10 rebounds per game... Against Radford the Chants shot a 78.6 percent from the free throw line, a high in conference games this season, with **OLIVIA IRICK** leading the way as she was a perfect 10-of-10... Coastal's victory of Radford was the first time this season the Chants had won despite trailing at the half... The Chanticleers are on the road this week with games at Gardner-Webb (Saturday) and UNC Asheville (Monday).

GARDNER-WEBB

The Runnin' Bulldogs played to a 1-1 split on the week and finished its three-game road trip at 2-1 with the lone loss coming at Liberty on Saturday night. Gardner-Webb was out-rebounded 65-34 and saw Liberty shoot 31 free throws compared to its 11 for the game, yet found themselves in the contest until the end in which Liberty held on for a 56-51 home win. Gardner-Webb bounced back with a solid team effort at UNCA on Monday night, holding off a hot-shooting Asheville team to come away with a 68-65 road conference win, their fifth road conference win of the season. In the win on Monday night at UNCA, **MONIQUE HUDSON** scored her 1,000th career point, becoming only the 16th player in GWU women's basketball 36 year history to do so. Monique joined her sister, **DOMINIQUE**, who scored her 1,000th career point back in November. The Hudson sisters became the fifth set of siblings in Big South history to each score 1,000 career points and only the second set of siblings to reach that feat in the same season. Earlier in the week, in the loss to Liberty, Dominique made history of her own, dishing out her 500th career assist, the first Runnin' Bulldog to reach that feat in GWU's Division I history. The Runnin' Bulldogs sit at 7-4 and in third place in the conference standings heading into a three-game home stand which includes games versus Coastal Carolina and High Point next week.

HIGH POINT

The High Point University women's basketball team used great defense and a balanced offensive attack to pick up wins over Charleston Southern and Presbyterian College and move back to .500 on the season. High Point held both its opponents to less than 60 points and had five players average at least 9.5 points per game in the two wins. Against the Lady Buccaneers, HPU limited the usually free-shooting CSU squad to just four three pointers on the way to a 68-54 win. HPU held **KELSEY WASMER** scoreless and had four players finish in double figures, led by senior **JURICA HARGRAVES** who scored 14. The Panthers then followed that performance with a shutdown effort against PC. High Point held the Blue Hose to just 12 points in the second half, outscoring them 47-12 after halftime. HPU limited PC to just 4-24 shooting, forced 11 second half turnovers and blocked six shots. **SHAMIA BROWN** scored 17 to lead four players in double figures for High Point while freshman **CHEYENNE PARKER** pulled down a career-high 17 boards and blocked five shots.

LIBERTY

Liberty has won a season-high seven games in a row and is 12-1 in its last 13 outings ... At 16-8, the Lady Flames have clinched their 15th consecutive winning season ... Liberty outrebounded Gardner-Webb 65-34 on Saturday, marking the Lady Flames' largest rebound margin (+31) against a Big South opponent since Feb. 19, 2007, when Liberty had 34 more rebounds than Charleston Southern ... **EVERY WARLEY** grabbed a career-high 20 rebounds versus Gardner-Webb, making her the first Lady Flame to notch a 20-rebound game since Theresa Bream's 23-rebound effort against St. Peter's on Dec. 4, 1992 ... Liberty is 100-6 in its last 106 games played during the month of February ... **DEVON BROWN** is only four points away from becoming the fourth Lady Flame ever to reach 800 career points during her sophomore season.

PRESBYTERIAN

PC went 1-1 on the road last week, giving up 23 ppg higher than their season average. Entering the games, opponents averaged 53.8 ppg, but UNCA and HPU averaged 76.5 ppg. **MARIAH PIETROWSKI** averaged a double-double (15 pts, 10 rebs). **KARLEE TAYLOR** set new career-highs against UNCA by scoring on 6-of-12 3pt FG shooting, scoring 21 points, 7 rebounds, and 8 assists in the 74-68 win. PC swept a conference opponent for the first time since joining the Big South. The game was also broadcast on WMY40, making it the first tv game win since moving to Division I.

RADFORD

Radford looks to snap its first losing streak of the conference season when it wraps up the home portion of its schedule on Saturday and Monday against Liberty and Winthrop. The Highlanders will recognize its senior class of **KAYLYN CROSIER**, **CIARA HAYES**, **BROOKE MCELROY** and **DENAY WOOD** prior to the contest against the Lady Flames. It will also be Radford's annual Pink Zone game which is part of the WBCA's initiative to spread awareness about the fight against breast cancer. In RU's lone game against Coastal Carolina, McElroy matched a career-high with 15 rebounds, her seven double figure game on the glass this season.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville went 0-3 on the week with losses to Big South foes Presbyterian College and Gardner-Webb with a loss to non-conference opponent Longwood. The Bulldogs are also 0-5 at home in Big South Conference games. Senior guard **KENDALL SHEPARD** is now just 15 points away from reaching 1,000 for her career after scoring 46 points over three contests this past week. She now stands at 985. Fellow upperclassman **LINDSEY MONTGOMERY** is also chasing the 1,000-point plateau as she has accumulated 942 for her career. Asheville is now tied for first in points per game in the Big South with High Point as both teams are averaging 68.5 ppg. The Bulldogs lead the league in free throw percentage with a mark of 70.6 percent and are second in field goal percentage shooting 40.8 percent on the season. The Blue & White will host conference foes Charleston Southern and Coastal Carolina this week. Asheville defeated the Chanticleers on Jan. 15 before falling to the Lady Buccaneers on Jan. 17. These will be the last to home games of the season for the Bulldogs, who finish out the year with three consecutive road contests.

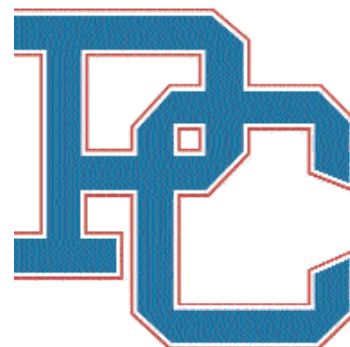
