**UNC ASHEVILLE SCORES COME BACK WIN TO ADVANCE IN 2011 NCAA TOURNAMENT**

The first school to punch its ticket to the 2011 "Big Dance" was the first team to win in the NCAA Tournament this year. **MATT DICKEY** hit a game-tying three-pointer with 10 seconds left in regulation, and UNC Asheville eventually pulled out an 81-77 overtime win over Arkansas-Little Rock Tuesday night in the first round of the NCAA Tournament. The Bulldogs advance to the second round against No. 1 seed Pittsburgh. The Big South is 1-1 against current BIG EAST members in the NCAA Tournament.

**UNC ASHEVILLE MAKES BIG SOUTH HISTORY WITH NCAA TOURNAMENT VICTORY**

UNC Asheville is now the first program in Big South Conference history to win two NCAA Tournament games. The Bulldogs were the first Conference member to win an NCAA Tournament game back in 2003 when Asheville won the Opening Round contest against Texas Southern -- which was also in overtime and also in Dayton. Head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** is now 2-1 in the NCAA Tournament and is the only Big South head coach with two NCAA wins in League history.

**JUNIOR 15**

UNC Asheville juniors **MATT DICKEY** and **J.P. PRIMM** each scored 22 points in Tuesday's NCAA Tournament first round overtime victory over Arkansas-Little Rock, marking the 14th time this season the duo has scored at least 15 points in the same game. The Bulldogs are 10-4 in those contests, with the losses coming at the hands of nationally-ranked North Carolina and Georgetown, as well as a two-point double-overtime loss at USC Upstate and a one-point setback against Northeastern in the Sears BracketBusters. The duo has reached the 15-point threshold in the same game 19 times since arriving on campus in 2008-09, and Asheville is 14-5 in those games.

**STEADY EDDIE**

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH**, who recorded his 200th career win at Asheville with the Bulldogs' 86-57 victory over Montreat College on Dec. 11, is the Big South's all-time winningest coach for overall wins (216) and Big South victories (128). Biedenbach is 245-282 in 18 years as a collegiate head coach.

**JOHN WILLIAMS' BUILDING BLOCKS**

UNC Asheville redshirt-senior **JOHN WILLIAMS** is just the third player in Big South history with 1,000 career points, 600 career rebounds and 250 career blocked shots. With career totals of 1,164 points, 676 rebounds and 252 career blocks (third all-time in Big South history), Williams joins Liberty's **PETER ALUMA** (1,715 points, 682 rebounds, 366 blocks) and Radford's **TYRONE TRAVIS** (1,313 points, 718 rebounds, 215 blocks) in this elite group. Williams also is one of 27 players in League annals with 1,000 points and 600 rebounds.

**UNC ASHEVILLE CAPTURES 2011 BIG SOUTH TOURNAMENT TITLE**

The No. 3 seed UNC Asheville Bulldogs defeated No. 1-seeded Coastal Carolina, 60-47 in the Big South Tournament Championship Game to the advance to the NCAA Tournament. It is Asheville's second berth in the Big Dance, as well as its third overall Big South Tournament title. UNC Asheville is the second consecutive No. 3 seed to win the Big South Tournament and the third No. 3 seed in League history, joining the 1992 Campbell Camels and 2010 Winthrop Eagles.

**POSTSEASON MOVES**

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** is the fourth coach in Big South Conference history to make two appearances in the NCAA Tournament, and is the third to have at least three postseason berths. Biedenbach and the Bulldogs advanced to the 2003 NCAA Tournament, and in 2008, UNC Asheville was the Big South's first-ever participant in the NIT. Meanwhile, Biedenbach improved his Big South Tournament career record to 17-13, the second-most Conference Tournament wins in League history.

**BIG SOUTH SENDS MULTIPLE TEAMS TO POSTSEASON FOR FOURTH-STRAIGHT YEAR**

For the fourth consecutive year, the Big South Conference had two men's basketball teams playing in the postseason in the same year. UNC Asheville received the League's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament, while Coastal Carolina was the Conference's third participant in the NIT and the first to make two appearances in the long-running event. Last season, the Big South had a team in the NAAs (Winthrop) and NIT (Coastal Carolina). In 2008-09, it was Radford (NAAs) and Liberty (*Collegeinsider.com* Postseason Tournament), and in 2007-08, the Big South had participants in the NCAA Tournament (Winthrop) and NIT (UNC Asheville).

**COASTAL CAROLINA'S SEASON ENDS IN FIRST ROUND OF NIT**

Big South regular-season champion Coastal Carolina lost in the first round of the NIT to No. 1 overall seed Alabama, 68-44, Tuesday night in Tuscaloosa. **ANTHONY RAFFA** and **CHAD GRAY** led the squad with 10 points each, but the Chanticleers were held to season-lows in points and field goals made.

**BIG SOUTH IN THE NCAA TOURNAMENT**

The Big South Conference first secured an automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament in 1992, sending its postseason tournament champion to the Big Dance every year, with the exception of 1995.

Winthrop garnered the League's highest seed at No. 11 in 2007. Below is a look at the Conference's NCAA Tournament history through last season:

**THREE (BULL)DOG NIGHT**

UNC Asheville's **JOHN WILLIAMS** (1,164), **MATT DICKEY** (1,209) and **J.P. PRIMM** (1,151) scored their 1,000th career point in 2010-11, marking the third time in Conference history that a Big South team had three players reach the scoring milestone in the same season. Coastal Carolina was the first in 1990-91 (**BRIAN PENNY**, **ROBERT DOWDELL**, **DuWAYNE CHEATAM**) and Radford was the last in 2001-02 (**RAYMOND ARRINGTON**, **ANDREY SAVTCHENKO**, **CORREY WATKINS**).

**BLOCK OF AGES**

UNC Asheville redshirt-senior **JOHN WILLIAMS** blocked a Big South Championship Game-record six shots against Coastal Carolina, breaking the previous record of five blocked shots that was accomplished three times. Campbell's **HENRY WILSON** was the first to do so in the 1987 title game against Charleston Southern, followed by Liberty's **PETER ALUMA** against Campbell in 1994 and Radford's **CHRIS McEACHIN** against VMI in 2009.

**ALL ABOUT THE NUMBER 10**

UNC Asheville recorded its fourth consecutive season with at least 10 Big South wins, becoming just the second Big South team to accomplish this feat in four consecutive years. Winthrop holds the record of nine-straight seasons with at least 10 Big South wins from 1999-08.

**BIG SOUTH OWNS THREE WINS OVER THE SEC, TWO OVER THE ACC**

The Big South enjoyed some monumental non-Conference success in the regular-season, as the League captured three wins over the SEC and two over the ACC. UNC Asheville (at Auburn), Coastal Carolina (at LSU) and Presbyterian College (at Auburn) won at SEC venues, giving the Big South Conference three wins against the SEC for the first time since 1993-94. That season, the Conference had wins over LSU and South Carolina (twice). Meanwhile, both Winthrop and Presbyterian College won at Wake Forest, the League's first multi-win season against the ACC since 2007-08. The Big South Conference has recorded wins over members from the Atlantic Coast Conference and the Southeastern Conference in the same season now for the third time in the last four years.

**GRAND STRAND**

Coastal Carolina has gone 56-13 the past two seasons, establishing the Big South record for most wins in back-to-back years. Winthrop set the previous all-time mark of 52 combined wins from 2005-07. The Eagles won 23 games in 2005-06 and followed with a League-record 29 victories in 2006-07. The Chanticleers are the first team in Big South history to win 25 games in consecutive campaigns, and their 28 wins this season are second-most in a single-season in Big South history. Coastal Carolina also tied its League mark for most wins before the Conference Tournament (26).

**ROADIES**

Coastal Carolina will carry a school-record 10-consecutive Big South road game win streak into next season. In addition, the Chanticleers were the first team in League history to win five Big South road games by at least 20 points -- bettering Asheville's record of three that was established earlier this season. Coastal won by 22 at VMI (Jan. 6), 21 at UNC Asheville (Jan. 20), 24 at High Point (Jan. 27), 23 at Radford (Jan. 29) and 20 at Presbyterian (Feb. 10). The Chanticleers were also just the second team in League history to go 9-0 in Big South road contests. Radford was the first in 2008-09.

**McSWATTY**

Coastal Carolina redshirt-sophomore **SAM McLAURIN**, who became the 26th player in Big South history with 100 career blocked shots when he reached the milestone Feb. 10 at Presbyterian College, is 21st in League history with 119 in his career. McLaurin, who is the third Chanticleer in Conference annals to reach the century mark in rejections, blocked a school-record 60 shots this season.

**COASTAL CAROLINA TOOK OVER NATION'S LONGEST WINNING STREAK DURING 2010-11**

Coastal Carolina's Big South- and school-record 22-game win streak ended Feb. 15 with a 59-57 home loss to Gardner-Webb, which was the longest win streak in the nation at the time. Also ending was Coastal's 19 consecutive regular-season Big South win streak, which was the second-longest Conference-game win streak in League annals. Winthrop still owns that top spot with 21 consecutive Big South wins from Jan. 8, 2005 to Jan. 21, 2006.

**CHANTICLEERS SET TWO LEAGUE RECORDS FOR CONFERENCE WINS**

Coastal Carolina went 16-2 in Conference play this season, setting the League mark for most Big South wins in a single-season. The previous record was 15 Big South victories, which was accomplished four times. Former member Towson State was the first in 1993-94, followed by Winthrop (2004-05), Radford (2008-09) and Coastal Carolina in 2009-10. This season, Coastal Carolina was the first team in League history to start 15-0 in Big South play, breaking the Conference record for best League start that was established by the 2006-07 Winthrop Eagles (14-0). That season, Winthrop swept through a 14-game Conference slate.

**ELLIS' POSTSEASON APPEARANCE TALLY NOW AT 21**

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** made his 21st career postseason appearance when the Chanticleers played in the NIT. He now has 13 NIT berths along with eight NCAA Tournament bids to his credit. Ellis recorded his 11th career 20-win season at the Division I level this season, and 14th overall. The 10th active coach and 26th overall to win 600 career Division I games, Ellis has directed four different Division I programs to at least two 20-win campaigns during his tenure, and owns six seasons with at least 25 wins. Ellis is 614-385 at the Division I level and 692-397 overall in 35 years as a head coach, including 80-48 ( =62.5 percent) in four seasons at Coastal Carolina. He has been named Coach of the Year in four difference Conferences (Sun Belt, ACC, SEC, Big South) and six times overall.

**BIG SOUTH TOURNAMENT RECAP**

For the first time since 2007, a lower-seeded team advanced to the Semifinals of the Big South Tournament as No. 7-seeded High Point upset No. 2 seed Liberty in the Quarterfinals, 66-60. The Panthers were the first No. 7 seed to reach the League's final four since Charleston Southern in 2005. It was also High Point's first Semifinal appearance since 2008. Tournament Champion UNC Asheville advanced to the Semifinals for the fifth consecutive year, becoming the first Big South team to achieve this feat since High Point from 2004-08. Meanwhile, the No. 1 seed reached the title game for the eighth-straight year, and the Championship Game featured No. 1-vs.-No. 3 for just the fifth time. In addition, UNC Asheville and Coastal Carolina met in the Finals for the second time, but the first time in 21 years. The teams are now 1-1 when meeting in the Championship Game.

**SEVERAL FIRSTS AROUND THIS YEAR'S HARDWARE**

The Big South's major postseason awards for 2010-11 have a first time theme, as Liberty was honored with the Player of the Year (**JESSE SANDERS**) and Coach of the Year (**DALE LAYER**) trophies for the first time as members of the Conference. In addition, VMI had its first Big South Freshman of the Year (**D.J. COVINGTON**) since joining the Big South in 2003, and Charleston Southern had its first Defensive Player of the Year (**KELVIN MARTIN**) honoree in the award's six-year history. Presbyterian College represented the Men's Basketball Scholar-Athlete of the Year (**WALT ALLEN**) for the first time as well.

**LENDING A HELPING HAND**

Liberty junior guard **JESSE SANDERS** is 11th all-time in Big South history with 472 career assists, and needs 28 to become the 11th player with 500. UNC Asheville junior guard **J.P. PRIMM** is 14th in League annals with 462 career assists and needs seven to move into the 13th spot (Winthrop's **TYSON WATERMAN**, 469).

**ANOTHER BROWN LEADING LIBERTY**

Liberty newcomer and redshirt-junior **JOHN BROWN** leads the Big South with 10.8 rebounds a game, becoming the first Flame to average double-digit rebounds since Liberty joined the Big South Conference in 1991-92. The last Liberty player to average at least 10 rebounds per game an entire season was **MIKE COLEMAN** in 1990-91 (10.1). Meanwhile, Brown will be the first Liberty player to lead the Conference in rebounding since **LEO LIGHTBOURNE** in 2004-05. Brown also is the first newcomer to finish as the Big South's top rebounder since High Point's **DANNY GATHINGS** in 2002-03.

**MY FAVORITE MARTIN**

Charleston Southern junior forward **KELVIN MARTIN** scored his 1,000th career point during the Buccaneers' Big South Quarterfinal game at UNC Asheville, becoming the 27th player in League history with 1,000 career points (1,007) and 600 career rebounds (687). He will enter his senior season of 2011-12 needing 13 boards to become the 20th player with 1,000 points and 700 rebounds. Martin will also have an outside chance next season of becoming the third Big South player in history with 1,000 points and 1,000 rebounds.

**RADICAL**

Radford sophomore **BLAKE SMITH** leads the Big South in steals per game with 2.44, becoming the first Highlander to lead the Big South in the category since **ANTHONY WALKER** in 1995-96. Smith is the third Radford player overall to accomplish this feat.

**NO. 5 IS NUMBER 7**

Charleston Southern senior guard **JAMARCO WARREN** ended his career seventh on the Big South's all-time scoring list with 1,968 points. He is one of seven players in League history with 1,900 career markers, and he closed out his career with five consecutive 20-point games, averaging 24.2 points per game in that span.

**ALL-TIME SCORERS**

Six players entered the Big South's 1,000 career point chart this season, most recently Charleston Southern's **KELVIN MARTIN**, who became the 105th member on March 1. The single-season record for most players entering the Conference's 1,000-point club is eight during the 2007-08 campaign. ### **PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE SCORES BCS DOUBLE**

Presbyterian College is the second team in Big South Conference history to defeat an SEC team and ACC team in the same season, as the Blue Hose did it in back-to-back games! PC first knocked off the Auburn Tigers, 62-59, on Dec. 18 and then won at Wake Forest, 66-64 on Dec. 20. Former (and returning) member Campbell was the first Big South member to achieve the feat. In 1993-94, the Camels defeated North Carolina State (72-69) and South Carolina (73-72).

### **WARREN SECOND BIG SOUTH PLAYER WITH 300 3FG-300 ASSISTS-150 STEALS**

Charleston Southern senior **JAMARCO WARREN** ends his career one of two players in Big South history with 300 career three-point field goals (337), 300 career assists (336) and 150 career steals (153). He joins VMI's **CHAVIS HOLMES** (306 3FG, 313 AST and 304 STL) in the club. Warren is one of four players all-time with 300 career treys and 300 career helpers, as Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** (411 3FG, 353 AST), and UNC Greensboro's **SCOTT HARTZELL** (309 3FG, 552 AST) also reached those totals.

### **BOARD MEETING**

Gardner-Webb's **JOSH HENLEY** became the 21st player in Big South history to grab 700 career rebounds when he reached the milestone in the regular-season finale against High Point. The junior is 20th in League annals with 702 boards. In addition, Winthrop's **CHARLES CORBIN** concludes his career with 648 rebounds, good for 31st all-time, while Charleston Southern's **KELVIN MARTIN** is currently 23rd in League history with 687 career rebounds. UNC Asheville's **JOHN WILLIAMS** enters the second round of the NCAA Tournament with 676 rebounds in his career with the Bulldogs, which ranks 25th in the Conference's record books.

### **DO THE CHARLESTON**

Charleston Southern won 16 games for the first time since 1996-97 (17 wins), and won nine Big South contests for the first time since going 9-5 in League play in 1995-96.

### **SCOREBOARD WATCHING**

VMI leads both the Big South and the nation in scoring offense at 87.8 points a game, and is attempting to finish as the country's top scoring offense for an unprecedented fifth-straight year. VMI led the nation in scoring offense in 2009-10 for the fourth consecutive season, becoming the first team in NCAA Division I history to lead the country in scoring offense four consecutive years. The Keydets are the first Conference member to lead the Big South in scoring five consecutive years, surpassing Radford (1995-99) as the only programs to lead four-straight seasons.

### **BIG SOUTH SEPARATION**

Of the 90 Big South games this season, 53 had winning margins of less than 10 points (=57.8 percent), including 21 that were decided by three points-or-less. However, the overall Conference season had an average margin of victory of 10.48 points. Last year, the overall margin of victory in League play was 10.51 points, while the 2008-09 average margin was 8.96 points. Meanwhile, in the 37 Big South games decided by double digits this season, the average margin of victory was 18.59 points, while the 53 games decided by less than 10 points had an average victory margin of 4.81 points.

### **SEASON SWEEPS**

Of the 45 Conference series this season, 24 resulted in season sweeps (=53.3 percent). Coastal Carolina led the way with seven, followed by Liberty (5), UNC Asheville (3) and VMI (3). Last season, 28 of the 45 season series resulted in sweeps (=62.2), while 2008-09 had 26 (57.8 percent).

### **MEANWHILE...**

The home teams finished the year with the upper hand over their road counterparts when winning in Conference this season, as hosting squads had an average margin of victory of 10.56 points in their 54 Big South wins. The road teams won their 36 League games by an average margin of 10.36 points.

### CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

CSU's 12 home wins this season tied the program record ... The Buccaneers posted their first .500 season since 2002-03 ... Charleston Southern set program season records for games played (32), points scored (2,362) and free throw percentage (75.5) ... **JAMARCO WARREN** ends his career as the all-time program leader in three-pointers made and games played, in second-place in points scored and field goals made, and third in free throw percentage ... **KELVIN MARTIN** is the 18th Buccaneer with 1,000 career points, and grabbed the most rebounds (269) by a Buccaneer since 1987-88. He ranks ninth at CSU in career rebounds, second in blocked shots, and fourth in steals.

### COASTAL CAROLINA

The Chanticleers made their fourth all-time postseason appearance earlier this week. Coastal has made two NCAA Tournament appearances (1991, 1993) and now owns two trips to the NIT (2010, 2011) ... Coastal Carolina reached the Big South Tournament Championship Game for the second consecutive season. The Chants fell to UNC Asheville in the title game after committing a season-high 21 turnovers that resulted in 29 points for the Bulldogs ... The top-seeded Chants opened the Tournament with an 83-72 win over No. 8 seed Gardner-Webb to avenge an earlier loss to GWU that snapped the Chants' national-best 22-game winning streak. **ANTHONY RAFFA** hit a career-high four 3-pointers and Coastal finished 9-for-18 from beyond the arc and shot 54.9 percent from the field (28-of-51) against GWU. **SAM McLAURIN** added 14 points, a career-high 14 rebounds and four blocked shots.

### GARDNER-WEBB

Gardner-Webb lost seven of its 21 games by just one possession in 2010-11, the most one-possession losses by the team since moving to NCAA Division I in 2000-01 ... **LARON BUGGS** (10.2 ppg) is the team's top returning scorer for 2011-12, as GWU is set to return three of its top four scorers ... Transfer guards **JASON DAWSON** (Wofford) and **TAYSHAWN NEWSOME** (Mississippi Valley State) will add immediate firepower to the roster next season, with both sitting out the current season due to NCAA transfer regulations.

### HIGH POINT

Junior guard **NICK BARBOUR** led High Point in scoring and earned Conference honors for the third-straight season. After scoring 13.8 points per game in his first 13 games this year, Barbour averaged 20.9 points the rest of the way. Barbour now ranks seventh in career scoring at HPU with 1,488 points. He also ranks second in both three-pointers made (206) and attempted (557) and ranks ninth in points per game (16.9) ... Senior **DAVID CAMPBELL** finishes his career with 199 games played, which ranks fifth all-time at HPU ... The Panthers went 2-6 down the stretch after losing redshirt-sophomore **COREY LAW** to injury. Law led the Panthers in rebounding for the second year in a row, this time averaging 7.6 per game. Without Law, the Panthers were outrebounded by an average of 38.0 to 29.8 (8.2).

### LIBERTY

**JESSE SANDERS** and **EVAN GORDON** finish the season 25th and 26th on Liberty's all-time scoring list with 836 and 832 points, respectively ... Sanders concluded the season with 183 assists and now has 472 helpers for his Liberty career. He needs 133 to break the Big South Conference record of 604 and 177 to surpass the program record of 648, held by **KARL HESS** ... **JOHN BROWN** concluded the season with 14 double-doubles, one shy of tying Liberty's single-season record of 15, set by **MIKE COLEMAN** (1990) and **ALEX McLEAN** (2008).

### PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE

PC ended the season 13-18 overall and 7-11 in Conference for its best overall mark since making the move to Division I. Not eligible for the postseason, the Blue Hose finished the campaign with a 73-66 win over Liberty ... **AL'LONZO COLEMAN** reached 1,000 points this season (he currently has 1,010) to become the first player since the transition to Division I, and the 20th player under Coach **GREGG NIBERT**, to reach 1,000 points.

### RADFORD

**JAREAL SMITH** became the first freshman in school history to lead the team in scoring, as his 9.4 points per game paced the Highlanders ... Radford did not qualify for the Big South Tournament for the first time in school history.

### UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville has now advanced in the NCAA Tournament in each of its two NCAA appearances ... The Bulldogs are on a season-high seven-game win streak ... Asheville is 3-2 in overtime games this season ... Big South Tournament MVP **MATT DICKEY** scored a career-high 29 points in the Big South Quarterfinals against Charleston Southern, which was the second-highest in a Big South Tournament game for a Bulldogs. Dickey averaged 19.7 points, made seven 3-pointers and was 18-of-20 from the free throw line in the three games.

### VMI

The Keydets reached the Big South Semifinals for the third time in five seasons -- all coming during odd-numbered years ... **AUSTIN KENON** averaged 19.0 points in the Tournament, including 27 in the final game of his career ... **STAN OKOYE** led the Keydets with 22.5 points, scoring 23 against Winthrop and 22 vs. Coastal Carolina.

### WINTHROP

For only the fourth time in the last 13 years, Winthrop failed to capture the Big South Conference Tournament championship. The defending champs exited the tournament in the Quarterfinals for the second time in three years and for the third time in 13 seasons ... The season did produce four double figure scorers (**ROBBIE DREHER**, 12.7; **CHARLES CORBIN**, 11.5; **REGGIE MIDDLETON**, 11.0; and **ANDRE JONES**, 10.7) for the first time since the 1979-80 season. It also marked the first time since the 1995-96 season that four Eagles averaged double figures in Conference games ... Senior **CHARLES CORBIN** closed out his career with 648 rebounds to move into sixth-place on the Winthrop all-time list. He also came up just short of 1,000 points as he had 954 while missing 11 games during his career ... Junior guard **REGGIE MIDDLETON** now has 274 career assists to rank 11th on the Winthrop all-time list ... Junior center **GEORGE VALENTINE** did not qualify for the Conference field goal leaders for not having the minimum made FGs per game, but he finished the season with a .620 percentage (85-137).

In the quarterfinals, the home seeds are 26-10 (=72.2 percent) on their home courts after three of this year's top four seeds advanced to the semifinals.
