DEFENDING REGULAR-SEASON CHAMPION COASTAL CAROLINA TABBED FAVORITE IN 2010-11

Coastal Carolina, last year's Big South regular-season champion, has been voted as the favorite to win the Conference in 2010-11 by the League's head coaches and media panel in the annual preseason poll. It is the first time since 1993-94 and fourth time overall that the Chanticleers are the Big South's preseason No. 1, and they enter the season with six returning letterwinners from last year's NIT squad that finished 28-7. Winthrop, last year's Big South Tournament champion and NCAA participant, finds itself as the preseason No. 2 this season with 191 points, which included five first-place votes. UNC Asheville was third in the voting with 181 points and received four first-place votes, while Presbyterian College was fourth in the poll after collecting 159 points and four top nods. The Blue Hose are eligible for the regular-season title but will not participate in the Conference tournament due do its transition to Division I. Liberty received the remaining first-place vote and finished sixth in the poll.

BARBOUR VOTED PRESEASON PLAYER OF THE YEAR

High Point's **NICK BARBOUR** is the 2010-11 Big South Conference Preseason Men's Basketball Player of the Year. He is the first High Point player to be voted Preseason Player of the Year since **ARIZONA REID** in 2007-08. Barbour was second in the Big South last season with 18.9 points per game and led the Conference with a 40.1 percentage from three-point range en route to First-Team All-Conference honors. He also ranked fifth in free throw percentage (76.3) and was eighth in field goal shooting (42.5). Barbour, an NABC Second-Team All-District selection last season, scored more than 20 points in 14 games in 2009-10, two of which were 30-point performances. He also drained 10-of-11 three-pointers in High Point's season opener a year ago. Joining Barbour on the preseason team are Coastal Carolina's **CHAD GRAY**, Presbyterian College's **AL'LONZO COLEMAN**, Charleston Southern's **JAMARCO WARREN** and VMI's **AUSTIN KENON**.

COASTAL CAROLINA'S MID-MAJOR MADNESS

Coastal Carolina is ranked No. 22 in the *Collegeinsider.com* Preseason Mid-Major Top 25 poll, which marks the 12th consecutive week that the Chanticleers have appeared in the ranking. Coastal was ranked as high as No. 10 last season the week of March 1. This is the seventh consecutive year that the Big South has had a team ranked in the Mid-Major Top 25 poll, which is in its 12th season.

SCOREBOARD WATCHING

VMI led the nation in scoring offense in 2009-10 for the fourth consecutive season, becoming the first team in NCAA Division I history to lead the country in scoring offense four consecutive years. The Keydets averaged 88.6 points last season and return 91.3 percent of that scoring output this year -- which is considerably more than the 48.9 percent that returned from their 2008-09 scoring offense that averaged 93.8 points.

AN A-PEELING NOTE

Winthrop head coach **RANDY PEELE** is just the second coach in Big South Conference history to make three appearances in the NCAA Tournament following the Eagles trip to the Big Dance in 2009-10. Peele led former member UNC Greensboro to the Big South title and NCAAs in 1996, and repeated the accomplishment in his first season as Winthrop's head coach in 2008. Meanwhile, Peele has won his three Big South Tournament Championships on the home floor of his opponents. In 1996, Peele and UNC Greensboro defeated Liberty in the title game in the Vines Center, and in 2008, Peele and Winthrop downed UNC Asheville in the Championship game at Justice Center. Last season it was a victory over Coastal Carolina at Kimbel Arena.

ELDER STATESMAN

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** has directed four Division I programs to 20 win seasons in his career after the Chanticleers won a school-record 28 games in 2009-10 -- the fifth time he has won at least 25 games in a season. He has been named Coach of the Year in four difference Conferences (Sun Belt, ACC, SEC, Big South) and owns a lifetime record of 664-391. Ellis has amassed 586 Division I victories, which ranks 10th on the NCAA's active win list.

COASTAL CAROLINA RE-WRITES HISTORY

Last season, Coastal Carolina was the first team in Big South history to improve from eighth-place the previous year to regular-season Conference champions the next. The Chanticleers re-established the Big South's best "worst-to-first" in League history, as the previous best was accomplished two seasons ago when Radford improved from seventh-place in 2007-08 to League champion in 2008-09.

ALL ABOUT THE NUMBER 10

Six teams won at leats 10 Big South games last season, tying the League record that was first accomplished in 1993-94. UNC Asheville won at least 10 Big South games for the third consecutive season -- the first time in school history and just the third Big South program to accomplish the trifecta. The Bulldogs joined UNC Greensboro (three times from 1993-96) and Winthrop (nine times from 1999-08) as the only schools with three-straight 10-win Conference seasons.

BIG SOUTH TO MAKE SIXTH APPEARANCE IN BRACKETBUSTERS EVENT

The Big South Conference will again participate in the BracketBusters event this season during the weekend of February 18-19, with a League-record nine teams among the field of 114. Representing the Big South in the 2011 event will be last year's four BracketBusters participants Winthrop, Radford, Presbyterian College and Gardner-Webb, plus High Point, Liberty, UNC Asheville, Charleston Southern and VMI -- the latter two making their first appearance in the series. The Big South has the third-most Conference members participating of the 15 Leagues involved this season. The Conference is 7-8 all-time in the BracketBusters, including two wins in 2006, 2007 and 2010, and has been selected for national television appearances three times: 2007 (ESPN2), 2008 (ESPN2) and 2009 (ESPNU). In 2011-12 and 2012-13, the Big South Conference will have 11 teams in the event, including new member Campbell.

ALL ALONE AT THE TOP

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** is the Big South's all-time winningest coach for overall wins (196) and Big South victories (117). He first broke the League record for regular-season Conference wins on Jan. 21, 2010 with the Bulldogs' 66-53 triumph over Winthrop, which was his 110th Big South victory, breaking the record of 109 that was established by former Radford coach **RON BRADLEY** from 1991-02. On Feb. 27, Biedenbach became the overall record holder with the Bulldogs' 89-86 win over Gardner-Webb. The victory was his 195th overall win at Asheville, breaking the previous League record of 194 wins that was established by former Winthrop coach **GREGG MARSHALL** from 1998-07.

BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB

High Point junior **NICK BARBOUR** enters the 2010-11 season just 26 points away from 1,000 in his career, as he has 974 points in 59 career games played. Below is a look at the Big South's active 1,000-point scorers, as well as those closing in on the milestone:

JOHN WILLIAMS' BUILDING BLOCKS

UNC Asheville redshirt-senior **JOHN WILLIAMS**, the school's all-time leading shot blocker, is one of four players in Big South history with 500 career rebounds and 200 career blocked shots. Williams is fourth all-time with 209 rejections, and needs six more to move into a tie for third-place. His 541 career caroms are tied for 49th, and he is 59 boards shy of becoming the 32nd player in Conference annals with 600 rebounds.

GARDNER-WEBB'S JOSHUA TREE

Gardner-Webb junior forward **JOSH HENLEY** ranks fifth all-time in Big South history with 8.81 rebounds a game, as he has grabbed 520 in just 59 career games. He is just one of two players in Conference history to surpass 500 career rebounds as a sophomore.

KEEP AN EYE ON...

...UNC Asheville junior **J.P. PRIMM** and Liberty junior **JESSE SANDERS**. The talented point guards enter 2010-11 with a chance to etch their names in the Big South record books. Primm surpassed 300 career assists in the Bulldogs' 2010 Big South Tournament Quarterfinal win over High Point and has 311 through two seasons. He also has 113 career steals. Sanders was the Flames' top rebounder in 14 of 31 games last season and already has 375 boards in his career. He also is 11 assists shy of 300.

KEYDET KICKS

VMI senior **AUSTIN KENON** has made a three-pointer in 73 of his 77 career games and has made 256 total for a 3.32 per game average, which is currently the fourth-highest per game clip in League history. The Big South career record is 3.51, set by Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** from 2004-08. Meanwhile, Kenon's teammate **KEITH GABRIEL** has drained a three-pointer in 54 of his 60 career games and already has 173 in his career, an average of 2.88 per game.

FROM THE LAND OF THREE...

Charleston Southern senior **JAMARCO WARREN** has made a school-record 257 three-point field goals in his career, good for 10th on the Big South's all-time list. He enters 2010-11 needing 47 to become just the fifth Big South player with 300 career threes.
