Holmes made his season debut for Coastal Carolina last week and opened with a double-double off the bench in the Chanticleers' 78-69 overtime win at LSU. He scored 14 points and pulled down 10 boards against the Tigers, and blocked two shots in his first game action in a year. Holmes finished the week with 16 points, seven rebounds and a career-high eight free throws to help Coastal to a 59-58 win over East Carolina on Saturday. With one minute to play against the Pirates, Holmes made two free throws that gave CCU its first lead since earlier in the half, and later sank an offensive putback with 27 seconds left to put Coastal ahead. For the week, Holmes averaged 15.0 points, 8.5 rebounds, 45.5 percent from the floor and 71.4 percent from the line.

Strickland scored a career-high 27 points against College of Charleston last Wednesday, including a Big South-record 7-of-7 from three-point range. He was 9-of-13 from the floor overall (=69.2 percent), made each of his two free throws and added two steals. With CSU trailing by 13 with 16:40 remaining in the second half, Strickland spurred a 23-9 run with 12 points on four treys to give the Bucs a one-point advantage at 56-55 with 10:30 left. He finished the second half with 17 points and five triples to keep the game close.

OTHER WEEK 6 FRESHMEN NOMINEES

BIG SOUTH OWNS THREE WINS OVER THE SEC

Coastal Carolina and Presbyterian College each won at SEC venues last week, giving the Big South Conference three wins in five games against Southeastern Conference opponents this season. Coastal won at LSU in overtime, while PC downed Auburn. UNC Asheville started it all with its season-opening win at Auburn on Nov. 12. The Big South has won three times over the SEC for the first time since 1993-94. That season, the Conference had wins over LSU and South Carolina (twice). Meanwhile, with Winthrop's win over Wake Forest on Nov. 22, the Big South Conference has recorded wins over members from the Atlantic Coast Conference and the Southeastern Conference in the same season now for the third time in the last four years.

MAKING WAVES

Coastal Carolina has started 9-2 for the second consecutive year, as the Chanticleers opened the 2009-10 season with a school-record 16-2 start. It is the third-straight year that a Big South team has opened a season at least 9-2. VMI opened the 2008-09 campaign with a 14-2 mark.

SEA SHELL

Charleston Southern freshman **SHELDON STRICKLAND** is the first player in Big South history to finish with a perfect 7-of-7 on three-point field goal attempts in a single-game, the minimum to qualify for the Conference and NCAA single-game marks.

STAN'S THE MAN

VMI sophomore **STAN OKOYE** leads the Big South in scoring (20.0), double-doubles (7) and is second in rebounding (10.1). He already has five games with at least 20 points and 10 rebounds, and is averaging 21.1 points and 11.9 rebounds when he records a double-double in a game this season.

ELDER STATESMAN

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** is five wins shy of 600 career Division I victories, as he is 595-381 at the Division I level. Ellis, who entered the season 10th on the NCAA's active Division I win list, has directed four Division I programs to 20-win seasons in his career, which includes five seasons with at least 25 wins. He has been named Coach of the Year in four difference Conferences (Sun Belt, ACC, SEC, Big South) and owns a lifetime record of 673-393.

JUNIOR 15

UNC Asheville juniors **MATT DICKEY** and **J.P. PRIMM** have scored at least 15 points in the same game seven times this season, with the Bulldogs going 4-3 in those games. It should be noted that the losses have been to nationally-ranked North Carolina and Georgetown, as well as a two-point overtime loss at USC Upstate. The duo has reached the 15-point threshold in the same game 12 times since arriving on campus in 2008-09, and Asheville is 8-4 in those games.

IT'S GOOD TO DOUBLE DIP

Just two players have scored in double figures in every game thus far -- Coastal Carolina's **DESMOND HOLLOWAY** and High Point's **NICK BARBOUR**. Holloway has scored at least 13 points in the Chanticleers' first 11 games and ranks second in the Big South with 18.6 points per game. Barbour's streak stands at 15 games, dating back to last season. He is third in the League in scoring this season with a 16.8 per game clip.

HOME COOKIN'

The 10 Big South men's basketball programs are a collective 30-4 at home this season in non-Conference games, a combined 88.2 winning percentage. The teams actually won the first 21 home games before High Point suffered a six-point loss to Hampton inside the Millis Center on Sunday, Nov. 28.

300/300 CLUB

Charleston Southern senior **JAMARCO WARREN** is looking to become the fourth player in Big South history with 300 career three-pointers and 300 career assists. Warren is one of just six players in League annals in the 250/250 club, as he owns 282 career treys and 277 career helpers. Warren is looking to join Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** (411 3FG, 353 AST), UNC Greensboro's **SCOTT HARTZELL** (309 3FG, 552 AST) and VMI's **CHAVIS HOLMES** (306 3FG, 313 AST) on the League's 300 three-pointer, 300 assist list.

KENON CRACKS ALL-TIME TOP 10 FOR THREE-POINT FIELD GOALS

VMI senior **AUSTIN KENON** moved into 10th all-time in Big South history for career three-point field goals over the weekend, as he buried his 281st career trey on Sunday. He has made a three-pointer in 81 of his 86 career games and has made 281 total for a 3.27 per game average, which is currently the fourth-highest per game clip in League history. The Big South career record is 3.51, set by Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** from 2004-08. Kenon is 19 three-pointers shy of joining the Big South's 300-career three-point club, which is currently at four members.

MR. SAND MAN

Liberty junior guard **JESSE SANDERS** is 36 assists shy of 400 in his career in addition to needing 48 rebounds for 500. Once he reaches both milestones, he would be the first player in Big South history to achieve both the rebound and assist totals in a career. Meanwhile, Sanders is 13th in the country with 6.4 assists per game, and is the only player in the nation averaging at least 6.0 assists and 6.0 rebounds (6.4) a contest.

BE MY VALENTINE

Winthrop redshirt-junior **GEORGE VALENTINE** ranks sixth in the Big South with 8.0 rebounds per game, the highest rebounding average by a Winthrop Eagle since **GREG LEWIS** averaged 10.1 boards a night during the 2001-02 season. Valentine entered the season averaging 3.1 in his career and was averaging 4.6 last year before suffering a season-ending injury in game seven.

SPECIAL K

Charleston Southern junior **KELVIN MARTIN** became the 58th member of the Big South's 500 career rebound club as he eclipsed the milestone with 14 boards against Milligan on Dec. 11. He is the first Charleston Southern player on the list since **NICK MITCHELL** in 2000-01. Martin's total stands at 515, and is seven shy of 56th place in League history.

SIR CHARLES

Winthrop senior forward/center **CHARLES CORBIN** made his season debut Dec. 7 after missing the first eight games due to suspension. He grabbed a game-high 11 rebounds in the win over Jacksonville on Dec. 12, and is now 22 caroms away from 500 in his career. Once he reaches the milestone, he would become the second Winthrop Eagle in two seasons to accomplish the feat (following **MANTORIS ROBINSON** last season) and 10th overall, as well as the 59th player on the Conference's all-time rebounding chart.

ALL-TIME SCORERS

Charleston Southern senior **JAMARCO WARREN** cracked the Big South's all-time top 20 scorers Dec. 11 against Milligan, and is 39 points away from becoming the 20th player in Conference annals with 1,600. Presbyterian College redshirt-junior **AL'LONZO COLEMAN** has scored 913 points and grabbed 481 rebounds in his collegiate career (593 points and 337 rebounds as an official Big South member).

GARDNER-WEBB'S JOSHUA TREE

Gardner-Webb junior forward **JOSH HENLEY**, who became the 32nd player in Big South history with 600 career rebounds when he reached the milestone Dec. 4 at Radford, is averaging 8.48 rebounds a game in his career (619 in 73 games), the eighth-highest career rebounding average in League history. Just the second player in the Conference's existence to surpass 500 rebounds as a sophomore, Henley is on pace to surpass 700 rebounds 10 games from now -- Feb. 3 against Winthrop, based on his career rebounding average.

PRIMM-TIME

UNC Asheville junior **J.P. PRIMM** has 355 career assists and needs 45 to join the Big South's 400-assist club, which currently boasts 17 members. He also has 134 career steals and is 66 away from joining the Conference's 12-member 200-steal club. Once he reaches both milestones, he would become the fifth player in League history with 400 assists and 200 steals. The group currently includes Winthrop's **CHRIS GAYNOR** (567 AST, 259 STL), Coastal Carolina's **ROBERT DOWDELL** (561 AST, 239 STL), Campbell's **BRAD CHILDRESS** (543 AST, 243 STL) and Charleston Southern's **ED O'NEIL** (504 AST, 241 STL).

MILESTONE MAN

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** recorded his 200th career win at Asheville with the Bulldogs' 86-57 victory over Montreat College on Dec. 11. The Big South's all-time winningest coach for overall wins (201) and Big South victories (118), Biedenbach is 230-273 in 17-plus years as a collegiate head coach.

ANOTHER BROWN LEADING LIBERTY

Liberty newcomer and redshirt-junior **JOHN BROWN** leads the Big South with 10.6 rebounds a game. If he can maintain his position, he would be the first Liberty player to lead the Conference in rebounding since **LEO LIGHTBOURNE** in 2004-05. Brown could also become the first newcomer to finish as the Big South's top rebounder since High Point's **DANNY GATHINGS** in 2002-03.

SCOREBOARD WATCHING

VMI leads both the Big South and the nation in scoring offense at 93.3 points a game, and is attempting to finish as the country's top scoring offense for an unprecedented fifth-straight year. VMI led the nation in scoring offense in 2009-10 for the fourth consecutive season, becoming the first team in NCAA Division I history to lead the country in scoring offense four consecutive years. The Keydets are also looking to become the first Conference member to lead the Big South in scoring five consecutive years. VMI (2006-present) and Radford (1995-99) are the only programs to lead four-straight seasons.

FROM THE LAND OF THREE...

Charleston Southern senior **JAMARCO WARREN** has made a school-record 282 three-point field goals in his career, good for ninth on the Big South's all-time list. He needs one to move into a tie with High Point's **EUGENE HARRIS** for eighth place at 283. Warren is 18 three-pointers away from becoming just the fifth Big South player with 300 career threes. Meanwhile, VMI junior **KEITH GABRIEL** has drained a three-pointer in 64 of his 72 career games and already has 197 in his career, an average of 2.74 per game. He is three away from becoming the 27th Big South player with 200 career three-pointers.

SWAT TEAM

VMI freshman **D.J. COVINGTON** blocked nine shots against Southern Virginia on Nov. 23, the highest block total in the Big South since former UNC Asheville center **KENNY GEORGE** swatted away 10 shots against Campbell on Nov. 17, 2007. Covington has played in just seven of VMI's 12 games due to injuries (58.3 percent), but still has 25 blocked shots in his limited action (3.57 per game), including three games with at least four rejections. He needs to appear in 75 percent of his team's games in order to qualify for the Big South and NCAA statistical rankings.

HELLO 2-0

With the first set of Big South games concluding Dec. 4, Liberty and High Point emerged from the pack with 2-0 League records to tie for first-place in the Conference standings. The Flames are 2-0 in the Big South for the first time ever, while the Panthers have won their first two League games for the first time since 2006-07. Conference play will resume Dec. 31.

EDGE OF YOUR SEAT ACTION...

Seven of the first nine Big South games had winning margins of less than 10 points, including four that were decided by three points-or-less. Overall, the first nine Conference games of the 2010-11 season had an average margin of victory of 7.33 points. Last year, the overall margin of victory in League play was 10.51 points, while the 2008-09 average margin was 8.96 points.

BIG SOUTH TO MAKE SIXTH APPEARANCE IN BRACKETBUSTERS EVENT

The Big South Conference will again participate in the BracketBusters event this season during the weekend of February 18-19, with a League-record nine teams among the field of 114. Representing the Big South in the 2011 event will be last year's four BracketBusters participants **WINTHROP**, **RADFORD**, **PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE** and **GARDNER-WEBB**, plus **HIGH POINT**, **LIBERTY**, **UNC ASHEVILLE**, **CHARLESTON SOUTHERN** and **VMI** -- the latter two making their first appearance in the series. The Big South has the third-most Conference members participating of the 15 Leagues involved this season. The Conference is 7-8 all-time in the BracketBusters, including two wins in 2006, 2007 and 2010, and has been selected for national television appearances three times: 2007 (ESPN2), 2008 (ESPN2) and 2009 (ESPNU). In 2011-12 and 2012-13, the Big South Conference will have 11 teams in the event, including new member **CAMPBELL**.

The Bucs stormed back from a 13-point second-half deficit to take the lead at 56-55 midway through the second half behind the scoring exploits of freshman **SHELDON STRICKLAND**, who led all players with a career-high 27 points. **KENNY MITCHELL** added 12 points and eight rebounds and **KELVIN MARTIN** chipped in 10 points and nine boards for CSU ... Strickland's 7-of-7 three-point shooting bested **JAMARCO WARREN**'s program single-game record for three-point attempts without a miss (6-of-6).

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina won both twice last week to run its winning streak to seven games. The Chants opened the week with a 78-69 overtime win Monday at LSU to snap a 37-game losing streak to BCS schools. The Chants last defeated a BCS school in 1993-94 (South Carolina). **CHAD GRAY** scored a game-high 22 points at LSU, which included 20 in the second half and overtime combined. He finished with a career-high four three-pointers and hit two on back-to-back possessions in overtime to help Coastal outscore LSU 14-5 in the extra session ... Coastal closed the week with a 59-58 win over East Carolina following a game-winning jumper from sophomore guard **KIERRE GREENWOOD**. **DESMOND HOLLOWAY** scored a game-high 21 points to record his fourth game this season with at least 20 points.

GARDNER-WEBB

Gardner-Webb played without leading scorer **JON MOORE** and reserve forward **SANTOINE BUTLER** at No. 20/21 Louisville, with both out due to injuries ... Junior **LARON BUGGS** netted a career-high 16 points at Louisville ... GWU will not play again until Dec. 31 at home vs. Liberty ... GWU finished its grueling, 10-game road swing with a 3-7 record, with losses at BCS programs Michigan, Oklahoma, Arizona State and Louisville among that total.

HIGH POINT

The Panthers play Georgia for the first time in team history on Tuesday, the third of a seven-game road stretch ... HPU is 0-9 against Southeastern Conference teams since joining NCAA Division I in 1999-00 ... In HPU's 79-65 loss to Wofford last Saturday, the Panthers scored 16 points in the first half and 49 in the second half. The 16 points were HPU's least in a half since scoring 16 in a 75-58 loss at Coastal Carolina on Jan. 16, 2010 ... The 49 were HPU's most since scoring 53 in the second half of an 83-73 loss at UNC Asheville on March 2, 2010.

LIBERTY

The Flames will face Hampton this week for the first time since Feb. 1, 1996, and third time overall. Neither team has won a game on their home court when going head-to-head ... In Liberty's 71-62 win over William & Mary this past Saturday, **JOEL VANDER POL** finished with a career-high nine points while chipping in three rebounds and a steal. **JOHN BROWN** posted his sixth double-double with 14 points and 12 rebounds against the Tribe ... Liberty's win over William & Mary ended a five-game losing skid against CAA opponents. Prior to Saturday's win, the last time the Flames defeated a CAA member was Dec. 1, 2008, when Liberty edged George Mason in overtime, 69-66.

PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE

PC went 2-0 last week, defeating Jacksonville State and Auburn ... The win over JSU was PC's second-straight over the Gamecocks, with the first coming a year ago in PC's BracketBusters' debut. Redshirt-freshman **TOLGA CERRAH** was Radford's top scorer in the Highlanders' lone game last week, a 64-50 loss at UNC Wilmington. Cerrah scored 16 points on 6-of-10 shooting while grabbing six rebounds against the Seahawks.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville defeated King College, 90-72 last Thursday night in its lone action of the week. **D.J. CUNNINGHAM** earned his second double-double with 20 points and 11 rebounds, while **MATT DICKEY** scored a game-high 21 points ... The victory was Asheville's 12th-straight at Justice Center dating back to last season. The Bulldogs have the 16th-longest home court winning streak in the nation ... Asheville has one game this week and it's a tough one -- at No. 2 Ohio State Tuesday night, then plays its next three at home beginning Dec. 28 against mountain rival Western Carolina. That game will be televised locally by WMYA-TV.

VMI

VMI will not play for 11 days and resumes action on Friday, Dec. 31 at UNC Asheville. VMI is in the middle of a three-game road swing and returns home to Cameron Hall Jan. 6 ... **STAN OKOYE** posted his third-straight double-double and seventh of the season when he scored 24 points and grabbed 15 rebounds at Marshall on Sunday ... VMI did not hold a lead at any point against Marshall on Sunday, the first time this season that has happened in a game for the Keydets. VMI did tie the game at 2-2 early in the contest ... Heading into the Marshall game, the Keydets had regained the No. 1 spot in the nation in scoring and three-pointers made.

Winthrop will travel to snowy Ohio and Kentucky to face defending NIT champion Dayton and No. 13/14 Kentucky. Winthrop will be facing both schools for just the second time ... The Eagles have been off for exams since defeating Jacksonville on Dec. 12 ... Winthrop has all three starting guards averaging in double figures, a rarity for the Eagles since they have not been a high scoring team over the last four years.
