Barbour averaged 22.5 points and 3.5 rebounds in two games last week, in addition to hitting 62.5 percent from the floor (15-of-24), 85.7 percent from three-point range (6-of-7) and 90.0 percent from the line (9-of-10). Playing both games with an injured ankle and not expecting to see much action, Barbour opened the week with 20 points off the bench at The Citadel, which included a stretch of eight-straight points in the second half. Sunday against Hampton, Barbour went 8-of-13 from the floor, 5-of-6 from beyond the arc and hit all four free throws en route to 25 points. The Big South Preseason Player of the Year entered the week averaging just 13.3 points, 26.2 percent from the field and 19.0 percent from long range.

Davis helped Gardner-Webb collect two wins in three games at the 2010 Legends Classic in Williamsburg, Va. He averaged 10.3 points, 5.3 assists, 1.7 rebounds and 1.7 steals in the tournament, including a career-high 15 points on 5-of-9 shooting (4-of-7 from three-point range) and three assists in a one-point loss to host William & Mary. Davis dished off a career-high seven assists and had seven points in a win over Western Carolina, and followed with nine points, six helpers and three steals in a victory over Mercer. He also was clutch at the free throw line, hitting 10-of-13 chances on the week (=76.9 percent).

TIS THE CONFERENCE SEASON...

The Big South Conference season begins this week with nine games on the slate, as the Conference resumes its Thursday-Saturday playing format. All but Charleston Southern and Coastal Carolina will play two League games this week, as those two teams will meet in a Saturday afternoon tilt. Below is a team-by-team look at Big South openers:

Coastal Carolina carries a four-game Conference win streak into this week's action, while Radford has won its last three Big South contests. High Point has won its last two League games. Liberty and UNC Asheville each won their last regular-season Big South game of the 2009-10 season.

A LOOK BACK AT 2009-10

Of the 45 Conference series last season, 28 resulted in season sweeps (62.2 percent), up from 26 in 2008-09. Coastal Carolina swept six League foes in 2009-10, followed by Radford, Winthrop, UNC Asheville and Liberty with four each.

BIG SOUTH TELEVISION PACKAGE TIPS OFF THIS WEEK

The Big South "Royal Purple Game of the Week" television package officially tips off this week with a doubleheader on the Mid-Atlantic Sports Network (MASN). The network will televise Thursday's Gardner-Webb at High Point contest live at 7:00pm, followed by Presbyterian College's visit to Liberty at 9:00pm. **MATT HOGUE** (play-by-play) and **NATE ROSS** (analyst) will call the action from High Point, while **RAY JONES** (play-by-play) and **TIM SCARBOROUGH** (analyst) will handle the call of Blue Hose-Flames.

OPENING TIP

For the third time in the last four seasons, the Big South Conference has recorded wins over members from the Atlantic Coast Conference and the Southeastern Conference in the same season. UNC Asheville opened the 2010-11 campaign with a 70-69 overtime win at Auburn, while Winthrop won at Wake Forest in the consolation round of the Preseason NIT with an 83-74 victory over the Demon Deacons. The Big South also recorded wins over the ACC and SEC in 2008-09 and 2007-08.

SCORING TOUCH

Winthrop's 83 points scored at Wake Forest last week was the most by the Eagles in a regular-season non-Conference Division I game since scoring 98 points against Northern Illinois in a BracketBusters contest on Feb. 18, 2006. Against the Demon Deacons, Winthrop was 32-of-62 from the field (=51.6 percent), including 6-of-11 from three-point range (=54.5). **ROBBIE DREHER** had a career-high 20 points off the bench while **REGGIE MIDDLETON** just missed a triple-double with 15 points, 9 rebounds and 8 assists.

VMI ENJOYS BEST START IN GENERATIONS

VMI opened the season 5-0 before suffering its first loss of the season Saturday against West Virginia. The Keydets' 5-0 start was their best in the modern era and the fastest start since the 1921-22 season when VMI opened 8-0.

HOME COOKIN'

The 10 Big South men's basketball programs are a collective 21-1 at home this season in non-Conference games, a combined 95.5 winning percentage. The teams actually won the first 21 home games before High Point suffered a six-point loss to Hampton Sunday afternoon inside the Millis Center.

MILESTONE MAN

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** is two wins shy of 200 career victories at Asheville. The Big South's all-time winningest coach for overall wins (198) and Big South victories (117), Biedenbach is 227-272 in 17-plus years as a collegiate head coach.

300/300 CLUB

Charleston Southern senior **JAMARCO WARREN** is looking to become the fourth player in Big South history with 300 career three-pointers and 300 career assists. Warren is one of just six players in League annals in the 250/250 club, as he owns 277 career treys and 262 career helpers. Warren is looking to join Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** (411 3FG, 353 AST), UNC Greensboro's **SCOTT HARTZELL** (309 3FG, 552 AST) and VMI's **CHAVIS HOLMES** (306 3FG, 313 AST) on the League's 300 three-pointer, 300 assist list.

ALL-TIME SCORERS

Charleston Southern senior **JAMARCO WARREN** became the 24th player in Big South history to surpass 1,500 career points when he reached the milestone this past week. Meanwhile, VMI's **KEITH GABRIEL** became the 101st player in Conference annals to score 1,000 career points, as he eclipsed the mark last week against Southern Virginia. Presbyterian College redshirt-junior **AL'LONZO COLEMAN** has scored 841 points and grabbed 434 rebounds in his collegiate career (521 points and 290 rebounds as an official Big South member).

JOHN WILLIAMS' BUILDING BLOCKS

UNC Asheville redshirt-senior **JOHN WILLIAMS** is 47 points away from becoming just the third player in Big South history with 1,000 career points, 500 career rebounds and 200 career blocked shots. Already one of four players in League annals with 500 rebounds (562) and 200 blocks (school-record 213), Williams is looking to join Liberty's **PETER ALUMA** (1,715 points, 682 rebounds, 366 blocks) and Radford's **TYRONE TRAVIS** (1,313 points, 718 rebounds, 215 blocks) in the elite group. Williams is fourth all-time in Big South history with 213 rejections, and needs two more to move into a tie with Travis for third-place.

ELDER STATESMAN

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** is eight wins shy of 600 career Division I victories, as he is 592-381 at the Division I level. Ellis, who entered the season 10th on the NCAA's active Division I win list, has directed four Division I programs to 20-win seasons in his career, which includes five seasons with at least 25 wins. He has been named Coach of the Year in four difference Conferences (Sun Belt, ACC, SEC, Big South) and owns a lifetime record of 670-393.

GARDNER-WEBB'S JOSHUA TREE

Gardner-Webb junior forward **JOSH HENLEY** is 22 rebounds away from becoming the 32nd player in Big South history with 600 in a career. Just the second player in the Conference's existence to surpass 500 rebounds as a sophomore, Henley is averaging 8.63 rebounds a game in his career (578 in 67 games), the sixth-highest career rebounding average in League history.

SPECIAL K

Charleston Southern junior **KELVIN MARTIN** is 26 rebounds away from becoming the 58th member of the Big South's 500-rebound club. Martin would be the first Charleston Southern player on the list since **NICK MITCHELL** surpassed the milestone in 2000-01.

PRIMM-TIME

UNC Asheville junior **J.P. PRIMM** has 333 career assists and needs 67 to join the Big South's 400-assist club, which currently boasts 17 members. He also has 124 career steals and is 76 away from joining the Conference's 12-member 200-steal club. Once he reaches both milestones, he would become the fifth player in League history with 400 assists and 200 steals. The group currently includes Winthrop's **CHRIS GAYNOR** (567 AST, 259 STL), Coastal Carolina's **ROBERT DOWDELL** (561 AST, 239 STL), Campbell's **BRAD CHILDRESS** (543 AST, 243 STL) and Charleston Southern's **ED O'NEIL** (504 AST, 241 STL).

BIG SOUTH PRESEASON PLAYER OF THE YEAR

Nick Barbour, High Point

MR. SAND MAN

Liberty junior guard **JESSE SANDERS** is 74 rebounds shy of 500 in his career in addition to needing 63 assists for 400. Once he reaches both milestones, he would be the first player in Big South history to achieve both the rebound and assist totals in a career. Stay tuned.

MID-MAJOR MADNESS

Coastal Carolina fell out of the *Collegeinsider.com* Mid-Major Top 25 poll last week, ending a string of 13 consecutive weeks appearing in the ranking. The Chanticleers were in the 27th spot after four teams moved into the ranking for the first time this season. Meanwhile, VMI received votes in the Mid-Major Top 25 for the first time since being ranked during the 2008-09 season. The Big South Conference has had a team ranked in the 12-year-old Mid-Major Top 25 poll the last seven consecutive seasons. SCOREBOARD WATCHING

After four games, VMI is averaging 90.8 points a game and will attempt to lead the nation in scoring for an unprecedented fifth-straight year. VMI led the nation in scoring offense in 2009-10 for the fourth consecutive season, becoming the first team in NCAA Division I history to lead the country in scoring offense four consecutive years. The Keydets returned 91.3 percent of their scoring output from last season's 88.6 points per game -- which is considerably more than the 48.9 percent that returned from their 2008-09 scoring offense that averaged 93.8 points.

KEYDET KICKS

VMI senior **AUSTIN KENON** has made a three-pointer in 76 of his 81 career games and has made 265 total for a 3.27 per game average, which is currently the fourth-highest per game clip in League history. The Big South career record is 3.51, set by Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** from 2004-08. Meanwhile, Kenon's teammate **KEITH GABRIEL** has drained a three-pointer in 60 of his 66 career games and already has 188 in his career, an average of 2.85 per game.

FROM THE LAND OF THREE...

Charleston Southern senior **JAMARCO WARREN** has made a school-record 277 three-point field goals in his career, good for ninth on the Big South's all-time list. He needs six to move into a tie with High Point's **EUGENE HARRIS** for eighth place at 283. Warren is 23 three-pointers away from becoming just the fifth Big South player with 300 career threes.

AN A-PEELING NOTE

Winthrop head coach **RANDY PEELE** recorded his 100th collegiate head coaching victory of his career with last week's 83-74 win at Wake Forest. Peele is just the second coach in Big South Conference history to make three appearances in the NCAA Tournament following the Eagles trip to the Big Dance in 2009-10. Peele led former member UNC Greensboro to the Big South title and NAAs in 1996, and repeated the accomplishment in his first season as Winthrop's head coach in 2008. Meanwhile, Peele has won his three Big South Tournament Championships on the home floor of his opponents. In 1996, Peele and UNC Greensboro defeated Liberty in the title game in the Vines Center, and in 2008, Peele and Winthrop downed UNC Asheville in the Championship game at Justice Center. Last season it was a victory over Coastal Carolina at Kimbel Arena.

BIG SOUTH TO MAKE SIXTH APPEARANCE IN BRACKETBUSTERS EVENT

The Big South Conference will again participate in the BracketBusters event this season during the weekend of February 18-19, with a League-record nine teams among the field of 114. Representing the Big South in the 2011 event will be last year's four BracketBusters participants Winthrop, Radford, Presbyterian College and Gardner-Webb, plus High Point, Liberty, UNC Asheville, Charleston Southern and VMI -- the latter two making their first appearance in the series. The Big South has the third-most Conference members participating of the 15 Leagues involved this season. The Conference is 7-8 all-time in the BracketBusters, including two wins in 2006, 2007 and 2010, and has been selected for national television appearances three times: 2007 (ESPN2), 2008 (ESPN2) and 2009 (ESPNU). In 2011-12 and 2012-13, the Big South Conference will have 11 teams in the event, including new member Campbell.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern closed out the 2010 Chicago Invitational Challenge with an 89-54 win over Southern. Martin was one of five Buccaneers to score in double-figures last week, joining **JAMARCO WARREN**, **KENNY MITCHELL**, **JEREMY SEXTON** and **SHELDON STRICKLAND**.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina has now won four-straight games following wins last week over North Carolina Wesleyan and The Citadel ... **KIERRE GREENWOOD** had a game-high 19 points on 8-of-10 shooting against Wesleyan, while the Coastal defense forced the Battling Bishops into 25 turnovers and turned those miscues into 36 points ... **CHAD GRAY** scored a season-high 27 points to go along with seven rebounds in the come-from-behind win over The Citadel. Gray shot 13-for-15 from the field and hit his first 10 shots. **DESMOND HOLLOWAY** had a double-double with 18 points and 11 rebounds against the Bulldogs ... Coastal is now 22-1 at home against non-conference foes under head coach **CLIFF ELLIS**.

GARDNER-WEBB

Gardner-Webb enters week three of the season just three wins shy of equaling last season's win total, and has won five games before December for the first time since 2007 (started 5-4) ... GWU picked up a pair of wins on consecutive days at the 2010 Legends Classic, and missed a third win on opening night by just one point, falling to host William & Mary 56-55 in a heartbreaker ... The 'Dogs made more free throws than their opponents attempted in the final two games, and shot 61-of-79 from the charity stripe (=77.2 percent) for the weekend ... GWU also held a sizable rebounding edge, despite being undersized in all three matchups, grabbing 34.7 boards per game and holding a seven-rebound edge.
