Holloway averaged 20.0 points, 6.0 rebounds, 51.1 percent from the field and 84.4 percent from the charity stripe (27-of-32) in four games last week. Holloway opened with 24 points and a career-high nine rebounds at College of Charleston. He followed that with 13 points, a career-high three steals and 7-of-8 from the line against No. 20 Georgetown. Holloway then scored 18 points and had six rebounds in a win over USC Upstate. He concluded his week with 25 points, seven rebounds and two blocks in the Chanticleers' double-overtime win over Charlotte on Sunday. He scored six of the team's final seven points in the second overtime and put Coastal ahead for good with two free throws with 1:01 remaining.

Strickland averaged 12.3 points, 5.0 assists and 1.3 steals in three games for the Buccaneers. He opened with nine points off the bench in Charleston Southern's win over The Citadel, then recorded his first career double-double with 16 points and 10 assists against Montreat. He also had three steals in that win. Strickland completed his week with 12 points and three helpers at Richmond. For the week, he was 12-of-20 from the field (=60.0 percent), 4-of-9 from three-point range (=44.4) and 9-of-10 from the line (=90.0).

LOOK WHO IS 4-0

VMI is 4-0 for the first time in 25 years and will seek its first 5-0 start of the modern era Tuesday night, as the Keydets renew a Rockbridge County rivalry by taking on Southern Virginia. The Keydets' start has gotten the attention of some pollsters, as VMI received votes in this week's *Collegeinsider.com* Mid-Major Top 25 poll, as well as a vote in the *Associated Press* Top 25.

BARBOUR SHOP

High Point junior **NICK BARBOUR** became the 100th member of the Big South's 1,000-point club when he surpassed the milestone with 19 points against Gwynedd-Mercy last Friday. Barbour now has 1,014 points in his career, good for 98th in Conference history. VMI's **KEITH GABRIEL** is on the cusp of becoming the 101st player in Big South history with 1,000 points, as he enters this week's action needing just three points for the milestone. Below is a look at the Big South's active 1,000-point scorers, as well as those closing in on the milestone:

Presbyterian College redshirt-junior **AL'LOUNZO COLEMAN** has scored 804 points and grabbed 416 rebounds in his collegiate career (484 points and 272 rebounds as an official Big South member).

MID-MAJOR MADNESS

Coastal Carolina fell out of the *Collegeinsider.com* Mid-Major Top 25 poll this week, ending a string of 13 consecutive weeks appearing in the ranking. The Chanticleers are in the 27th spot after four teams moved into the ranking for the first time this season. Meanwhile, VMI has received votes in the Mid-Major Top 25 for the first time since being ranked during the 2008-09 season, and holds the 45th position in this week's poll. The Big South Conference has had a team ranked in the 12-year-old Mid-Major Top 25 poll the last seven consecutive seasons.

SCOREBOARD WATCHING

After four games, VMI is averaging 96.2 points a game and will attempt to lead the nation in scoring for an unprecedented fifth-straight year. VMI led the nation in scoring offense in 2009-10 for the fourth consecutive season, becoming the first team in NCAA Division I history to lead the country in scoring offense four consecutive years. The Keydets averaged 88.6 points last season and return 91.3 percent of that scoring output this year -- which is considerably more than the 48.9 percent that returned from their 2008-09 scoring offense that averaged 93.8 points.

ALL ALONE AT THE TOP

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** is the Big South's all-time winningest coach for overall wins (198) and Big South victories (117). He first broke the League record for regular-season Conference wins on Jan. 21, 2010 with the Bulldogs' 66-53 triumph over Winthrop, which was his 110th Big South victory, breaking the record of 109 that was established by former Radford coach **RON BRADLEY** from 1991-02. On Feb. 27, Biedenbach became the overall record holder with the Bulldogs' 89-86 win over Gardner-Webb. The victory was his 195th overall win at Asheville, breaking the previous League record of 194 wins that was established by former Winthrop coach **GREGG MARSHALL** from 1998-07.

JOHN WILLIAMS' BUILDING BLOCKS

UNC Asheville redshirt-senior **JOHN WILLIAMS**, the school's all-time leading shot blocker, is one of four players in Big South history with 500 career rebounds and 200 career blocked shots. Williams is fourth all-time with 212 rejections, and needs three more to move into a tie for third-place. His 562 career caroms rank 47th, and he is 38 boards shy of becoming the 32nd player in Conference annals with 600 rebounds. Williams is also closing in on 1,000 career points (49 away) and would be the 40th player in Big South history with 1,000 points and 500 rebounds.

GARDNER-WEBB'S JOSHUA TREE

Gardner-Webb junior forward **JOSH HENLEY** currently ranks fifth all-time in Big South history with 8.80 rebounds a game, as he has grabbed 563 in 64 career games. Just one of two players in Conference history to surpass 500 career rebounds as a sophomore, Henley is just 37 away from 600.

KEEP AN EYE ON...

...UNC Asheville junior **J.P. PRIMM** and Liberty junior **JESSE SANDERS**, as the talented point guards will etch their names in the Big South record books. Primm surpassed 300 career assists in the Bulldogs' 2010 Big South Tournament Quarterfinal win over High Point and currently has 327. He also has 124 career steals. Sanders surpassed 300 career assists Nov. 14 at Notre Dame and is currently at 323. He also owns 410 career rebounds.

KEYDET KICKS

VMI senior **AUSTIN KENON** has made a three-pointer in 74 of his 79 career games and has made 259 total for a 3.28 per game average, which is currently the fourth-highest per game clip in League history. The Big South career record is 3.51, set by Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** from 2004-08. Meanwhile, Kenon's teammate **KEITH GABRIEL** has drained a three-pointer in 58 of his 64 career games and already has 185 in his career, an average of 2.89 per game.

FROM THE LAND OF THREE...

Charleston Southern senior **JAMARCO WARREN** has made a school-record 270 three-point field goals in his career, good for 10th on the Big South's all-time list. He needs five to move into a tie with Coastal Carolina's **KEKE HICKS** for ninth place at 275. Warren is 30 three-pointers away from becoming just the fifth Big South player with 300 career threes.

ELDER STATESMAN

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** has directed four Division I programs to 20 win seasons in his career after the Chanticleers won a school-record 28 games in 2009-10 -- the fifth time he has won at least 25 games in a season. He has been named Coach of the Year in four difference Conferences (Sun Belt, ACC, SEC, Big South) and owns a lifetime record of 668-393. Ellis has amassed 590 Division I victories, which ranks 10th on the NCAA's active win list.

COASTAL CAROLINA RE-WRITES HISTORY

Last season, Coastal Carolina was the first team in Big South history to improve from eighth-place the previous year to regular-season Conference champions the next. The Chanticleers re-established the Big South's best "worst-to-first" in League history, as the previous best was accomplished two seasons ago when Radford improved from seventh-place in 2007-08 to League champion in 2008-09.

ALL ABOUT THE NUMBER 10

With Big South Conference play beginning Thursday, Dec. 2, last season's Conference schedule saw six teams win at least 10 Big South games in the same year, tying the League record that was first accomplished in 1993-94. UNC Asheville won at least 10 Big South games for the third consecutive season -- the first time in school history and just the third Big South program to accomplish the trifecta. The Bulldogs joined UNC Greensboro (three times from 1993-96) and Winthrop (nine times from 1999-08) as the only schools with three-straight 10-win Conference seasons.

AN A-PEELING NOTE

Winthrop head coach **RANDY PEELE** needs one more victory for 100 in his collegiate head coaching career. He is just the second coach in Big South Conference history to make three appearances in the NCAA Tournament following the Eagles trip to the Big Dance in 2009-10. Peele led former member UNC Greensboro to the Big South title and NAAs in 1996, and repeated the accomplishment in his first season as Winthrop's head coach in 2008. Meanwhile, Peele has won his three Big South Tournament Championships on the home floor of his opponents. In 1996, Peele and UNC Greensboro defeated Liberty in the title game in the Vines Center, and in 2008, Peele and Winthrop downed UNC Asheville in the Championship game at Justice Center. Last season it was a victory over Coastal Carolina at Kimbel Arena.

BIG SOUTH TO MAKE SIXTH APPEARANCE IN BRACKETBUSTERS EVENT

The Big South Conference will again participate in the BracketBusters event this season during the weekend of February 18-19, with a League-record nine teams among the field of 114. Representing the Big South in the 2011 event will be last year's four BracketBusters participants Winthrop, Radford, Presbyterian College and Gardner-Webb, plus High Point, Liberty, UNC Asheville, Charleston Southern and VMI -- the latter two making their first appearance in the series. The Big South has the third-most Conference members participating of the 15 Leagues involved this season. The Conference is 7-8 all-time in the BracketBusters, including two wins in 2006, 2007 and 2010, and has been selected for national television appearances three times: 2007 (ESPN2), 2008 (ESPN2) and 2009 (ESPNU). In 2011-12 and 2012-13, the Big South Conference will have 11 teams in the event, including new member Campbell.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern is competing in the Chicago Invitational Challenge this week. The Buccaneers opened the tournament Sunday at Richmond ... The Bucs have shot .400 or higher in each of their past three games. They have also ended each game shooting .400 or higher from beyond the arc.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina played four games in six days last week and turned in a 2-2 record ... The Chanticleers opened the week with a 83-67 setback Tuesday at the College of Charleston. Coastal led by 12 points at halftime, but the Cougars quickly erased that deficit with a pair of runs in the second half. Sophomore **DANNY NIEMAN** tied his career-high with four three-pointers. **SAM McLAURIN** also tied his career-high by grabbing 11 rebounds ... After falling to #20/21 Georgetown to open the Charleston Classic, Coastal Carolina defeated USC Upstate, 71-50, and Charlotte, 79-75 in double overtime to finish in fifth-place. Against the 49ers, **ANTHONY RAFFA** finished with 17 points and four steals and hit 7-of-8 free throws in overtime. The victory gave Coastal Carolina its first-ever win over an Atlantic 10 opponent, as the Chants entered the game 0-15 all-time against the League. In addition, it was Coastal's first-ever win over Charlotte in eight chances.

GARDNER-WEBB

Gardner-Webb suffered two road losses last week, losing at Florida State and Michigan ... **JON MOORE** led the Runnin' Bulldogs with 21 points against the Seminoles, including 5-of-8 from three-point range ... Against Michigan, **BRIAN McNAIR** had a team-high 14 points in 18 minutes off the bench ... Sandwiched in between the losses was a 78-42 home win over Virginia Intermont. **STEFON JOHNSON** had a double-double with 10 points and 12 rebounds in the victory.

HIGH POINT

Junior **NICK BARBOUR** now ranks 28th in High Point history with 1,014 career points. Among HPU's Division I-era players, Barbour ranks sixth ... HPU's seven newcomers have accounted for 49.8 percent of the team's scoring and 50.0 percent of the team's rebounding through three games ... Freshman forward **Du'VAUGHN MAXWELL** led HPU with nine rebounds at Old Dominion and had seven against Gwynedd-Mercy. He made his first career start against Gwynedd-Mercy ... Senior **EARNEST BRIDGES** made his first start in two seasons against Gwynedd-Mercy and scored 15 points, the second-most of his career.

LIBERTY

Liberty travels to South Florida this week and has yet to defeat a BIG EAST opponent in seven attempts ... Head Coach **DALE LAYER** enters the Sun Dome with an unblemished 2-0 record against USF. The wins occurred during his tenure at Colorado State ... **JESSE SANDERS** finished with 10 points and seven assists in Liberty's 82-49 win over Southern Virginia last Thursday, moving him passed 500 points and 400 rebounds in his collegiate career. The junior point guard now has 510 career points (48th all-time at Liberty) and 410 boards ... Liberty's overtime game at UNC Wilmington last Tuesday ended a 44-game streak without an overtime contest. The last time Liberty went to an extra period was on Feb. 4, 2009, when the Flames were edged on the road by Gardner-Webb, 95-90.

PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE

PC went 1-1 last week after splitting games at #3/3 Kansas State (loss) and at Eastern Kentucky (win) ... The Blue Hose were within three points of the Wildcats before losing by nine ... In the win over Eastern Kentucky, PC dished out 23 assists -- the most for the Blue Hose against a Division I opponent. **PIERRE MILLER** accounted for a PC Division I-record 10 assists in the game. The victory over the Colonials was the 350th for Head Coach **GREGG NIBERT** ... The Blue Hose conclude the O'Reilly Auto Parts CBE Classic this week with three games at James Madison (Bucknell, JMU, Princeton).

RADFORD

The Highlanders played once last week, dropping an 85-56 decision at South Carolina last Friday. **BLAKE SMITH** had a team-high 14 points off the bench ... Radford's road swing continues with two games this week with stops at George Mason on Wednesday and Charlotte on Saturday before returning home to open Big South play Dec. 2 against UNC Asheville.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville went 1-1 last week as the Bulldogs lost at Furman, 69-67, before exploding for a 116-58 victory over Virginia Intermont on Saturday afternoon in its home opener ... Asheville's 116 points was the most by a Bulldog team since **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** became head coach. The Bulldogs' 58-point win was the second-largest since the program moved to Division I 25 years ago. Asheville's 20 steals in the game tied a school record. The Bulldogs had seven players in double figures, the most since a 144-93 win over Voorhees in the opening game of the 1987-88 season ... Junior guard **MATT DICKEY** is Asheville's leading scorer with a 20.0 average. He has led the Bulldogs in scoring all three games this year, including a career-high tying 26 points at Furman.

VMI

STAN OKOYE has recorded double-doubles in his last three games, averaging 22.3 points and 11.3 rebounds in that span. He also is making 74.2 percent of his field goals (23-of-31) during his current streak.

WINTHROP
