Kenon averaged 21.5 points, 5.0 assists and 2.5 rebounds in two games last week. He opened with 17 points, five helpers and 6-of-6 from the free throw line at VCU. Kenon then scored 26 points on 8-of-15 field goals - including seven three-pointers, while handing out five assists and grabbing four rebounds in a win over Longwood. For the week, Kenon was 12-of-26 from the field (=46.2), 10-of-20 from three-point range (=50.0) and 9-of-10 from the charity stripe (=90.0).

MILESTONE MAN

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** recorded his 200th career win at Asheville with the Bulldogs' 86-57 victory over Montreat College this past Saturday. The Big South's all-time winningest coach for overall wins (200) and Big South victories (118), Biedenbach is 229-273 in 17-plus years as a collegiate head coach.

SPEAKING OF COACHING WINS

VMI head coach **DUGGAR BAUCOM** picked up his 76th win as the Keydets leader with this past Saturday's 114-82 triumph over Longwood. Baucom is now No. 3 on the school's all-time win list. Meanwhile, Winthrop head coach **RANDY PEELE** won his 100th game as a collegiate head coach with the Eagles' 83-74 win at Wake Forest on Nov. 22. He needs one more Conference victory to become the eighth coach in League history with 50 regular-season Big South wins.

ELDER STATESMAN

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** is seven wins shy of 600 career Division I victories, as he is 593-381 at the Division I level. Ellis, who entered the season 10th on the NCAA's active Division I win list, has directed four Division I programs to 20-win seasons in his career, which includes five seasons with at least 25 wins. He has been named Coach of the Year in four difference Conferences (Sun Belt, ACC, SEC, Big South) and owns a lifetime record of 671-393.

SPECIAL K

Charleston Southern junior **KELVIN MARTIN** became the 58th member of the Big South's 500 career rebound club as he eclipsed the milestone this past Saturday with 14 boards against Milligan. He is the first Charleston Southern player on the list since **NICK MITCHELL** in 2000-01. Martin's total stands at 506, and is seven shy of 57th place in League history.

JUNIOR 15

UNC Asheville juniors **MATT DICKEY** and **J.P. PRIMM** have scored at least 15 points in the same game six times this season, with the Bulldogs going 3-3 in those games. It should be noted that the losses have been to nationally-ranked North Carolina and Georgetown, as well as a two-point overtime loss at USC Upstate. The duo has reached the 15-point threshold in the same game 11 times since arriving on campus, and Asheville is 7-4 in those games.

IT'S GOOD TO DOUBLE DIP

Just two players have scored in double figures in every game thus far -- Coastal Carolina's **DESMOND HOLLOWAY** and High Point's **NICK BARBOUR**. Holloway has scored at least 13 points in the Chanticleers' first nine games and ranks second in the Big South with 18.4 points per game. Barbour's streak stands at 14 games, dating back to last season. He is fourth in the League in scoring this season with a 16.6 per game clip.

HOME COOKIN'

The 10 Big South men's basketball programs are a collective 27-3 at home this season in non-Conference games, a combined 90.0 winning percentage. The teams actually won the first 21 home games before High Point suffered a six-point loss to Hampton inside the Millis Center on Sunday, Nov. 28.

ANOTHER BROWN LEADING LIBERTY

Liberty newcomer and redshirt-junior **JOHN BROWN** leads the Big South with 10.5 rebounds a game. If he can maintain his position, he would be the first Liberty player to lead the Conference in rebounding since **LEO LIGHTBOURNE** in 2004-05. Brown could also become the first newcomer to finish as the Big South's top rebounder since High Point's **DANNY GATHINGS** in 2002-03.

300/300 CLUB

Charleston Southern senior **JAMARCO WARREN** is looking to become the fourth player in Big South history with 300 career three-pointers and 300 career assists. Warren is one of just six players in League annals in the 250/250 club, as he owns 282 career treys and 273 career helpers. Warren is looking to join Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** (411 3FG, 353 AST), UNC Greensboro's **SCOTT HARTZELL** (309 3FG, 552 AST) and VMI's **CHAVIS HOLMES** (306 3FG, 313 AST) on the League's 300 three-pointer, 300 assist list.

GARDNER-WEBB'S JOSHUA TREE

Gardner-Webb junior forward **JOSH HENLEY**, who became the 32nd player in Big South history with 600 career rebounds when he reached the milestone Dec. 4 at Radford, is averaging 8.50 rebounds a game in his career (612 in 72 games), the eighth-highest career rebounding average in League history. Just the second player in the Conference's existence to surpass 500 rebounds as a sophomore, Henley is on pace to surpass 700 rebounds 11 games from now -- Feb. 3 against Winthrop, based on his career rebounding average.

MR. SAND MAN

Liberty junior guard **JESSE SANDERS** is 51 rebounds shy of 500 in his career in addition to needing 43 assists for 400. Once he reaches both milestones, he would be the first player in Big South history to achieve both the rebound and assist totals in a career. Meanwhile, Sanders is 14th in the country with 6.4 assists per game, and is the only player in the nation averaging at least 6.0 assists and 6.5 rebounds (6.7) a contest.

BE MY VALENTINE

Winthrop redshirt-junior **GEORGE VALENTINE** ranks sixth in the Big South with 8.0 rebounds per game, the highest rebounding average by a Winthrop Eagle since **GREG LEWIS** averaged 10.1 boards a night during the 2001-02 season. Valentine entered the season averaging 3.1 in his career and was averaging 4.6 last year before suffering a season-ending injury in game seven.

SIR CHARLES

Winthrop senior forward/center **CHARLES CORBIN** made his season debut last week after missing the first eight games due to suspension. He grabbed a game-high 11 rebounds in Sunday's win over Jacksonville, and is now 22 caroms away from 500 in his career. Once he reaches the milestone, he would become the second Winthrop Eagle in two seasons to accomplish the feat (following **MANTORIS ROBINSON** last season) and the 59th player on the Conference's all-time rebounding chart.

ALL-TIME SCORERS

Charleston Southern senior **JAMARCO WARREN** cracked the Big South's all-time top 20 scorers this past Saturday against Milligan, as his 27 markers pushed his career scoring total to 1,557 -- third all-time in CSU history. He is 43 points away from becoming the 20th player in Conference annals with 1,600. Below is a look at the Big South's active 1,000-point scorers, as well as those closing in on the milestone:

Presbyterian College redshirt-junior **AL'ONZO COLEMAN** has scored 881 points and grabbed 457 rebounds in his collegiate career (561 points and 313 rebounds as an official Big South member).

JOHN WILLIAMS' BUILDING BLOCKS

UNC Asheville redshirt-senior **JOHN WILLIAMS**, who has missed his last five games due to injury, remains 47 points away from becoming just the third player in Big South history with 1,000 career points, 500 career rebounds and 200 career blocked shots. Already one of four players in League annals with 500 rebounds (562) and 200 blocks (school-record 213), Williams is looking to join Liberty's **PETER ALUMA** (1,715 points, 682 rebounds, 366 blocks) and Radford's **TYRONE TRAVIS** (1,313 points, 718 rebounds, 215 blocks) in this elite group. Williams is fourth all-time in Big South history with 213 rejections, and needs two more to move into a tie with Travis for third-place.

PRIMM-TIME

UNC Asheville junior **J.P. PRIMM** has 349 career assists and needs 51 to join the Big South's 400-assist club, which currently boasts 17 members. He also has 133 career steals and is 67 away from joining the Conference's 12-member 200-steal club. Once he reaches both milestones, he would become the fifth player in League history with 400 assists and 200 steals. The group currently includes Winthrop's **CHRIS GAYNOR** (567 AST, 259 STL), Coastal Carolina's **ROBERT DOWDELL** (561 AST, 239 STL), Campbell's **BRAD CHILDRESS** (543 AST, 243 STL) and Charleston Southern's **ED O'NEIL** (504 AST, 241 STL).

SCORING TOUCH

Winthrop had a 20-point scorer in five of its first eight games, including three-straight outings -- the first such streak since the 2006-07 season. That year, the Eagles had an individual score more than 20 points in three-straight games on three different occasions. The 2010-11 Winthrop squad saw **ANDRE JONES** reach 20 points in three games (20-21-23 = 21.3) and **ROBBIE DREHER** score 20 in back-to-back appearances (28-21 = 24.5). It is the first time Winthrop had two teammates score 20 points in consecutive games since at least before the 1994-95 season. The last time Winthrop had a player score 20 in consecutive games was in 2007-08 (**MICHAEL JENKINS**). The last time Winthrop had two players score 20 points in back-to-back contests was in 2006-07 (Jenkins, **TORRELL MARTIN** and **CRAIG BRADSHAW**).

MID-MAJOR MADNESS

Coastal Carolina moved up in the *Collegeinsider.com* Mid-Major Top 25 poll last week to No. 22, up from the 25th position the week of Nov. 29. The Big South Conference has had a team ranked in the 12-year-old Mid-Major Top 25 poll the last seven consecutive seasons. Below is a week-by-week look at this year's rankings among the Conference members:

SCOREBOARD WATCHING

VMI leads both the Big South and the nation in scoring offense at 95.5 points a game, and is attempting to finish as the country's top scoring offense for an unprecedented fifth-straight year. VMI led the nation in scoring offense in 2009-10 for the fourth consecutive season, becoming the first team in NCAA Division I history to lead the country in scoring offense four consecutive years. The Keydets are also looking to become the first Conference member to lead the Big South in scoring five consecutive years. VMI (2006-present) and Radford (1995-99) are the only programs to lead four-straight seasons.

KEYDET KICKS

VMI senior **AUSTIN KENON** has made a three-pointer in 80 of his 85 career games and has made 279 total for a 3.28 per game average, which is currently the fourth-highest per game clip in League history. The Big South career record is 3.51, set by Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** from 2004-08. Meanwhile, Kenon's teammate **KEITH GABRIEL** has drained a three-pointer in 64 of his 71 career games and already has 197 in his career, an average of 2.77 per game. He is three away from becoming the 27th Big South player with 200 career three-pointers.

FROM THE LAND OF THREE...

Charleston Southern senior **JAMARCO WARREN** has made a school-record 282 three-point field goals in his career, good for ninth on the Big South's all-time list. He needs one to move into a tie with High Point's **EUGENE HARRIS** for eighth place at 283. Warren is 18 three-pointers away from becoming just the fifth Big South player with 300 career threes.

COVER TWO

VMI freshman **D.J. COVINGTON** blocked nine shots against Southern Virginia on Nov. 23, the highest block total in the Big South since former UNC Asheville center **KENNY GEORGE** swatted away 10 shots against Campbell on Nov. 17, 2007. Covington has played in just six of VMI's 11 games due to injuries, but still has 22 blocked shots in his limited action (3.7 per game), including three games with at least four rejections.

DID YOU KNOW ...

... that High Point set the Big South single-game record for most free throw attempts in its season opener? Against Ferrum on Nov. 13, the Panthers attempted 60 free throws, breaking the old mark of 53 that was first set by former member UMBC against Charleston Southern on Jan. 23, 1993, and later tied by CSU against Stetson on Dec. 18, 1999. High Point made 36 of those free throw attempts against Ferrum, which is tied for the fifth-most made in a single-game in League history.

HELLO 2-0

With the first set of Big South games concluding Dec. 4, Liberty and High Point emerged from the pack with 2-0 League records to tie for first-place in the Conference standings. The Flames are 2-0 in the Big South for the first time ever, while the Panthers have won their first two League games for the first time since 2006-07. Conference play will resume Dec. 31.

HOME TEAMS GET THE EDGE IN FIRST WEEKEND

The home teams claimed five of the first nine Big South games played this season (=55.6 percent), an improvement over last season's opening weekend that saw six road teams win the first nine League games. In 2009-10, the home teams won 62.2 percent of the time (56-34), which was the highest in the Big South since the 2007-08 season.

EDGE OF YOUR SEAT ACTION...

Seven of the first nine Big South games had winning margins of less than 10 points, including four that were decided by three points-or-less. Overall, the first nine Conference games of the 2010-11 season had an average margin of victory of 7.33 points. Last year, the overall margin of victory in League play was 10.51 points, while the 2008-09 average margin was 8.96 points.
