Dreher averaged 24.5 points and 4.0 rebounds in two games last week. He scored a career-high 28 points in an overtime win at VMI, including 4-of-8 from beyond the arc and 8-of-8 from the foul line. He scored 15 of his points in the second half and overtime, in addition to five rebounds and three steals against the Keydets. Dreher followed with 21 points in a three-point loss at Liberty, plus three rebounds and two assists. For the week, he was 15-of-33 from the floor (=45.5), 6-of-13 from three-point range (=46.2) and went 13-of-16 from the charity stripe (=81.3).

HELLO 2-0

With the first set of Big South games concluding this past Saturday, Liberty and High Point emerged from the pack with 2-0 League records to tie for first-place in the Conference standings. The Flames are 2-0 in the Big South for the first time ever, while the Panthers have won their first two League games for the first time since 2006-07. Conference play will resume Dec. 31.

HOME TEAMS GET THE EDGE IN FIRST WEEKEND

The home teams claimed five of the first nine Big South games played over the weekend (=55.6 percent), an improvement over last season's opening weekend that saw six road teams win the first nine League games. In 2009-10, the home teams won 62.2 percent of the time (56-34), which was the highest in the Big South since the 2007-08 season.

EDGE OF YOUR SEAT ACTION...

Seven of the first nine Big South games had winning margins of less than 10 points, including four that were decided by three points-or-less. Overall, the first nine Conference games of the 2010-11 season had an average margin of victory of 7.33 points. Last year, the overall margin of victory in League play was 10.51 points, while the 2008-09 average margin was 8.96 points.

THINGS ARE BOILING AT GARDNER-WEBB

Gardner-Webb enters the week at 6-4, and is just two wins away from matching its victory total from all of last season. Under new coach **CHRIS HOLTMANN**, the Runnin' Bulldogs are off to their best 10-game start since 2004-05 when Gardner-Webb opened that season 6-4.

BLUE HOSE GET BACK ON TRACK

Presbyterian College snapped two Conference losing streaks over the weekend. The Blue Hose won at VMI Saturday afternoon, 92-78, to end their 8-game Conference losing streak. The victory in Lexington also snapped PC's 17-game Conference road losing streak. Presbyterian College, which is two wins away from matching its win total from all of last season, was the only Big South team to shoot better than 50 percent from the field in both League games last week (51.0 at Liberty at 54.8 at VMI).

HOME COOKIN'

The 10 Big South men's basketball programs are a collective 23-1 at home this season in non-Conference games, a combined 95.8 winning percentage. The teams actually won the first 21 home games before High Point suffered a six-point loss to Hampton inside the Millis Center on Sunday, Nov. 28.

MILESTONE MAN

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** is one win shy of 200 career victories at Asheville. The Big South's all-time winningest coach for overall wins (199) and Big South victories (118), Biedenbach is 228-273 in 17-plus years as a collegiate head coach.

SPEED TRAP

Presbyterian College held VMI to 78 points this past Saturday, the fewest the Keydets have scored in a home Conference game since Feb. 20, 2008 when Winthrop held VMI to 70 points at Cameron Hall. VMI entered the 2010-11 League season last Thursday averaging 99.4 points, but was limited to an average of 80 after scoring just 82 against Winthrop in overtime in its Big South opener, and 78 against the Blue Hose two days later.

SCORING TOUCH

Winthrop has had a 20-point scorer in five of its first eight games, including the last three outings -- the first such streak since the 2006-07 season. That year, the Eagles had an individual score more than 20 points in three-straight games on three different occasions. The 2010-11 Winthrop squad has seen **ANDRE JONES** reach 20 points in the last three games (20-21-23 = 21.3) and **ROBBIE DREHER** score 20 in his last two appearances (28-21 = 24.5). It is the first time Winthrop had two teammates score 20 points in back-to-back games since at least before the 1994-95 season. The last time Winthrop had a player score 20 in consecutive games was in 2007-08 (**MICHAEL JENKINS**). The last time Winthrop had two players score 20 points in back-to-back contests was in 2006-07 (Jenkins, **TORRELL MARTIN** and **CRAIG BRADSHAW**).

GARDNER-WEBB'S JOSHUA TREE

Gardner-Webb junior forward **JOSH HENLEY** became the 32nd player in Big South history with 600 career rebounds when he reached the milestone this past Saturday at Radford. Henley sits at exactly 600 and is averaging 8.70 rebounds a game in his career (600 in 69 games), the sixth-highest career rebounding average in League history. Just the second player in the Conference's existence to surpass 500 rebounds as a sophomore, Henley is on pace to surpass 700 rebounds 12 games from now -- Jan. 27 against VMI, based on his career rebounding average.

BE MY VALENTINE

Winthrop redshirt-junior **GEORGE VALENTINE** ranks sixth in the Big South with 8.0 rebounds per game, the highest rebounding average by a Winthrop Eagle since **GREG LEWIS** averaged 10.1 boards a night during the 2001-02 season. Valentine entered the season averaging 3.1 in his career and was averaging 4.6 last year before suffering a season-ending injury in game seven.

ANOTHER BROWN LEADING LIBERTY

Liberty newcomer and redshirt-junior **JOHN BROWN** leads the Big South with 10.8 rebounds a game. If he can maintain his position, he would be the first Liberty player to lead the Conference in rebounding since **LEO LIGHTBOURNE** in 2004-05. Brown could also become the first newcomer to finish as the Big South's top rebounder since High Point's **DANNY GATHINGS** in 2002-03.

300/300 CLUB

Charleston Southern senior **JAMARCO WARREN** is looking to become the fourth player in Big South history with 300 career three-pointers and 300 career assists. Warren is one of just six players in League annals in the 250/250 club, as he owns 279 career treys and 267 career helpers. Warren is looking to join Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** (411 3FG, 353 AST), UNC Greensboro's **SCOTT HARTZELL** (309 3FG, 552 AST) and VMI's **CHAVIS HOLMES** (306 3FG, 313 AST) on the League's 300 three-pointer, 300 assist list.

ALL-TIME SCORERS

Charleston Southern senior **JAMARCO WARREN** needs 10 points to move into sole possession of 21st on the Big South's all-time scoring list, as well as 17 markers to enter the League's top 20. Presbyterian College redshirt-junior **AL'LONZO COLEMAN** has scored 871 points and grabbed 447 rebounds in his collegiate career (551 points and 303 rebounds as an official Big South member).

JOHN WILLIAMS' BUILDING BLOCKS

UNC Asheville redshirt-senior **JOHN WILLIAMS**, who has missed his last four games due to injury, remains 47 points away from becoming just the third player in Big South history with 1,000 career points, 500 career rebounds and 200 career blocked shots. Already one of four players in League annals with 500 rebounds (562) and 200 blocks (school-record 213), Williams is looking to join Liberty's **PETER ALUMA** (1,715 points, 682 rebounds, 366 blocks) and Radford's **TYRONE TRAVIS** (1,313 points, 718 rebounds, 215 blocks) in this elite group. Williams is fourth all-time in Big South history with 213 rejections, and needs two more to move into a tie with Travis for third-place.

ELDER STATESMAN

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** is seven wins shy of 600 career Division I victories, as he is 593-381 at the Division I level. Ellis, who entered the season 10th on the NCAA's active Division I win list, has directed four Division I programs to 20-win seasons in his career, which includes five seasons with at least 25 wins. He has been named Coach of the Year in four difference Conferences (Sun Belt, ACC, SEC, Big South) and owns a lifetime record of 671-393.

SPECIAL K

Charleston Southern junior **KELVIN MARTIN** is eight rebounds away from becoming the 58th member of the Big South's 500-rebound club. Martin would be the first Charleston Southern player on the list since **NICK MITCHELL** surpassed the milestone in 2000-01.

PRIMM-TIME

UNC Asheville junior **J.P. PRIMM** has 347 career assists and needs 53 to join the Big South's 400-assist club, which currently boasts 17 members. He also has 130 career steals and is 70 away from joining the Conference's 12-member 200-steal club. Once he reaches both milestones, he would become the fifth player in League history with 400 assists and 200 steals. The group currently includes Winthrop's **CHRIS GAYNOR** (567 AST, 259 STL), Coastal Carolina's **ROBERT DOWDELL** (561 AST, 239 STL), Campbell's **BRAD CHILDRESS** (543 AST, 243 STL) and Charleston Southern's **ED O'NEIL** (504 AST, 241 STL).

MR. SAND MAN

Liberty junior guard **JESSE SANDERS** is 57 rebounds shy of 500 in his career in addition to needing 48 assists for 400. Once he reaches both milestones, he would be the first player in Big South history to achieve both the rebound and assist totals in a career. Meanwhile, Sanders is 15th in the country with 6.5 assists per game, and is the only player in the nation averaging at least 6.5 assists and 6.5 rebounds (6.8) a contest.

MID-MAJOR MADNESS

Coastal Carolina re-entered the *Collegeinsider.com* Mid-Major Top 25 poll last week, claiming the 25th position in the poll after falling out the week before. VMI also received votes in the Mid-Major Top 25 for the second-straight week. The Big South Conference has had a team ranked in the 12-year-old Mid-Major Top 25 poll the last seven consecutive seasons. Below is a week-by-week look at this year's rankings among the Conference members:

SCOREBOARD WATCHING

VMI leads the Big South in scoring offense at 95.1 points a game and will attempt to lead the nation in scoring for an unprecedented fifth-straight year (the Keydets are currently second nationally, with Washington leading the country at 95.7). VMI led the nation in scoring offense in 2009-10 for the fourth consecutive season, becoming the first team in NCAA Division I history to lead the country in scoring offense four consecutive years. The Keydets are also looking to become the first Conference member to lead the Big South in scoring five consecutive years. VMI (2006-present) and Radford (1995-99) are the only programs to lead four-straight seasons.

KEYDET KICKS

VMI senior **AUSTIN KENON** has made a three-pointer in 78 of his 83 career games and has made 269 total for a 3.24 per game average, which is currently the fourth-highest per game clip in League history. The Big South career record is 3.51, set by Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** from 2004-08. Meanwhile, Kenon's teammate **KEITH GABRIEL** has drained a three-pointer in 62 of his 69 career games and already has 193 in his career, an average of 2.80 per game.

FROM THE LAND OF THREE...

Charleston Southern senior **JAMARCO WARREN** has made a school-record 279 three-point field goals in his career, good for ninth on the Big South's all-time list. He needs four to move into a tie with High Point's **EUGENE HARRIS** for eighth place at 283. Warren is 21 three-pointers away from becoming just the fifth Big South player with 300 career threes.

COVER TWO

VMI freshman **D.J. COVINGTON** blocked nine shots against Southern Virginia on Nov. 23, the highest block total in the Big South since former UNC Asheville center **KENNY GEORGE** swatted away 10 shots against Campbell on Nov. 17, 2007. Covington has been limited to just four games this season due to injuries, but still has 17 blocked shots in his limited action (4.3 per game).

OPENING TIP

For the third time in the last four seasons, the Big South Conference has recorded wins over members from the Atlantic Coast Conference and the Southeastern Conference in the same season. UNC Asheville opened the 2010-11 campaign with a 70-69 overtime win at Auburn, while Winthrop won at Wake Forest in the consolation round of the Preseason NIT with an 83-74 victory over the Demon Deacons. The Big South also recorded wins over the ACC and SEC in 2008-09 and 2007-08.

BIG SOUTH TO MAKE SIXTH APPEARANCE IN BRACKETBUSTERS EVENT

The Big South Conference will again participate in the BracketBusters event this season during the weekend of February 18-19, with a League-record nine teams among the field of 114. Representing the Big South in the 2011 event will be last year's four BracketBusters participants Winthrop, Radford, Presbyterian College and Gardner-Webb, plus High Point, Liberty, UNC Asheville, Charleston Southern and VMI -- the latter two making their first appearance in the series. The Big South has the third-most Conference members participating of the 15 Leagues involved this season. The Conference is 7-8 all-time in the BracketBusters, including two wins in 2006, 2007 and 2010, and has been selected for national television appearances three times: 2007 (ESPN2), 2008 (ESPN2) and 2009 (ESPNU). In 2011-12 and 2012-13, the Big South Conference will have 11 teams in the event, including new member Campbell.

Charleston Southern opened the Conference schedule with a 73-71 setback at rival Coastal Carolina, a game in which the Bucs came back from a 12-point second-half deficit to tie it with :07 seconds remaining. **KELVIN MARTIN** led the Buccaneers with 19 points and 11 rebounds at Coastal for his first double-double of the season, and **JEREMY SEXTON** added 14 points ... **ZIMMY NWOGBO** posted his first career double-double in a 120-43 win over Toccoa Falls last Tuesday. The 120 points was the most by CSU in the **BARCLAY RADEBAUGH** era, and the 77-point victory margin is the second-highest in program history.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina ran its winning streak to five games after a 73-71 win over Charleston Southern Saturday afternoon at Kimbel Arena. **CHAD GRAY** scored the game-winning basket on a dunk with 1.6 seconds left to lift the Chanticleers to their fifth-straight Conference victory dating back to last season. Gray finished with 18 points and three rebounds to lead a trio of Chants in double figures. **DESMOND HOLLOWAY** tallied his second-straight double-double with a game-high 21 points and 11 caroms ... Coastal is idle until a Dec. 13 game at LSU.

GARDNER-WEBB

Gardner-Webb is off to its best 10-game start since going 6-4 to start the 2004-05 season. GWU went on to post an 18-12 mark and win the Atlantic Sun Conference regular-season title that season ... GWU did not reach its sixth win last season until January 21 ... The Runnin' Bulldogs last two losses have come by a combined three points ... **STEFON JOHNSON** netted a career-high 20 points at High Point last Thursday, and scored all 12 of his points at Radford in the decisive second half.

HIGH POINT

High Point has won its first two Big South games for the first time since 2006-07, when the team started 6-0 ... Against Gardner-Webb, **NICK BARBOUR** (16 points), **TEHRAN COX** (15) and **SHAY SHINE** (15) combined for 46 of HPU's 66 points. Shine later scored a season-high 19 points against UNC Asheville. He also posted season-highs of seven steals and six assists against Asheville ... Cox has scored in double-figures three times this season, including both games last week, after reaching double digits once in 2009-10 ... **COREY LAW** had a career-high 19 points and a season-high 12 rebounds vs. Asheville ... Shine's dunk before halftime against UNC Asheville was ESPN's top play on Saturday. It was the first time HPU has ever been featured as ESPN's top play.

LIBERTY

With four-straight wins, Liberty is currently on its longest win streak since the 2008-09 season ... **DAVID MINAYA** is Liberty's most improved player this season, putting up better numbers in almost every major statistical category. The 92 points marked the most points PC has ever scored against a Division I team ... Four players averaged double figures for the week as the team went a combined 60-of-113 (=53.1 percent) from the field ... The Blue Hose are off for exams before traveling to No. 11/15 Missouri this Saturday.

RADFORD

GORKEM SONMEZ scored a career-high 17 points vs. UNC Asheville last week ... **JOHNATHAN EDWARDS** had team-highs of 13 points and nine rebounds vs. Gardner-Webb this past Saturday.

UNC ASHEVILLE

The Bulldogs went 1-2 on the road last week. Asheville lost by two in double overtime at USC Upstate, 93-91. **J.P. PRIMM** scored a career-high 26 points in the loss to the Spartans, while **D.J. CUNNINGHAM** pulled down a career-high 18 rebounds. The 18 boards were the most by an Asheville player in the Division I era ... The Bulldogs opened Big South Conference play with a 70-50 victory at Radford Thursday night to move to 14-1 in Conference openers under **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** ... The Bulldogs lost at High Point, 76-73 Saturday night despite a career-high 17 points from **QUINARD JACKSON**. Asheville had a season-high 22 turnovers in the loss ... Primm moved into sixth-place on Asheville's all-time career assists list as he now has 347 assists.

VMI

STAN OKOYE produced two-career scoring highs over VMI's three-game span last week. He matched his career-high with 26 points against Central Penn, then later pumped in a career-high 30 points and connected on 13-of-22 shots against Presbyterian College on Saturday ... VMI's 151 points against Central Penn was the second-most points scored in a game by the Keydets in school history, and just five points shy of the program record of 156, which was accomplished in 2006-07 and 2007-08, respectively. VMI buried 21 three-pointers, the first game VMI had with 20-plus treys since January of 2009, and posted a school-record 85-point second half.
