Moore, one of only three seniors on the GWU roster, led the Runnin' Bulldogs to a strong 2-0 start in back-to-back games over the weekend. He opened the season with 24 points Friday at Charlotte, helping the 'Dogs to a 78-70 victory. Moore made 10 free throws, including 4-of-6 in the final two minutes to seal the win. He also grabbed nine rebounds and was 6-of-11 from the field. On Saturday, Moore had 11 points and seven rebounds in just 19 minutes of action in a victory over Mary Washington. He finished the week averaging 17.5 points, 8.0 rebounds and 50.0 percent from the field.

Davis became the first freshman to start a game at point guard for Gardner-Webb since 2006 and helped the Runnin' Bulldogs to two wins. He recorded eight points and two steals in the win at Charlotte, then scored 12 points and dished off six assists the next night against Mary Washington. For the week, Davis averaged 10.0 points, 4.0 assists and 2.0 steals, as well as 66.7 percent from the field, 50.0 percent from three-point range and 75.0 percent from the charity stripe.

OH WHAT A NIGHT

The Big South enjoyed a memorable start to the 2010-11 season last Friday, as Gardner-Webb opened the campaign with a 78-70 road win at Atlantic 10 member Charlotte. UNC Asheville capped the evening with a 70-69 overtime win at SEC member Auburn. Liberty, VMI and Coastal Carolina were also victorious on opening night last Friday. It is the third time in the last four years that a Big South member has defeated an SEC team. In 2007-08, Asheville won at South Carolina and the following season VMI opened with a win at Kentucky.

WELCOME MAT

The Big South's newest head coach -- Gardner-Webb's **CHRIS HOLTMANN**, picked up his first win as a collegiate head coach in his first game at the helm of the Runnin' Bulldog cagers with GWU's 78-70 victory at Charlotte on Nov. 12.

COASTAL CAROLINA'S MID-MAJOR MADNESS

Coastal Carolina is ranked No. 20 in this week's *Collegeinsider.com* Preseason Mid-Major Top 25 poll, which marks the 13th consecutive week that the Chanticleers have appeared in the ranking. Coastal, ranked No. 22 in the preseason poll, was ranked as high as No. 10 last season the week of March 1. This is the seventh consecutive year that the Big South has had a team ranked in the Mid-Major Top 25 poll, which is in its 12th season.

SCOREBOARD WATCHING

After two games, VMI is averaging exactly 100.0 points a game and will attempt to lead the nation in scoring for an unprecedented fifth-straight year. VMI led the nation in scoring offense in 2009-10 for the fourth consecutive season, becoming the first team in NCAA Division I history to lead the country in scoring offense four consecutive years. The Keydets averaged 88.6 points last season and return 91.3 percent of that scoring output this year -- which is considerably more than the 48.9 percent that returned from their 2008-09 scoring offense that averaged 93.8 points.

ALL ALONE AT THE TOP

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** is the Big South's all-time winningest coach for overall wins (197) and Big South victories (117). He first broke the League record for regular-season Conference wins on Jan. 21, 2010 with the Bulldogs' 66-53 triumph over Winthrop, which was his 110th Big South victory, breaking the record of 109 that was established by former Radford coach **RON BRADLEY** from 1991-02. On Feb. 27, Biedenbach became the overall record holder with the Bulldogs' 89-86 win over Gardner-Webb. The victory was his 195th overall win at Asheville, breaking the previous League record of 194 wins that was established by former Winthrop coach **GREGG MARSHALL** from 1998-07.

BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB

High Point junior **NICK BARBOUR** is just 16 points away from 1,000 in his career, as he has 984 points in 60 career games played. Below is a look at the Big South's active 1,000-point scorers, as well as those closing in on the milestone:

Presbyterian College redshirt-junior **AL'LONZO COLEMAN** has scored 771 points and grabbed 394 rebounds in his collegiate career (451 points and 250 rebounds as an official Big South member).

JOHN WILLIAMS' BUILDING BLOCKS

UNC Asheville redshirt-senior **JOHN WILLIAMS**, the school's all-time leading shot blocker, is one of four players in Big South history with 500 career rebounds and 200 career blocked shots. Williams is fourth all-time with 209 rejections, and needs six more to move into a tie for third-place. His 552 career caroms rank 47th, and he is 48 boards shy of becoming the 32nd player in Conference annals with 600 rebounds.

GARDNER-WEBB'S JOSHUA TREE

Gardner-Webb junior forward **JOSH HENLEY** currently ranks fourth all-time in Big South history with 8.87 rebounds a game, as he has grabbed 541 in just 61 career games. Just one of two players in Conference history to surpass 500 career rebounds as a sophomore, Henley is just 59 away from 600.

BIG SOUTH TO MAKE SIXTH APPEARANCE IN BRACKETBUSTERS EVENT

The Big South Conference will again participate in the BracketBusters event this season during the weekend of February 18-19, with a League-record nine teams among the field of 114. Representing the Big South in the 2011 event will be last year's four BracketBusters participants Winthrop, Radford, Presbyterian College and Gardner-Webb, plus High Point, Liberty, UNC Asheville, Charleston Southern and VMI -- the latter two making their first appearance in the series. The Big South has the third-most Conference members participating of the 15 Leagues involved this season. The Conference is 7-8 all-time in the BracketBusters, including two wins in 2006, 2007 and 2010, and has been selected for national television appearances three times: 2007 (ESPN2), 2008 (ESPN2) and 2009 (ESPNU). In 2011-12 and 2012-13, the Big South Conference will have 11 teams in the event, including new member Campbell.

KEEP AN EYE ON...

...UNC Asheville junior **J.P. PRIMM** and Liberty junior **JESSE SANDERS**, as the talented point guards will etch their names in the Big South record books. Primm surpassed 300 career assists in the Bulldogs' 2010 Big South Tournament Quarterfinal win over High Point and currently has 315. He also has 114 career steals. Sanders surpassed 300 career assists on Sunday at Notre Dame and is currently at 301. He also owns 389 career rebounds.

KEYDET KICKS

VMI senior **AUSTIN KENON** has made a three-pointer in 73 of his 78 career games and has made 256 total for a 3.28 per game average, which is currently the fourth-highest per game clip in League history. The Big South career record is 3.51, set by Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** from 2004-08. Meanwhile, Kenon's teammate **KEITH GABRIEL** has drained a three-pointer in 56 of his 62 career games and already has 180 in his career, an average of 2.90 per game.

FROM THE LAND OF THREE...

Charleston Southern senior **JAMARCO WARREN** has made a school-record 259 three-point field goals in his career, good for 10th on the Big South's all-time list. He needs 16 to move into a tie with Coastal Carolina's **KEKE HICKS** for ninth place. Warren is 41 three-pointers away from becoming just the fifth Big South player with 300 career threes.

ELDER STATESMAN

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** has directed four Division I programs to 20 win seasons in his career after the Chanticleers won a school-record 28 games in 2009-10 -- the fifth time he has won at least 25 games in a season. He has been named Coach of the Year in four difference Conferences (Sun Belt, ACC, SEC, Big South) and owns a lifetime record of 666-391. Ellis has amassed 588 Division I victories, which ranks 10th on the NCAA's active win list.

COASTAL CAROLINA RE-WRITES HISTORY

Last season, Coastal Carolina was the first team in Big South history to improve from eighth-place the previous year to regular-season Conference champions the next. The Chanticleers re-established the Big South's best "worst-to-first" in League history, as the previous best was accomplished two seasons ago when Radford improved from seventh-place in 2007-08 to League champion in 2008-09.

ALL ABOUT THE NUMBER 10

With Big South Conference play beginning in just two weeks, last season's Conference schedule saw six teams win at least 10 Big South games in the same year, tying the League record that was first accomplished in 1993-94. UNC Asheville won at least 10 Big South games for the third consecutive season -- the first time in school history and just the third Big South program to accomplish the trifecta. The Bulldogs joined UNC Greensboro (three times from 1993-96) and Winthrop (nine times from 1999-08) as the only schools with three-straight 10-win Conference seasons.

AN A-PEELING NOTE

Winthrop head coach **RANDY PEELE** is just the second coach in Big South Conference history to make three appearances in the NCAA Tournament following the Eagles trip to the Big Dance in 2009-10. Peele led former member UNC Greensboro to the Big South title and NAAs in 1996, and repeated the accomplishment in his first season as Winthrop's head coach in 2008. Meanwhile, Peele has won his three Big South Tournament Championships on the home floor of his opponents. In 1996, Peele and UNC Greensboro defeated Liberty in the title game in the Vines Center, and in 2008, Peele and Winthrop downed UNC Asheville in the Championship game at Justice Center. Last season it was a victory over Coastal Carolina at Kimbel Arena.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern opened the season against an ACC opponent for the second year in a row, falling at Georgia Tech, 52-39. The Buccaneers pulled to within nine points in the waning minutes. Junior **JOHATHAN BROOKS** contributed a double-double in his CSU debut with 14 points and 11 rebounds, the first season-opening double-double by a Buccaneer since 1991 ... CSU is now 2-4 in season-openers under head coach **BARCLAY RADEBAUGH** ... The Bucs host city rival The Citadel in their home opener Tuesday.

COASTAL CAROLINA

The Chanticleers opened the season with a pair of home wins to start the season at 2-0 ... Eight Chants scored in double figures Friday night as Coastal defeated Piedmont College, 112-52, to secure the 500th win in program history. It was the most points scored by a Coastal Carolina team since the Chanticleers poured in 115 points in a 2003 victory over Lees-McRae. **CHAD GRAY** led the way with 22 points and career-high 11 rebounds ... Coastal picked up its second win of the weekend with a 79-40 win over LaGrange College on Saturday ... Coastal returns to action Tuesday night at the College of Charleston.

GARDNER-WEBB

Gardner-Webb shocked Atlantic 10 member Charlotte in Halton Arena to open the season, avenging last year's 95-66 loss to the same 49ers. It was GWU's first win over Charlotte in three tries ... GWU is off to a 2-0 start with a Division I win included in that total for the first time since 2007-08 ... Gardner-Webb started two freshmen in each of its first two games, with **LUKE DAVIS** manning the point guard spot and 6-foot-10 **MIKE BYRON** holding down the center position ... Following this Thursday's home date with Virginia Intermont, Gardner-Webb will not play a home game until New Year's Eve against Liberty ... First-year head coach **CHRIS HOLTMANN** is known as a sharp defensive mind, and his team has held the first two opponents to a combined 32.0 percent from the floor.

HIGH POINT

HPU opened the season with a win for the second year in a row with a 90-57 win over Ferrum. Redshirt-sophomore **COREY LAW** had a double-double (10 points, 11 rebounds) -- his sixth double-double in his last 15 games ... High Point got 53 of its 90 points (59 percent) from its seven newcomers. Junior transfer **Shay Shine** and freshman **Du'VAUGHN MAXWELL** led HPU with 12 points each in the game. For a significant portion of the second half, HPU had five freshmen on the floor.

LIBERTY

Redshirt-junior **JOHN BROWN** recorded a double-double with 18 points and 17 rebounds in his debut with the Flames. It was the most rebounds since **ANTHONY SMITH** finished with 17 at VMI on Jan. 17, 2009 ... **JESSE SANDERS** is approaching two other career milestones, as he currently has 490 points and 389 rebounds ... After scoring nine points in Liberty's contest at Notre Dame on Sunday, **EVAN GORDON** now has more than 400 career points (404). The sophomore's father, **ERIC GORDON, SR.**, holds 16th-place in the Liberty record books as a member of the 1,000-point club with 1,154 career points.

PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE

The Blue Hose opened the season with an 88-47 loss at Vanderbilt ... **AL'LONZO COLEMAN**, playing in his first game since the 2008-09 season, had team-highs of 17 points and six rebounds against the Commodores, in addition to three steals.

RADFORD

For the first time in 30 years, Radford opened the season with home games on consecutive days ... Ten of the 15 players that make up the 2010-11 roster are freshmen and sophomores. In addition to suiting up one of the youngest teams in the nation, the Highlander returnees (1 senior, 1 junior, 3 sophomores) have just seven combined years of Division I experience, which makes them the sixth-least experienced team in the country. The squad also features five international players ... To create more awareness for Heart Disease and to raise money to benefit the American Heart Association during the 2010-11 season, head coach **BRAD GREENBERG** and assistant **CEDRIC SMITH** will take part in "Shots From the Heart" presented by *CollegeInsider.com* in honor of former Wake Forest coach **SKIP PROSSER**.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville opened its season in dramatic fashion with a thrilling 70-69 overtime win at Auburn Friday night. The Bulldogs spoiled the the inaugural game at Auburn Arena with a determined comeback. Asheville trailed 37-21 at halftime and 60-48 with four minutes left before rallying to send the game into overtime. Coming back from 16 points at halftime is believed to be the greatest road comeback in school history for the Bulldogs. The victory was the first opening-night road victory for the Bulldogs since the 1978-79 season ... **J.P. PRIMM** moved into seventh place on Asheville's career assist list during the game and now has 315 ... Asheville is back on the road Tuesday night at Furman before having its home opener vs. Virginia Intermont Saturday afternoon.

VMI

VMI is 2-0 for the first time under head coach **DUGGAR BAUCOM** ... **STAN OKOYE**'s 14 rebounds at UMBC Sunday equaled his career-high and was part of his ninth career double-double ... **KEITH GABRIEL**'s 30 points against the Retrievers was his fourth career 30-point game ... The Keydets host Virginia-Wise Tuesday in a bid for their first 3-0 start since 1985-86.

WINTHROP

The Eagles opened the season with a 70-61 victory over Queens on Saturday. **GEORGE VALENTINE** recorded a double-double with 13 points and 11 rebounds, while **REGGIE MIDDLETON** had a team-high 15 points ... Winthrop participates in the Preseason NIT this week in Winston-Salem, N.C. and faces VCU on Monday night and either Hampton or Wake Forest Tuesday evening.
