3-0 STARTS

For the second consecutive season, two Big South teams have started Conference play 3-0. Liberty is 4-0 in League action for the first time in school history, while Coastal Carolina is 3-0 in the Big South for the second-straight year and the seventh time overall. The Chanticleers are the first team to open 3-0 in back-to-back seasons since Winthrop in 2005-06 and 2006-07.

WILL SUCCESSFUL TREND OF STARTING 3-0 IN CONFERENCE PLAY CONTINUE?

Starting at least 3-0 in the Big South has proven to pay dividends in League history. A total of 37 teams have started Conference play at least 3-0 since 1985-86, and 20 of those squads have won or shared the regular-season crown. In addition, 10 teams that opened 3-0 went on to win the Conference Tournament title -- the last being Winthrop in 2006-07, while another 10 finished as Big South Tournament runner-up. Furthermore, 11 teams reached the Tournament Semifinals. Meanwhile, of the previous 26 teams that started 4-0, eight won the Big South Tournament championship.

MAKING WAVES

Coastal Carolina has started 12-2 for the second consecutive year, as the Chanticleers opened the 2009-10 season with a school-record 16-2 start. It is the third-straight year that a Big South team has opened a season at least 12-2. VMI opened the 2008-09 campaign with a 14-2 mark. Coastal Carolina needs to win its next three games to match the Big South record for fastest team to win 15 games. The Chanticleers set that record just last season, as the 2009-10 Coastal squad won its 15th game in just its 17th contest of the year. Stay tuned.

ELDER STATESMAN

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** is two wins shy of becoming the 26th coach with 600 career Division I victories, as he is 598-381 at the Division I level. Ellis, who entered the season 10th on the NCAA's active Division I win list, has directed four Division I programs to 20-win seasons in his career, which includes five seasons with at least 25 wins. He has been named Coach of the Year in four difference Conferences (Sun Belt, ACC, SEC, Big South) and owns a lifetime record of 676-393.

WARREN REPORT

Charleston Southern senior guard **JAMARCO WARREN** scored 24 points in each of his last three games to vault into 16th-place on the Big South's all-time scoring list with 1,650 career points. He needs 11 points to surpass Radford's **CHRIS OLIVER** (1,659) and Winthrop's **LaSHAWN COULTER** (1,660) and reach 14th-place. Warren is 50 points away from becoming the 14th player in Big South history with 1,700 points, and needs to average 20.6 points in Charleston Southern's remaining 17 scheduled games to reach 2,000 career markers.

LEGEND OF SLEEPY HOLLOW

Coastal Carolina's **DESMOND HOLLOWAY** is the lone Big South men's basketball player to score in double figures in all of his team's games this season. Holloway has scored at least 13 points in the Chanticleers' first 14 games and ranks second in the Big South with 18.9 points per game.

STAN'S THE MAN

VMI sophomore **STAN OKOYE** leads the Big South in scoring (19.8), field goal percentage (57.9) and double-doubles (7), and is second in rebounding (9.6) -- just 0.2 off the lead. He already has five games with at least 20 points and 10 rebounds, and is averaging 21.1 points and 11.9 rebounds when he records a double-double in a game this season. Meanwhile, Okoye could become just the third player in Big South history to lead the League in scoring, rebounding and field goal percentage in the same season should he grab the rebounding lead. High Point's **DANNY GATHINGS** was the first in 2002-03 and Radford's **ART PARAKHOUSKI** was the last in 2009-10.

HOME COOKIN'

The 10 Big South men's basketball programs are a collective 35-4 at home this season in non-Conference games, a combined 89.7 winning percentage. The teams actually won the first 21 home games before High Point suffered a six-point loss to Hampton inside the Millis Center on Sunday, Nov. 28. Seven non-Conference home games remain on the 2010-11 schedule, including five BracketBusters match-ups.

JUNIOR 15

UNC Asheville juniors **MATT DICKEY** and **J.P. PRIMM** have scored at least 15 points in the same game eight times this season, with the Bulldogs going 5-3 in those games. It should be noted that the losses have been to nationally-ranked North Carolina and Georgetown, as well as a two-point double-overtime loss at USC Upstate. The duo has reached the 15-point threshold in the same game 13 times since arriving on campus in 2008-09, and Asheville is 9-4 in those games.

COASTAL 10

Coastal Carolina is in the midst of a 10-game winning streak, the second-straight season the Chanticleers have strung together a double-digit win streak. Last year, Coastal put together a 12-game win streak from Nov. 28 - Jan. 9. The Chants are the first Big South team to have a 10-game win streak in back-to-back seasons since Radford in 1997-98 (11) and 1998-99 (13).

SIR CHARLES

Winthrop senior forward/center **CHARLES CORBIN** became the 59th Big South player overall and second this season to surpass 500 career rebounds. Corbin eclipsed the milestone in Winthrop's 53-51 win over Presbyterian College on New Year's Eve. He also is the second Winthrop Eagle in two seasons to accomplish the feat (following **MANTORIS ROBINSON** last season) and 10th overall.

WARREN APPROACHING SPECIAL 300/300 CLUB

Charleston Southern senior **JAMARCO WARREN** is on the cusp of becoming just the fourth player in Big South history with 300 career three-pointers and 300 career assists. Warren currently owns 296 career treys and 293 career helpers, and would join Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** (411 3FG, 353 AST), UNC Greensboro's **SCOTT HARTZELL** (309 3FG, 552 AST) and VMI's **CHAVIS HOLMES** (306 3FG, 313 AST) on the League's 300 three-pointer, 300 assist list.

FROM THE LAND OF THREE...

As mentioned above, Charleston Southern's **JAMARCO WARREN** has 296 career three-pointers, which is tied for fifth in Big South history with UNC Asheville's **JOSH KOHN** (1992-96). Warren needs four more three-pointers to become the fifth player in League annals with 300. In addition, VMI senior **AUSTIN KENON** is tied for eighth in the Conference record books with 289 career three-pointers. He has made a three-pointer in 83 of his 88 career games for a 3.28 per game average, which is currently the fourth-highest per game clip in League history. Meanwhile, VMI junior **KEITH GABRIEL** became the 27th Big South player with 200 career three-pointers when he reached the milestone on Sunday at Gardner-Webb.

MR. SAND MAN

Liberty junior guard **JESSE SANDERS** is 16 assists shy of 400 in his career in addition to needing 29 rebounds for 500. Once he reaches both milestones, he would be the first player in Big South history to achieve both the rebound and assist totals in a career. Meanwhile, Sanders is 19th in the country with 6.1 assists per game, and is the only player in the nation averaging at least 6.0 assists and 6.0 rebounds (6.0) a contest.

COLEMAN GRABS REBOUND MILESTONE; CLOSE TO SCORING ACHIEVEMENT

Presbyterian College redshirt-junior **AL'LONZO COLEMAN** has scored 988 points and grabbed 520 rebounds in his collegiate career at PC (651 points and 369 rebounds as an official Big South member). He eclipsed the rebounding milestone with his 16-rebound effort at Winthrop on Dec. 31.

SPECIAL K

Charleston Southern junior **KELVIN MARTIN** needs 50 rebounds to become the first Charleston Southern player with 600 career rebounds since **JEFF DANIELS** surpassed the mark in 1996-97. Martin, who ranks 49th in League history with 550 career boards, would be the fourth Buccaneer in the Big South's 600-rebound club once he reaches the milestone.

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** recorded his 200th career win at Asheville with the Bulldogs' 86-57 victory over Montreat College on Dec. 11. The Big South's all-time winningest coach for overall wins (202) and Big South victories (118), Biedenbach is 231-277 in 17-plus years as a collegiate head coach.

EDGE OF YOUR SEAT ACTION...

Eleven of the first 18 Big South games this season had winning margins of less than 10 points, including six that were decided by three points-or-less. Overall, the first 18 Conference games of the 2010-11 campaign had an average margin of victory of 9.17 points. Last year, the overall margin of victory in League play was 10.51 points, while the 2008-09 average margin was 8.96 points.

HOME TEAMS HAVE SLIGHT EDGE IN CONFERENCE WINS, BUT...

The home teams claimed 10 of the first 18 Big South games played this season (=55.6 percent). In 2009-10, the home teams won 62.2 percent of the time (56-34), which was the highest in the Big South since the 2007-08 season. However, the road teams are winning more convincingly. The road teams own an average margin of victory of 10.6 points in their eight Conference wins. The home teams have won their 10 League games by an average margin of 8.0 points.

MID-MAJOR MADNESS

Coastal Carolina was ranked No. 14 in the *Collegeinsider.com* Mid-Major Top 25 poll last week, its highest ranking of the season. The Big South Conference has had a team ranked in the 12-year-old Mid-Major Top 25 poll the last seven consecutive seasons. ANOTHER BROWN LEADING LIBERTY

Liberty newcomer and redshirt-junior **JOHN BROWN** leads the Big South with 9.8 rebounds a game. If he can maintain his position, he would be the first Liberty player to lead the Conference in rebounding since **LEO LIGHTBOURNE** in 2004-05. Brown could also become the first newcomer to finish as the Big South's top rebounder since High Point's **DANNY GATHINGS** in 2002-03.

SCOREBOARD WATCHING

VMI leads both the Big South and the nation in scoring offense at 92.9 points a game, and is attempting to finish as the country's top scoring offense for an unprecedented fifth-straight year. VMI led the nation in scoring offense in 2009-10 for the fourth consecutive season, becoming the first team in NCAA Division I history to lead the country in scoring offense four consecutive years. The Keydets are also looking to become the first Conference member to lead the Big South in scoring five consecutive years. VMI (2006-present) and Radford (1995-99) are the only programs to lead four-straight seasons.

JOHN WILLIAMS' BUILDING BLOCKS

UNC Asheville redshirt-senior **JOHN WILLIAMS**, who missed seven games from Nov. 23 - Dec. 21 due to injury, is 37 points away from becoming just the third player in Big South history with 1,000 career points, 500 career rebounds and 200 career blocked shots. Already one of four players in League annals with 500 rebounds (574) and 200 blocks (school-record 216), Williams is looking to join Liberty's **PETER ALUMA** (1,715 points, 682 rebounds, 366 blocks) and Radford's **TYRONE TRAVIS** (1,313 points, 718 rebounds, 215 blocks) in this elite group. Williams moved into third all-time in Big South history in blocked shots (216) on Sunday, Jan. 2, and is 81 away from second-place.

COVER TWO

VMI freshman **D.J. COVINGTON** blocked nine shots against Southern Virginia on Nov. 23, the highest block total in the Big South since former UNC Asheville center **KENNY GEORGE** swatted away 10 shots against Campbell on Nov. 17, 2007. Covington has played in just nine of VMI's 14 games due to injuries (64.3 percent), but still has 26 blocked shots in his limited action (2.89 per game, which would lead the Big South), including three games with at least four rejections. He needs to appear in 75 percent of his team's games in order to qualify for the Big South and NCAA statistical rankings.

PRIMM-TIME

UNC Asheville junior **J.P. PRIMM** has 373 career assists and needs 27 to join the Big South's 400-assist club. He also has 145 career steals and is 55 away from joining the Conference's 12-member 200-steal club. Once he reaches both milestones, he would become the fifth player in League history with 400 assists and 200 steals. The group currently includes Winthrop's **CHRIS GAYNOR** (567 AST, 259 STL), Coastal Carolina's **ROBERT DOWDELL** (561 AST, 239 STL), Campbell's **BRAD CHILDRESS** (543 AST, 243 STL) and Charleston Southern's **ED O'NEIL** (504 AST, 241 STL).

BIG SOUTH PRESEASON PLAYER OF THE YEAR

PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE SCORES BCS DOUBLE

Presbyterian College is the second team in Big South Conference history to defeat an SEC team and ACC team in the same season, as the Blue Hose did it in back-to-back games! PC first knocked off the Auburn Tigers, 62-59, on Dec. 18 and then won at Wake Forest, 66-64 on Dec. 20. Former (and future) member Campbell was the first Big South member to achieve the feat. In 1993-94, the Camels defeated North Carolina State (72-69) and South Carolina (73-72).

BIG SOUTH OWNS THREE WINS OVER THE SEC, TWO OVER THE ACC

The Big South has enjoyed some monumental non-Conference success this season, as the League owns three wins over the SEC and two over the ACC. UNC Asheville (at Auburn), Coastal Carolina (at LSU) and Presbyterian College (at Auburn) won at SEC venues, giving the Big South Conference three wins against the SEC for the first time since 1993-94. That season, the Conference had wins over LSU and South Carolina (twice). Meanwhile, both Winthrop and Presbyterian College won at Wake Forest, the League's first multi-win season against the ACC since 2007-08. The Big South Conference has recorded wins over members from the Atlantic Coast Conference and the Southeastern Conference in the same season now for the third time in the last four years.

SEA SHELL

Charleston Southern freshman **SHELDON STRICKLAND** is the first player in Big South history to finish with a perfect 7-of-7 on three-point field goal attempts in a single-game, the minimum to qualify for the Conference and NCAA single-game marks. Strickland went 7-of-7 against the College of Charleston on Dec. 15.

JOSHUA TREE

Gardner-Webb junior forward **JOSH HENLEY**, who became the 32nd player in Big South history with 600 career rebounds when he reached the milestone Dec. 4 at Radford, is the League's active leading career rebounder with 629 career caroms. He is 30th in Conference annals, and is nine away from jumping into 28th place. Just the second player in the Conference's existence to surpass 500 rebounds as a sophomore, Henley is 71 rebounds away from becoming the 21st player in League history with 700 career boards.

OTHER COACHES NETTING MILESTONE WINS

Coastal Carolina's **CLIFF ELLIS** and UNC Asheville's **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** are not the only Big South head coaches notching milestone victories this season. VMI head coach **DUGGAR BAUCOM** picked up his 76th win as the Keydets leader on Dec. 11 to move into third on the school's all-time win list. Winthrop head coach **RANDY PEELE** won his 100th game as a collegiate head coach with the Eagles' 83-74 win at Wake Forest on Nov. 22, and became the eighth coach in League history with 50 regular-season Big South wins with Winthrop's 53-51 win over Presbyterian College on Dec. 31. Liberty head coach **DALE LAYER** needs five more wins for 300 in his coaching career.

BIG SOUTH TO MAKE SIXTH APPEARANCE IN BRACKETBUSTERS EVENT

The Big South Conference will again participate in the BracketBusters event this season during the weekend of February 18-19, with a League-record nine teams among the field of 114. Representing the Big South in the 2011 event will be last year's four BracketBusters participants **WINTHROP**, **RADFORD**, **PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE** and **GARDNER-WEBB**, plus **HIGH POINT**, **LIBERTY**, **UNC ASHEVILLE**, **CHARLESTON SOUTHERN** and **VMI** -- the latter two making their first appearance in the series. The Big South has the third-most Conference members participating of the 15 Leagues involved this season. The Conference is 7-8 all-time in the BracketBusters, including two wins in 2006, 2007 and 2010, and has been selected for national television appearances three times: 2007 (ESPN2), 2008 (ESPN2) and 2009 (ESPNU). In 2011-12 and 2012-13, the Big South Conference will have 11 teams in the event, including new member **CAMPBELL**.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern improved to 8-7 on the season following a 3-1 showing during the past two weeks ... The Bucs have won all seven games at the Buc Dome this season ... **JAMARCO WARREN** has scored exactly 24 points in each of the last three games, his third 20+ point streak of three-or-more games in his career ... **KELVIN MARTIN** posted his fourth double-double of the season against High Point with 14 points and a career-high-tying 15 rebounds, as CSU evened the all-time series with the Panthers at 13-13.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina won its 10th straight game with a 78-60 victory over High Point Sunday afternoon. The Chanticleers scored the final eight points of the first half to take a 35-27 lead into intermission. The Panthers fought to within 10 points at the 6:22 mark on a jumper in the paint, but the Chanticleers outscored High Point 12-4 the rest of the way to improve to 8-0 at home this season.

GARDNER-WEBB

Two of Gardner-Webb's three League losses have come by a combined four points. GWU has four losses of eight points or less so far in 2010-11 ... The 'Dogs have played three-straight games without leading scorer **JON MOORE** (15.5 ppg), who is the only player on the current stat sheet averaging more than 9.0 ppg. Moore is out indefinitely after an injury suffered at Arizona State in mid-December ... Freshman **LUKE DAVIS** averaged 12.5 points and 4.0 assists in two games last week, including a career-high 17 markers vs. Liberty ... Center **MIKE BYRON** averaged 9.0 ppg in the two outings, and narrowly missed a double-double against the Flames after grabbing a career-high 11 rebounds.

HIGH POINT

Junior transfer **SHAY SHINE** has led or ranked second in scoring for HPU in nine of 12 games this season and has scored in double figures 10 times. Beginning with HPU's win over Gardner-Webb on Dec. 2, Shine has averaged 15.4 points, 4.7 rebounds and 3.0 assists over the last seven games. In four Big South games, Shine leads the Panthers in both points (15.8) and assists (4.3) per game ... With **EARNEST BRIDGES** out due to an injury, freshman forward **DU'VAUGHN MAXWELL** grabbed eight rebounds in both games last week. Against Coastal Carolina, Maxwell posted career-highs in points (14) and blocks (4) ... Freshman guard **XAVIER MARTIN** scored a career-high 15 points in just 15 minutes against Charleston Southern on Dec. 31 ... High Point will try to snap its four-game road losing streak this week.

LIBERTY

JESSE SANDERS surpassed the 600 career point mark at Gardner-Webb. The floor general is currently tied for 36th on Liberty's all-time scoring list with **ERIK SORENSON** with 623 points ... **EVAN GORDON** also surpassed the 600-point mark in Liberty's game against UNC Asheville. The sophomore guard is currently 40th on Liberty's all-time scoring list with 609 tallies ... Liberty's 59-55 win at UNC Asheville on Sunday marked the program's first win inside the Justice Center since a 92-80 victory on Feb. 24, 2005.

PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE

Presbyterian College went 2-2 over the last two weeks, including wins over Wake Forest and Navy. During the stretch, PC was led in scoring by **AL'LONGO COLEMAN**, who scored 14.5 points per game with 8.0 rebounds per game ... **PIERRE MILLER** is 11-of-20 from beyond the arc (=55.0 percent) in his last four games and is averaging 11.3 points in that stretch ... PC will play just its second and third home games of the season this week.

RADFORD

During Radford's four-game span from Dec. 20-Jan. 2, **GORKEM SONMEZ** averaged a team-high 12.0 points, while **TOLGA CERRAH** tallied 9.5 points and 6.8 rebounds in that span, while shooting 59.1 percent (13-of-22) from the floor.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville had its 13-game homecourt winning streak snapped last week by VMI and the Bulldogs followed that up with a loss to Liberty ... The Bulldogs started the week out strong with a dramatic 85-79 overtime win over Western Carolina as **J.P. PRIMM** tied his career-high with 26 points ... Asheville is 1-3 in League play for the third-straight year but has recovered each time to finish in fourth place and host a Big South Tournament game. The Bulldogs have led in the second half of every Conference game thus far ... **JOHN WILLIAMS**, who missed seven games due to injury, returned to the lineup Dec. 28 vs. Western Carolina.

VMI

VMI's wins at UNC Asheville and Gardner-Webb were the Keydets' first back-to-back Conference road wins since the last two regular-season games of 2008-09. The recent road swing also produced VMI's fourth win in its last five visits to the Justice Center in Asheville, and VMI remained a perfect 3-0 at Paul Porter Arena ... The Keydets shot a season-high 58.7 percent from the floor (37-of-63) in the 97-76 win at Gardner-Webb and held a 52-38 advantage in points in the paint. VMI outrebounded the Bulldogs 37-32 to go 7-0 in games it has outrebounded its foe ... VMI will play its first home game since Dec. 11 when Coastal Carolina visits on Thursday, Jan. 6.

WINTHROP

After dropping back-to-back road games to Dayton and Kentucky in two of the best college basketball venues in the country -- UD Arena and Rupp Arena -- the Eagles returned home to rally from a 12-point halftime deficit to defeat Presbyterian College for the seventh-straight time, 53-51 on New Year's Eve. PC led for 39 minutes and 44 seconds before **ANDRE JONES** tied the game at 51 with a driving layup. **REGGIE MIDDLETON** was later fouled with 1.2 ticks remaining on an in-bounds play and hit the winning free throw ... Senior forward **CHARLES CORBIN** collected his first double-double of the season against PC ... **MATT MORGAN** tied his career best with 18 points at Kentucky. Both of his 18-point efforts have come in the state of Kentucky, as he netted 18 at Eastern Kentucky in the 2010 BracketBusters.
