COASTAL CAROLINA ESTABLISHES LONGEST WIN STREAK IN BIG SOUTH HISTORY

Coastal Carolina has won 20 consecutive games, the longest win streak in Big South Conference history and currently the second-longest in the nation behind Ohio State's 24-game streak. The Chanticleers have also won 17 consecutive regular-season Big South games, dating back to last season, which is the second-longest Conference-game win streak in League annals. Winthrop owns the top spot with 21 consecutive Big South wins from Jan. 8, 2005 to Jan. 21, 2006.

IT'S A TWO TEAM RACE; COASTAL FIRST TO CLINCH HOME SEED

With five Conference games remaining, Coastal Carolina (13-0) and Liberty (11-2) are the only teams still mathematically in contention to win the Big South's regular-season title. The Chanticleers have already clinched a home seed in the 2011 Advance Auto Parts Big South Men's Basketball Championship, and their magic number for the No. 1 seed as of Feb. 7 is three games. Should Coastal and Liberty tie for the regular-season championship, Coastal would receive the No. 1 seed based on its season sweep of the Flames.

CHANTICLEERS APPROACHING TWO LEAGUE RECORDS FOR CONFERENCE WINS

Coastal Carolina is just the second team in League history to stand 13-0 in Big South play, and a win in its next game would tie the 2006-07 Winthrop Eagles for the best League start (14-0). That season, Winthrop swept through a 14-game Conference slate. Meanwhile, the Chanticleers are also approaching the Big South record for most Conference wins in a season, which is 15 and accomplished four times. Former member Towson State was the first in 1993-94, followed by Winthrop (2004-05), Radford (2008-09) and Coastal Carolina in 2009-10. The 2010-11 Chanticleers are the first team to sweep the first half of an 18-game Big South schedule.

THREE (BULL)DOG NIGHT

UNC Asheville's **J.P. PRIMM** (1,016) became the third Bulldog to reach 1,000 career points this season when he reached the milestone Feb. 3 vs. Presbyterian College. He joined teammates **MATT DICKEY** (1,039) and **JOHN WILLIAMS** (1,066) in the club, and it marks the third time in Conference history that a Big South team had three players score their 1,000th point in the same season. Coastal Carolina was the first in 1990-91 (**BRIAN PENNY, ROBERT DOWDELL, DuWAYNE CHEATAM**) and Radford was the last in 2001-02 (**RAYMOND ARRINGTON, ANDREY SAVTCHENKO, CORREY WATKINS**).

BIG SOUTH'S BRACKETBUSTERS OPPONENTS REVEALED; LIBERTY GETS TV GAME

The official 2011 Sears BracketBusters match-ups were unveiled Monday evening, Jan. 31, and for the fourth time in the Big South's six years of participation, a League member has received a television slot. Liberty will host MAAC member Iona on Saturday, Feb. 19, live on ESPNU at 3:00pm. The Flames are one of a Big South-record nine teams participating in this year's event. The Big South is 7-8 all-time in the series has the third-most Conference members participating of the 13 Leagues involved this season. The Conference will play three members of the Colonial Athletic Association (CAA), two members from the Southern Conference (SoCon), and one each from the Ohio Valley Conference (OVC), Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference (MEAC), Mid-American Conference (MAC) and the MAAC. Each team that participates in BracketBusters will schedule a return date, likely in November or December of the 2012-13 season. The match-ups are below.

ROADIES

Coastal Carolina has won seven-straight Big South road games, one shy of tying the school record of eight. In addition, the Chanticleers are the first team in League history to win four Big South road games by at least 20 points -- bettering Asheville's record of three that was established earlier this season. Coastal won by 22 at VMI (Jan. 6), 21 at UNC Asheville (Jan. 20), 24 at High Point (Jan. 27) and 23 at Radford (Jan. 29).

CONFERENCE TOURNAMENT APPROACHING

The 2011 Advance Auto Parts Big South Men's Basketball Championship Tournament will commence on Tuesday, March 1 at the home sites of the top four seeds.

The top eight of the nine postseason eligible teams will earn a berth in this year's Championship, with the No. 1 seed having a chance to host throughout the Tournament.

For the sixth consecutive season, the Semifinals will be contested at the site of the No. 1 seed and will be broadcast live on ESPNU on Thursday, March 3. The highest remaining seed will host the Championship game on its home floor Saturday, March 5 at 4:00pm live on ESPN2.

TV TIME

The Big South Conference "Royal Purple Game of the Week" television package continues with two broadcasts this week. Thursday's Charleston Southern-Winthrop game will air live on MASN at 7:00pm and will be simulcast on WMMP-TV in Charleston, S.C. The package continues on Saturday with UNC Asheville at Gardner-Webb airing on MASN at 8:00pm with the simulcast on WMYA-TV in Asheville/Greenville/Spartanburg. **MIKE MORGAN** (play-by-play) and **NATE ROSS** (analyst) will call the action from the Winthrop Coliseum on Thursday, while Morgan and **RALPH PATTERSON** will handle the call on Saturday in Boiling Springs.

McSWATTY

Coastal Carolina redshirt-sophomore **SAM McLAURIN** is two blocked shots away from becoming the 26th player in Big South history with 100 career blocks. He would be the third Chanticleer in Conference annals to reach the century mark in rejections.

COASTAL CAROLINA ON DOORSTEP OF TOP 25 RANKINGS

For the fifth consecutive week, Coastal Carolina has received votes in the *Associated Press* Top 25 national ranking and is 28th in this week's poll with 26 total points. In addition, the Chanticleers have earned Top 25 consideration in the ESPN/USA Today Coaches poll for the third week in a row. Coastal received 15 points in this week's Coaches poll, good for the 29th position. Earlier this season, VMI picked up an AP Top 25 vote when the Keydets received a vote in the Nov. 28 poll.

ON THE RADAR SCREEN

Coastal Carolina is 50-9 the past two seasons, and needs two more victories to tie the Big South record for most wins in back-to-back years. Winthrop holds the all-time mark of 52 combined wins from 2005-07. The Eagles won 23 games in 2005-06 and followed with a League-record 29 victories in 2006-07. The Chanticleers are one of just four different Big South programs to win 20 games in back-to-back seasons, and need three more victories to become the first Conference member to win 25 games in consecutive campaigns.

HOMEWARD BOUND

Since the second half of the Conference season began Jan. 27, the home teams have won 13 of the 20 contests played (=65.0 percent), an improvement over their 25-20 record (=55.6) in the first half of the League season. Overall, the road teams are still above 40 percent in the win column (27-38, 41.5), and would mark the third time in the last five seasons that road teams won at least 40 percent of the Conference games. TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

Charleston Southern and Gardner-Webb have each lost a League-high seven games by eight points-or-less, five of which have been Big South contests. In each of those five Conference games, the Runnin' Bulldogs average margin of defeat is 3.60, while the Buccaneers' average is 4.20. High Point is next with six losses of eight points-or-less. Interestingly enough, the Panthers have won each of their six Big South games by seven points-or-less and 20 points combined (3.33 average).

WORKING OVERTIME

Liberty and UNC Asheville have played a League-high four overtime games this season, the most by a Big South team since Presbyterian College played five in 2009-10. Liberty is 3-1 in its overtime games, having won its last three games that went extra time, while Asheville 2-2 in overtime contests. Meanwhile, PC has played 11 overtime games since 2008-09 -- 10 of which were Big South games.

LENDING A HELPING HAND

Liberty junior guard **JESSE SANDERS** is 13th all-time in Big South history with 448 career assists, and needs 21 to reach the 12th position (Winthrop's **TYSON WATERMAN**, 469). UNC Asheville junior guard **J.P. PRIMM** is 16th in League annals with 420 career assists and needs 10 to move into the 15th spot (UNC Asheville's **JOSH KOHN**, 430).

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** has recorded his 11th career 20-win season at the Division I level, and 14th overall. The 10th active coach and 26th overall to win 600 career Division I games, Ellis has directed four different Division I programs to at least two 20-win campaigns during his tenure, and owns five seasons with at least 25 wins. Ellis is 608-381 at the Division I level and 686-393 overall in 35 years as a head coach, including 74-44 (=62.7 percent) in four seasons at Coastal Carolina. He has been named Coach of the Year in four difference Conferences (Sun Belt, ACC, SEC, Big South) as well.

ANOTHER BROWN LEADING LIBERTY

Liberty newcomer and redshirt-junior **JOHN BROWN** continues to lead the Big South with 10.6 rebounds a game. If he can maintain his position, he would be the first Liberty player to lead the Conference in rebounding since **LEO LIGHTBOURNE** in 2004-05. Brown could also become the first newcomer to finish as the Big South's top rebounder since High Point's **DANNY GATHINGS** in 2002-03. Meanwhile, Brown is third in the Conference with a 51.4 overall field goal percentage and ranks first in the category in Conference games at 54.9 percent. If he can maintain his production on both ends of the floor, Brown would be the ninth Big South player with a 10.0 rebounding average and 50.0 overall field goal percentage in the same season.

JUNIOR 15

UNC Asheville juniors **MATT DICKEY** and **J.P. PRIMM** have scored at least 15 points in the same game 10 times this season, with the Bulldogs going 7-3 in those games. It should be noted that the losses have been to nationally-ranked North Carolina and Georgetown, as well as a two-point double-over-time loss at USC Upstate. The duo has reached the 15-point threshold in the same game 15 times since arriving on campus in 2008-09, and Asheville is 11-4 in those games.

3-BALL

Charleston Southern's **JAMARCO WARREN** and VMI's **AUSTIN KENON** entered the Big South's 300-career three-point club on Jan. 15, becoming the fifth and sixth players, respectively, to reach the plateau (Warren hit the milestone first due to the Buccaneers' earlier tip time that day). Both players are now among the Conference's all-time top four, and are also their respective schools' all-time leader. Kenon, who has made a three-pointer in 92 of his 97 career games for a 3.30 per game average (fourth-highest per game clip in League history), is the second Keydet on the Big South's 300-career three-point list. WARREN ALSO MEMBER OF 300 3-POINTER/300 ASSIST CLUBS

Charleston Southern senior **JAMARCO WARREN** is one of four players in Big South history with 300 career three-point field goals and 300 career assists. Warren (322 3FG, 318 AST) has joined Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** (411 3FG, 353 AST), UNC Greensboro's **SCOTT HARTZELL** (309 3FG, 552 AST) and VMI's **CHAVIS HOLMES** (306 3FG, 313 AST) in the club.

STEADY EDDIE

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH**, who recorded his 200th career win at Asheville with the Bulldogs' 86-57 victory over Montreat College on Dec. 11, is the Big South's all-time winningest coach for overall wins (208) and Big South victories (124). Biedenbach is 237-280 in 17-plus years as a collegiate head coach.

NOTHING MARGINAL ABOUT THIS

Coastal Carolina owns a +15.8 scoring margin this season, which is pacing way ahead of the Big South single-season record of +13.7 set last year by the Chanticleers. Coastal has won 12 of its 22 games by at least 18 points, including seven Big South games. The Chants' +13.5 scoring margin in League contests this season is ahead of last year's average of +12.9.

MR. SAND MAN

Liberty junior guard **JESSE SANDERS** -- the first player in Big South history with 500 career rebounds (528) and 400 career assists (448), is 12th in the nation with 6.4 assists per game and is just one of two players in the nation this season averaging at least 6.0 assists and 6.0 rebounds (6.1) a contest (Texas Southern forward **KEVIN GALLOWAY** is the other). If Sanders can maintain his averages, he would become the first player in Big South history to average 6.0 assists and 6.0 rebounds in the same season.

BOARD MEETING

The Big South has three active players with 600 career rebounds, led by Gardner-Webb junior **JOSH HENLEY** with 677 -- good for 23rd all-time in Big South history. Henley is 23 rebounds shy of becoming the 21st player with 700. Charleston Southern junior **KELVIN MARTIN** has pulled down 646 rebounds and ranks 29th in League annals, ahead of UNC Asheville redshirt-senior **JOHN WILLIAMS**, who is tied for 32nd with 627 career boards. Meanwhile, Winthrop's **CHARLES CORBIN** is 26 caroms away from becoming the first Eagle to join the 600-rebound club since **TYRONE WALKER** in 2003-04.

JOHN WILLIAMS' BUILDING BLOCKS

UNC Asheville redshirt-senior **JOHN WILLIAMS** is just the third player in Big South history with 1,000 career points, 600 career rebounds and 200 career blocked shots. With career totals of 1,066 points, 627 rebounds and 233 career blocks (third all-time in Big South history), Williams joins Liberty's **PETER ALUMA** (1,715 points, 682 rebounds, 366 blocks) and Radford's **TYRONE TRAVIS** (1,313 points, 718 rebounds, 215 blocks) in this elite group. Williams also is one of 26 players in League annals with 1,000 points and 600 rebounds.

SCOREBOARD WATCHING

VMI leads both the Big South and the nation in scoring offense at 91.3 points a game, and is attempting to finish as the country's top scoring offense for an unprecedented fifth-straight year. VMI led the nation in scoring offense in 2009-10 for the fourth consecutive season, becoming the first team in NCAA Division I history to lead the country in scoring offense four consecutive years. The Keydets are also looking to become the first Conference member to lead the Big South in scoring five consecutive years. VMI (2006-present) and Radford (1995-99) are the only programs to lead four-straight seasons.

BIG SOUTH PRESEASON PLAYER OF THE YEAR

Nick Barbour, High Point

R-P-HIGH

Through games of Feb. 6, the Big South Conference was again ranked No. 17 in the RPI by Collegiate Basketball News, the League's highest since finishing the 2006-07 season at No. 19 -- which happens to be the Conference's all-time best. Coastal Carolina was the Big South's highest-rated team in the RPI at No. 62.

BIG SOUTH SEPARATION

Of the 65 Big South games this season, 38 had winning margins of less than 10 points (=58.5 percent), including 16 that were decided by three points-or-less. However, the Conference season currently has an average margin of victory of 11.02 points. Last year, the overall margin of victory in League play was 10.51 points, while the 2008-09 average margin was 8.96 points. Meanwhile, in the 27 Big South games decided by double digits this season, the average margin of victory was 19.85 points, while the 38 games decided by less than 10 points had an average victory margin of 4.74 points.

MEANWHILE...

The road teams have the upper hand over their home counterparts when winning in Conference this season, as visiting squads own an average margin of victory of 11.96 points in their 27 Big South wins. The home teams have won their 38 League games by an average margin of 10.34 points.

NEW KID ON THE BLOCK

VMI freshman **D.J. COVINGTON** has a League-high 42 blocked shots in 17 games played, but has not yet appeared in the required 75 percent of his team's games to qualify for the Big South and NCAA statistical ranking. Covington has appeared in 73.9 percent (17 of 23 games) and his 2.47 blocks per game would lead the Big South. Meanwhile, Covington is eight blocks away from becoming just the seventh Big South freshman (true or redshirt) with 50 blocks in a season.

PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE SCORES BCS DOUBLE

Presbyterian College is the second team in Big South Conference history to defeat an SEC team and ACC team in the same season, as the Blue Hose did it in back-to-back games! PC first knocked off the Auburn Tigers, 62-59, on Dec. 18 and then won at Wake Forest, 66-64 on Dec. 20. Former (and future) member Campbell was the first Big South member to achieve the feat. In 1993-94, the Camels defeated North Carolina State (72-69) and South Carolina (73-72).

BIG SOUTH OWNS THREE WINS OVER THE SEC, TWO OVER THE ACC

The Big South has enjoyed some monumental non-Conference success this season, as the League owns three wins over the SEC and two over the ACC. UNC Asheville (at Auburn), Coastal Carolina (at LSU) and Presbyterian College (at Auburn) won at SEC venues, giving the Big South Conference three wins against the SEC for the first time since 1993-94. That season, the Conference had wins over LSU and South Carolina (twice). Meanwhile, both Winthrop and Presbyterian College won at Wake Forest, the League's first multi-win season against the ACC since 2007-08. The Big South Conference has recorded wins over members from the Atlantic Coast Conference and the Southeastern Conference in the same season now for the third time in the last four years.

HEY YOU!! I KNOW YOU, I KNOW YOU!

Former Big South charter member Campbell University is rejoining the Big South Conference beginning in 2011-12, increasing the League's membership to 11. Campbell enjoyed a successful stint in the Conference, winning the 1992 Big South championship and becoming the League's first NCAA Tournament automatic bid recipient that year. The Camels appeared in a total of four Conference Championship games before departing for the Trans America Athletic Conference (TAAC) following the 1993-94 season.

BIG SOUTH TIEBREAKING PROCEDURE

Seeding of teams for the Big South Tournament will be based on Conference win-loss record. The following tiebreaker shall be applied to determine seeding:

TWO-WAY TIES

(a) Records in head-to-head competition are compared with the higher seed going to the team that has won the most games against the other.

(b) In the event step "a" does not resolve the tie (i.e. if the two teams split during the regular season), then the records of the tying teams against the No. 1 seed shall be compared. The team with the better record against the No. 1 seed shall gain the higher seed.

(c) The process outlined in step "b" shall continue through the last place team, if necessary.

(d) In the event that the tie cannot be broken, the seeding shall be determined by a coin toss.

MULTIPLE TIES

(a) Composite records between the tying teams will be evaluated to determine if one team has won more games against the other tying teams.

(b) In the event step "a" does not resolve the multiple ties or reduce the multiple ties to one tie, then a comparison of records of the tying teams against the No. 1 seed will occur. The team among the tying institutions with the better record against the top-seeded team will receive the highest seed.

(c) The procedure outlined in step "b" shall continue through the last place team, if necessary, until the seeding is complete.

(d) In the event this process does not resolve the ties, a coin toss will be the final alternative.

(e) If the multiple ties are reduced to a tie between two teams, the two-way tiebreaker formula will be utilized.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern has swept two Conference opponents for the first time since 2005-06 ... Charleston Southern's 101 points vs. VMI last Thursday was its first over 100 points in a Big South game since a 105-88 win over UMBC on Feb. 12, 1994 ... CSU's perfect 10-0 record at the Buc Dome ended this past Saturday against Liberty, and the Buccaneer programs, men's and women's, both broke their undefeated record at Buccaneer Field House ... The Bucs, at 13-12, are over .500 after 25 games for the first time since opening the 1996-97 season 14-11.

COASTAL CAROLINA

The Chants welcomed second-place Liberty, which was just one game behind Coastal in the standings, to Kimbel Arena last week and defeated the Flames, 77-71. The Chants never trailed and defeated Liberty for the second time this season. **ANTHONY RAFFA** scored 19 points, grabbed four rebounds and had three assists, and Coastal converted 21 points off 19 Liberty turnovers ... On Saturday, **DESMOND HOLLOWAY** (22 points), **CHAD GRAY** (22) and **DANNY NIEMAN** (20) combined for 64 of Coastal's 99 points against VMI ... **SAM McLAURIN** finished with 11 points and a career-high 13 rebounds and helped the Chants hold a 54-40 edge in rebounding.

GARDNER-WEBB

Gardner-Webb has now held five consecutive opponents under their season scoring average ... GWU has been strong at home in its last four outings, despite going 2-2 in those four games. The two losses have come by three points to first-place Coastal Carolina and three points on a buzzer-beater to Winthrop ... **JON MOORE** came out of a severe shooting slump to score 14 points in the win over Presbyterian College. **LARON BUGGS** netted a career-high 17 points against the Blue Hose, and averaged 15.0 ppg for the week. Buggs leads Gardner-Webb in scoring vs. League foes (10.7 per game).

HIGH POINT

High Point has won three games in a row, tying its longest winning streak of the season from Dec. 2-8. The Panthers have won four of their last six to improve to 6-7 in Conference play ... HPU's last nine games have all been Conference games, and seven of the nine were decided by seven points or less. Twelve of HPU's 22 games have been decided by eight points or less ... Junior guards **NICK BARBOUR** and **SHAY SHINE** have both scored in double figures in their last eight games. Freshman forward **DU'VAUGHN MAXWELL** has scored in double figures in six of his last seven games ... Redshirt-sophomore forward **COREY LAW** played with a hand injury last week but still had 10 points and four rebounds against PC and four points and 10 rebounds against Radford.

LIBERTY

With its win at Charleston Southern last Saturday, Liberty now has five-straight victories over the Buccaneers. Liberty is also the first team to defeat the Buccaneers on their home court this season. Prior to Saturday's win, the Flames were also the last team to earn a victory in the Buc Dome, doing so in the 2009-10 regular-season finale ... **EVAN GORDON** and **JESSE SANDERS** are currently 30th and 31st, respectively, on Liberty's all-time scoring list. Gordon has 746 for his career, while Sanders is six points back with 740.

PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE

RADFORD

Radford is 20-6 in February under fourth-year head coach **BRAD GREENBERG** ... So far this season the Highlanders have used 14 different starting lineups, which is tied with Pepperdine for the most in the nation ... The Highlanders are shooting 57.6 percent (15-26) from behind the three-point line in their last two games.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville split a pair of home games last week. The Bulldogs routed Presbyterian College Thursday night, 88-55. It tied a school record for biggest margin of victory (33 points) in a Big South game. Asheville placed six players in double figures and shot a season-high 61 percent in the win ... Two days later, Winthrop edged the Bulldogs 57-53 as Asheville scored a season-low 53 points in a League game. **MATT DICKEY** tied a school record with seven steals in the loss to the Eagles.

VMI
