Holloway averaged 22.5 points, 56.0 percent from the field (14-of-25) and 87.5 percent from the free throw line (14-of-16) in leading the Chanticleers to two Big South road wins. He opened the week with a team-high 18 points in addition to four rebounds and two steals at UNC Asheville. Holloway scored seven points in the final 3:55 of the first half to help Coastal take a nine-point lead at the break. On Saturday at Gardner-Webb, Holloway scored a career-high 27 points in the Chants' three-point win, including a personal-best three 3-point field goals. He scored seven points in the final 1:56, including the game-winning jumper with 45 seconds remaining.

Maxwell averaged 11.0 points, 5.0 rebounds and was a perfect 11-of-11 from the field in two games last week. At Winthrop on Saturday, Maxwell was 5-of-5 from the floor and finished with 10 points, six boards and one block. **COASTAL CAROLINA NETS BEST 20-GAME START IN LEAGUE HISTORY**

At 18-2 overall, Coastal Carolina has recorded the best 20-game start in Big South history. The Chanticleers bested the old mark of 17-3, which was established by three programs -- Liberty in 1991-92, VMI in 2008-09 and Coastal last season. The 18-2 start is the best in school history as well, and the Chanticleers have buoyed their start with a school-record 16-game win streak, which is the longest in the Big South since Winthrop won 19-straight in 2006-07. Coastal Carolina, which tied its Big South single-season record for fastest team to win 15 games, is challenging the League record for fastest to win 20 games, which is 24 games. Meanwhile, the Chants have put together a 13-game Conference win streak, dating back to last season and the longest in the Big South since Winthrop won 16 consecutive Conference games from Feb. 23, 2006 - Feb. 24, 2007.

**WAS THAT A NINER I JUST HEARD?**

Coastal Carolina is 9-0 in Big South play for the first time since 1990-91 and the third time overall. The Chants are the first Big South member to open the League season 9-0 since Winthrop swept through the 2006-07 Conference season with a 14-0 mark. However, the Chanticleers are the first team to sweep the first half of an 18-game Big South schedule, which has been utilized since 2008-09 and four times total (1993-94 was the first). Meanwhile, Coastal is just the fifth team to start 9-0 in League play. The previous four teams all captured the regular-season and Conference Tournament titles.

**TV TIME**

The Big South Conference "Royal Purple Game of the Week" television package continues this Saturday when Radford hosts Coastal Carolina live on MASN at 6:00pm. The game will also be simulcast on WMBF News XTRA in Conway/Myrtle Beach. **MATT HOGUE** (play-by-play) and **NATE ROSS** (analyst) will call the action from the Dedmon Center. The next Big South broadcast will be Thursday, Feb. 10.

**HALFWAY HOME**

The Conference season is at the exact midway point, and the road teams have won 20 of the first 45 Big South games played -- a 44.4 winning percentage. Last season, the road team was also victorious in 20 of the first 45 contests. In addition, five teams stand at 5-4 in Conference play -- the same total at the midway point in 2009-10. **BOARD MEETING**

Charleston Southern junior **KELVIN MARTIN** became the 33rd player in Big South history with 600 career rebounds when he surpassed the milestone Jan. 20 at Gardner-Webb. Two days later, UNC Asheville's **JOHN WILLIAMS** became the 34th player to eclipse the mark. Martin is the first Charleston Southern player with 600 career rebounds since **JEFF DANIELS** surpassed the mark in 1996-97 and the fourth Buccaneer in the Big South's 600-rebound club. The Big South now has three active players with 600 boards, as Martin and Williams join Gardner-Webb's **JOSH HENLEY**, who surpassed the milestone earlier this season and is the League's active leading rebounder with 652 (28th in Big South history).

**300-LAYER CAKE**

Liberty head coach **DALE LAYER** needs one more win for 300 in his coaching career. Layer's win total includes 167 victories as head coach of Division II member Queens (1989-98), 103 wins at the helm of Colorado State (2000-07) and 29 in less than two seasons at Liberty. The next victory would give the Flames 15 wins this season -- which would match their win total from all of last year, as well as mark the fourth consecutive campaign that Liberty won at least 15 games. The Flames' 8-1 start in Big South play is their best in school history.

**TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT**

Gardner-Webb and High Point have each lost a League-high six games by eight points-or-less, including four Big South contests. In those four Conference games, the Runnin' Bulldogs average margin of defeat is 3.75, while the Panthers' average margin of defeat is 6.25. One of GWU's losses was a 2-point setback at High Point on Dec. 2. Charleston Southern is next with five losses by eight points-or-less.

## NATIONAL POLLSTERS VOTERS TAKING NOTICE OF COASTAL CAROLINA, BIG SOUTH

For the third consecutive week, Coastal Carolina has received votes in the *Associated Press* Top 25 national ranking, and for the first time this season, the Chanticleers earned Top 25 consideration in the *ESPN/USA Today* Coaches poll. Coastal received three points in this week's Coaches poll, ahead of notable programs Kansas State, Memphis and North Carolina, and two points in the AP ranking. VMI also picked up an AP Top 25 vote this season when the Keydets received a vote in the Nov. 28 poll.

## LENDING A HELPING HAND

UNC Asheville junior guard **J.P. PRIMM** handed out his 400th career assist this past Saturday in the Charleston Southern game, becoming the 19th player to join the Big South's 400-assist club. Primm is at 402, just two from moving into 18th-place all-time. Liberty junior guard **JESSE SANDERS** ranks 15th with 426 career helpers and needs five to jump ahead of UNC Asheville's **JOSH KOHN** (430) into 14th in League history.

## 3-BALL

Charleston Southern's **JAMARCO WARREN** and VMI's **AUSTIN KENON** entered the Big South's 300-career three-point club on Jan. 15, becoming the fifth and sixth players, respectively, to reach the plateau (Warren hit the milestone first due to the Buccaneers' earlier tip time that day). Warren has since moved into third in League history with 311 treys, while Kenon is tied for fifth. Kenon, who has made a three-pointer in 88 of his 93 career games for a 3.29 per game average (fourth-highest per game clip in League history), is the second Keydet on the Big South's 300-career three-point list. ## McSWATTY

Coastal Carolina redshirt-sophomore **SAM McLAURIN** is 10 blocked shots away from becoming the 26th player in Big South history with 100 career blocks. He would be the third Chanticleer in Conference annals to reach the century mark in rejections.

## THREE (BULL)DOG NIGHT

UNC Asheville's **MATT DICKEY** (979) and **J.P. PRIMM** (966) are poised to join teammate **JOHN WILIAMS** (1,020) in the 1,000-point club, which would mark the third time in Conference history that a Big South team had three players score their 1,000th point in the same season. Coastal Carolina was the first in 1990-91 (**BRIAN PENNY, ROBERT DOWDELL, DuWAYNE CHEATAM**) and Radford was the last in 2001-02 (**RAYMOND ARRINGTON, ANDREY SAVTCHENKO, CORREY WATKINS**).

## NOTHING MARGINAL ABOUT THIS

Coastal Carolina owns a +15.6 scoring margin this season, which is pacing ahead of the Big South single-season record of +13.7 set last year by the Chanticleers. Coastal has won 10 of its 18 games by at least 18 points, including five Big South games. The Chants' +12.2 scoring margin in League contests this season is just below last year's average of +12.9.

## MR. SAND MAN

Liberty junior guard **JESSE SANDERS** -- the first player in Big South history with 500 career rebounds and 400 career assists, is eighth in the country with 6.5 assists per game and is just one of two players in the nation this season averaging at least 6.0 assists and 6.0 rebounds (6.3) a contest (Texas Southern forward **KEVIN GALLOWAY** is the other). If Sanders can maintain his averages, he would become the first player in Big South history to average 6.0 assists and 6.0 rebounds in the same season.

## STAN'S THE MAN

VMI sophomore **STAN OKOYE** continues to lead the Big South in scoring (tied for first at 19.2) and field goal percentage (53.8). If he can maintain his hold on both categories, he would be the fifth player in League history to lead the Conference in scoring and field goal percentage. The previous individuals were Liberty's **PETER ALUMA** (1995-96), UNC Asheville's **JOSH PITTMAN** (1997-98), High Point's **DANNY GATHINGS** (2002-03) and Radford's **ART PARAKHOUSKI** (2009-10).

## COMMANDING OFFICER

VMI head coach **DUGGAR BAUCOM** recorded his 80th win as the Keydets' leader Jan. 15 with VMI's 97-91 win at High Point, giving him sole possession of second-place for coaching wins at the Institute. **BART BELLAIRS** is VMI's all-time winningest coach with 116 victories from 1994-05.

**JUNIOR 15**

UNC Asheville juniors **MATT DICKEY** and **J.P. PRIMM** have scored at least 15 points in the same game nine times this season, with the Bulldogs going 6-3 in those games. It should be noted that the losses have been to nationally-ranked North Carolina and Georgetown, as well as a two-point double-overtime loss at USC Upstate. The duo has reached the 15-point threshold in the same game 14 times since arriving on campus in 2008-09, and Asheville is 10-4 in those games.

**WARREN ALSO MEMBER OF 300 3-POINTER/300 ASSIST CLUBS**

Charleston Southern senior **JAMARCO WARREN** is one of four players in Big South history with 300 career three-point field goals and 300 career assists. Warren (311 3FG, 304 AST) joins Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** (411 3FG, 353 AST), UNC Greensboro's **SCOTT HARTZELL** (309 3FG, 552 AST) and VMI's **CHAVIS HOLMES** (306 3FG, 313 AST) in the club.

**MID-MAJOR MADNESS**

Coastal Carolina was ranked No. 8 in the *Collegeinsider.com* Mid-Major Top 25 poll last week, its second consecutive week in that position as well as its highest ranking of the season. In addition, Liberty has received votes in the poll for three consecutive weeks. The Big South Conference has had a team ranked in the 12-year-old Mid-Major Top 25 poll the last seven consecutive seasons. **JOHN WILLIAMS' BUILDING BLOCKS**

UNC Asheville redshirt-senior **JOHN WILLIAMS** is just the third player in Big South history with 1,000 career points, 600 career rebounds and 200 career blocked shots. With career totals of 1,020 points, 604 rebounds and 226 career blocks (third all-time in Big South history), Williams joins Liberty's **PETER ALUMA** (1,715 points, 682 rebounds, 366 blocks) and Radford's **TYRONE TRAVIS** (1,313 points, 718 rebounds, 215 blocks) in this elite group. Williams also is one of 26 players in League annals with 1,000 points and 600 rebounds.

**ANOTHER BROWN LEADING LIBERTY**

Liberty newcomer and redshirt-junior **JOHN BROWN** continues to lead the Big South with 10.2 rebounds a game. If he can maintain his position, he would be the first Liberty player to lead the Conference in rebounding since **LEO LIGHTBOURNE** in 2004-05. Brown could also become the first newcomer to finish as the Big South's top rebounder since High Point's **DANNY GATHINGS** in 2002-03. Meanwhile, Brown is third in the Conference with a 52.8 overall field goal percentage (105-of-199) -- meeting the 5.0 field goals per game requirement on the dot (105 in 21 games). He is first in the category in Conference games at 59.8 percent (52-of-87 in nine League contests).

**NEW KID ON THE BLOCK**

VMI freshman **D.J. COVINGTON** has a League-high 37 blocked shots in just 13 games played, but has not yet appeared in the required 75 percent of his team's games to qualify for the Big South and NCAA statistical ranking. Covington has appeared in 68.4 percent (13 of 19) and his 2.85 block per game would lead the Big South. He has four games with at least four rejections, including a season-high nine against Southern Virginia on Nov. 23, the highest block total in the Big South since former UNC Asheville center **KENNY GEORGE** swatted away 10 shots against Campbell on Nov. 17, 2007. Meanwhile, Covington is 13 blocks away from becoming just the seventh Big South freshman (true or redshirt) with 50 blocks in a season.

**STEADY EDDIE**

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH**, who recorded his 200th career win at Asheville with the Bulldogs' 86-57 victory over Montreat College on Dec. 11, is the Big South's all-time winningest coach for overall wins (206) and Big South victories (122). Biedenbach is 235-278 in 17-plus years as a collegiate head coach.

**ELLIS TWO WINS AWAY FROM 11TH 20-WIN SEASON**

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS**, who became the 10th active coach and 26th overall to win 600 career Division I games when the Chanticleers defeated Liberty, 70-67 in Lynchburg on Jan. 8, is two wins away from his 11th career 20-win season. He is 604-381 at the Division I level and 682-393 overall in 35 years as a head coach, and has directed four different Division I programs to 20-win campaigns during his tenure (five of which are 25-win seasons). Ellis, who has been named Coach of the Year in four different Conferences (Sun Belt, ACC, SEC, Big South), is 70-44 (=61.4 percent) in four seasons at Coastal Carolina.

**MR. TRIPLE-DOUBLE**

Liberty junior guard **JESSE SANDERS** notched his Big South-record third career triple-double on Jan. 6 against Charleston Southern, as he finished with 10 points, 10 rebounds and 10 assists against the Buccaneers. All three have come at the Vines Center. As a freshman in 2008-09, Sanders had the exact same output against Presbyterian College on Feb. 9, 2009 for his first career trifecta. Last season as a sophomore, Sanders had 11 points, 10 boards and 10 helpers against Kentucky Christian on Dec. 12, 2009. Sanders owns three of the eight triple-doubles on record in Big South history, including two of the five that have occurred in Conference games.

**ALL-TIME SCORERS**

Charleston Southern's **JAMARCO WARREN** moved into the League's Top 10 all-time scorers this past weekend, and needs 42 to become the eighth player in Big South history with 1,800 career points. UNC Asheville's **MATT DICKEY** is 21 points away from becoming the 103rd player on the Conference's 1,000-point chart. **ASHEVILLE SCORES BIG SOUTH'S FIRST 20-20-20 ON THE ROAD, BUT COULD HAVE COMPANY**

UNC Asheville has won three Big South road games by at least 20 points this season, becoming the first team in Big South men's basketball history to accomplish this feat. The Bulldogs first won by 20 points at Radford (Dec. 2), then did it in back-to-back games the week of Jan. 3 -- winning by 21 at Winthrop (Jan. 6) and 26 at Presbyterian College (Jan. 8). The 26-point margin against the Blue Hose was the biggest Big South Conference road victory in school history. Asheville's feat could be short-lived, as both Coastal Carolina and VMI have two 20-point Conference road wins this season.

**SCOREBOARD WATCHING**

VMI leads both the Big South and the nation in scoring offense at 92.2 points a game, and is attempting to finish as the country's top scoring offense for an unprecedented fifth-straight year. VMI led the nation in scoring offense in 2009-10 for the fourth consecutive season, becoming the first team in NCAA Division I history to lead the country in scoring offense four consecutive years. The Keydets are also looking to become the first Conference member to lead the Big South in scoring five consecutive years. VMI (2006-present) and Radford (1995-99) are the only programs to lead four-straight seasons.

**PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE SCORES BCS DOUBLE**

Presbyterian College is the second team in Big South Conference history to defeat an SEC team and ACC team in the same season, as the Blue Hose did it in back-to-back games! PC first knocked off the Auburn Tigers, 62-59, on Dec. 18 and then won at Wake Forest, 66-64 on Dec. 20. Former (and future) member Campbell was the first Big South member to achieve the feat. In 1993-94, the Camels defeated North Carolina State (72-69) and South Carolina (73-72).

**HEY YOU!! I KNOW YOU, I KNOW YOU!**

Former Big South charter member Campbell University is rejoining the Big South Conference beginning in 2011-12, increasing the League's membership to 11. Campbell enjoyed a successful stint in the Conference, winning the 1992 Big South championship and becoming the League's first NCAA Tournament automatic bid recipient that year. The Camels appeared in a total of four Conference Championship games before departing for the Trans America Athletic Conference (TAAC) following the 1993-94 season.

**BIG SOUTH PRESEASON PLAYER OF THE YEAR**

### R-P-HIGH

Through games of Jan. 23, the Big South Conference was ranked No. 17 in the RPI by Collegiate Basketball News, the League's highest since finishing the 2006-07 season at No. 19 -- which happens to be the Conference's all-time best. In addition, the Big South has the fourth-highest non-Conference strength of schedule in the country, led by Winthrop's No. 5 national ranking in the category. Coastal Carolina is the Big South's highest-rated team in the RPI at No. 68.

### BIG SOUTH SEPARATION

Of the first 45 Big South games this season, 26 had winning margins of less than 10 points ( =57.8 percent), including eight that were decided by three points-or-less. However, the first 45 Conference games of the 2010-11 campaign had an average margin of victory of 11.67 points. In the 19 games decided by double digits, the average margin of victory was 20.21 points. The 26 games decided by less than 10 points had an average victory margin of 5.42 points. Last year, the overall margin of victory in League play was 10.51 points, while the 2008-09 average margin was 8.96 points.

### MEANWHILE...

The road teams have the upper hand over their home counterparts when winning in Conference this season, as visiting squads own an average margin of victory of 12.35 points in their 20 Big South wins. The home teams have won their 25 League games by an average margin of 11.12 points.

### BIG SOUTH OWNS THREE WINS OVER THE SEC, TWO OVER THE ACC

The Big South has enjoyed some monumental non-Conference success this season, as the League owns three wins over the SEC and two over the ACC. UNC Asheville (at Auburn), Coastal Carolina (at LSU) and Presbyterian College (at Auburn) won at SEC venues, giving the Big South Conference three wins against the SEC for the first time since 1993-94. That season, the Conference had wins over LSU and South Carolina (twice). Meanwhile, both Winthrop and Presbyterian College won at Wake Forest, the League's first multi-win season against the ACC since 2007-08. The Big South Conference has recorded wins over members from the Atlantic Coast Conference and the Southeastern Conference in the same season now for the third time in the last four years.

### BIG SOUTH TO MAKE SIXTH APPEARANCE IN BRACKETBUSTERS EVENT

The Big South Conference will again participate in the BracketBusters event this season during the weekend of February 18-19, with a League-record nine teams among the field of 114. Representing the Big South in the 2011 event will be last year's four BracketBusters participants **WINTHROP, RADFORD, PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE** and **GARDNER-WEBB**, plus **HIGH POINT, LIBERTY, UNC ASHEVILLE, CHARLESTON SOUTHERN** and **VMI** -- the latter two making their first appearance in the series. The Big South has the third-most Conference members participating of the 15 Leagues involved this season. The Conference is 7-8 all-time in the BracketBusters, including two wins in 2006, 2007 and 2010, and has been selected for national television appearances three times: 2007 (ESPN2), 2008 (ESPN2) and 2009 (ESPNU). In 2011-12 and 2012-13, the Big South Conference will have 11 teams in the event, including new member **CAMPBELL**.

### CONFERENCE TOURNAMENT APPROACHING

The 2011 Advance Auto Parts Big South Men's Basketball Championship Tournament will commence on Tuesday, March 1 at the home sites of the top four seeds.

The top eight of the nine postseason eligible teams will earn a berth in this year's Championship, with the No. 1 seed having a chance to host throughout the Tournament.

For the sixth consecutive season, the Semifinals will be contested at the site of the No. 1 seed and will be broadcast live on ESPNU on Thursday, March 3. The highest remaining seed will host the Championship game on its home floor Saturday, March 5 at 4:00pm live on ESPN2.

**CHARLESTON SOUTHERN**

**JAMARCO WARREN** is now second at Charleston Southern in career scoring with 1,758 points ... **KELVIN MARTIN** is 19 points shy of 900 at CSU ... The Buccaneers pace the Conference in free-throw percentage at 74.7, led by Warren's Big South-leading 87.2 percent from the charity stripe. CSU's clip is the highest by a Big South member since UNC Asheville in 2002-03 (76.1), while Warren's percentage is currently the highest since Liberty's **LARRY JACKSON** (88.3) in 1997-98.

**COASTAL CAROLINA**

Coastal Carolina set the school record for the most consecutive Big South Conference wins with 12 following its 80-58 win at UNC Asheville. **DESMOND HOLLOWAY** and **ANTHONY RAFFA** each scored 18 points for the Chants, while **CHAD GRAY** added 15 points and tied his career-high in rebounds (12) and blocked shots (5) ... Coastal's 58-55 win at Gardner-Webb marked the 10th time this season the Chants have held an opponent under 60 points.

**GARDNER-WEBB**

Gardner-Webb nearly recorded two upsets last week, as the Runnin' Bulldogs downed third-place Charleston Southern, 58-50, last Thursday, before suffering a three-point loss to League-leading Coastal. GWU held both opponents to their lowest point total in a Conference game this season ... **JON MOORE** returned from injury and played in both games last week. He missed seven games and the Runnin' Bulldogs went 0-7 in his absence.

**HIGH POINT**

High Point broke an eight-game losing streak with its overtime road win over Presbyterian College on Thursday. It was the Panthers' first win since Dec. 8 -- also on the road -- at Tennessee Tech. HPU plays its next five game and seven of its last 11 regular-season games at home ... HPU's overtime win over Presbyterian was the Panthers' first OT game of the season. High Point has played just four overtime games in the last six seasons and won three of them ... **SHAY SHINE** scored a career-high 27 points and set an HPU record for single-game three-point percentage, going a perfect 6-for-6 from beyond the arc at PC. The previous record was 90.9 (10-for-11) by **NICK BARBOUR** against UNC Pembroke last season ... Freshman guard **XAVIER MARTIN** played 29 minutes in both games last week (his previous career high was 16) and averaged 10.0 points.

**LIBERTY**

Liberty is off to an 8-2 start at home this season ... Liberty's 8-1 Big South start is its best showing in program history. The Flames had been 7-2 on three occasions (1991-92, 1992-93, 1996-97) ... In Liberty's 100-82 victory over VMI, **DAVID MINAYA** finished with a career-high 22 points, while **JESSE SANDERS** added a season-high 21 points and a career-high 13 assists ... Liberty is 4-0 when playing on Thursday this season and hosts UNC Asheville this Thursday evening ... The Flames are undefeated (6-0) when controlling the tip this season.

**PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE**

The Blue Hose snapped a four-game losing streak with a 67-61 win over Radford on Saturday. PC erupted for a 14-0 run in the last four minutes to take a commanding lead with 18 seconds left. Trailing by five points with 3:28 remaining in the game, the Blue Hose used back-back three pointers from **KHALID MUTAKABBIR** and **WALT ALLEN** to take a one point lead, and hit their free throws down the stretch to clinch the win over the Highlanders.

**RADFORD**

**BLAKE SMITH** currently leads the Big South with 2.47 steals per game and is looking to become the first Highlander to lead the Conference in steals per game since **ANTHONY WALKER** in 1995-96 ... Freshman **MARTINS ABELE** was a force at Winthrop last Thursday, as he turned in a double-double with 15 points and 10 rebounds while going 7-of-10 from the field ... Radford has recorded three double-doubles this season, all of which have come from a freshman ... Radford has used 10 different starting lineups this season in attempts to find its best rotation.

**UNC ASHEVILLE**

UNC Asheville has won four of its last five games, but the one loss was a disappointing 80-59 home loss to Coastal Carolina last Thursday. It was the Bulldogs' worst home loss in three years ... **J.P. PRIMM** is now fourth on Asheville's all-time assist list with 402 ... **JOHN WILLIAMS** moved into ninth-place on Asheville's career rebounding list with 604.

**VMI**

COVINGTON** sidelined at Liberty with a thumb injury, VMI employed its sixth different starting lineup of the season and fourth over the last five games when it faced the Flames. Junior forward/guard **RON BURKS** was re-inserted into the starting five and made his 10th start of the season ...
