Kenon bounced back from a scoring slump to average 26.5 points in two Big South road wins last week, helping the Keydets move to .500 in the Conference standings. He opened the week with 20 points on 6-of-8 shooting and 4-of-5 from three-point range in a win at Radford. Kenon then scored a Big South season-high 33 points in the Keydets' six-point win at High Point. He made five treys while hitting 12 consecutive free throws before missing his final attempt of the night. For the week, Kenon was 14-of-23 from the field (=60.9 percent), 9-of-14 from three-point range (=64.3) and 16-of-18 from the charity stripe (=88.9). He also averaged 3.0 rebounds, 1.5 steals and 1.5 assists.

Byron, who entered the week averaging just 4.4 points and 3.6 rebounds, posted his first career double-double with 11 points and 15 rebounds at UNC Asheville this past Saturday. Byron tied his personal-best with four field goals and went 3-of-4 from the line. He also blocked a shot and handed out an assist.

MAKING WAVES

Coastal Carolina tied the Big South single-season record for fastest team to win 15 games, as the Chanticleers equaled the Conference mark they set last season by opening the season 15-2. Coastal is now 16-2 following two more League wins last week, matching its best start in school history -- which was also accomplished last season. The Chants have buoyed their start with a school-record 14-game win streak, which is the longest in the Big South since Winthrop won 19-straight in 2006-07. It is the second-straight season the Chanticleers have strung together a double-digit win streak, as Coastal put together a 12-game win streak from Nov. 28, 2009 - Jan. 9, 2010. The Chants are the first Big South team to have at least an 11-game win streak in back-to-back seasons since Radford in 1997-98 (11) and 1998-99 (13). Meanwhile, the Chanticleers have won 11 consecutive Big South games, dating back to last season.

SEVEN-UP

Coastal Carolina is 7-0 in Big South play for the first time since 1990-91 and the third time overall. The Chants are the first Big South member to open the League season 7-0 since UNC Asheville in 2007-08 and is the 10th program in Conference history to start 7-0. The previous nine teams all won or shared the regular-season crown, and six of those squads captured the Conference Tournament championship -- the last being Winthrop in 2006-07. Coastal also is the first Big South team to open League play at least 6-0 in consecutive seasons since Winthrop in 2005-06 (6-0) and 2006-07 (14-0).

WELCOME TO THE CLUB

Charleston Southern's **JAMARCO WARREN** and VMI's **AUSTIN KENON** entered the Big South's 300-career three-point club this past Saturday, becoming the fifth and sixth players, respectively, to reach the plateau (Warren hit the milestone first due to the Buccaneers' earlier tip time). Kenon, who has made a three-pointer in 87 of his 92 career games for a 3.27 per game average (fourth-highest per game clip in League history), is the second Keydet on the Big South's 300-career three-point list. WARREN ALSO ENTERS 300 3-POINTER/300 ASSIST CLUB

In addition to surpassing 300 career three-pointers, Charleston Southern senior **JAMARCO WARREN** also handed out his 300th assist this past Saturday in the Winthrop game, becoming the just the fourth player in Big South history with 300 career three-pointers and 300 career assists. Warren (302 3FG, 301 AST) joins Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** (411 3FG, 353 AST), UNC Greensboro's **SCOTT HARTZELL** (309 3FG, 552 AST) and VMI's **CHAVIS HOLMES** (306 3FG, 313 AST) in the club.

MORE MILESTONES FROM SATURDAY -- UNC ASHEVILLE'S JOHN WILLIAMS GETS 1,000TH POINT

UNC Asheville redshirt-senior **JOHN WILLIAMS** scored his 1,000th career point this past Saturday in the Gardner-Webb game, and became the just the third player in Big South history with 1,000 career points, 500 career rebounds and 200 career blocked shots. With career totals of 1,005 points, 591 rebounds and 222 career blocks (third all-time in Big South history), Williams joins Liberty's **PETER ALUMA** (1,715 points, 682 rebounds, 366 blocks) and Radford's **TYRONE TRAVIS** (1,313 points, 718 rebounds, 215 blocks) in this elite group. Meanwhile, Williams is now one of 40 players in League annals with 1,000 points and 500 rebounds, and his nine rebounds away from becoming the 26th player with 1,000 points and 600 boards.

MORE MILESTONES FROM SATURDAY -- LIBERTY'S JESSE SANDERS GRABS 500TH REBOUND

Liberty junior guard **JESSE SANDERS** is the first player in Big South history with 500 career rebounds and 400 career assists. Sanders grabbed his 500th career carom this past Saturday at High Point, becoming the 60th player in League history with that total. Seven days earlier (Jan. 8), Sanders became the 18th player in Big South history to hand out 400 assists when he eclipsed the milestone against Coastal Carolina. He is now 16th all-time in the Conference record books with 413 assists, and needs five to move into 15th (Radford's **WHIT HOLCOMB-FAYE**, 417). Meanwhile, Sanders is 14th in the country with 6.2 assists per game, and is one of two players in the nation averaging at least 6.0 assists and 6.0 rebounds (6.4) a contest (Texas Southern's **KEVIN GALLOWAY** is the other).

BEACH BALL

Charleston Southern is off to its best start overall (11-8) and in the Big South (5-2) in head coach **BAR-CLAY RADEBAUGH**'s six seasons, and it is the program's best overall start since opening the 2002-03 campaign with an 11-7 mark. That same 2002-03 season was the last time the Buccaneers started 5-2 in Big South play, as CSU opened 6-2 against League foes.

FLIP THIS HOUSE?

VMI is the only Big South team thus far to be undefeated in road Conference games (4-0) and winless in home League contests (0-4). In opposing Big South venues this season, the Keydets are averaging 95.5 points, 50.2 percent from the floor and 43.9 percent from beyond the arc (50-of-114), and have been led by **AUSTIN KENON**'s 24.3 points and 17-of-29 from 3-point range. Defensively, the Keydets have held their hosts to 77.5 points, 40.7 percent from the field and just 28.2 percent from long range. In home Big South games, VMI is averaging just 81.8 points (compared to allowing 94.2) and is shooting 39.8 percent on its home floor, including just 27.6 percent from beyond the arc. The visitors own a 47.7 field goal percentage inside Cameron Hall.

THREE (BULL)DOG NIGHT

UNC Asheville's **MATT DICKEY** (955) and **J.P. PRIMM** (938) are poised to join teammate **JOHN WIL-LIAMS** (1,005) in the 1,000-point club, which would mark the third time in Conference history that a Big South team had three players score their 1,000th point in the same season. Coastal Carolina was the first in 1990-91 (**BRIAN PENNY**, **ROBERT DOWDELL**, **DuWAYNE CHEATAM**) and Radford was the last in 2001-02 (**RAYMOND ARRINGTON**, **ANDREY SAVTCHENKO**, **CORREY WATKINS**).

BIG SOUTH SEPARATION

Of the first 36 Big South games this season, 21 had winning margins of less than 10 points (=58.3 percent), including seven that were decided by three points-or-less. However, the first 36 Conference games of the 2010-11 campaign had an average margin of victory of 11.47 points. In the 15 games decided by double digits, the average margin of victory was 20.07 points. The 21 games decided by less than 10 points had an average victory margin of 5.33 points. Last year, the overall margin of victory in League play was 10.51 points, while the 2008-09 average margin was 8.96 points.

TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

High Point has lost a League-high seven games by eight points-or-less, four of which have been Big South contests (including the last three). In those games, the Panthers average margin of defeat is 5.86 points. After High Point, Gardner-Webb has the next most losses by eight points-or-less (5), followed by UNC Asheville (4).

ROAD TRIP

The road teams have claimed 17 of the 36 Big South games thus far (=47.2 percent), ahead of the 2008-09 mark of 46.7 percent (42-48) and the third time in five seasons that the visiting squads are winning at least 40 percent of the Conference games. In addition, the road teams are winning convincingly this year, as visiting squads own an average margin of victory of 12.88 points in their 17 Conference wins. The home teams have won their 19 League games by an average margin of just 10.21 points.

JUNIOR 15

UNC Asheville juniors **MATT DICKEY** and **J.P. PRIMM** have scored at least 15 points in the same game nine times this season, with the Bulldogs going 6-3 in those games. It should be noted that the losses have been to nationally-ranked North Carolina and Georgetown, as well as a two-point double-over-time loss at USC Upstate. The duo has reached the 15-point threshold in the same game 14 times since arriving on campus in 2008-09, and Asheville is 10-4 in those games. Meanwhile, Primm needs 10 assists to join the Big South's 400-assist club.

BOARD MEETING

Charleston Southern junior **KELVIN MARTIN** needs eight rebounds to become the first Charleston Southern player with 600 career rebounds since **JEFF DANIELS** surpassed the mark in 1996-97. Martin, who is tied for 34th in League history with 592 career boards, would be the fourth Buccaneer in the Big South's 600-rebound club once he reaches the milestone. In addition, UNC Asheville's **JOHN WIL-LIAMS** is nine caroms away from 600, which would give the Big South three active players with that total. Gardner-Webb's **JOSH HENLEY** surpassed the milestone earlier this season and is the League's active leading rebounder with 634 (29th in Big South history).

STAN'S THE MAN

VMI sophomore **STAN OKOYE** continues to lead the Big South in scoring (19.3) and field goal percentage (53.8). If he can maintain his hold on both categories, he would be the fifth player in League history to lead the Conference in scoring and field goal percentage. The previous individuals were Liberty's **PETER ALUMA** (1995-96), UNC Asheville's **JOSH PITTMAN** (1997-98), High Point's **DANNY GATHINGS** (2002-03) and Radford's **ART PARAKHOUSKI** (2009-10).

ASSOCIATED PRESS VOTERS TAKING NOTICE OF THE BIG SOUTH

The Big South has received votes in the *Associated Press* Top 25 poll three times this season. Coastal Carolina has received AP Top 25 consideration the last two weeks (Jan. 10 and Jan. 17) -- the second consecutive season that the Chanticleers have garnered a vote in the weekly ranking. VMI also picked up an AP Top 25 vote this season when the Keydets received a vote in the Nov. 28 poll.

300-LAYER CAKE

Liberty head coach **DALE LAYER** needs two more wins for 300 in his coaching career. Layer's win total includes 167 victories as head coach of Division II member Queens (1989-98), 103 wins at the helm of Colorado State (2000-07) and 28 in less than two seasons at Liberty. The next two wins would give the Flames 15 wins this season -- which would match their win total from all of last season, as well as mark the fourth consecutive campaign that Liberty won at least 15 games. The Flames' 7-1 start in Big South play is their best in school history.

COMMANDING OFFICER

VMI head coach **DUGGAR BAUCOM** recorded his 80th win as the Keydets' leader this past Saturday with VMI's 97-91 win at High Point, giving him sole possession of second-place for coaching wins at the Institute. **BART BELLAIRS** is VMI's all-time winningest coach with 116 victories from 1994-05.

MID-MAJOR MADNESS

Coastal Carolina was ranked No. 8 in the *Collegeinsider.com* Mid-Major Top 25 poll last week, its highest ranking of the season and first time within the Top 10. In addition, Liberty received votes in the poll for two consecutive weeks. The Big South Conference has had a team ranked in the 12-year-old Mid-Major Top 25 poll the last seven consecutive seasons. ANOTHER BROWN LEADING LIBERTY

Liberty newcomer and redshirt-junior **JOHN BROWN** continues to lead the Big South with 10.3 rebounds a game. If he can maintain his position, he would be the first Liberty player to lead the Conference in rebounding since **LEO LIGHTBOURNE** in 2004-05. Brown could also become the first newcomer to finish as the Big South's top rebounder since High Point's **DANNY GATHINGS** in 2002-03. Meanwhile, Brown has recorded a double-double in four consecutive games and is averaging 12.8 points and 12.3 rebounds in that span. He is two field goals short of qualifying for the Conference's percentage leaders (5.0 per game minimum).

NEW KID ON THE BLOCK

VMI freshman **D.J. COVINGTON** has a League-high 37 blocked shots in just 13 games played, but has not yet appeared in the required 75 percent of his team's games to qualify for the Big South and NCAA statistical ranking. Covington has appeared in 72.2 percent (13 of 18) and his 2.85 block per game would lead the Big South. He has four games with at least four rejections, including a season-high nine against Southern Virginia on Nov. 23, the highest block total in the Big South since former UNC Asheville center **KENNY GEORGE** swatted away 10 shots against Campbell on Nov. 17, 2007. Meanwhile, Covington is 13 blocks away from becoming just the seventh Big South freshman (true or redshirt) with 50 blocks in a season.

ELLIS EARNS 600TH CAREER DIVISION I WIN

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** became the 10th active coach and 26th overall to win 600 career Division I games when the Chanticleers defeated Liberty, 70-67 in Lynchburg on Jan. 8. He is 602-381 at the Division I level and 680-393 overall in 35 years as a head coach. Ellis, who has now won at least 15 games in a season for the 28th time in his career, has directed four different Division I programs to 20-win seasons in his career (10 overall), which includes five seasons with at least 25 wins. He has been named Coach of the Year in four difference Conferences (Sun Belt, ACC, SEC, Big South). Ellis is 68-44 (=60.7 percent) at Coastal Carolina.

MR. TRIPLE-DOUBLE

Liberty junior guard **JESSE SANDERS** notched his Big South-record third career triple-double on Jan. 6 against Charleston Southern, as he finished with 10 points, 10 rebounds and 10 assists against the Buccaneers. All three have come at the Vines Center. As a freshman in 2008-09, Sanders had the exact same output against Presbyterian College on Feb. 9, 2009 for his first career trifecta. Last season as a sophomore, Sanders had 11 points, 10 boards and 10 helpers against Kentucky Christian on Dec. 12, 2009. Sanders owns three of the eight triple-doubles on record in Big South history, including two of the five that have occurred in Conference games.

ASHEVILLE SCORES BIG SOUTH'S FIRST 20-20-20 ON THE ROAD

UNC Asheville has won three Big South road games by at least 20 points this season, becoming the first team in Big South men's basketball history to accomplish this feat. The Bulldogs first won by 20 points at Radford (Dec. 2), then did it in back-to-back games the week of Jan. 3 -- winning by 21 at Winthrop (Jan. 6) and 26 at Presbyterian College (Jan. 8). The 26-point margin against the Blue Hose was the biggest Big South Conference road victory in school history. Asheville is the first Big South member since Winthrop last season to win back-to-back Conference road games by at least 20 points.

STEADY EDDIE

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH**, who recorded his 200th career win at Asheville with the Bulldogs' 86-57 victory over Montreat College on Dec. 11, is the Big South's all-time winningest coach for overall wins (205) and Big South victories (121). Biedenbach is 234-277 in 17-plus years as a collegiate head coach.

SCOREBOARD WATCHING

VMI leads both the Big South and the nation in scoring offense at 92.7 points a game, and is attempting to finish as the country's top scoring offense for an unprecedented fifth-straight year. VMI led the nation in scoring offense in 2009-10 for the fourth consecutive season, becoming the first team in NCAA Division I history to lead the country in scoring offense four consecutive years. The Keydets are also looking to become the first Conference member to lead the Big South in scoring five consecutive years. VMI (2006-present) and Radford (1995-99) are the only programs to lead four-straight seasons.

PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE SCORES BCS DOUBLE

Presbyterian College is the second team in Big South Conference history to defeat an SEC team and ACC team in the same season, as the Blue Hose did it in back-to-back games! PC first knocked off the Auburn Tigers, 62-59, on Dec. 18 and then won at Wake Forest, 66-64 on Dec. 20. Former (and future) member Campbell was the first Big South member to achieve the feat. In 1993-94, the Camels defeated North Carolina State (72-69) and South Carolina (73-72).

BIG SOUTH OWNS THREE WINS OVER THE SEC, TWO OVER THE ACC

The Big South has enjoyed some monumental non-Conference success this season, as the League owns three wins over the SEC and two over the ACC. UNC Asheville (at Auburn), Coastal Carolina (at LSU) and Presbyterian College (at Auburn) won at SEC venues, giving the Big South Conference three wins against the SEC for the first time since 1993-94. That season, the Conference had wins over LSU and South Carolina (twice). Meanwhile, both Winthrop and Presbyterian College won at Wake Forest, the League's first multi-win season against the ACC since 2007-08. The Big South Conference has recorded wins over members from the Atlantic Coast Conference and the Southeastern Conference in the same season now for the third time in the last four years.

The Bucs are 9-0 inside the Buc Dome this season ... CSU doubled its two opponents last week in points from the free throw line, shooting 48-for-59 (=81.4), including 25-of-29 (=86.2) Saturday vs. Winthrop ... **JAMARCO WARREN** (1,717 points) is just 21 points behind **BRETT LARRICK** (1993-97) for second-place on the school's all-time scoring list ... **KELVIN MARTIN** has posted double-doubles in each of the last three games, averaging 17.3 points and 12.0 rebounds in that span.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina broke the school-record for longest win streak on Jan. 13 with its 13th consecutive win, a 74-69 victory over Winthrop ... **SAM McLAURIN** posted his first career double-double with a career-high 17 points to go along with 10 rebounds against the Eagles ... **CHAD GRAY** scored 19 points and grabbed five rebounds to lead Coastal Carolina to its 14th-straight win with a 60-42 victory over Presbyterian College Saturday afternoon. The victory also was the Chants' 11th-straight Big South Conference victory, tying the school record for the most consecutive Conference victories previously accomplished in 1989-90 and 1990-91 ... Coastal has also won 15-straight regular season homes games, dating back to last season ... **DESMOND HOLLOWAY** returned to the Chanticleer lineup after missing the Winthrop game and finished with 15 points against PC. He has scored in double figures in every game in which he has appeared ... Against the Blue Hose, **KIERRE GREENWOOD** dished out a career-high nine assists to go along with seven rebounds, while McLaurin posted a career-best six blocked shots.

GARDNER-WEBB

Gardner-Webb got its first double-double from freshman center **MIKE BYRON** at UNC Asheville. Byron netted 11 points and pulled down a career-high 15 rebounds in the game, collecting eight of those caroms before halftime ... GWU played its sixth game in a row without leading scorer **JON MOORE** (15.5 ppg), who is working his way back in the training room following a broken foot suffered at Arizona State. The Runnin' Bulldogs are 0-6 without Moore.

HIGH POINT

HPU played two close games last week but couldn't halt its losing streak, now at eight games ... In the loss to Liberty on Thursday, HPU led with 4:37 to go and, in the loss to VMI, the Panthers trailed by just two points with 2:37 left ... **NICK BARBOUR** has broken out of the scoring slump that plagued him around the holidays. After three games scoring in single digits and averaging 5.7 points, Barbour has averaged 21.8 points in four games since. That includes a season-high 32 against VMI this past Saturday, and his scoring average has risen from 13.8 to 15.9 in the last three games ... Freshman **Du'VAUGHN MAXWELL** had his first career double-double with 15 points and 10 rebounds -- both career highs, against VMI. **COREY LAW** had 10 points and 12 rebounds for his third double-double of the season and eighth of his career ... In recent losses to Radford and VMI, HPU out-rebounded its opponent by a significant margin. HPU pulled in 17 more than Radford on Jan. 8 and 12 more than VMI last Saturday.

LIBERTY

After posting 14 points and 10 rebounds at High Point and 11 points and 14 boards at Radford, **JOHN BROWN** has recorded four-straight double-doubles and 10 on the season ... With 1:48 remaining in the first half of Liberty's game against Radford, **JESSE SANDERS** notched his 500th career rebound ... Liberty's win over Radford was its third-straight in the Dedmon Center and fourth in five seasons.

PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE

Presbyterian College dropped both Conference road games last week to fall to 2-5 in League games and 8-11 overall. The Blue Hose nearly overcame an 11-point second half deficit at Charleston Southern with help from three consecutive three-pointers from **KHALID MUTAKABBIR** in the last 1:11 of play, but the comeback fell just short and PC lost, 76-71. The Blue Hose continued to fight and threatened multiple times in the second half, including in the last 23 seconds when they were down by two points, but the Bucs held on and came away with the win.

RADFORD

In his last three games, **JOHNATHAN EDWARDS** is averaging 11.7 points, 7.7 rebounds and 56.5 percent from the field (13-of-23) ... **BLAKE SMITH** is averaging 3.0 steals in his last eight games.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville picked up its third-straight win with a 68-59 home victory over Gardner-Webb Saturday afternoon. Asheville shot 56 percent from the field as the Bulldogs shot above 50 percent from the floor for the third consecutive game. **MATT DICKEY** scored a game-high 20 points in the victory, while **JOHN WILLIAMS** added 13 points and seven rebounds. Williams also moved into 10th place on Asheville's all-time career rebounding list with 591 ... Asheville is on a season-high three-game winning streak but will be tested this week as the Bulldogs host Big South leader Coastal Carolina and third-place Charleston Southern. Asheville was 0-5 against both teams last season.

VMI

VMI shot 29-of-59 from 3-point range (=49.2 percent) in two games last week and matched a season-best against Division I competition with 15 treys at Radford ... In two starts last week, freshman **D.J. COVINGTON** averaged 11.0 points and 6.5 rebounds while blocking eight shots. Covington registered five blocks in the win at Radford ... The Keydets' 105 points at Radford was the fifth time this year VMI went over the century mark.

WINTHROP

Winthrop dropped its third-straight Conference road game for the first time since the 2003-04 season as it fell at Coastal Carolina and Charleston Southern ... **CHARLES CORBIN**, who got the starting nod at CSU in place of **MATT MORGAN**, responded with his second double-double of the season with 11 points and 11 rebounds against the Bucs ... In three of Winthrop's four Big South losses, the opponents have won the battle on the glass. The Eagles out-rebounded Coastal by one and lost. The Eagles are now 5-1 this season when they win the rebound battle.
