Dickey averaged 17.5 points, 3.5 assists and 2.0 steals in two key Big South road wins last week against teams above the Bulldogs in the Conference standings. He scored 19 points, was 4-of-5 from three-point range and recorded three steals in Asheville's 88-67 win at Winthrop last Thursday, handing the Eagles their worst home loss in 14 seasons as well as giving the Bulldogs their second regular-season win at Winthrop in the last 13 years. Dickey then scored a team-high 16 points on 6-of-10 from the field, in addition to four rebounds and three assists, in the Bulldogs' 74-48 win Saturday at Presbyterian College -- Asheville's largest Conference road win in school history (26 points). For the week, Dickey was 11-of-20 from the field (=55.0 percent), 5-of-8 from three-point range (=62.5) and 8-of-10 from the free throw line (=80.0).

Sanders scored a career-high 16 points in 16 minutes against Coastal Carolina on Saturday. He went 6-of-8 from the field, including 4-of-6 from three-point range against the Chanticleers. Sanders scored seven-straight points at the end of the first half to close the gap to four at halftime, then knocked down a three-pointer late in the game that put Liberty within two points with 9 seconds left.

ELLIS EARNS 600TH CAREER DIVISION I WIN

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** became the 10th active coach and 26th overall to win 600 career Division I games when the Chanticleers defeated Liberty this past Saturday night, 70-67 in Lynchburg. He is now 600-381 at the Division I level and 678-393 overall in 35 years as a head coach. Ellis, who is one win away from 15 wins in a season for the 28th time in his career, has directed four different Division I programs to 20-win seasons in his career (10 overall), which includes five seasons with at least 25 wins. He has been named Coach of the Year in four difference Conferences (Sun Belt, ACC, SEC, Big South). Ellis is now 66-44 (=60.0 percent) at Coastal Carolina.

COASTAL CAROLINA DEFEATS LIBERTY IN BATTLE OF UNBEATENS

Liberty (5-0) and Coastal Carolina (4-0) -- the Big South's last remaining undefeated teams in Conference play -- faced off this past Saturday, and the Chanticleers emerged with a 70-67 victory to move a half-game ahead of the Flames in the standings to stay unbeaten in Big South games. The game was the first time that two teams with at least 4-0 Big South records met on the hardwood since 2006-07, when High Point (6-0) and Winthrop (5-0) went head-to-head on Jan. 25, 2007. Coastal and Liberty are also the first Big South teams since the Panthers and Eagles in 2006-07 to open Conference play at least 5-0.

MR. TRIPLE-DOUBLE

Liberty junior guard **JESSE SANDERS** notched his Big South-record third career triple-double on Jan. 6 against Charleston Southern, as he finished with 10 points, 10 rebounds and 10 assists against the Buccaneers. All three have come at the Vines Center. As a freshman in 2008-09, Sanders had the exact same output against Presbyterian College on Feb. 9, 2009 for his first career trifecta. Last season as a sophomore, Sanders had 11 points, 10 boards and 10 helpers against Kentucky Christian on Dec. 12, 2009. Sanders owns three of the eight triple-doubles on record in Big South history, including two of the five that have occurred in Conference games.

TV TIME

The "Royal Purple Big South Game of the Week" TV package resumes this Thursday night when High Point hosts Liberty live on ESPN3.com at 7:00pm. It is the Big South's first-ever exclusive Conference game televised on the broadband channel, and the first of two League tilts on ESPN3.com this season. **MATT HOGUE** (play-by-play) and **NATE ROSS** (analyst) will call the action from the Millis Center.

OFF AND RUNNING

This week, Coastal Carolina will attempt to start 6-0 in the Conference for the second-straight year, and the Chanticleers host defending Big South Tournament Champion Winthrop in Kimbel Arena on Thursday night in a rematch of last year's title game. The last Big South team to open League play 6-0 in consecutive seasons was Winthrop in 2005-06 (6-0) and 2006-07 (14-0). If successful on Thursday night, the Chanticleers would be the 17th Conference member to start 6-0 in Big South games in League history.

THE IMPORTANCE OF A GOOD START

A total of 22 teams have started Conference play at least 5-0 since 1985-86, and 18 of those squads have won or shared the regular-season crown. In addition, eight teams that opened 5-0 went on to win the Conference Tournament title -- the last being Winthrop in 2006-07, while another five finished as Big South Tournament runner-up. Furthermore, six teams reached the Tournament Semifinals.

MAKING WAVES

Coastal Carolina, which garnered a Top 25 vote in this week's AP poll, has started 14-2 for the second consecutive year, as the Chanticleers opened the 2009-10 season with a school-record 16-2 start. It is the third-straight year that a Big South team has opened a season at least 14-2. VMI opened the 2008-09 campaign with a 14-2 mark. Coastal Carolina needs to win its next game (Thursday vs. Winthrop) to match the Big South record for fastest team to win 15 games. The Chanticleers set that record just last season, as the 2009-10 Coastal squad won its 15th game in just its 17th contest of the year. Stay tuned.

TONIGHT ON 20/20

UNC Asheville has won its three Big South games this season by at least 20 points, and all on the road. The Bulldogs first won by 20 points at Radford (Dec. 2), then did it in back-to-back games last week -- winning by 21 at Winthrop (Jan. 6) and 26 at Presbyterian College (Jan. 8). The 26-point margin against the Blue Hose was the biggest Big South Conference road victory in school history. Asheville is the first Big South member since Winthrop last season to win back-to-back Conference road games by at least 20 points.

LEGEND OF SLEEPY HOLLOW

Coastal Carolina's **DESMOND HOLLOWAY** is the lone Big South men's basketball player to score in double figures in all of his team's games this season. Holloway has scored at least 13 points in the Chanticleers' first 16 games and ranks second in the Big South with 19.0 points per contest.

DID YOU KNOW...

...that through games of Jan. 2, the Winthrop Eagles had the No. 1-ranked non-Conference strength of schedule according to *Collegiate Basketball News*, one of the main RPI reports used by the NCAA Men's Basketball Committee? Entering this week, Winthrop is No. 4 in the category.

JUNIOR 15

UNC Asheville juniors **MATT DICKEY** and **J.P. PRIMM** have scored at least 15 points in the same game nine times this season, with the Bulldogs going 6-3 in those games. It should be noted that the losses have been to nationally-ranked North Carolina and Georgetown, as well as a two-point double-over-time loss at USC Upstate. The duo has reached the 15-point threshold in the same game 14 times since arriving on campus in 2008-09, and Asheville is 10-4 in those games.

GOING FOR THE BAKER'S DOZEN

Coastal Carolina carries a 12-game winning streak into this week's action, which ties the school record. It is the second-straight season the Chanticleers have strung together a double-digit win streak, as Coastal put together a 12-game win streak from Nov. 28, 2009 - Jan. 9, 2010. The Chants are the first Big South team to have at least a 10-game win streak in back-to-back seasons since Radford in 1997-98 (11) and 1998-99 (13).

MR. SAND MAN

Liberty junior guard **JESSE SANDERS** became the 18th player in Big South history to hand out 400 assists when he eclipsed the milestone this past Saturday against Coastal Carolina. He is tied for 17th in League annals with 403 helpers. Sanders is just 10 rebounds away from becoming the 60th Big South player with 500 career rebounds -- but would be the first to have 500 rebounds and 400 assists. Meanwhile, Sanders is 12th in the country with 6.1 assists per game, and is one of two players in the nation averaging at least 6.0 assists (6.3) and 6.0 rebounds (6.4) a contest (Texas Southern's **KEVIN GALLOWAY** is the other).

JOHN WILLIAMS' BUILDING BLOCKS

UNC Asheville redshirt-senior **JOHN WILLIAMS**, who missed seven games from Nov. 23 - Dec. 21 due to injury, is eight points away from becoming just the third player in Big South history with 1,000 career points, 500 career rebounds and 200 career blocked shots. Already one of four players in League annals with 500 rebounds (584) and 200 blocks (school-record 219), Williams is looking to join Liberty's **PETER ALUMA** (1,715 points, 682 rebounds, 366 blocks) and Radford's **TYRONE TRAVIS** (1,313 points, 718 rebounds, 215 blocks) in this elite group.

WARREN ON DOORSTEP OF SPECIAL 300/300 CLUB

Charleston Southern senior **JAMARCO WARREN** is on the cusp of becoming just the fourth player in Big South history with 300 career three-pointers and 300 career assists. Warren currently owns 297 career treys and 298 career helpers, and would join Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** (411 3FG, 353 AST), UNC Greensboro's **SCOTT HARTZELL** (309 3FG, 552 AST) and VMI's **CHAVIS HOLMES** (306 3FG, 313 AST) on the League's 300 three-pointer, 300 assist list.

STAN'S THE MAN

VMI sophomore **STAN OKOYE** leads the Big South in scoring (19.6) and field goal percentage (54.2) and is second in double-doubles (7). He already has five games with at least 20 points and 10 rebounds, and is averaging 21.1 points and 11.9 rebounds when he records a double-double in a game this season. If he can maintain his hold on both categories, he would be the fifth player in League history to lead the Conference in scoring and field goal percentage. The previous individuals were Liberty's **PETER ALUMA** (1995-96), UNC Asheville's **JOSH PITTMAN** (1997-98), High Point's **DANNY GATHINGS** (2002-03) and Radford's **ART PARAKHOUSKI** (2009-10).

COLEMAN ECLIPSES SCORING AND REBOUNDING MILESTONES

Presbyterian College redshirt-junior **AL'LOUNZO COLEMAN** scored his 1,000th career point in the Blue Hose's 78-44 victory over Gardner-Webb on Jan. 6. He surpassed 500 career rebounds with his 16-rebound effort at Winthrop on Dec. 31. Coleman, who stands at 1,010 points and 532 rebounds in his collegiate career at PC (673 points and 381 rebounds as an official Big South member), left this past Saturday's game against UNC Asheville with an injury just nine minutes into the contest. He had six points and three rebounds before getting hurt.

FROM THE LAND OF THREE...

As mentioned above, Charleston Southern's **JAMARCO WARREN** has 297 career three-pointers, which gives him sole possession of fifth-place in Big South history. Warren needs three more three-pointers to become the fifth player in League annals with 300. In addition, VMI senior **AUSTIN KENON** is eighth in the Conference record books with 292 career three-pointers. He has made a three-pointer in 85 of his 90 career games for a 3.24 per game average, which is currently the fourth-highest per game clip in League history.

SPECIAL K

Charleston Southern junior **KELVIN MARTIN** needs 34 rebounds to become the first Charleston Southern player with 600 career rebounds since **JEFF DANIELS** surpassed the mark in 1996-97. Martin, who is tied for 46th in League history with 566 career boards, would be the fourth Buccaneer in the Big South's 600-rebound club once he reaches the milestone.

BIG SOUTH SEPARATION

Of the first 27 Big South games this season, 14 had winning margins of less than 10 points, including seven that were decided by three points-or-less. However, the first 27 Conference games of the 2010-11 campaign had an average margin of victory of 11.59 points. In the 13 games decided by double digits, the average margin of victory was 19.2 points. The 14 games decided by less than 10 points had an average victory margin of 4.57 points. Last year, the overall margin of victory in League play was 10.51 points, while the 2008-09 average margin was 8.96 points.

ROAD TRIP

The road teams claimed 13 of the first 27 Big South games played this season (=48.1 percent), ahead of the 2008-09 mark of 46.7 percent (42-48) and the third time in five seasons that the visiting squads are winning at least 40 percent of the Conference games. In addition, the road teams are winning convincingly this year, as visiting squads own an average margin of victory of 12.7 points in their 13 Conference wins. The home teams have won their 14 League games by an average margin of just 10.6 points.

MID-MAJOR MADNESS

Coastal Carolina is ranked No. 8 in the *Collegeinsider.com* Mid-Major Top 25 poll this week, its highest ranking of the season and first time within the Top 10. In addition, Liberty has received votes in the poll for the past two weeks. The Big South Conference has had a team ranked in the 12-year-old Mid-Major Top 25 poll the last seven consecutive seasons. ANOTHER BROWN LEADING LIBERTY

Liberty newcomer and redshirt-junior **JOHN BROWN** leads the Big South with 10.1 rebounds a game. If he can maintain his position, he would be the first Liberty player to lead the Conference in rebounding since **LEO LIGHTBOURNE** in 2004-05. Brown could also become the first newcomer to finish as the Big South's top rebounder since High Point's **DANNY GATHINGS** in 2002-03.

PRIMM-TIME

UNC Asheville junior **J.P. PRIMM** has 381 career assists and needs 19 to join the Big South's 400-assist club. He also has 147 career steals and is 53 away from joining the Conference's 12-member 200-steal club. Once he reaches both milestones, he would become the fifth player in League history with 400 assists and 200 steals. The group currently includes Winthrop's **CHRIS GAYNOR** (567 AST, 259 STL), Coastal Carolina's **ROBERT DOWDELL** (561 AST, 239 STL), Campbell's **BRAD CHILDRESS** (543 AST, 243 STL) and Charleston Southern's **ED O'NEIL** (504 AST, 241 STL).

COVER TWO

VMI freshman **D.J. COVINGTON** blocked nine shots against Southern Virginia on Nov. 23, the highest block total in the Big South since former UNC Asheville center **KENNY GEORGE** swatted away 10 shots against Campbell on Nov. 17, 2007. Covington has played in just 11 of VMI's 16 games due to injuries (68.8 percent), but still has a League-high 29 blocked shots in his limited action (2.64 per game, which would also lead the Big South), including three games with at least four rejections. He needs to appear in 75 percent of his team's games in order to qualify for the Big South and NCAA statistical rankings.

SCOREBOARD WATCHING

VMI leads both the Big South and the nation in scoring offense at 91.7 points a game, and is attempting to finish as the country's top scoring offense for an unprecedented fifth-straight year. VMI led the nation in scoring offense in 2009-10 for the fourth consecutive season, becoming the first team in NCAA Division I history to lead the country in scoring offense four consecutive years. The Keydets are also looking to become the first Conference member to lead the Big South in scoring five consecutive years. VMI (2006-present) and Radford (1995-99) are the only programs to lead four-straight seasons.

PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE SCORES BCS DOUBLE

Presbyterian College is the second team in Big South Conference history to defeat an SEC team and ACC team in the same season, as the Blue Hose did it in back-to-back games! PC first knocked off the Auburn Tigers, 62-59, on Dec. 18 and then won at Wake Forest, 66-64 on Dec. 20. Former (and future) member Campbell was the first Big South member to achieve the feat. In 1993-94, the Camels defeated North Carolina State (72-69) and South Carolina (73-72).

BIG SOUTH OWNS THREE WINS OVER THE SEC, TWO OVER THE ACC

The Big South has enjoyed some monumental non-Conference success this season, as the League owns three wins over the SEC and two over the ACC. UNC Asheville (at Auburn), Coastal Carolina (at LSU) and Presbyterian College (at Auburn) won at SEC venues, giving the Big South Conference three wins against the SEC for the first time since 1993-94. That season, the Conference had wins over LSU and South Carolina (twice). Meanwhile, both Winthrop and Presbyterian College won at Wake Forest, the League's first multi-win season against the ACC since 2007-08. The Big South Conference has recorded wins over members from the Atlantic Coast Conference and the Southeastern Conference in the same season now for the third time in the last four years.

HOME COOKIN'

The 10 Big South men's basketball programs are a collective 35-4 at home this season in non-Conference games, a combined 89.7 winning percentage. The teams actually won the first 21 home games before High Point suffered a six-point loss to Hampton inside the Millis Center on Sunday, Nov. 28. Seven non-Conference home games remain on the 2010-11 schedule, including five BracketBusters match-ups.

STEADY EDDIE

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** recorded his 200th career win at Asheville with the Bulldogs' 86-57 victory over Montreat College on Dec. 11. The Big South's all-time winningest coach for overall wins (204) and Big South victories (120), Biedenbach is 233-277 in 17-plus years as a collegiate head coach.

OTHER COACHES NETTING MILESTONE WINS

Coastal Carolina's **CLIFF ELLIS** and UNC Asheville's **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** are not the only Big South head coaches notching milestone victories this season. Liberty head coach **DALE LAYER** needs four more wins for 300 in his coaching career. VMI head coach **DUGGAR BAUCOM** (78) stands one win away from second-place on VMI's all-time coaching win list. Winthrop head coach **RANDY PEELE** won his 100th game as a collegiate head coach with the Eagles' 83-74 win at Wake Forest on Nov. 22, and became the eighth coach in League history with 50 regular-season Big South wins with Winthrop's 53-51 win over Presbyterian College on Dec. 31.

BIG SOUTH TO MAKE SIXTH APPEARANCE IN BRACKETBUSTERS EVENT

The Big South Conference will again participate in the BracketBusters event this season during the weekend of February 18-19, with a League-record nine teams among the field of 114. Representing the Big South in the 2011 event will be last year's four BracketBusters participants **WINTHROP, RADFORD, PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE** and **GARDNER-WEBB**, plus **HIGH POINT, LIBERTY, UNC ASHEVILLE, CHARLESTON SOUTHERN** and **VMI** -- the latter two making their first appearance in the series. The Big South has the third-most Conference members participating of the 15 Leagues involved this season. The Conference is 7-8 all-time in the BracketBusters, including two wins in 2006, 2007 and 2010, and has been selected for national television appearances three times: 2007 (ESPN2), 2008 (ESPN2) and 2009 (ESPNU). In 2011-12 and 2012-13, the Big South Conference will have 11 teams in the event, including new member **CAMPBELL**.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

At VMI, **KELVIN MARTIN** scored a season-high 22 points and added 10 rebounds for his fifth double-double of the season, helping CSU to a 56-33 edge on the boards. **KENNY MITCHELL** also recorded a double-double at VMI, the first of his career, with 19 points and a career-high 17 rebounds. Martin and Mitchell are the first Buccaneer tandem to record double-doubles in the same game since Martin and **JO'EL LAMB** did so Jan. 5, 2009 vs. VMI ... Mitchell's 17 rebounds are tied for the most by a CSU player in the last 10 seasons ... CSU's win at VMI was its first in Cameron Hall since the 2005-06 season.

COASTAL CAROLINA

DESMOND HOLLOWAY tied his career-high with 25 points at VMI to go along with six rebounds. **KIERRE GREENWOOD** scored 18 points, grabbed six rebounds and dished out a game-high five assists. In all, six players scored in double figures against the Keydets, including all five starters ... Greenwood scored 15 points to lead four Chanticleers in double figures in the Liberty win. Holloway added 14 points and six rebounds.

GARDNER-WEBB

The Runnin' Bulldogs have dropped eight consecutive games since starting 6-4, and have been without leading scorer **JON MOORE** (15.5 points) for the last five contests ... Freshman **LUKE DAVIS** ranks fifth in the Big South with 3.89 assists per game.

HIGH POINT

High Point ended a seven-game stretch of road games with a 1-6 record. The Panthers won the first game of the trip, 80-69 at Tennessee Tech, before losing six straight. It's HPU's longest losing streak since a seven-game losing skid from Jan. 10-31, 2009 ... The Panthers are 4-1 at the Millis Center this season and play nine of their remaining 15 regular-season games at home ... **NICK BARBOUR** scored 22 points at Radford on Saturday, including 20 in the second half -- the fifth time in his career that Barbour scored more than 20 points in a half ... In five Conference games, **SHAY SHINE** leads the squad in both scoring (14.4 ppg) and assists (4.0 apg) ... **EARNEST BRIDGES** missed three games with an injury before returning to grab a game-high nine rebounds at Radford.

LIBERTY

After struggling with turnovers for several games, Liberty is now managing its miscues once again. This past week, the Flames turned the ball over just 13 times against Charleston Southern and 10 times against League leader Coastal Carolina for an average of 11.5 ... Following a 13-point, 12-rebound performance against Charleston Southern on Thursday, **JOHN BROWN** posted 13 points and 13 rebounds vs. Coastal Carolina for his Big South-leading eighth double-double of the season.

PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE

PC looks to rebound from a tough home loss to UNC Asheville when the Blue Hose travel to Charleston Southern on Thursday, Jan. 13 ... Before the loss to Asheville, the Blue Hose were on a two-game win streak, including a victory over Conference member Gardner-Webb ... In the win over the Runnin' Bulldogs, **AL'ONZO COLEMAN** became the first PC student-athlete since the school's transition to Division I to reach the 1,000 point milestone.

RADFORD

Radford recorded its first Division I and Conference win of the season with a 64-59 victory over High Point this past Saturday evening at the Dedmon Center. It also marked the first time the Highlanders hit the 60-point plateau against a Division I opponent. **JEREMY ROBINSON** and **JOHNATHAN EDWARDS** led Radford with 11 points each.

UNC ASHEVILLE

Asheville won at Winthrop last week for just the second time in the last 13 years during the regular-season. **J.P. PRIMM** scored a Big South-career high 24 points in the win ... Coming into this season, the Bulldogs had won just one Big South Conference road game by 20 points or more in 25 years of play in the Big South. Asheville already has three such games in 2010-11 ... **JOHN WILLIAMS** played his best basketball since coming back from a facial injury last week. He scored 15 points with seven rebounds and three blocked shots at Winthrop and then added 14 points on 7-of-11 field goals at Presbyterian College. Williams is poised to become the 25th player at Asheville to score 1,000 career points and needs five rebounds to move into 10th place on the school's career rebounding list.

VMI

Freshman point guard **RODNEY GLASGOW** missed the Coastal Carolina game but made a recovery in time to come off the bench to play 20 minutes and score 10 points in Saturday's game against Charleston Southern ... **RON BURKS** returned to action after missing seven games with a broken hand sustained in the Nov. 29 game against Central Penn. He averaged 9.5 points and 7.0 rebounds in two games last week ... VMI's six 3-pointers against Charleston Southern were a season-low in Conference games ... Freshman **D.J. COVINGTON** made his first collegiate start against Charleston Southern and hit 7-of-11 shots and scored 15 points ... The Keydets will play the next three games on the road and will not return to Cameron Hall until Jan. 27.

WINTHROP

Winthrop suffered a rare home loss against UNC Asheville as the Bulldogs snapped the Eagles' 12-game home winning streak. The 21-point loss to Asheville was Winthrop's worst home court loss in 14 years since the Bulldogs won by the same margin during the 1997-98 season ... **ANDRE JONES** led Winthrop to a 15-point win over Gardner-Webb as he had his best scoring game since Dec. 4 (seven games) with 17 points. Jones (4) and **GEORGE VALENTINE** (5) also had career-highs in steals in the GWU game ... Winthrop is 6-1 when holding opponents below 40 percent from the field.
