Mutakabbir scored a career-high 25 points and grabbed seven rebounds in PC's 76-74 overtime win over Winthrop, snapping a seven-game losing streak to the Eagles. He played all 45 minutes and hit a jumper with five seconds left that tied the game at 64-64 and eventually forced overtime. Mutakabbir later hit two free throws with 20 seconds remaining in overtime that gave the Blue Hose a three-point lead. He finished the day 8-of-14 from the field, 2-of-5 from three-point range and 7-of-8 from the line. He also scored 15 of his 25 points in the second half/overtime, including 6-of-6 from the charity stripe.

COASTAL CAROLINA FASTEST TEAM IN BIG SOUTH HISTORY TO WIN 20 GAMES

Coastal Carolina became the fastest team in Big South history to win 20 games, as the Chanticleers captured their 20th victory in just 22 games. The old record was 24 games, which was accomplished on four occasions -- 1991-92 (Liberty), 2006-07 (Winthrop), 2008-09 (VMI) and 2009-10 (Coastal Carolina). The Chanticleers have buoyed their start with a school-record 18-game win streak, which is currently the second-longest in the nation behind Ohio State's 22-game streak. Coastal's streak is the longest in the Big South since Winthrop won a League-record 19-straight in 2006-07.

CHANTICLEERS ALSO HAVE THIRD-LONGEST CONFERENCE-GAME WIN STREAK

Coastal Carolina has won 15 consecutive regular-season Big South games, dating back to last season, which is the third-longest Conference-game win streak in League annals. Winthrop owns the top two -- 21 consecutive Big South wins from Jan. 8, 2005 to Jan. 21, 2006 and 16-straight Conference victories from Feb. 23, 2006 to Feb. 24, 2007.

ELEVEN IS HEAVEN

Coastal Carolina is 11-0 in Big South play for the first time since 1990-91 and the third time overall. The Chants are the first Big South member to open the League season 11-0 since Winthrop swept through the 2006-07 Conference season with a 14-0 mark. The Chanticleers -- the first team to sweep the first half of an 18-game Big South schedule, which has been utilized since 2008-09 and four times total (1993-94 was the first) -- is just the fourth team to start 11-0 in League play. The previous three teams all captured the regular-season and Conference Tournament titles.

VACATION HOME?

The road teams have won 24 of the first 54 Big South games played -- a 44.4 winning percentage, and marks the third time in the last five seasons that road teams were winning at least 40 percent of the Conference games. ROADIES

Coastal Carolina has won seven-straight Big South road games, one shy of tying the school record of eight. In addition, the Chanticleers are the first team in League history to win four Big South road games by at least 20 points -- bettering Asheville's record of three that was established earlier this season. Coastal won by 22 at VMI (Jan. 6), 21 at UNC Asheville (Jan. 20), 24 at High Point (Jan. 27) and 23 at Radford (Jan. 29).

300-LAYER CAKE

Liberty head coach **DALE LAYER** recorded his 300th career coaching win with the Flames' 83-81 overtime win over UNC Asheville on Jan. 27. He now has 301, and his win total includes 167 victories as head coach of Division II member Queens (1989-98), 103 wins at the helm of Colorado State (2000-07) and 31 in less than two seasons at Liberty.

THREE (BULL)DOG NIGHT

UNC Asheville's **MATT DICKEY** (1,017) became the second Bulldog to reach 1,000 career points this season, joining **JOHN WILLIAMS** (1,049) in the club. Teammate **J.P. PRIMM** (985) enters this week needing 15 points for the milestone. One Primm hits the mark, it would mark the third time in Conference history that a Big South team had three players score their 1,000th point in the same season. Coastal Carolina was the first in 1990-91 (**BRIAN PENNY**, **ROBERT DOWDELL**, **DuWAYNE CHEATAM**) and Radford was the last in 2001-02 (**RAYMOND ARRINGTON**, **ANDREY SAVTCHENKO**, **CORREY WATKINS**).

BURNING UP

Liberty has won 15 games for the fourth consecutive season, the fourth-longest such streak in Big South history. The last Big South team to win at least 15 games in four consecutive years was Winthrop, which strung together a League-record 10 consecutive seasons with at least 15 wins. Meanwhile, the Flames have won 10 Big South games for the third-straight year.

CONFERENCE TOURNAMENT APPROACHING

The 2011 Advance Auto Parts Big South Men's Basketball Championship Tournament will commence on Tuesday, March 1 at the home sites of the top four seeds.

The top eight of the nine postseason eligible teams will earn a berth in this year's Championship, with the No. 1 seed having a chance to host throughout the Tournament.

For the sixth consecutive season, the Semifinals will be contested at the site of the No. 1 seed and will be broadcast live on ESPNU on Thursday, March 3. The highest remaining seed will host the Championship game on its home floor Saturday, March 5 at 4:00pm live on ESPN2.

BIG SOUTH'S BRACKETBUSTERS OPPONENTS TO BE UNVEILED JAN. 31

ESPN will formerly announce the 2011 BracketBusters pairings on Monday evening, Jan. 31, beginning at 6:30pm with a Selection Show on ESPNU to announce the TV match-ups. At 7:00pm, the non-TV games will be released. The Big South is participating in the annual event for the sixth consecutive season, with a League-record nine teams among the field of 114. Representing the Big South are **WINTHROP, RADFORD, PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE** and **GARDNER-WEBB**, plus **HIGH POINT, LIBERTY, UNC ASHEVILLE, CHARLESTON SOUTHERN** and **VMI** -- the latter two making their first appearance in the series. The Big South has the third-most Conference members participating of the 15 Leagues involved this season. The Conference is 7-8 all-time in the BracketBusters, including two wins in 2006, 2007 and 2010, and has been selected for national television appearances three times: 2007 (ESPN2), 2008 (ESPN2) and 2009 (ESPNU). In 2011-12 and 2012-13, the Big South Conference will have 11 teams in the event, including new member **CAMPBELL**.

NATIONAL POLLSTERS VOTERS TAKING NOTICE OF COASTAL CAROLINA, BIG SOUTH

For the fourth consecutive week, Coastal Carolina has received votes in the *Associated Press* Top 25 national ranking and is 36th in this week's poll. In addition, the Chanticleers have earned Top 25 consideration in the *ESPN/USA Today* Coaches poll for the second week in a row. Coastal received six points in this week's Coaches poll (tied for 35th) after collecting three points last week. VMI also picked up an AP Top 25 vote this season when the Keydets received a vote in the Nov. 28 poll.

ON THE RADAR SCREEN

Coastal Carolina is 48-9 the past two seasons, and needs four more victories to tie the Big South record for most wins in back-to-back years. Winthrop holds the all-time mark of 52 combined wins from 2005-07. The Eagles won 23 games in 2005-06 and followed with a League-record 29 victories in 2006-07.

TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

Charleston Southern, Gardner-Webb and High Point have each lost a League-high six games by eight points-or-less, four of which have been Big South contests. In each of those four Conference games, the Runnin' Bulldogs average margin of defeat is 3.75, while the Panthers' average margin of defeat is 6.25. Charleston Southern's average is 5.00. Gardner-Webb and Charleston Southern each suffered a 2-point loss to High Point this season.

WORKING OVERTIME

Liberty and UNC Asheville have played a League-high four overtime games this season, the most by a Big South team since Presbyterian College played five in 2009-10. Liberty is 3-1 in its overtime games, having won its last three games that went extra time, while Asheville 2-2 in overtime contests. Meanwhile, PC has played 11 overtime games since 2008-09 -- 10 of which were Big South games.

LENDING A HELPING HAND

Liberty junior guard **JESSE SANDERS** is 14th all-time in Big South history with 440 career assists, and needs eight to surpass former Flame **MATT HILDEBRAND** for 13th-place. Hildebrand handed out 447 during his days in the Big South from 1991-94. UNC Asheville junior guard **J.P. PRIMM**, who became the 19th player to join the Big South's 400-assist club on Jan. 22, is 17th in League annals with 412 career assists and needs six to move into the 16th spot, which is held by former Radford player **WHIT HOLCOMB-FAYE**.

3-BALL

Charleston Southern's **JAMARCO WARREN** and VMI's **AUSTIN KENON** entered the Big South's 300-career three-point club on Jan. 15, becoming the fifth and sixth players, respectively, to reach the plateau (Warren hit the milestone first due to the Buccaneers' earlier tip time that day). Both players are now among the Conference's all-time top four, and are also their respective schools' all-time leader. Kenon, who has made a three-pointer in 90 of his 95 career games for a 3.29 per game average (fourth-highest per game clip in League history), is the second Keydet on the Big South's 300-career three-point list. ELLIS NOTCHES 11TH CAREER 20-WIN SEASON

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** has recorded his 11th career 20-win season. The 10th active coach and 26th overall to win 600 career Division I games, Ellis has directed four different Division I programs to at least two 20-win campaigns during his tenure, and owns five seasons with at least 25 wins. Ellis is 606-381 at the Division I level and 684-393 overall in 35 years as a head coach, including 72-44 (=62.1 percent) in four seasons at Coastal Carolina. He has been named Coach of the Year in four different Conferences (Sun Belt, ACC, SEC, Big South) as well.

ANOTHER BROWN LEADING LIBERTY

Liberty newcomer and redshirt-junior **JOHN BROWN** continues to lead the Big South with 10.6 rebounds a game. If he can maintain his position, he would be the first Liberty player to lead the Conference in rebounding since **LEO LIGHTBOURNE** in 2004-05. Brown could also become the first newcomer to finish as the Big South's top rebounder since High Point's **DANNY GATHINGS** in 2002-03. Meanwhile, Brown is third in the Conference with a 52.3 overall field goal percentage and ranks first in the category in Conference games at 57.4 percent. If he can maintain his production on both ends of the floor, Brown would be the ninth Big South player with a 10.0 rebounding average and 50.0 field goal percentage in the same season.

WARREN ALSO MEMBER OF 300 3-POINTER/300 ASSIST CLUBS

Charleston Southern senior **JAMARCO WARREN** is one of four players in Big South history with 300 career three-point field goals and 300 career assists. Warren (315 3FG, 312 AST) has joined Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** (411 3FG, 353 AST), UNC Greensboro's **SCOTT HARTZELL** (309 3FG, 552 AST) and VMI's **CHAVIS HOLMES** (306 3FG, 313 AST) in the club.

MID-MAJOR MADNESS

Coastal Carolina was ranked No. 8 in the *Collegeinsider.com* Mid-Major Top 25 poll last week, its third consecutive week in that position as well as its highest ranking of the season. The Big South Conference has had a team ranked in the 12-year-old Mid-Major Top 25 poll the last seven consecutive seasons. JOHN WILLIAMS' BUILDING BLOCKS

UNC Asheville redshirt-senior **JOHN WILLIAMS** is just the third player in Big South history with 1,000 career points, 600 career rebounds and 200 career blocked shots. With career totals of 1,049 points, 620 rebounds and 230 career blocks (third all-time in Big South history), Williams joins Liberty's **PETER ALUMA** (1,715 points, 682 rebounds, 366 blocks) and Radford's **TYRONE TRAVIS** (1,313 points, 718 rebounds, 215 blocks) in this elite group. Williams also is one of 26 players in League annals with 1,000 points and 600 rebounds.

NEW KID ON THE BLOCK

VMI freshman **D.J. COVINGTON** has a League-high 40 blocked shots in just 15 games played, but has not yet appeared in the required 75 percent of his team's games to qualify for the Big South and NCAA statistical ranking. Covington has appeared in 71.4 percent (15 of 21) and his 2.67 blocks per game would lead the Big South. He has four games with at least four rejections, including a season-high nine against Southern Virginia on Nov. 23, the highest block total in the Big South since former UNC Asheville center **KENNY GEORGE** swatted away 10 shots against Campbell on Nov. 17, 2007. Meanwhile, Covington is 10 blocks away from becoming just the seventh Big South freshman (true or redshirt) with 50 blocks in a season.

STEADY EDDIE

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH**, who recorded his 200th career win at Asheville with the Bulldogs' 86-57 victory over Montreat College on Dec. 11, is the Big South's all-time winningest coach for overall wins (207) and Big South victories (123). Biedenbach is 236-279 in 17-plus years as a collegiate head coach.

NOTHING MARGINAL ABOUT THIS

Coastal Carolina owns a +16.3 scoring margin this season, which is pacing way ahead of the Big South single-season record of +13.7 set last year by the Chanticleers. Coastal has won 12 of its 20 games by at least 18 points, including seven Big South games. The Chants' +14.3 scoring margin in League contests this season is ahead of last year's average of +12.9.

MR. SAND MAN

Liberty junior guard **JESSE SANDERS** -- the first player in Big South history with 500 career rebounds (520) and 400 career assists (440), is eighth in the nation with 6.6 assists per game and is just one of two players in the nation this season averaging at least 6.0 assists and 6.0 rebounds (6.3 a contest (Texas Southern forward **KEVIN GALLOWAY** is the other). If Sanders can maintain his averages, he would become the first player in Big South history to average 6.0 assists and 6.0 rebounds in the same season.

ALL-TIME SCORERS

UNC Asheville's **MATT DICKEY** became the 103rd player on the Big South's 1,000-point chart when he eclipsed the milestone this past Saturday at VMI, and teammate **J.P. PRIMM** is 15 points away from becoming No. 104 on the list. Meanwhile, Charleston Southern's **JAMARCO WARREN** needs nine points to become the eighth player in Big South history with 1,800 career points. BOARD MEETING

The Big South has three active players with 600 career rebounds, led by Gardner-Webb junior **JOSH HENLEY** with 668 -- good for 26th all-time in Big South history. Henley is 32 rebounds shy of becoming the 21st player with 700. Charleston Southern junior **KELVIN MARTIN** has pulled down 626 rebounds and ranks 32nd in League annals, just ahead of UNC Asheville redshirt-senior **JOHN WILLIAMS**, who is 33rd with 620 career boards. Meanwhile, Winthrop's **CHARLES CORBIN** is 49 caroms away from joining the 600-rebound club.

STAN'S THE MAN

VMI sophomore **STAN OKOYE** is first in the Big South in field goal percentage (53.7) and second in scoring (18.6). If he can re-gain the top scoring spot, he would be the fifth player in League history to lead the Conference in scoring and field goal percentage. The previous individuals were Liberty's **PETER ALUMA** (1995-96), UNC Asheville's **JOSH PITTMAN** (1997-98), High Point's **DANNY GATHINGS** (2002-03) and Radford's **ART PARAKHOUSKI** (2009-10).

SCOREBOARD WATCHING

VMI leads both the Big South and the nation in scoring offense at 91.6 points a game, and is attempting to finish as the country's top scoring offense for an unprecedented fifth-straight year. VMI led the nation in scoring offense in 2009-10 for the fourth consecutive season, becoming the first team in NCAA Division I history to lead the country in scoring offense four consecutive years. The Keydets are also looking to become the first Conference member to lead the Big South in scoring five consecutive years. VMI (2006-present) and Radford (1995-99) are the only programs to lead four-straight seasons.

PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE SCORES BCS DOUBLE

Presbyterian College is the second team in Big South Conference history to defeat an SEC team and ACC team in the same season, as the Blue Hose did it in back-to-back games! PC first knocked off the Auburn Tigers, 62-59, on Dec. 18 and then won at Wake Forest, 66-64 on Dec. 20. Former (and future) member Campbell was the first Big South member to achieve the feat. In 1993-94, the Camels defeated North Carolina State (72-69) and South Carolina (73-72).

HEY YOU!! I KNOW YOU, I KNOW YOU!

Former Big South charter member Campbell University is rejoining the Big South Conference beginning in 2011-12, increasing the League's membership to 11. Campbell enjoyed a successful stint in the Conference, winning the 1992 Big South championship and becoming the League's first NCAA Tournament automatic bid recipient that year. The Camels appeared in a total of four Conference Championship games before departing for the Trans America Athletic Conference (TAAC) following the 1993-94 season.

BIG SOUTH PRESEASON PLAYER OF THE YEAR
Nick Barbour, High Point

R-P-HIGH

Through games of Jan. 30, the Big South Conference was again ranked No. 17 in the RPI by Collegiate Basketball News, the League's highest since finishing the 2006-07 season at No. 19 -- which happens to be the Conference's all-time best. Coastal Carolina was the Big South's highest-rated team in the RPI at No. 79.

BIG SOUTH SEPARATION

Of the first 54 Big South games this season, 30 had winning margins of less than 10 points (=55.6 percent), including 11 that were decided by three points-or-less. However, the first 54 Conference games of the 2010-11 campaign had an average margin of victory of 11.74 points. Last year, the overall margin of victory in League play was 10.51 points, while the 2008-09 average margin was 8.96 points. Meanwhile, in the 24 Big South games decided by double digits this season, the average margin of victory was 19.96 points, while the 30 games decided by less than 10 points had an average victory margin of 5.17 points.

MEANWHILE...

The road teams have the upper hand over their home counterparts when winning in Conference this season, as visiting squads own an average margin of victory of 13.13 points in their 24 Big South wins. The home teams have won their 30 League games by an average margin of just 10.63 points.

MR. TRIPLE-DOUBLE

Liberty junior guard **JESSE SANDERS** notched his Big South-record third career triple-double on Jan. 6 against Charleston Southern, as he finished with 10 points, 10 rebounds and 10 assists against the Buccaneers. All three have come at the Vines Center. As a freshman in 2008-09, Sanders had the exact same output against Presbyterian College on Feb. 9, 2009 for his first career trifecta. Last season as a sophomore, Sanders had 11 points, 10 boards and 10 helpers against Kentucky Christian on Dec. 12, 2009. Sanders owns three of the eight triple-doubles on record in Big South history, including two of the five that have occurred in Conference games.

JUNIOR 15

UNC Asheville juniors **MATT DICKEY** and **J.P. PRIMM** have scored at least 15 points in the same game nine times this season, with the Bulldogs going 6-3 in those games. It should be noted that the losses have been to nationally-ranked North Carolina and Georgetown, as well as a two-point double-over-time loss at USC Upstate. The duo has reached the 15-point threshold in the same game 14 times since arriving on campus in 2008-09, and Asheville is 10-4 in those games.

COMMANDING OFFICER

VMI head coach **DUGGAR BAUCOM** became the school's second-leading winningest coach on Jan. 15 when he recorded his 80th win as the Keydets' leader. Baucum, who is 81-90 in just six seasons at the Institute, trails **BART BELLAIRS**, who won 116 games from 1994-05.

BIG SOUTH OWNS THREE WINS OVER THE SEC, TWO OVER THE ACC

The Big South has enjoyed some monumental non-Conference success this season, as the League owns three wins over the SEC and two over the ACC. UNC Asheville (at Auburn), Coastal Carolina (at LSU) and Presbyterian College (at Auburn) won at SEC venues, giving the Big South Conference three wins against the SEC for the first time since 1993-94. That season, the Conference had wins over LSU and South Carolina (twice). Meanwhile, both Winthrop and Presbyterian College won at Wake Forest, the League's first multi-win season against the ACC since 2007-08. The Big South Conference has recorded wins over members from the Atlantic Coast Conference and the Southeastern Conference in the same season now for the third time in the last four years.

BIG SOUTH TIEBREAKING PROCEDURE

Seeding of teams for the Big South Tournament will be based on Conference win-loss record. The following tiebreaker shall be applied to determine seeding:

TWO-WAY TIES

(a) Records in head-to-head competition are compared with the higher seed going to the team that has won the most games against the other.

(b) In the event step "a" does not resolve the tie (i.e. if the two teams split during the regular season), then the records of the tying teams against the No. 1 seed shall be compared. The team with the better record against the No. 1 seed shall gain the higher seed.

(c) The process outlined in step "b" shall continue through the last place team, if necessary.

(d) In the event that the tie cannot be broken, the seeding shall be determined by a coin toss.

MULTIPLE TIES

(a) Composite records between the tying teams will be evaluated to determine if one team has won more games against the other tying teams.

(b) In the event step "a" does not resolve the multiple ties or reduce the multiple ties to one tie, then a comparison of records of the tying teams against the No. 1 seed will occur. The team among the tying institutions with the better record against the top-seeded team will receive the highest seed.

(c) The procedure outlined in step "b" shall continue through the last place team, if necessary, until the seeding is complete.

(d) In the event this process does not resolve the ties, a coin toss will be the final alternative.

(e) If the multiple ties are reduced to a tie between two teams, the two-way tiebreaker formula will be utilized.

Charleston Southern completed the season sweep of Radford last week, its first sweep of the Highlanders since 1995-96. It was the Buccaneers' first win at Radford since 2004-05 ... Thursday's win at Radford was CSU's first victory this season in which the Bucs trailed in the final minute of regulation ... Each of Charleston Southern's last three games at the Dedmon Center have gone into overtime ... **KELVIN MARTIN** sent last Thursday's game into overtime with a three-pointer and a pair of free throws in the last 33 seconds of regulation ... Two of CSU's Conference losses this season have been by just two points and decided in the final seconds.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina's 82-58 win at High Point last Thursday was its third-straight game holding an opponent to fewer than 60 points. **SAM McLAURIN** poured in 13 points and 10 rebounds for his second double-double of the season, while **ANTHONY RAFFA** added 10 points and two steals ... In Saturday's 86-63 win at Radford, Raffa added 17 points and seven rebounds, **KIERRE GREENWOOD** tied his career-high with nine assists ... Coastal Carolina hosts second-place Liberty Thursday night.

GARDNER-WEBB

Despite dropping three of its last four games, Gardner-Webb has been solid on the defensive end of the floor overall. The Runnin' Bulldogs have held four consecutive opponents under their season scoring average ... **KEITH MANLEY** came off the bench at Liberty to post career-high totals in scoring (9) and rebounding (10) ... **JOSH HENLEY** scored eight of Gardner-Webb's first 10 points at LU ... GWU returns home for a pair of games this week, where the Runnin' Bulldogs are 3-3 on the season.

HIGH POINT

High Point came back from a 17-point deficit to beat Charleston Southern, 77-75, on Saturday. The most HPU had trailed in any other win this season was seven in a 76-73 win over UNC Asheville on Dec. 4. It was HPU's largest comeback for a win since the Panthers came back from a 21-point deficit in the first half of a 90-64 win over UNC Asheville on Jan. 13, 2007 ... High Point carries a three-game winning streak vs. Presbyterian into Tuesday's match-up. That includes a win on a last-second layup as well as an overtime win ... **NICK BARBOUR** scored 21 points in the second half against CSU on Saturday, the third time in his last six games he scored over 20 points in the second half. He hit four 3-pointers in the game, the fourth time he has hit at least four this season.

LIBERTY

Liberty is currently on its longest win streak of the season at five ... While the Flames have played four overtime contests this season, last Thursday's 83-81 win over UNC Asheville marked the first overtime game in the Vines Center since Jan. 24, 2009 ... The last time a Liberty squad had four players finish the season with double-digits in scoring was the 2006-07 season ... With his 20-point performance against UNC Asheville last Thursday, Sanders surpassed 700 career points. He is currently 30th on Liberty's all-time scoring with 719 tallies. **EVAN GORDON** also surpassed the 700-point milestone with his 16-point effort against Gardner-Webb on Saturday. He now has 703 points for his career at Liberty.

PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE
