Gordon averaged 18.0 points, 3.5 rebounds and 3.5 steals in two wins last week, helping Liberty clinch a Top 2 seed in the 2011 Advance Auto Parts Big South Men's Basketball Championship. He opened his week with 20 points and five steals in the Flames' victory over Radford, in addition to going 7-of-13 from the field and 4-of-8 from three-point range. Gordon then scored 16 points and had four rebounds and two steals in Liberty's win against High Point, guaranteeing the Flames a top two finish in the Conference standings as well as securing a program-record 13th Big South win of the season.

Covington averaged 15.5 points, 7.5 rebounds and went 12-of-22 from the field ( =54.5 percent) and 7-of-10 from the free throw line ( =70.0) to lead VMI to two Big South victories last week. He scored a career-high 20 points, grabbed eight rebounds and blocked two shots in the Keydets' victory over High Point. Covington followed that effort with 11 points and seven boards in VMI's win against Radford, in which he scored eight points -- including six-straight -- in a 16-2 run he started in the second half that eventually put away the Highlanders.

**COASTAL CAROLINA TAKES OVER NATION'S LONGEST WINNING STREAK**

Coastal Carolina has won 22 consecutive games, the longest win streak in Big South Conference history and currently the longest in the country. The Chanticleers took over the national lead after Ohio State's 24-game streak ended this past Saturday afternoon. Coastal has also won 19 consecutive regular-season Big South games, dating back to last season, which is the second-longest Conference-game win streak in League annals. Winthrop owns the top spot with 21 consecutive Big South wins from Jan. 8, 2005 to Jan. 21, 2006.

**CHANTICLEERS NETS TWO LEAGUE RECORDS FOR CONFERENCE WINS**

Coastal Carolina is first team in League history to stand 15-0 in Big South play, breaking the Conference record for best League start that was established by the 2006-07 Winthrop Eagles (14-0). That season, Winthrop swept through a 14-game Conference slate. Meanwhile, the Chanticleers have also tied the Big South record for most Conference wins in a season, which is 15 and accomplished four previous times. Former member Towson State was the first in 1993-94, followed by Winthrop (2004-05), Radford (2008-09) and Coastal Carolina in 2009-10. Coastal has three chances to win a record 16th Big South game.

**COASTAL ON VERGE OF NO. 1 SEED, REGULAR-SEASON TITLE**

Coastal Carolina enters the second-to-last week of the regular-season needing one Conference victory to secure the No. 1 seed in the Advance Auto Parts Men's Basketball Championship. With three Conference games remaining, the Chanticleers (15-0) and Liberty (13-2) are the only teams still in contention to win the regular-season crown. Both squads have secured home seeds, and the Chants can claim at least a share of the regular-season title with a victory Tuesday night against Gardner-Webb. Should Coastal and Liberty tie for the regular-season championship, Coastal would receive the No. 1 seed based on its season sweep of the Flames.

**BIG SOUTH ON NATIONAL STAGE THIS WEEKEND WITH SEARS BRACKETBUSTERS**

The Big South's nine Sears BracketBusters match-ups this Saturday features the League's fourth appearance on national television during the series, as Liberty will host MAAC member Iona Saturday at 3:00pm on ESPNU. The Big South is 1-2 in its televised appearances in the event. The Big South is 7-8 all-time in the series and has the third-most Conference members participating of the 13 Leagues involved this season.

**LIBERTY BELL**

Liberty has won a school-record 13 Big South games this season, surpassing the previous best of 12 set three times (1993-94, 2003-04 and 2008-09). The Flames are one victory away from their second 20-win season in three years and fourth overall since joining the Big South Conference in 1991-92.

**SEASON SWEEPS**

With 29 Conference series in the books already, 20 have resulted in season sweeps (69.0 percent). Coastal Carolina leads the way with six, followed by Liberty (5) and VMI (3). Last season, 28 of the 45 season series resulted in sweeps (62.2), while 2008-09 had 26 (57.8 percent).

**TWO TO TANGO**

The Big South could have two teams with 20 wins prior to the Conference Tournament for the third time in five seasons, as Liberty (19 wins) could join Coastal Carolina (24) in the 20-win column before the postseason begins March 1. It would be the fourth time overall -- with the first occurrence in 1990-91 (Coastal Carolina, Radford), followed by the 2006-07 (Winthrop, High Point) and 2008-09 (VMI, Liberty) seasons.

**BOARD MEETING**

Winthrop's **CHARLES CORBIN** is six rebounds away from becoming the fourth Big South player this season and 35th overall to grab 600 in a career. Corbin is set to become the first Eagle (and seventh overall) to join the 600-rebound club since **TYRONE WALKER** in 2003-04. The Big South's active 600-rebounders are Gardner-Webb junior **JOSH HENLEY** (682 - T-22nd), Charleston Southern junior **KELVIN MARTIN** (646 - 29th) and UNC Asheville redshirt-senior **JOHN WILLIAMS** (628 - 32nd). Henley is 18 rebounds shy of becoming the 21st player in Big South history with 700.

**CONFERENCE TOURNAMENT APPROACHING**

The 2011 Advance Auto Parts Big South Men's Basketball Championship Tournament will commence on Tuesday, March 1 at the home sites of the top four seeds.

The top eight of the nine postseason eligible teams will earn a berth in this year's Championship, with the No. 1 seed having a chance to host throughout the Tournament.

For the sixth consecutive season, the Semifinals will be contested at the site of the No. 1 seed and will be broadcast live on ESPNU on Thursday, March 3. The highest remaining seed will host the Championship game on its home floor Saturday, March 5 at 4:00pm live on ESPN2.

**GRAND STRAND**

Coastal Carolina is 52-9 the past two seasons, tying the Big South record for most wins in back-to-back years. Winthrop first set the all-time mark of 52 combined wins from 2005-07. The Eagles won 23 games in 2005-06 and followed with a League-record 29 victories in 2006-07. The Chanticleers are one of just four different Big South programs to win 20 games in back-to-back seasons, and need one more victory to become the first Conference member to win 25 games in consecutive campaigns. Meanwhile, Coastal's 24 wins are already tied for fourth-most in a single-season in Big South history, and the Chants need two victories to tie its Conference mark for most wins before the Conference Tournament (26).

**COASTAL CAROLINA ON CUSP OF NATIONAL TOP 25 RANKINGS**

Coastal Carolina remains on the verge of cracking the national Top 25 rankings, as the Chanticleers continue to receive strong consideration in both the *Associated Press* ranking and the *ESPN/USA Today* Coaches poll. This week, Coastal Carolina is No. 27 in the Coaches poll and tied with UCLA for 28th in the AP poll. **LENDING A HELPING HAND**

Liberty junior guard **JESSE SANDERS** is 13th all-time in Big South history with 458 career assists, and needs 11 to reach the 12th position (Winthrop's **TYSON WATERMAN**, 469). UNC Asheville junior guard **J.P. PRIMM** is 16th in League annals with 424 career assists and needs six to move into the 15th spot (UNC Asheville's **JOSH KOHN**, 430).

**ROADIES**

Coastal Carolina has won a school-record nine-straight Big South road games, dating back to last season and bettering its old mark of eight. In addition, the Chanticleers are the first team in League history to win five Big South road games by at least 20 points -- bettering Asheville's record of three that was established earlier this season. Coastal won by 22 at VMI (Jan. 6), 21 at UNC Asheville (Jan. 20), 24 at High Point (Jan. 27), 23 at Radford (Jan. 29) and 20 at Presbyterian (Feb. 10). If the Chanticleers can win their final Conference road game of the season -- Feb. 26 at Charleston Southern -- they would be just the second team in League history to go 9-0 in Big South road contests. Radford was the first in 2008-09.

**HOMEWARD BOUND**

Since the second half of the Conference season began Jan. 27, the home teams have won 19 of the 29 contests played (=65.5 percent), an improvement over their 25-20 record (=55.6) in the first half of the League season. Overall, the road teams are still above 40 percent in the win column (30-44, 40.5), and would mark the third time in the last five seasons that road teams won at least 40 percent of the Conference games. Here is a look at each team's home and road record in Big South games, in current standings order:

**McSWATTY**

Coastal Carolina redshirt-sophomore **SAM McLAURIN** became the 26th player in Big South history with 100 career blocked shots when he reached the milestone Feb. 10 at Presbyterian College. McLaurin is now the third Chanticleer in Conference annals to reach the century mark in rejections, and is tied for 25th all-time with 104 blocks.

**NEW KID ON THE BLOCK**

VMI freshman **D.J. COVINGTON** has finally appeared in at least 75 percent of the Keydets' contests, meaning he is officially leading the Big South in blocked shots per game with 2.37 -- good for 26th in the nation. Covington, who is tied for the League-lead with 45 blocks, needs five more blocked shots to become just the seventh Big South freshman (true or redshirt) with 50 blocks in a season.

**THREE (BULL)DOG NIGHT**

UNC Asheville's **JOHN WILLIAMS** (1,071), **MATT DICKEY** (1,057) and **J.P. PRIMM** (1,026) scored their 1,000th career point in 2010-11, marking the third time in Conference history that a Big South team had three players reach the scoring milestone in the same season. Coastal Carolina was the first in 1990-91 (**BRIAN PENNY**, **ROBERT DOWDELL**, **DuWAYNE CHEATAM**) and Radford was the last in 2001-02 (**RAYMOND ARRINGTON**, **ANDREY SAVTCHENKO**, **CORREY WATKINS**).

**ANOTHER BROWN LEADING LIBERTY**

Liberty newcomer and redshirt-junior **JOHN BROWN** continues to lead the Big South with 10.6 rebounds a game. If he can maintain his position, he would be the first Liberty player to lead the Conference in rebounding since **LEO LIGHTBOURNE** in 2004-05. Brown could also become the first newcomer to finish as the Big South's top rebounder since High Point's **DANNY GATHINGS** in 2002-03.

**3-BALL**

Charleston Southern's **JAMARCO WARREN** and VMI's **AUSTIN KENON** entered the Big South's 300-career three-point club on Jan. 15, becoming the fifth and sixth players, respectively, to reach the plateau (Warren hit the milestone first due to the Buccaneers' earlier tip time that day). Both players are now among the Conference's all-time top four, and are also their respective schools' all-time leader. Kenon, who has made a three-pointer in 94 of his 99 career games for a 3.26 per game average (fourth-highest per game clip in League history), is the second Keydet on the Big South's 300-career three-point list. **WARREN ALSO MEMBER OF 300 3-POINTER/300 ASSIST CLUBS**

Charleston Southern senior **JAMARCO WARREN** is one of four players in Big South history with 300 career three-point field goals and 300 career assists. Warren (323 3FG, 321 AST), Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** (411 3FG, 353 AST), UNC Greensboro's **SCOTT HARTZELL** (309 3FG, 552 AST) and VMI's **CHAVIS HOLMES** (306 3FG, 313 AST) comprise the club.

**STEADY EDDIE**

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH**, who recorded his 200th career win at Asheville with the Bulldogs' 86-57 victory over Montreat College on Dec. 11, is the Big South's all-time winningest coach for overall wins (209) and Big South victories (125). Biedenbach is 238-280 in 17-plus years as a collegiate head coach.

**NOTHING MARGINAL ABOUT THIS**

Coastal Carolina owns a +15.5 scoring margin this season, which is pacing way ahead of the Big South single-season record of +13.7 set last year by the Chanticleers. Coastal has won 13 of its 24 games by at least 18 points, including eight Big South games. The Chants' +13.4 scoring margin in League contests this season is ahead of last year's average of +12.9.

**MR. SAND MAN**

Liberty junior guard **JESSE SANDERS** -- the only player in Big South history with 500 career rebounds (545) and 400 career assists (458), is 11th in the nation with 6.3 assists per game and is just one of two players in the nation this season averaging at least 6.0 assists and 6.0 rebounds (6.3) a contest (Texas Southern forward **KEVIN GALLOWAY** is the other). If Sanders can maintain his averages, he would become the first player in Big South history to average 6.0 assists and 6.0 rebounds in the same season.

### JUNIOR 15

UNC Asheville juniors **MATT DICKEY** and **J.P. PRIMM** have scored at least 15 points in the same game 10 times this season, with the Bulldogs going 7-3 in those games. It should be noted that the losses have been to nationally-ranked North Carolina and Georgetown, as well as a two-point double-overtime loss at USC Upstate. The duo has reached the 15-point threshold in the same game 15 times since arriving on campus in 2008-09, and Asheville is 11-4 in those games.

### JOHN WILLIAMS' BUILDING BLOCKS

UNC Asheville redshirt-senior **JOHN WILLIAMS** is just the third player in Big South history with 1,000 career points, 600 career rebounds and 200 career blocked shots. With career totals of 1,071 points, 628 rebounds and 233 career blocks (third all-time in Big South history), Williams joins Liberty's **PETER ALUMA** (1,715 points, 682 rebounds, 366 blocks) and Radford's **TYRONE TRAVIS** (1,313 points, 718 rebounds, 215 blocks) in this elite group. Williams also is one of 26 players in League annals with 1,000 points and 600 rebounds.

### SCOREBOARD WATCHING

VMI leads both the Big South and the nation in scoring offense at 90.3 points a game, and is attempting to finish as the country's top scoring offense for an unprecedented fifth-straight year. VMI led the nation in scoring offense in 2009-10 for the fourth consecutive season, becoming the first team in NCAA Division I history to lead the country in scoring offense four consecutive years. The Keydets are also looking to become the first Conference member to lead the Big South in scoring five consecutive years. VMI (2006-present) and Radford (1995-99) are the only programs to lead four-straight seasons.

#### BIG SOUTH PRESEASON PLAYER OF THE YEAR Nick Barbour, High Point

**R-P-HIGH**

Through games of Feb. 13, the Big South Conference was again ranked No. 17 in the RPI by Collegiate Basketball News, the League's highest since finishing the 2006-07 season at No. 19 -- which happens to be the Conference's all-time best. Coastal Carolina is currently the Big South's highest-rated team in the RPI this week at No. 56.

**BIG SOUTH SEPARATION**

Of the 74 Big South games this season, 42 had winning margins of less than 10 points (=56.8 percent), including 17 that were decided by three points-or-less. However, the Conference season currently has an average margin of victory of 10.93 points. Last year, the overall margin of victory in League play was 10.51 points, while the 2008-09 average margin was 8.96 points. Meanwhile, in the 32 Big South games decided by double digits this season, the average margin of victory was 18.94 points, while the 42 games decided by less than 10 points had an average victory margin of 4.83 points.

**MEANWHILE...**

The road teams still have the upper hand over their home counterparts when winning in Conference this season, as visiting squads own an average margin of victory of 11.70 points in their 30 Big South wins. The home teams have won their 44 League games by an average margin of 10.41 points.

**ELLIS NOTCHES 11TH CAREER 20-WIN SEASON IN DIVISION I**

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** has recorded his 11th career 20-win season at the Division I level, and 14th overall. The 10th active coach and 26th overall to win 600 career Division I games, Ellis has directed four different Division I programs to at least two 20-win campaigns during his tenure, and owns five seasons with at least 25 wins. Ellis is 610-381 at the Division I level and 688-393 overall in 35 years as a head coach, including 76-44 (=63.3 percent) in four seasons at Coastal Carolina. He has been named Coach of the Year in four difference Conferences (Sun Belt, ACC, SEC, Big South) as well.

**PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE SCORES BCS DOUBLE**

Presbyterian College is the second team in Big South Conference history to defeat an SEC team and ACC team in the same season, as the Blue Hose did it in back-to-back games! PC first knocked off the Auburn Tigers, 62-59, on Dec. 18 and then won at Wake Forest, 66-64 on Dec. 20. Former (and future) member Campbell was the first Big South member to achieve the feat. In 1993-94, the Camels defeated North Carolina State (72-69) and South Carolina (73-72).

**BIG SOUTH OWNS THREE WINS OVER THE SEC, TWO OVER THE ACC**

The Big South has enjoyed some monumental non-Conference success this season, as the League owns three wins over the SEC and two over the ACC. UNC Asheville (at Auburn), Coastal Carolina (at LSU) and Presbyterian College (at Auburn) won at SEC venues, giving the Big South Conference three wins against the SEC for the first time since 1993-94. That season, the Conference had wins over LSU and South Carolina (twice). Meanwhile, both Winthrop and Presbyterian College won at Wake Forest, the League's first multi-win season against the ACC since 2007-08. The Big South Conference has recorded wins over members from the Atlantic Coast Conference and the Southeastern Conference in the same season now for the third time in the last four years.

**HEY YOU!! I KNOW YOU, I KNOW YOU!**

Former Big South charter member Campbell University is rejoining the Big South Conference beginning in 2011-12, increasing the League's membership to 11. Campbell enjoyed a successful stint in the Conference, winning the 1992 Big South championship and becoming the League's first NCAA Tournament automatic bid recipient that year. The Camels appeared in a total of four Conference Championship games before departing for the Trans America Athletic Conference (TAAC) following the 1993-94 season.

**BIG SOUTH TIEBREAKING PROCEDURE**

Seeding of teams for the Big South Tournament will be based on Conference win-loss record. The following tiebreaker shall be applied to determine seeding:

**TWO-WAY TIES**

(a) Records in head-to-head competition are compared with the higher seed going to the team that has won the most games against the other.

(b) In the event step "a" does not resolve the tie (i.e. if the two teams split during the regular season), then the records of the tying teams against the No. 1 seed shall be compared. The team with the better record against the No. 1 seed shall gain the higher seed.

(c) The process outlined in step "b" shall continue through the last place team, if necessary.

(d) In the event that the tie cannot be broken, the seeding shall be determined by a coin toss.

**MULTIPLE TIES**

(a) Composite records between the tying teams will be evaluated to determine if one team has won more games against the other tying teams.

(b) In the event step "a" does not resolve the multiple ties or reduce the multiple ties to one tie, then a comparison of records of the tying teams against the No. 1 seed will occur. The team among the tying institutions with the better record against the top-seeded team will receive the highest seed.

(c) The procedure outlined in step "b" shall continue through the last place team, if necessary, until the seeding is complete.

(d) In the event this process does not resolve the ties, a coin toss will be the final alternative.

(e) If the multiple ties are reduced to a tie between two teams, the two-way tiebreaker formula will be utilized.

**POSITIONING FOR TOURNAMENT**

**CHARLESTON SOUTHERN**

Charleston Southern's winless streak reached three games following a pair of road setbacks to close out the away portion of the Conference schedule ... **JOHATHAN BROOKS** posted his fourth double-double of the season with a career-high 16 points and 12 rebounds at Winthrop. He then tied his career high with 14 rebounds at Presbyterian ... **JAMARCO WARREN** is currently tied with **BEN HINSON** (1983-87) for most career games played and most consecutive contests in a CSU uniform with 116 ... The Bucs host Asheville Tuesday night in the first of three remaining Conference tilts, which are all at the CSU Field House where the Bucs are 10-1 this season.

**COASTAL CAROLINA**

**DESMOND HOLLOWAY** registered his fourth double-double of the season with 23 points and 14 rebounds in the Chants' 61-41 win at Presbyterian College. Holloway also hit a career-high five three-pointers against the Blue Hose last Thursday ... On Saturday, the Chants used a strong second half to erase an 11-point deficit en route to a 61-56 win at Winthrop. **ANTHONY RAFFA** scored a career-high with 23 points, which included the final nine points for the Chants. Raffa hit 9-of-10 free-throw attempts, including 7-of-8 in the final 1:32. Holloway failed to score in double figures for the first time this season as he finished with nine points against the Eagles.

**GARDNER-WEBB**

Gardner-Webb has held six consecutive opponents under their season scoring average ... GWU's last three home losses have all come by three points (vs. Coastal Carolina, vs. Winthrop, and vs. UNC Asheville) ... The Runnin' Bulldogs are 1-1 in Conway, S.C., since joining the Big South Conference ... Coastal Carolina has won three in a row over GWU in the series.

**HIGH POINT**

High Point had two scorers with 20 points in the same game for the first time this season last Thursday at VMI. **NICK BARBOUR** scored 25 points and **SHAY SHINE** scored 22. The last time HPU had two 20-point scorers in the same game was when Barbour scored 30 and **EUGENE HARRIS** scored 22 in an overtime win at Gardner-Webb on Jan. 30, 2010 ... Shine went 10-for-10 from the free throw line against North Carolina Central, an HPU record for free throw shooting percentage in the Division I era ... Barbour has hit at least five three-pointers four times this season and 10 times in his career. Last week, he hit five against N.C. Central and six against VMI ... HPU's last three games have arguably been decided by rebounding. In the win over N.C. Central, HPU led the rebounding, 39-22. In losses at VMI and Liberty, High Point trailed in rebounds, 47-30 and 42-26, respectively.

**LIBERTY**

**EVAN GORDON** needs 18 points to reach 800 for his collegiate career ... With his 11-point, 13-rebound performance against Radford last Thursday, **JOHN BROWN** recorded his 13th double-double of this season. The most double-doubles posted in a single season by a Liberty player is 15 -- accomplished by **MIKE COLEMAN** (1990) and most recently **ALEX MCLEAN** ... Gordon and Brown each have 48 steals on the season, and both players could be the first Flames to reach the 50-steal mark since 2003-04 ... The Flames extended their Vines Center win streak over High Point to nine games this past Saturday, their longest against a Conference opponent.

**PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE**

PC snapped a four-game losing streak with a 61-48 victory over Charleston Southern Saturday. The Blue Hose used a 17-9 run early in the second half to extend their lead to as many as 11 points, and closed the game with a 13-6 run down the stretch to hold off the Bucs. PC was led by **PIERRE MILLER**'s 14 points while **KHALID MUTAKABIR** added 13. The crowd of 2,068 was the second-highest attendance total at the Templeton Center since the school's move to Division I ... Against Coastal Carolina, **WALT ALLEN** hit three consecutive three-pointers at the start of the second half to help bring PC from 20 down to within 10 points. Allen led the team with 15 points while Miller added nine points and a team-high nine rebounds.

**RADFORD**

Radford has used 15 different starting lineups this season, which is tops in the nation ... **JAREAL SMITH** is averaging 18.5 points and shooting 42.9 percent from behind the arc in his last four contests ... **BLAKE SMITH** continues to lead the Big South in steals per game with 2.61. The last Highlander to lead the Big South in steals was **ANTHONY WALKER** in 1995-96.

**UNC ASHEVILLE**

UNC Asheville's 57-54 win at Gardner-Webb this past Saturday improved the Bulldogs to 5-2 in road Conference games ... Saturday's game with Northeastern in the Sears BracketBusters starts a stretch for the Bulldogs where they will play four games over a seven-day period to close out the regular-season.

**VMI**

After dropping their first four home Conference games, the Keydets have posted wins in three of their last four home League tilts and moved to 9-5 at home overall ... In the two wins last week, VMI extended its win streak against High Point to six games and won its first home game against Radford since the 2006-07 season ... VMI is 8-0 in games where it has out-rebounded its foes ... Micheal Sparks averaged 12.5 points in the two wins last week and shot 58.3% (7-of-12) from 3-point range ... The Cameron Hall crowd of 3,510 for the Keydets-Radford game Saturday was VMI's largest of the season.

**WINTHROP**

Winthrop had its longest winning streak of the year snapped at three this past Saturday as Coastal Carolina recorded a come-from-behind win. Winthrop also suffered a rare loss when leading at the half. Over the last two seasons, Winthrop is 24-3 when leading at intermission ... Against Charleston Southern last Thursday, Winthrop equaled its lowest turnover total this year with just eight ... **REGGIE MIDDLETON** is two assists shy of 250 for his career. He now ranks 13th on the Winthrop career assist list.
