COASTAL CAROLINA CLINCHES NO. 1 SEED, SHARE OF REGULAR-SEASON TITLE

For the second consecutive season, Coastal Carolina has clinched the No. 1 seed in the Advance Auto Parts Men's Basketball Championship, in addition to at least a share of the 2010-11 regular-season title. Coastal is the first back-to-back No. 1 seed since Winthrop in 2005-06 and 2006-07, and needs one more Conference win or a Liberty loss to claim the outright regular-season championship. Despite the possibility that Coastal Carolina and Liberty could tie at 15-3 in the League standings, the Chanticleers already own the first tiebreaker of head-to-head with their season sweep of the Flames and therefore receive the No. 1 seed. Liberty gets the No. 2 seed.

FIVE TEAMS STILL ALIVE FOR FINAL TWO HOME SEEDS

With seeds Nos. 1 and 2 already determined, five teams are battling for the final two home seeds in the 2011 Advance Auto Parts Men's Basketball Championship -- UNC Asheville, Charleston Southern, Winthrop, VMI and High Point. Asheville is looking for its fourth consecutive Top 4 seed -- which would be the longest active streak in the Big South. High Point can finish anywhere from Nos. 3-8 -- just one of the many scenarios that are dependent on this week's results. Meanwhile, Gardner-Webb will be either a No. 7 or No. 8 seed, depending on the outcome of this week's contests.

DO THE CHARLESTON

Charleston Southern has won 15 games in a season for the first time since 1996-97 (17 wins), which was also the last time the Buccaneers won the Big South Conference Tournament. CSU has a chance to win at least nine Big South games this season for the first time since going 9-5 in League play in 1995-96. Charleston Southern will play its final two Conference games of the season this week at home where the Bucs are 11-2. In addition, the Buccaneers are seeking their first Top 4 seed since the 2003 postseason (No. 3 seed).

TV TIME

The Big South Conference "Royal Purple Game of the Week" television package concludes this week with two broadcasts. Tuesday's UNC Asheville-Coastal Carolina game will air live on ESPN3.com at 7:00pm. The package ends Saturday with VMI at Winthrop airing on MASN, also at 7:00pm. **MATT HOGUE** (play-by-play) and **NATE ROSS** (analyst) will call the action from Kimbel Arena on Tuesday, while Ross and **MARK BRYANT** will handle the call on Saturday from the Winthrop Coliseum.

GRAND STRAND

Coastal Carolina is 53-10 the past two seasons, establishing the Big South record for most wins in back-to-back years. Winthrop set the previous all-time mark of 52 combined wins from 2005-07. The Eagles won 23 games in 2005-06 and followed with a League-record 29 victories in 2006-07. The Chanticleers are the first team in Big South history to win 25 games in consecutive campaigns, and their 25 wins this season are fourth-most in a single-season in Big South history. Coastal Carolina needs one victory to tie its League mark for most wins before the Conference Tournament (26).

TWO TO TANGO

The Big South could have two teams with 20 wins prior to the Conference Tournament for the third time in five seasons, as Liberty (19 wins) could join Coastal Carolina (25) in the 20-win column before the postseason begins March 1. It would be the fourth time overall -- with the first occurrence in 1990-91 (Coastal Carolina, Radford), followed by the 2006-07 (Winthrop, High Point) and 2008-09 (VMI, Liberty) seasons.

COASTAL CAROLINA'S NATION-LEADING WINNING STREAK ENDS

Coastal Carolina's Big South- and school-record 22-game win streak ended Feb. 15 with a 59-57 home loss to Gardner-Webb, which was the longest win streak in the nation at the time. Also ending was Coastal's 19 consecutive regular-season Big South win streak, which was the second-longest Conference-game win streak in League annals. Winthrop still holds the top spot with 21 consecutive Big South wins from Jan. 8, 2005 to Jan. 21, 2006.

CONFERENCE TOURNAMENT APPROACHING

The 2011 Advance Auto Parts Big South Men's Basketball Championship Tournament will commence on Tuesday, March 1 at the home sites of the top four seeds.

The top eight of the nine postseason eligible teams will earn a berth in this year's Championship, with the No. 1 seed having a chance to host throughout the Tournament.

For the sixth consecutive season, the Semifinals will be contested at the site of the No. 1 seed and will be broadcast live on ESPNU on Thursday, March 3. The highest remaining seed will host the Championship game on its home floor Saturday, March 5 at 4:00pm live on ESPN2.

NO. 5 TO BECOME NUMBER 7

Charleston Southern senior guard **JAMARCO WARREN** is two points away from becoming the 7th player in Big South history to score 1,900 career points. Warren will likely end his career as the Big South's seventh all-time leading scorer in the record books, as Radford's **DOUG DAY** holds the sixth position with 2,027 career markers.

BOARD MEETING

Winthrop's **CHARLES CORBIN** became the fourth Big South player this season and 35th overall to grab 600 in a career when he surpassed the milestone Feb. 15 at High Point. Corbin is the first Eagle (and seventh overall) to join the 600-rebound club since **TYRONE WALKER** in 2003-04. The Big South's active 600-rebounders are Gardner-Webb junior **JOSH HENLEY** (692 - T-21st), Charleston Southern junior **KELVIN MARTIN** (659 - 29th), UNC Asheville redshirt-senior **JOHN WILLIAMS** (637 - T-30th), and now Corbin (616 - 34th). Henley is eight rebounds shy of becoming the 21st player in Big South history with 700.

NEW KID ON THE BLOCK

VMI freshman **D.J. COVINGTON** has blocked a League-high 53 shots this season, becoming the seventh Big South freshman (true or redshirt) in League history with 50 blocks in a season. He leads the Conference with a 2.52 per game average -- good for 19th in the nation. Covington's 53 rejections are the most by a Big South frosh since High Point's **CRUZ DANIELS** swatted away 65 during his redshirt-freshman season of 2006-07.

HOMeward BOUND

Since the second half of the Conference season began Jan. 27, the home teams have won 22 of the 34 contests played (=64.7 percent), an improvement over their 25-20 record (=55.6) in the first half of the League season. Overall, the road teams are still above 40 percent in the win column (32-47, =40.5), and would mark the third time in the last five seasons that road teams won at least 40 percent of the Conference games. TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

Gardner-Webb has lost a League-high nine games by eight points-or-less, including seven decided by three points-or-less. Six of the nine games have been Big South contests, and in those six Conference games, the Runnin' Bulldogs average margin of defeat is 3.50. Meanwhile, High Point has won each of its seven Big South games by seven points-or-less and 21 points total (3.00 average). Winthrop's last eight games have been decided by seven points-or-less (3.3 average), and the Eagles are 3-5 in that span.

SEASON SWEEPS

With 34 Conference series in the books already, 21 have resulted in season sweeps (=61.8 percent). Coastal Carolina leads the way with six, followed by Liberty (5) and VMI (3). Last season, 28 of the 45 season series resulted in sweeps (=62.2), while 2008-09 had 26 (57.8 percent).

CHANTICLEERS OWNS TWO LEAGUE RECORDS FOR CONFERENCE WINS

Coastal Carolina is first team in League history to start 15-0 in Big South play, breaking the Conference record for best League start that was established by the 2006-07 Winthrop Eagles (14-0). That season, Winthrop swept through a 14-game Conference slate. Meanwhile, the Chanticleers have also tied the Big South record for most Conference wins in a season, which is 15 and accomplished four previous times. Former member Towson State was the first in 1993-94, followed by Winthrop (2004-05), Radford (2008-09) and Coastal Carolina in 2009-10. Coastal has two chances to win a record 16th Big South game.

LIBERTY BELL

Liberty has won a school-record 13 Big South games this season, surpassing the previous best of 12 set three times (1993-94, 2003-04 and 2008-09). The Flames are one victory away from their second 20-win season in three years and fourth overall since joining the Big South Conference in 1991-92.

ROADIES

Coastal Carolina has won a school-record nine-straight Big South road games, dating back to last season and bettering its old mark of eight. In addition, the Chanticleers are the first team in League history to win five Big South road games by at least 20 points -- bettering Asheville's record of three that was established earlier this season. Coastal won by 22 at VMI (Jan. 6), 21 at UNC Asheville (Jan. 20), 24 at High Point (Jan. 27), 23 at Radford (Jan. 29) and 20 at Presbyterian (Feb. 10). If the Chanticleers can win their final Conference road game of the season -- this Saturday at Charleston Southern -- they would be just the second team in League history to go 9-0 in Big South road contests. Radford was the first in 2008-09.

McSWATTY

Coastal Carolina redshirt-sophomore **SAM McLaurin**, who became the 26th player in Big South history with 100 career blocked shots when he reached the milestone Feb. 10 at Presbyterian College, is 24th in League history with 107 in his career. He needs three to move into 23rd place. McLaurin is the third Chanticleer in Conference annals to reach the century mark in rejections.

LENDING A HELPING HAND

Liberty junior guard **JESSE SANDERS** is 13th all-time in Big South history with 464 career assists, and needs five to reach the 12th position (Winthrop's **TYSON WATERMAN**, 469). UNC Asheville junior guard **J.P. PRIMM** is 15th in League annals with 432 career assists and needs 15 to move into the 14th spot (Liberty's **MATT HILDEBRAND**, 447).

THREE (BULL)DOG NIGHT

UNC Asheville's **JOHN WILLIAMS** (1,092), **MATT DICKEY** (1,088) and **J.P. PRIMM** (1,062) scored their 1,000th career point in 2010-11, marking the third time in Conference history that a Big South team had three players reach the scoring milestone in the same season. Coastal Carolina was the first in 1990-91 (**BRIAN PENNY**, **ROBERT DOWDELL**, **DuWAYNE CHEATAM**) and Radford was the last in 2001-02 (**RAYMOND ARRINGTON**, **ANDREY SAVTCHENKO**, **CORREY WATKINS**).

ANOTHER BROWN LEADING LIBERTY

Liberty newcomer and redshirt-junior **JOHN BROWN** continues to lead the Big South with 10.8 rebounds a game. If he can maintain his position, he would be the first Liberty player to lead the Conference in rebounding since **LEO LIGHTBOURNE** in 2004-05. Brown could also become the first newcomer to finish as the Big South's top rebounder since High Point's **DANNY GATHINGS** in 2002-03. Meanwhile, Brown has grabbed at least 10 boards in 13 of his last 15 games.

3-BALL

Charleston Southern's **JAMARCO WARREN** and VMI's **AUSTIN KENON** entered the Big South's 300-career three-point club on Jan. 15, becoming the fifth and sixth players, respectively, to reach the plateau (Warren hit the milestone first due to the Buccaneers' earlier tip time that day). Both players are now among the Conference's all-time top four, and are also their respective schools' all-time leader. Kenon, who has made a three-pointer in 96 of his 101 career games for a 3.31 per game average (fourth-highest per game clip in League history), is the second Keydet on the Big South's 300-career three-point list. Charleston Southern senior **JAMARCO WARREN** is one of two players in Big South history with 300 career three-point field goals (326), 300 career assists (328) and 150 career steals (150). He joins VMI's **CHAVIS HOLMES** (306 3FG, 313 AST and 304 STL) in the club. Warren is one of four players all-time with 300 career treys and 300 career helpers, as Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** (411 3FG, 353 AST), and UNC Greensboro's **SCOTT HARTZELL** (309 3FG, 552 AST) also reached those totals.

STEADY EDDIE

UNC Asheville head coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH**, who recorded his 200th career win at Asheville with the Bulldogs' 86-57 victory over Montreat College on Dec. 11, is the Big South's all-time winningest coach for overall wins (209) and Big South victories (125). Biedenbach is 238-282 in 17-plus years as a collegiate head coach.

ALL ABOUT THE NUMBER 10

UNC Asheville needs to win two of its final three Conference games this week to record its fourth consecutive season with at least 10 Big South wins. If the Bulldogs can get to double-digit victories in Conference play, they would become just the second Big South team to accomplish this feat in four consecutive years. Winthrop holds the record of nine-straight seasons with at least 10 Big South wins from 1999-08.

RADICAL

Radford sophomore **BLAKE SMITH** continues to lead the Big South in steals per game with 2.52. If he can maintain his position, he would be the first Highlander to lead the Big South in the category since **ANTHONY WALKER** in 1995-96, and would be the third Radford player overall.

ALL-TIME SCORERS

Five players have entered the Big South's 1,000 career point chart this season, most recently UNC Asheville's **J.P. PRIMM**, who become the 104th member on Feb. 3. The single-season record for most players entering the Conference's 1,000-point club is eight during the 2007-08 campaign. MR. SAND MAN

Liberty junior guard **JESSE SANDERS** -- the only player in Big South history with 500 career rebounds (553) and 400 career assists (464), is 16th in the nation with 6.03 assists per game and is just one of two players in the country this season averaging at least 6.0 assists and 6.0 rebounds (6.1) a contest (Texas Southern forward **KEVIN GALLOWAY** is the other). If Sanders can maintain his averages, he would become the first player in Big South history to average 6.0 assists and 6.0 rebounds in the same season.

NOTHING MARGINAL ABOUT THIS

Coastal Carolina owns a +15.6 scoring margin this season, which is pacing way ahead of the Big South single-season record of +13.7 set last year by the Chanticleers. Coastal has won 14 of its 25 games by at least 18 points, including eight Big South games. The Chants' +12.4 scoring margin in League contests this season is just behind last year's average of +12.9.

MID-MAJOR MADNESS

Coastal Carolina was ranked No. 3 in the *Collegeinsider.com* Mid-Major Top 25 poll last week, its highest ranking of the season. The Chanticleers also received one first-place vote. It is the highest ranking for a Big South member since Winthrop was ranked No. 2 during the final five weeks of the 2006-07 season. The Big South Conference has had a team ranked in the 12-year-old Mid-Major Top 25 poll the last seven consecutive seasons. JUNIOR 15

UNC Asheville juniors **MATT DICKEY** and **J.P. PRIMM** have scored at least 15 points in the same game 11 times this season, with the Bulldogs going 7-4 in those games. The losses have been to nationally-ranked North Carolina and Georgetown, as well as a two-point double-overtime loss at USC Upstate and a one-point setback against Northeastern in the Sears BracketBusters. The duo has reached the 15-point threshold in the same game 16 times since arriving on campus in 2008-09, and Asheville is 11-5 in those games.

JOHN WILLIAMS' BUILDING BLOCKS

UNC Asheville redshirt-senior **JOHN WILLIAMS** is just the third player in Big South history with 1,000 career points, 600 career rebounds and 200 career blocked shots. With career totals of 1,092 points, 637 rebounds and 237 career blocks (third all-time in Big South history), Williams joins Liberty's **PETER ALUMA** (1,715 points, 682 rebounds, 366 blocks) and Radford's **TYRONE TRAVIS** (1,313 points, 718 rebounds, 215 blocks) in this elite group. Williams also is one of 26 players in League annals with 1,000 points and 600 rebounds.

SCOREBOARD WATCHING

VMI leads both the Big South and the nation in scoring offense at 88.8 points a game, and is attempting to finish as the country's top scoring offense for an unprecedented fifth-straight year. VMI led the nation in scoring offense in 2009-10 for the fourth consecutive season, becoming the first team in NCAA Division I history to lead the country in scoring offense four consecutive years. The Keydets are also looking to become the first Conference member to lead the Big South in scoring five consecutive years. VMI (2006-present) and Radford (1995-99) are the only programs to lead four-straight seasons.

BIG SOUTH SEPARATION

Of the 79 Big South games this season, 46 had winning margins of less than 10 points (=58.2 percent), including 20 that were decided by three points-or-less. However, the Conference season currently has an average margin of victory of 10.56 points. Last year, the overall margin of victory in League play was 10.51 points, while the 2008-09 average margin was 8.96 points. Meanwhile, in the 33 Big South games decided by double digits this season, the average margin of victory was 18.67 points, while the 46 games decided by less than 10 points had an average victory margin of 4.74 points.

MEANWHILE...

The road teams still have the upper hand over their home counterparts when winning in Conference this season, as visiting squads own an average margin of victory of 11.13 points in their 32 Big South wins. The home teams have won their 47 League games by an average margin of 10.17 points.

ELLIS NOTCHES 11TH CAREER 20-WIN SEASON IN DIVISION I

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** has recorded his 11th career 20-win season at the Division I level, and 14th overall. The 10th active coach and 26th overall to win 600 career Division I games, Ellis has directed four different Division I programs to at least two 20-win campaigns during his tenure, and owns six seasons with at least 25 wins. Ellis is 611-382 at the Division I level and 689-394 overall in 35 years as a head coach, including 77-45 (=63.1 percent) in four seasons at Coastal Carolina. He has been named Coach of the Year in four difference Conferences (Sun Belt, ACC, SEC, Big South) as well.

PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE SCORES BCS DOUBLE

Presbyterian College is the second team in Big South Conference history to defeat an SEC team and ACC team in the same season, as the Blue Hose did it in back-to-back games! PC first knocked off the Auburn Tigers, 62-59, on Dec. 18 and then won at Wake Forest, 66-64 on Dec. 20. Former (and future) member Campbell was the first Big South member to achieve the feat. In 1993-94, the Camels defeated North Carolina State (72-69) and South Carolina (73-72).

BIG SOUTH TIEBREAKING PROCEDURE

Seeding of teams for the Big South Tournament will be based on Conference win-loss record. The following tiebreaker shall be applied to determine seeding:

TWO-WAY TIES

(a) Records in head-to-head competition are compared with the higher seed going to the team that has won the most games against the other.

(b) In the event step "a" does not resolve the tie (i.e. if the two teams split during the regular season), then the records of the tying teams against the No. 1 seed shall be compared. The team with the better record against the No. 1 seed shall gain the higher seed.

(c) The process outlined in step "b" shall continue through the last place team, if necessary.

(d) In the event that the tie cannot be broken, the seeding shall be determined by a coin toss.

MULTIPLE TIES

(a) Composite records between the tying teams will be evaluated to determine if one team has won more games against the other tying teams.

(b) In the event step "a" does not resolve the multiple ties or reduce the multiple ties to one tie, then a comparison of records of the tying teams against the No. 1 seed will occur. The team among the tying institutions with the better record against the top-seeded team will receive the highest seed.

(c) The procedure outlined in step "b" shall continue through the last place team, if necessary, until the seeding is complete.

(d) In the event this process does not resolve the ties, a coin toss will be the final alternative.

(e) If the multiple ties are reduced to a tie between two teams, the two-way tiebreaker formula will be utilized.

FEBRUARY'S BEST

VMI's **AUSTIN KENON** is the Big South's leading scorer in the month of February this season, as he is averaging 21.0 points in six games this month. He was also the Conference's leading scorer in the same span last season (22.3 ppg). Liberty's **JOHN BROWN** is averaging a League-high 11.8 rebounds this month, one of three players pulling down double-digit boards a game in February. High Point's **SHAY SHINE** is the League's top shooter thus far in the month of February, as he is making 55.0 percent of his field goals (44-of-80), including a Conference-best 53.7 percent from three-point range (22-of-41). Presbyterian College's **JAKE TROYLI** is tops at the charity stripe with a 95.2 clip (20-of-21).

On the team side, Gardner-Webb is allowing just 59.2 points a game this month, as well as a League-low 30.5 percent from beyond the arc. Coastal Carolina is making a Conference-best 47.6 percent from the field this February, in addition to holding opponents to a League-low 36.4 percent from the field. Charleston Southern is tops this month in three-point shooting at 47.6 percent, just ahead of UNC Asheville's 47.3 clip from long range.

HOME COOKIN'

The 10 Big South men's basketball programs went a collective 37-9 at home this season in non-Conference games, a combined 80.4 winning percentage. The teams actually won the first 21 home games before High Point suffered a six-point loss to Hampton inside the Millis Center on Sunday, Nov. 28.

WORKING OVERTIME

Presbyterian College, Liberty, UNC Asheville and Winthrop have played a League-high four overtime games this season, the most by a Big South team since PC played five in 2009-10. Liberty and Presbyterian are 3-1 in their respective overtime games this season, while Asheville 2-2 in overtime contests. Winthrop is 1-3 in games needing extra time. Meanwhile, the Blue Hose have played 12 overtime games since 2008-09 -- 11 of which have been Big South games.

COASTAL CAROLINA STILL RECEIVING TOP 25 CONSIDERATION

BIG SOUTH OWNS THREE WINS OVER THE SEC, TWO OVER THE ACC

The Big South has enjoyed some monumental non-Conference success this season, as the League owns three wins over the SEC and two over the ACC. UNC Asheville (at Auburn), Coastal Carolina (at LSU) and Presbyterian College (at Auburn) won at SEC venues, giving the Big South Conference three wins against the SEC for the first time since 1993-94. That season, the Conference had wins over LSU and South Carolina (twice). Meanwhile, both Winthrop and Presbyterian College won at Wake Forest, the League's first multi-win season against the ACC since 2007-08. The Big South Conference has recorded wins over members from the Atlantic Coast Conference and the Southeastern Conference in the same season now for the third time in the last four years.

HEY YOU!! I KNOW YOU, I KNOW YOU!

Former Big South charter member Campbell University is rejoining the Big South Conference beginning in 2011-12, increasing the League's membership to 11. Campbell enjoyed a successful stint in the Conference, winning the 1992 Big South championship and becoming the League's first NCAA Tournament automatic bid recipient that year. The Camels appeared in a total of four Conference Championship games before departing for the Trans America Athletic Conference (TAAC) following the 1993-94 season.

BIG SOUTH TOURNAMENT TIDBITS

Since the Big South adopted its current home site Conference Tournament format in 2003, the home seeds are a combined 36-13 (=73.5 percent) in 49 possible home games. This total does not include games that were played on a neutral floor in 2003 (semifinals and finals) and 2006, 2007, 2008, 2009 and 2010 (semifinals).

In the quarterfinals, the home seeds are 23-9 (=71.9 percent) on their home courts after last year's top four seeds were all victorious in the same season for the third consecutive year.

The Chants quickly returned to their winning ways in the following game with a dominating 94-59 win over North Carolina Central. **CHAD GRAY** scored 25 points and grabbed six rebounds to help Coastal Carolina hold a 54-14 advantage in points in the paint. **DEXTER MOORE** earned his first start of the season and responded with 22 points and a career-high seven rebounds ... The Chanticleers lead the Big South with 15.9 assists per game and have posted more assists than their opponents in 16 of their last 18 games.

GARDNER-WEBB

The Runnin' Bulldogs have surpassed last season's win total overall ... Gardner-Webb ended the nation's longest win streak (22 games) with a 59-57 win at Coastal Carolina last Tuesday, its second tight game with the Chanticleers this season ... GWU has held nine consecutive opponents under their season scoring average ... Four of the GWU's last six losses have come by three points-or-less, including two in a row ... Gardner-Webb led OVC contender Tennessee Tech for much of the second half on Saturday before falling 60-58 in Cookeville.

HIGH POINT

NICK BARBOUR hit a shot with 2.2 seconds on the clock to lift HPU over Winthrop in double overtime last Tuesday. It was High Point's first 2OT game since a 92-87 loss to Radford on Feb. 23, 2005, and its first double-OT win since a 99-98 victory over Liberty on Feb. 16, 2002 ... High Point has won five of its last nine games against Winthrop, dating back to the 2007-08 season, including all four games at the Millis Center ... HPU went 9-5 at home during the regular season and is 21-6 at the Millis Center under head coach **SCOTT CHERRY** ... Barbour and **SHAY SHINE** have both scored in double figures in their last 13 games ... This past Saturday's game was the 99th meeting between High Point and Appalachian State, but the first since 1978. HPU leads the all-time series, 61-37.

LIBERTY

Liberty is looking to avoid losing three straight games for the first time this season ... Saturday's loss to Iona marks the first time Liberty has lost two-straight since falling to Texas Tech (79-71, Nov. 21) and USF (60-43, Nov. 23) ... With his 12-point performance against Iona on Saturday, sophomore **EVAN GORDON** surpassed 800 points for his Liberty career. The guard now has 805 points and is 26th on Liberty's all-time scoring list, 10 spots back of his father, **ERIC GORDON**, who resides in the 16th position with 1,154 tallies ... **JESSE SANDERS** could follow in Gordon's footsteps on Thursday, as the floor general needs five points to notch his 800th career point as a Flame.

PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE

PC used two huge three-pointers by **PIERRE MILLER** to defeat Radford in overtime, 52-49 on Feb. 15. Miller hit a long three to tie the game with 2.4 seconds left in regulation to send the game to overtime, and hit another three with four seconds left in overtime to give the Blue Hose a lead they would not relinquish ... The Blue Hose hosted Davidson in the Sears BracketBusters. PC was down 66-54 with 1:29 remaining in the game before going on a 9-2 run, sparked by two three-pointers by Miller to trail by just five with 45 seconds remaining. The Wildcats eventually pulled out the 71-65 victory, despite Miller's career-high 23 points.

RADFORD

After sitting out against Presbyterian College with an injury, **JAREAL SMITH** scored a game-high 18 points at William & Mary, while going 7-of-16 from the floor. He also added three rebounds and two assists in 34 minutes of action. Smith is averaging 18.4 points in his last five appearances.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville finishes up the regular season with three games in five days. The Bulldogs need wins in all three games to clinch third-place in the Big South Conference standings ... Last week was not a good one for Asheville, as the Bulldogs blew two double-digit halftime leads and lost both games to fall to 13-13 on the year ... The Bulldogs have now lost their last three games when they led at halftime ... **J.P. PRIMM** moved into third-place on Asheville's all-time career list with 432 assists.

VMI

AUSTIN KENON scored a career-high 39 points in the 79-69 win over Liberty. Kenon also matched his career-high of eight three-pointers and went 7-of-10 from behind the arc in the second half and hit a string of five straight treys during the stretch. He scored 35 of his 39 points in the final 24:40 of the game en route to his third 30+ point game of the year. Kenon became the fifth player in VMI history to score 39 or more points in a game ... **D.J. COVINGTON** has scored in double figures in four-straight games, averaging 13.8 points over that span ... Last week's Radford and Liberty wins and the Morgan State game marked the first time that VMI allowed fewer than 70 points in three-straight Division I games since the last three games of the 2004-05 season.

WINTHROP

Winthrop lost two games last week in overtime, losing in 2OT at High Point (70-69) and then falling at home to Ohio in OT (77-74) in the Sears BracketBusters ... Nail biters have become the norm for Winthrop over the past month as six of eight games have gone down to the final possession. Winthrop is 2-4 in those six contests ... **REGGIE MIDDLETON** scored his 21 points at High Point in the second half and both overtimes. He is averaging 17.5 points over the last four games ... **CHARLES CORBIN** had his eighth double-double of the year with a 17-point, 15-rebound performance at High Point. He followed that with 15 points vs. Ohio, and has now scored in double figures in 11-straight games and in all 13 games in which he has started.
