The Highlanders went 10-2 over the 10-day trip which included winning their first eight games and recording a nine-game winning streak, the second longest away from home streak in program history ... Week two had several highlights with HANNAH OJEDA getting things going matching a school record with six RBI in game one against Toledo ... From the leadoff spot, Ojeda 2-for-2 with a triple, two walks and sac fly ... Sophomore MORGAN EVE made an immediate impact over the two weeks. After being inserted a regular starter to begin the trip, Eye rattled off a seven-game hitting streak in the first seven games and capped it off with a four-RBI performance against UConn ... JACKIE JENKINS was Radford's workhorse in the circle as she pitched more innings last week (22.1) than she did all of last season (20.2) and 30.1 innings during the entire trip.
