She went 13-for-22 with five multi-hit games, including 4-for-4 in a 9-0 win vs. Delaware, finishing the game with five RBI. Beall scored six runs, stole three bases and was walked twice last week. On the defensive side, she tallied 22 putouts and 12 assists. With Beall's play, she was named the Radford Invitational Offensive MVP (10-16, 4 doubles, 1 HR and 8 RBI in the tournament).

Charleston Southern competed against 2010 NCAA Tournament competitor East Carolina Tuesday in Greenville, N.C. ... The Buccaneers were no-hit by ECU's Tony Paisley in game one, a 4-0 setback ... It marked the first time CSU had been held hitless since March 31, 2010 at Coastal Carolina ... The Bucs dropped their fifth game in a row with a 3-0 loss in game two ... Junior **MEGAN LOMBARD** hit a double at East Carolina, the 30th of her career, moving Lombard into a tie with **MEGAN HALL** for fifth all-time at CSU ... **JANA MATTHEWS** is currently third at CSU with 16 career homers, followed by Lombard with 15 and Erin Kegley with 14... the Bucs will play at Campbell Tuesday, followed by a three-game home series against Elon Thursday and Friday ... CSU will take on Elon to open an eight-game home stand, the longest of the season ... CSU has gone 3-4 against Campbell under Head Coach **SHANE WINKLER**.

NICHOLE BEALL was named the tournament's Most Valuable Offensive Player and JACKIE JENKINS was tabbed the co-most valuable pitcher ... The Highlanders recorded three shutouts and allowed just four runs over the five-game tournament.

Junior **TAYLOR WRIGHT** is still in search of her 100th career hit as she went 0-for-7 last week ... She is currently at 98 and is off to a slow start at 10-for-50 for a .200 average in 22 games. It was a rough week for the Eagle Softball team going 1-6 including six straight losses before defeating Dartmouth on Sunday, 4-3 ...
