

CSU reached 29 wins for the first time since the 2000 season, when the Bucs took second in the Conference at 31-31-1. COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina won an unprecedented fifth-straight Big South Tournament Championship, going through the event undefeated for a second-straight year. Coastal won its 12th Big South Tournament title overall. Add in four runner-up finishes and Coastal has played in the title game 16 of the 23 Big South Tournaments held ... Coastal Carolina also won its fifth-straight Big South regular-season title, its sixth in seven years and 14th overall ... Coastal Carolina will be making its 11th NCAA Regional appearance, its fifth-straight and 10th over the last 11 years (its only absence coming in 2006 when Coastal finished 30-27 and was third in the Big South) ... Coastal Carolina has won at least 40 games for the 12th time in GARY GILMORE's 16 years at the helm. The Chants have done so in each of the last five years and 12 of the last 14 ... ANTHONY MEO threw the first no-hitter in Big South Tournament history as the Chanticleers defeated Radford, 5-0, in CCU's opening game of the Conference postseason. He retired the first 16 batters he faced, struck out nine and walked one. In doing so, Coastal swept Radford in 2011 and did not allow a run in any game against the Highlanders, winning 8-0, 15-0, 10-0 and 5-0 ... KEITH HARDWICK was named the Big South Tournament MVP after hitting .429 batting average with four clutch RBI ... Coastal's pitching staff allowed just nine runs in four Tournament games and did not allow a run in 31 of 36 innings played ...
