La Stella batted .667 (10-15) with six runs scored, seven RBI, two doubles, one triple and three home runs in four games last week. He reached base safely in his first nine at-bats (six hits and three walks) to open the week, and led Coastal to a 6-5 win at The Citadel with a 3-3 effort at the plate, plus a double, home run and three RBI. La Stella went 3-3 with two home runs and 3 RBI in the Chanticleers' series-opening win at UNC Asheville, and followed with a double, walk and stolen base in game two against the Bulldogs. He concluded the series 3-6 on Sunday with a run scored and an RBI-triple. For the week, La Stella walked four times, had one stolen base and recorded a .737 on-base percentage and a 1.533 slugging percentage.

He tossed a season-high 8.0 innings and scattered five hits (one extra-base hit) and allowed only one run with no walks and four strikeouts in snapping the Eagles' four-game losing streak. After allowing a leadoff single in the first inning, Lake retired the next 12 batters and eventually held the Flames to a .185 batting average en route to his first win of the season. Charleston Southern's series sweep of Radford this past weekend was its first Big South Conference series sweep in six years. The last time was in 2005 when the Bucs swept UNC Asheville ... The Bucs walked a season-high 10 times in game one vs. Radford on March 25 ... Catcher **TUCKER FRAWLEY** made his return to the lineup, serving as the DH at The Citadel and starting behind the plate in the Saturday and Sunday Asheville games ... Coastal had its 36-game regular-season Big South win streak snapped Saturday at UNC Asheville (Coastal had won the last 10 regular-season league games in 2009, all 25 in 2010 and the first one in 2011). Coastal lost two of three at Asheville, marking the first time Coastal has lost a series to the Bulldogs since 2003 ... **SCOTT WOODWARD**, already the Big South's all-time leader with 71 hit-by-pitches, is now fourth all-time in Big South history with 216 runs scored. In addition, he is 17 stolen bases away from breaking the all-time Conference record of 160. Radford struggled in its first weekend of Big South action, suffering its first three-game series sweep since last April 9-11 at home against Liberty. The Highlanders collected 31 hits and stole eight bases in the weekend series against Charleston Southern, but scored just 11 runs. **MATT HILLSINGER** led Radford offensively, going 7-14 in the series with three stolen bases and his fifth homer of the season in the series finale. Hillsinger is on pace to break the school's single-season stolen bases record (33), which was set in 2010 by **TYREN RIVERS** ... **CORY TURNER** hit in all three games of the CSU series to extend his hitting streak to a team-high 10 games ... **BOBBY BOLLING** pitched effectively in the series finale, going 7.1 innings, striking out four and allowing two earned runs without a walk ... Bolling has four quality starts this season (out of six total starts) ... Radford returns home from its six-game road trip on Wednesday to play the first home night game in program history, hosting Longwood at 6:00pm ... UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville went 2-2 last week, with a midweek loss to Southern Conference foe Appalachian State and a 2-1 series victory over Big South foe and No. 29 ranked Coastal Carolina. The Bulldogs fell to Coastal, 13-2, in the Friday game before winning Saturday and Sunday in walk-off fashion. It was a special series for freshman catcher **NICK COLLAZO**, who recorded the game-winning RBI in each victory. On Saturday, Collazo entered the game as a pinch-hitter with the bases loaded and two outs in the bottom of ninth and drew a walk to give Asheville the 3-2 victory. Then on Sunday in the bottom of the 12th, Collazo hit a two-out single with the bases loaded to give the Bulldogs a 7-6 victory ... The win on Saturday was the first for Asheville against the Chanticleers in nearly four years. Asheville's previous victory against CCU was on May 11, 2007. It was also the first series win against Coastal since the 2003 season ... Asheville will have five games this week, weather permitting, beginning on Tuesday with North Carolina A&T. The following day the Bulldogs will take on SEC opponent Tennessee in a game scheduled for 7:00pm in Knoxville, Tenn. WINTHROP

Winthrop went 1-4 this past week in contests played against the top-ranked Florida Gators as well as the Liberty Flames. The two-game midweek series against the Gators was the first game against a No. 1 team for the Eagles since falling 10-0 to the Florida State Seminoles on March 14, 2006 ... In the opener against Florida, **EDDIE ROHAN** hit his first home run of the season and now puts him in second all-time at Winthrop with 43 career home runs and tied for fourth in Big South history with Liberty's **STEVE WRIGHT**. Rohan needs just 11 home runs to break both records held by former Eagle **JASON COLSON**, who finished his career with 53 long balls. Rohan recently became the 30th player in Conference history with 50 career doubles and is currently tied for 13th with 426 career total bases ... In the midweek finale, **MATT PIERPONT** made his first start of the season and tossed a career-high 5.1 innings against the Gators ... **MATT LOBACZ** hit his first career home run at Winthrop and first of the season in the three-game opener against the Flames ... In the finale against Liberty, the Eagles scored a season-best seven runs in an inning which came in the top of the seventh ...
