Zebedis batted .444 (8-18) in four games last week, helping the Blue Hose to a 3-1 record - including a 4-3 win over nationally-ranked Clemson. He had two hits in each contest in addition to two doubles and one home run. Zebedis opened his week with a 2-5 day and two doubles against Clemson. His two-out, RBI-single in the second inning gave PC an early 1-0 lead over the Tigers. On Friday against High Point, Zebedis knocked in two runs with his Big South-leading sixth home run of the season that sealed the Blue Hose's 4-1 series-opening win. He then singled twice and scored a run on Saturday against the Panthers, and finished the series with a 2-4 effort on Sunday. For the week, Zebedis slugged .722, had a .444 on-base percentage, scored three times and knocked in three runs.

Dull led UNC Asheville to a Big South series-opening win over Gardner-Webb last Friday that ended the Runnin' Bulldogs' nine-game win streak in the process. He held the League's top-hitting team to just three hits in seven innings of work, and fanned nine while walking two in earning the victory. Gardner-Webb managed a .130 batting average against Dull and did not score against the righthander. Dull's line last week: 1-0, 0.00 ERA, 7 IP, 3 H, 0 R/ER, 2 BB, 9 SO, .130 opponents' batting average.

**CHARLESTON SOUTHERN**

The Bucs staged their biggest comeback since at least 2000 with their 15-13 win over USC Upstate. CSU came back from an 8-0 deficit for the win.

**COASTAL CAROLINA**

Coastal is in the midst of a season-long, nine-game road swing ... Coastal was swept by Pepperdine for the weekend and in a Saturday doubleheader. It marked the first time March 27, 2009 (at Hawai'i) the Chants were swept in a doubleheader, and the first time since April 18-22, 2009 (High Point, High Point, Clemson and College of Charleston) that Coastal lost at least three-straight games, and the first time since April 30-May 2, 2004 (at Miami, Fla.) that Coastal was swept in a three-game series versus the same opponent ... Despite dropping three games at Pepperdine, Coastal's pitching has been outstanding in March. CCU pitchers have a 1.62 ERA for March with 111 strikeouts and just 40 walks. Leading the way is **JOSH CONWAY**, who is 3-0 in three starts with a 1.00 ERA, striking out 22 in 18.0 innings with just four walks allowed. Fellow starters **JIM BIRMINGHAM** and **ANTHONY MEO** both have stellar ERAs for March as well, as Birmingham is at 1.02 in 17.2 innings and Meo is at 1.42 in 19.0 innings ... Out of the bullpen, **RYAN CONNOLLY** has a 1.80 ERA in seven appearances (10.0 innings), **MATT REIN** is at 0.96 in three appearances (one start), **KEITH HESSLER** is at 1.17 in five appearances with nine Ks and one walk, while **AARON BURKE** is at 1.23 in five appearances with 10 Ks and 1 walk ... **SCOTT WOODWARD** is the only Chanticleer to reach base safely (hit, walk or hit by pitch) in all 21 games this season. He leads the team in both hitting (.319) and on-base percentage (.490), thanks to 16 walks and being hit by nine pitches. He is also 15-of-16 in stolen bases with his lone "caught stealing" being a technicality of the rule book as he was leaning toward third and took a step when the pitcher back-picked to second (he was "caught stealing" since he was going to third and not back to second).

**GARDNER-WEBB**

Gardner-Webb has won 11 of its last 12 games and is 9-3 at John Henry Moss Stadium this season ... The Runnin' Bulldogs remain undefeated on the road (3-0) ... The squad is now 13-0 when holding a lead heading into the eighth inning ... Friday's loss to UNC Asheville snapped a nine-game win streak and was Gardner-Webb's first one-run loss in five games (4-1 record) this season ... GWU has been balanced offensively all season, as evidenced by eight different players driving in at least 11 runs so far in 2011 ... Junior lefty **KYLE PAELOW**'s 6.0 scoreless innings on Sunday marked his best start of the season, as he helped stake GWU to a 16-0 lead ... The 'Dogs are now 6-3 vs. UNC Asheville since joining the Big South in 2009 ... GWU will host High Point next weekend. The teams have split the previous six league games played (3-3), with GWU taking the series in 2009 and High Point returning the favor last season.

**HIGH POINT**

High Point went 3-2 last week with wins over Appalachian State and VCU but dropped two out of three to Presbyterian College to open Big South play ... The midweek win over Appalachian State was the first win over the Mountaineers since 2002. **MURRAY WHITE IV** had five RBI in the rain-shortened six-inning game ... Sophomore **RYAN RETZ** had two home runs in the win over VCU, going 2-2 with three runs scored and five RBI ... In Saturday's loss to Presbyterian, the Panthers set a new single-game record with seven hit-by-pitches. The Panthers broke the record of six set last year against Richmond ... **SPENCER ANDREWS** pitched six innings of relief for the week, allowing just one hit with no walks and three strikeouts. He earned the win on Sunday against the Blue Hose.

**LIBERTY**

Liberty went 4-1 lastweek, splitting a midweek two-game series at Maryland and sweeping a Big South three-game series with Charleston Southern ... The Flames have won seven out of their last eight games ... Pitching keyed the week for the Flames. Liberty's three starting pitchers on the weekend, RHP **KEEGAN LINZA**, RHP **JOHN NIGGLI** and LHP **STEVEN EVANS** each pitched complete games, while reliever **GARRETT BAKER** entered the Flames 11-4 victory at Maryland with no outs and the bases loaded in the first inning and went on to shut down the Terps over eight innings, allowing only an unearned run ... In the weekend sweep of Charleston Southern, not only did the Liberty starting trio each go the distance, they held the Bucs to a combined four runs over the three games, a 1.33 ERA ... Linza started things on Friday night, pitching his second consecutive complete game in a 5-2 win. The RHP struck out a career-high 10 batters in the game. Niggli followed on Saturday, going the distance for the first time in a Liberty uniform in a 5-1 win. The junior did not allow a hit from the third inning until two away in the ninth inning. Sunday, Evans made it three-straight complete games, going the distance for the first time this season and the fifth time of his career. The senior LHP also struck out a career-high 12 in the 5-2 win ... Backing the strong pitching this week was RF **MICHAEL ROBERTSON**, who hit .412 with a home run, four RBIs and a team-high six runs scored during the five game stretch.

**PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE**

PC had a nine-game winning streak snapped by High Point on March 20. The streak included a 4-3 win over No. 14 Clemson on March 16.

**RADFORD**

Radford finished its homestand with a perfect 6-0 mark and a win streak standing at six games entering the week ... The Highlanders play their next six in a row away from home, and 10 of the next 11 games on the road ... Radford's new-look ballpark is set to open April 8-10, when the Highlanders host VMI ... In a series sweep of Cornell, the Highlanders got 8.1 innings from each of their three starters -- **EDDIE BUTLER**, **MARK PETERSON** and **BOBBY BOLLING** ... Butler leads the Highlanders with a 3-0 record and now has a 9-5 career mark, putting him just outside of the school's career top ten list for victories ... Peterson earned his first win on Saturday, and took a perfect game bid to the seventh inning, retiring the first 20 Cornell batters before allowing a double with two outs in the seventh ... Bolling had a career-long outing on Sunday, and retired 14 batters in a row after a leadoff triple to begin the game for Cornell. He matched a career-high with nine strikeouts. Radford's weekend starters have a combined 2.99 ERA while opponents are hitting .212 off the trio. The Highlanders only needed two total innings of relief work all weekend ... **CORY TURNER** extended his hitting streak to five games, going 4-9 during the weekend with 4 RBI ... **MATT MACK** was 4-4 in the series finale, and 5-12 over the weekend ... Seven of the 15 Radford runs against Cornell were scored with two outs.

**UNC ASHEVILLE**

UNC Asheville went 2-2 last week with a victory over Southern Conference foe Western Carolina on Wednesday and then went 1-2 against Big South Conference opponent Gardner-Webb in the League opener for both teams ... Asheville snapped a 10-game losing skid with its 6-2 victory over the Catamounts and then made it two in a row with a 3-2 win over the Runnin' Bulldogs in the series opener. GWU's offense would take over the final two games, exploding for 29 runs in the two contests. The Bulldogs are now 6-12 overall with a 1-2 mark in Conference play. Asheville is also 3-1 at home and 3-11 on the road ... The Blue & White will complete its 14-game road trip on Tuesday with a game at Appalachian State before coming home to the friendly confines of Greenwood Field for a three-game series with Conference foe Coastal Carolina set to begin on Friday.

**VMI**

**GRAHAM SULLIVAN** continues to blister the ball, as he now has a team-high nine-game hitting streak, during which he is hitting .432 ... **JUSTIN HESS** has also turned it around over the past nine games, as he is hitting .300 during that time after starting the year nearly 100 points lower ... **GEORGE PICCIRILLI** sparked VMI's lone win of the week with a career day Sunday, as he went 4-5 with a game-breaking three-run home run and two other extra base hits. The VMI first baseman went 6-14 during the three-game Winthrop series. **SAM ROBERTS** earned the save in that game, his first in nearly two years, and **JEREMY BROWN** pitched five innings, allowing just one run ... Brown's ERA, despite rising on Sunday, remains among the Big South's best at 1.08.

**WINTHROP**

Winthrop went 3-1 last week with a midweek victory against The Citadel, and a series win against VMI in its Big South opener ... The victory over the Bulldogs was the Eagles' first against them since a 12-9 win in Charleston on April 1, 2009, and snapped The Citadel's four-game winning streak in the series. It was also Winthrop's first midweek win in exactly one year. **TOMMY LAWRENCE** earned his third save of the season in the game, while **MATTEO D'ANGELO** earned the win in his first relief appearance of the season. **BRETT THOMAS** and **CAM WALTERS**, and sophomore **MATT LOBACZ**, all had an RBI each in the contest ... The Eagles have now won the series with the Keydets two years in a row, where Winthrop has won the first two games of the series before dropping the finale. The Eagle pitching staff allowed just two walks in 28.0 innings pitched in the VMI series, including none in the first two games. **EDDIE ROHAN** (13 games) and **TJ OLESCZUK** (12 games) saw both of their hitting streaks come to an end against the Keydets; Rohan went 0-5 in game two and Olesczuk 0-3 in game one ... **ERIC RUTH** earned his third win of the season in the series opener, all of which have come in relief outings ... The 10-inning contest in game two of the series was the first of the season for Winthrop and first since an 8-7 loss to Presbyterian in Rock Hill on May 2, 2010 ... **PATRICK GAMBLIN** recorded his first career walk-off base hit in the extra-inning affair with a single in the bottom of the tenth inning. It was the first walk-off hit for the Eagles since **TYLER COOK**'s RBI single lifted Winthrop to a 5-4 win over the Toledo Rockets on March 12, 2010 ... The Eagles will hit the road for five-straight games this week against the top-ranked Florida Gators (two) and Liberty Flames (three). It will be the first Big South road series of the season for Winthrop.
