The Blue Hose are off to the best record in their Division I era, racking up a 18-15 record thus far. The team's March 30th win over Wofford broke the Division I win record of 15 that PC set last year... Freshman **BRAD ZEBEDIS** leads the team in hits (57), doubles (14), RBI (33, tied with **TONY MICKLON**), home runs (nine, tied with Micklon), total bases (98), slugging percentage (.766) and on-base percentage (.500) ... PC captured its first-ever win over Tennessee with a 10-6 road victory over the Volunteers on Tuesday night ... The Blue Hose will play three more home games over the final 23 contests of the year. PC returns for a home series against Winthrop on May 6, playing 12 straight games on the road in the span between home games. A school record for home attendance, 1,085, was set on Friday before severe weather moved in and caused the suspension of the first game ... Weekends have been about double-dipping for the Highlanders in 2011, who played their fourth doubleheader in the last five weekends on Sunday ... The nine-run margin of victory for Radford in the series finale on Sunday was the most in a Big South game since an 11-run win over Presbyterian on May 8, 2010 ... Haitsuka is hitting .415 over that stretch ... **JUSTIN HESS** has also been hot, hitting .413 over those same 14 games. Hess is batting a stunning .463 in Conference play, including three home runs and 11 RBI ... From March 25 through April 10, a span of 10 games, Hess has raised his average from .265 to .323, a 58-point increase ... Haitsuka has also been solid in Conference, hitting .426 with a team-best 13 RBI ... **ALAN WATTS** earned VMI's lone win of the week, his second victory of the season, by pitching a season-high four innings against Radford in the series opener ...
