Quattlebaum batted .400 (8-20) with nine RBI in four road wins last week. He also had four doubles, three runs scored, a .400 on-base percentage and a .600 slugging percentage. He opened his week with a double and run scored in GWU's 3-2 win at Furman, before batting .438 (7-16) in the Runnin' Bulldogs' sweep of Radford. Quattlebaum went 4-6 with three RBI in the series opener -- including a two-run double with two outs in the top of the ninth that pushed Gardner-Webb to the eventual 11-10 victory. In the second game, he delivered a two-run, two-out double in the top of the seventh that provided the winning runs in the 5-4 win. Quattlebaum followed with four RBI in Sunday's finale -- including a three-run double in the third inning that put Gardner-Webb ahead for good.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal won at CAA-leading UNC Wilmington last Tuesday, 11-4 ... Coastal Carolina head coach **GARY GILMORE** is five wins shy of 900 for his 22-year career. His record stands at 895-420-2. Gilmore is 639-318 in 16 years at Coastal ... Coastal Carolina has reached the 30-win total for the 14th consecutive season ... Since playing the Texas Rangers in an exhibition on March 29, Coastal is 15-5 with a .311 batting average, 148 runs scored, 52 doubles, 20 HR and a .977 fielding clip. Five players have been key to the resurgence: **TOMMY La STELLA** (.466); **SCOTT WOODWARD** (.429); **DANIEL BOWMAN** (.355); **RICH WITTEN** (.338) and **KEITH HARDWICK** (.313) ... Woodward needs nine runs and nine stolen bases to tie the Big South career record in both categories ... Bowman hit his 10th home run of the season this past Saturday, becoming the eighth player in Big South history with three consecutive 10-home run seasons. Gardner-Webb is riding its second win streak of the season of at least eight games. GWU had a nine-game streak earlier in 2011 ... The Dogs will play four games this week against national top-25 opponents (North Carolina and Clemson) ... The team's RPI of 68 (according to boydsworld.com) is the highest ever for Gardner-Webb this late in the season, and ranks second in the League to Coastal Carolina (No. 41) ... GWU ranks among the national leaders in runs per game and batting average, and leads the Big South in nine major offensive categories as a team ... **DUSTY QUATTLEBAUM** ranks second nationally in doubles (23), and is seven away from tying **BLAKE LALLI** for the team's single-season record. The Big South single-season record for doubles is 28 (accomplished twice) ... GWU is 10-2 this season in one-run games and is now 26-1-1 when leading after the eighth inning ... He becomes the third Liberty player to hit two home runs in a game this season ... **MATT WILLIAMS** hit his fifth home run of the season, leading off the 12th inning for a walk-off, 3-2 win over Le Moyne on Friday ... LHP **STEVEN EVANS** moved into second-place on Liberty's career strikeout list during Friday's game. Evans, who did not figure in the decision, struck out eight batters to reach 244 for his career. **MIKE BROWN** holds the Liberty career mark with 287 strikeouts from 1994-97 ... **AUSTIN TAYLOR** provided the game-winning run with a home run in the seventh inning in a 3-2 victory over New Orleans on Saturday ... RHP **DANE BEAKLER** pitched a complete game in the win. Beakler, who was making his first start since May 16, 2006 against Richmond, did not allow a runner to reach base after New Orleans tied the game in the fifth inning. He retired the last 14 batters he faced in the contest ... Cordell and **ZACH HALEY** each had three hits in Liberty's 5-2 victory Sunday over New Orleans. Cordell went 3-3 in the contest for the first three-hit game of his career ... RADFORD

After winning four-straight Big South weekends and eight League games in a row entering the Gardner-Webb series, Radford lost a Big South series for the first time since the Charleston Southern set March 25-26 ... The Highlanders were last swept in a three-game home series at Liberty April 9-11, 2010 ... Radford finished the month of April 11-7 and 10-4 in the League. **MATT MACK** finished as the April batting champion at .420 (29-69) in 18 games. **ALEX GUERRA** had 25 RBI in April. **BOBBY BOLLING** and **EDDIE BUTLER** posted 3-0 April records ... **RYAN BURGESS** continued a 14-game hitting streak through Sunday's action, the longest streak for a Radford player in 2011.
